Invites applications for the Carrole Guntley Scholarship

The Carrole Guntley Scholarship is open to workers in the Jamaican Hospitality and Tourist Industry who are seeking to complete a Bachelors degree in Hospitality and Tourism Management.

Requirements

- Be a Jamaican between the ages of 20-50 years old.
- Possess a minimum of three (3) years working experience in the Jamaican Tourist Industry, preferably with at least one (1) year at the supervisory level.
- Demonstrate leadership skills and involvement in the community activities.
- Be accepted by the institution of choice at the time of the Scholarship interview.

Conditions of the Scholarship

- Be willing to be bonded to work in the Jamaican Industry for a period of three (3) years.
- Must maintain a B+ average to be eligible for continuing support.
- Be prepared to pursue a foreign language course over the life of the Scholarship.

The Scholarship covers:

- Tuition - as prescribed by the institution
- Books - as prescribed by the institution
- Maintenance allowance - as prescribed by the institution

All up to a maximum of JA\$1.5 million over the lifespan of the Scholarship

Send application letter, accompanied by detailed curriculum vitae, copy of TRN card, a passport sized photograph and two (2) letters of recommendation (at least one (1) of which should be from a Tourism Sector representative or employer)
