JAMAICA TOURIST BOARD

IN APRIL 2008.....

- Stopover arrivals up by 1.1%
- US Market up by 1.1%
- Canada increased by 11.9%
- Europe decreased by 0.2%
- Cruise Passenger arrivals down by 2.4%

TOURIST (Stopover Arrivals)

Stopover arrivals in April 2008 were **152,199**, an increase of **1.1%** over the **150,561** recorded in April 2007.

For the January to April period, arrivals increased by **10.1%** with **636,158** compared to **577,813** in 2007.

United States

Stopover arrivals from the United States market increased by **1.1%** in April with a total of **103,624** visitors compared to the **102,509** visitors who came in April 2007. With the exception of the Mid-west, all other marketing regions recorded increases. The Northeast increased by **3%**, the West by **2.7%**, and the South by **2.1%**, the Midwest declined by **6%**.

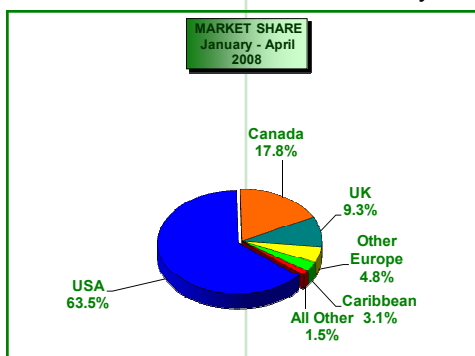
For the January to April period, the US market has recorded an increase of **8.5%**. This is a reversal from the **13%** decline recorded during the same period in 2007 compared to 2006. Total visitors from this market was **404,233** compared to **372,696** in 2007. All marketing regions recorded increases. The South increased by **10.4%**, The Northeast by **9.1%**, the West by **8.8%**, and the Midwest by **5.4%**.

Canada

In April, the Canadian market grew by **11.9%**. Total stopovers from Canada were **20,248** compared to **18,092** in April 2007.

The leading province of Ontario increased by **9.9%**, while the second most important visitor-producing province of Quebec increased by **37.2%**. Increases were also recorded for the provinces of British Columbia up by **25.4%**, New Brunswick up by **18.7%** and Newfoundland up by **82%**.

Cumulatively, the Canadian market continued on its remarkable growth trend recording an increase of **26.8%** in the January to April period with a total of **112,919** stopovers compared to **89,070** in 2007. The top visitor producing provinces of Ontario with **64,372** and Quebec with **17,077** increased by **23.9%** and **29.7%** respectively. The provinces of Alberta, Saskatchewan and British Columbia increased by **25.6%**, **85.6%** and **13.8%** respectively.



Europe

The European market recorded a **0.2%** decline in April 2008. The market provided a total of **21,445** stopover visitors compared to the **21,490** recorded in April 2007. In the Northern European market region the main visitor producing country, United Kingdom with **15,295** arrivals increased by **1.2%**. In the South/Western Europe region the main visitor producing countries, Germany with **1,516** increased

by **18.8%** and Italy with **1,222** declined by **15.3%**. From the third market region, Central/East Europe with **419** arrivals, increased by **76.1%**.

For the January to April period, the European market declined by **0.5%**, Total stopovers was **90,044** compared to **90,467** in 2007. From the Northern European market region **62,041** arrivals decreased by **0.2%**. From the South/Western Europe region, **24,637** arrivals declined by **5.1%**. From the third market region, Central/East **3,366** arrivals increased by **42.7%**.

Latin America

The Latin American market increased by **42.3%** in April with a total of **1,079** stopovers compared to **758** in April 2007. From the Central American region a total of **616** arrivals increased by **49.5%**. From South America, **463** arrivals increased by **33.8%**.

Cumulatively, for the January to April period, the Latin American market increased by **56%** with a total of **4,965** visitors compared to **3,182** for the corresponding period in 2007.

The Caribbean

Visitors to Jamaica from the Caribbean region declined by **10.3%** in April with a total of **4,780** visitors, compared to **5,327** in April 2007.

The major Caribbean countries which provided visitors to Jamaica in April were: the Cayman Islands (**1,571**), Trinidad and Tobago (**711**), Barbados (**441**), Bermuda (**435**) the Bahamas Is. (**211**), and Antigua (**182**).

Cumulatively, the Caribbean stopover arrivals to Jamaica in the January to April period increased by **15.6%**, moving from **16,933** in 2007 to **19,576** in 2008. The Cayman Islands is the leading provider of visitors to Jamaica from the Caribbean region. In the period under review, they provided a total of **6,034** visitors followed by Trinidad & Tobago with **3,379**, Barbados with **1,597** and the Bahamas Is. with **1,336** visitors.

Asia

The Asian market declined by **43.2%** in April with a total of **553** stopovers compared to **974** in April 2007.

The major Asian countries which provided visitors to Jamaica in April were: Japan (**259**) down **7.5%**, India (**70**) down **82.4%**, and China (**71**) up **4.4%**.

Year-to-date, January to April the Asian market declined by **0.5%** with **2,559** arrivals compared to **2,572** arrivals in 2007.

Other Countries

Of the other countries, Australia with **200** declined by **76%** and Israel with **116** increased by **22.1%** in April against the **835** and **95** respectively who came in 2007.

Market Share

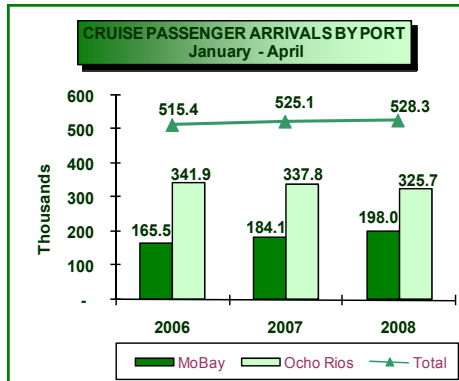
The market share of stopover visitors for the year-to-date period, January to April was as follows:

USA **63.5%**; Canada **17.8%**; UK **9.3%**; Continental Europe **4.8%**, the Caribbean **3.1%**; Latin America **0.8%**; Asia **0.4%** and Other Countries **0.3%**.

Cruise Passengers

A total of **110,838** cruise passengers visited Jamaica in April 2008. This represented a **2.4%** decrease against the **113,524** recorded for April 2007.

Cumulatively, a total of **528,259** cruise passengers visited our shores in the January to April period, an increase of **0.6%** against the **525,146** recorded for the corresponding period in 2007.



A total of **67,471** cruise passengers visited the port of Ocho Rios in April, a decline of **10.9%** over the **75,726** recorded for April 2007.

For the January to April period, cruise passenger arrivals to the port of Ocho Rios was **325,714**, a decline of **3.6%** against the **337,779** recorded for the corresponding period in 2007.

Montego Bay recorded a total of **42,230** cruise passengers for the month, an increase of **13.9%** against the **37,084** recorded for 2007.

Year-to-date, January to April period, cruise passenger arrivals to the port of Montego Bay was **197,980**, an increase of **7.5%** against the **184,141** recorded for the corresponding period in 2007.

Length of Stay

The average length of stay of **Foreign National** arrivals in April was **8.1** nights compared to the **8.4** nights in April 2007. The average length of stay in hotels was **6.6** nights the same level as in April 2007.

Cumulatively, the average length of stay for the January to April period was **8.6** nights as against the **9.1** nights recorded in 2007. In hotels the average length of

stay during the period under review was **6.9** nights compared to **7** nights during 2007.

The average length of stay of **Non-Resident Jamaican** arrivals in April was **15.6** nights compared to the **14.2** nights in April 2007. The average length of stay in hotels was **9.1** nights compared to **6.8** nights in April 2007.

Cumulatively, the average length of stay for the January to April period was **16.3** nights as against the **15.8** nights recorded in 2007. In hotels the average length of stay during the period under review was **8.7** nights compared to **7.6** nights during 2007.

Purpose of Visit

Year-to-date, January to April 2008, **80.1%** or **476,856** of the **595,468** Foreign Nationals who visited Jamaica were visiting for the purpose of Leisure, **6.2%** were on Business, **7.4%** were Visiting Friends & Relatives, and the remaining **6.3%** were on Other purposes of travel.

A total of **13,798** or **33.9%** of the **40,690** Non-Resident Jamaicans who travelled to Jamaica in January to April 2008 were visiting for Leisure, **31.5%** were visiting Friends & Relatives, **8.6%** were on Business and the remaining **26%** were on Other purposes of travel.

Intended Resort Area of Stay

Of the **636,158** stopover arrivals visiting Jamaica year-to-date, January to April 2008, the resort area of Montego Bay welcomed **180,058** arrivals or **28.3%**. Ocho Rios received **166,189** or **26.1%**, Negril got **134,351** or **21.1%**, and Kingston got **72,101** or **11.3%**. The remaining **13.2%** stayed in the Mandeville/Southcoast, Port Antonio resort regions and Other areas in Jamaica.

Type of Airlines used

Of the **636,158** stopover arrivals visiting Jamaica year-to-date, January to April 2008, **515,412** or **81%** used scheduled airlines, while **120,746** or **19%** used chartered flights.

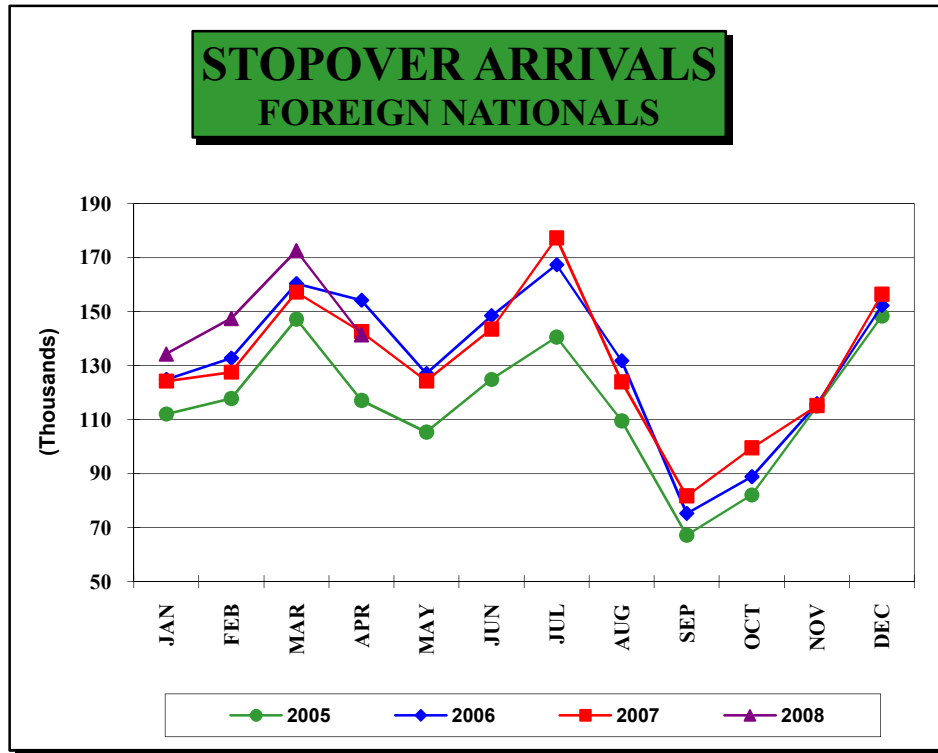

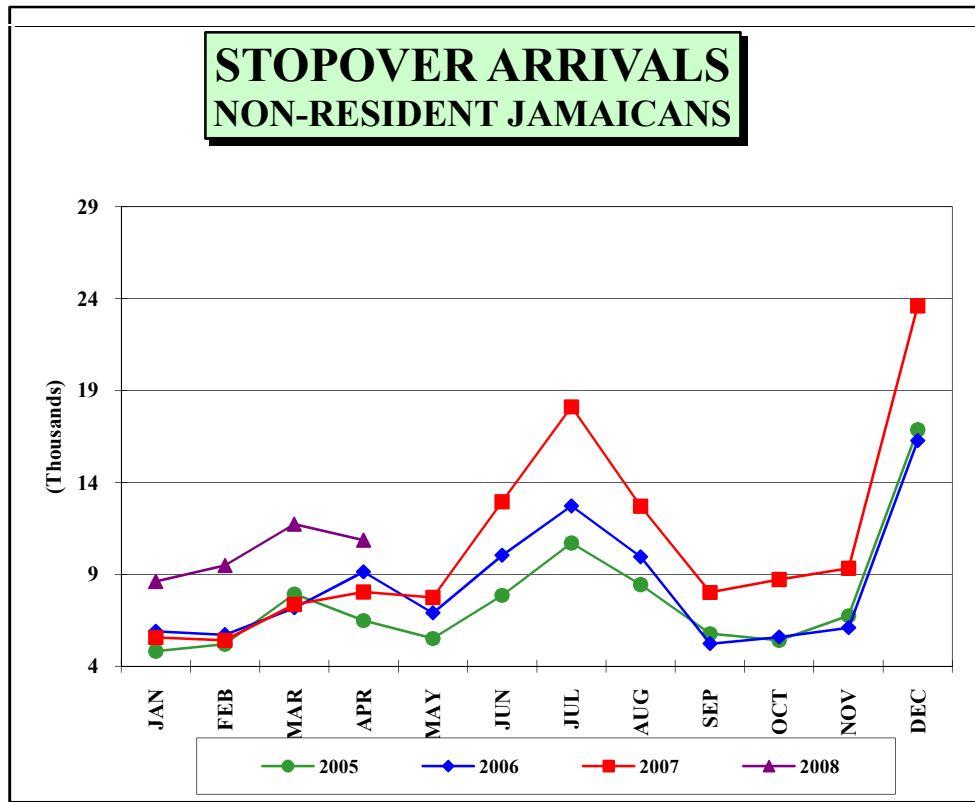

2008**

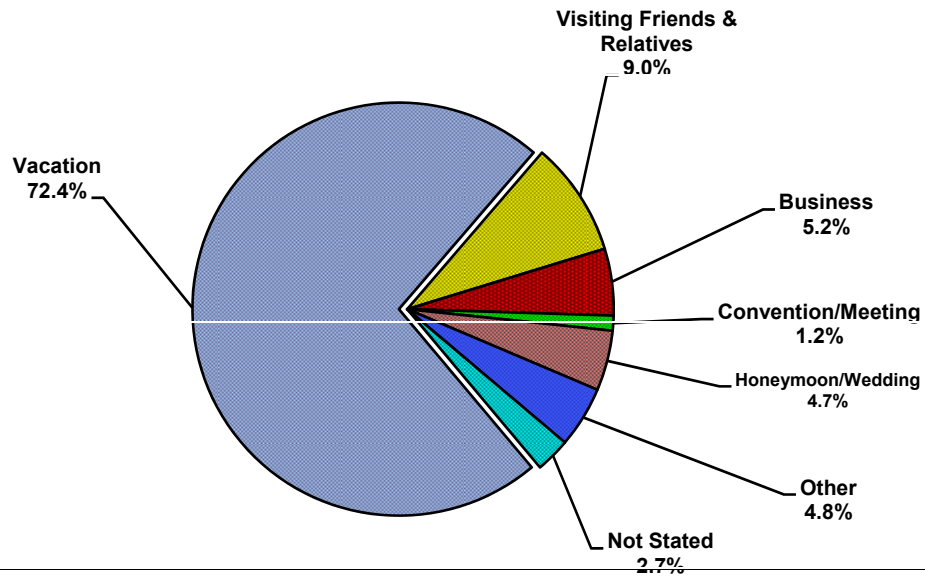

STOPOVER VISITORS BY MARKET SHARE

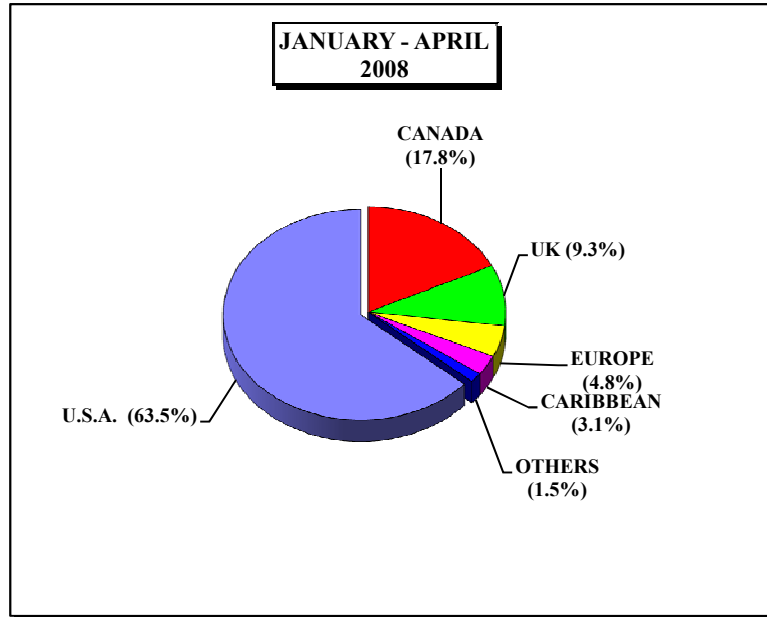

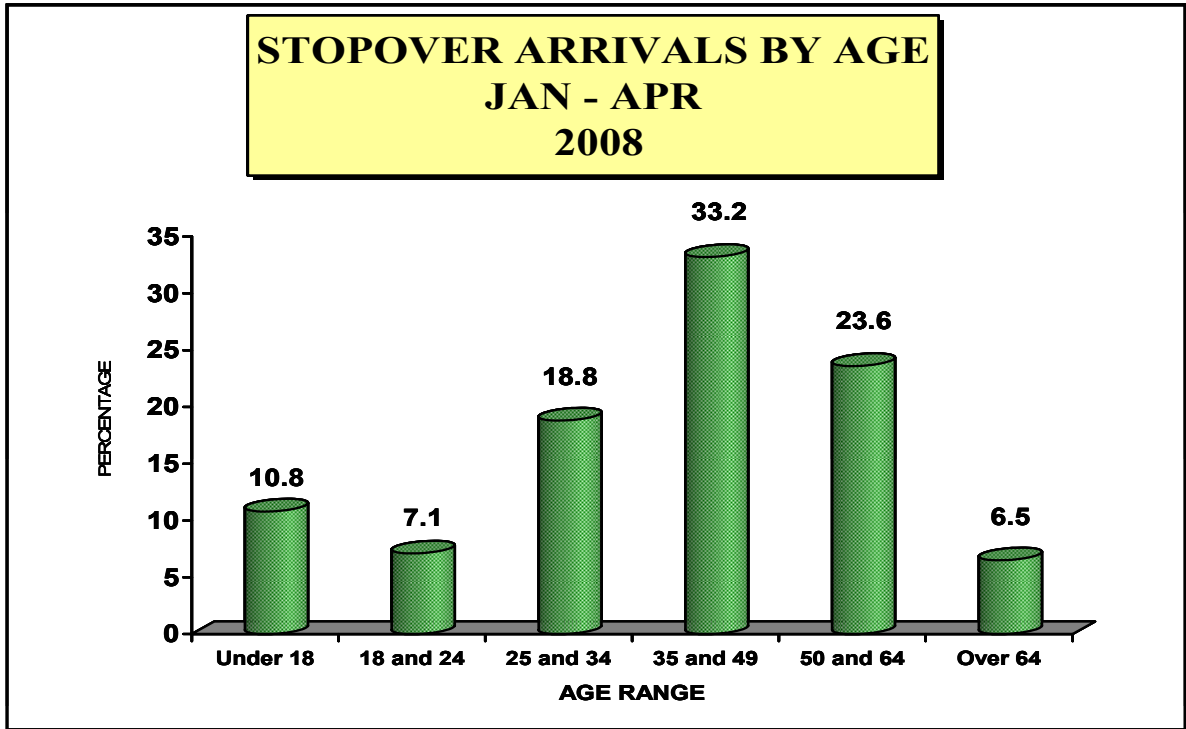

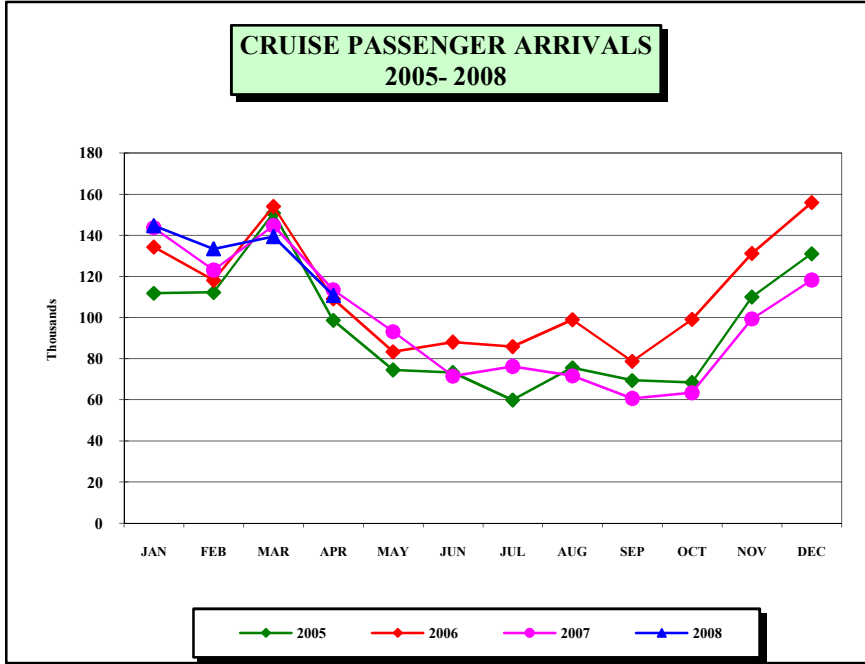

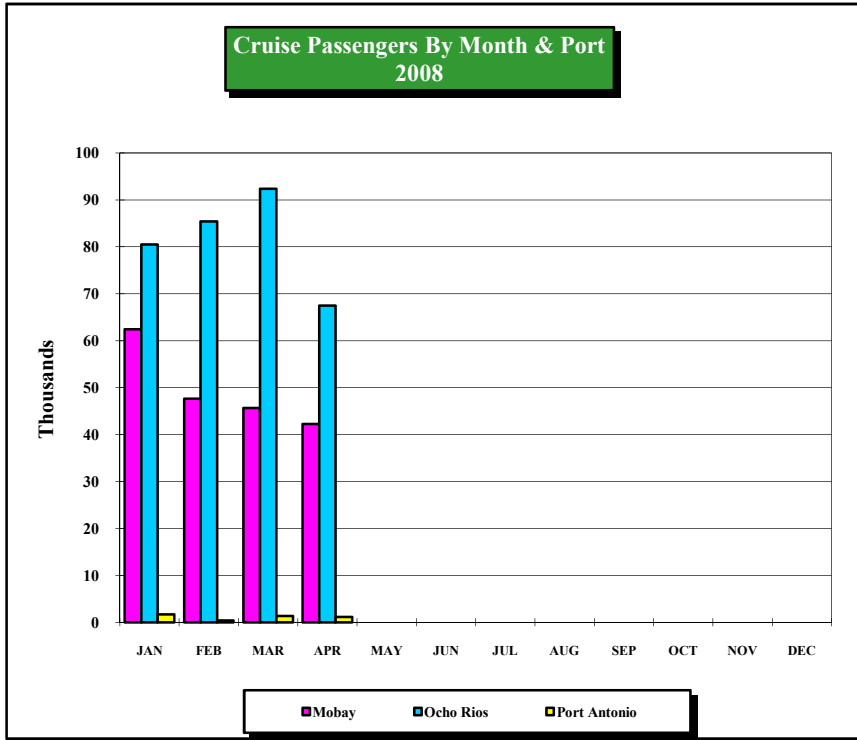

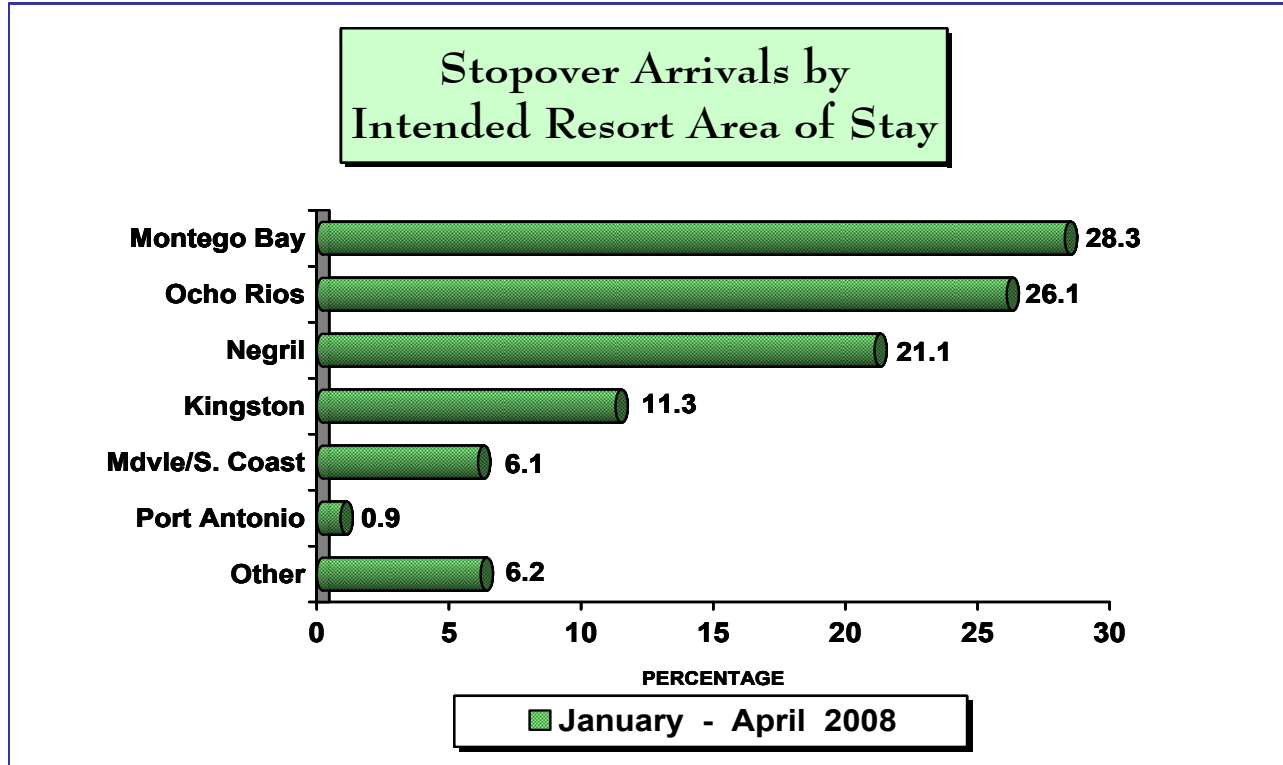
