

## Divers find woman's body in ship in Italy

ROME, Italy (AP) — Italian Coast Guard divers have found a woman's body in a corridor of a submerged section of the capsized Costa Concordia, raising to at least 12 the number of dead in the cruise liner accident.

Coast Guard Commander Cosimo Nicastro told The Associated Press that the body, wearing a life jacket, was found in a narrow corridor near an evacuation staging point at the ship's rear yesterday.

The body was brought to Giglio, the Tuscan island where the cruise liner hit a reef and ran aground on January 14. Twenty people are missing.
