- Stopover arrivals up by 7.5%
- US Market down by 3.1%
- Canada up by 34.1%

TOURIST (Stopover Arrivals)

Stopover arrivals in April 2011 were **179,444**, an increase of **7.5%** over the **166,955** recorded in April 2010.

For the January to April period, arrivals increased by **5.1%**, with **732,748** compared to **696,889** in 2010.

with **110,447** and **29,870** visitors in 2011, increased by **22.6%** and **20.0%**, respectively.

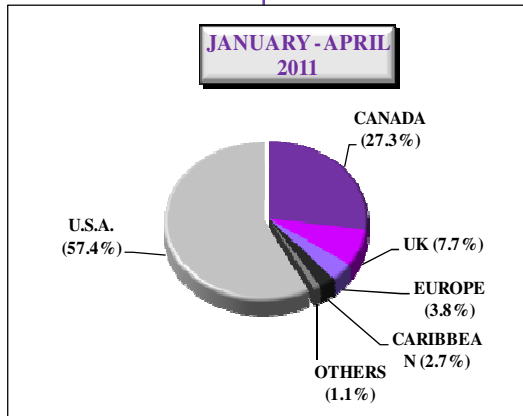
Europe

The European market recorded an increase of **26.5%** in April 2011. This market provided **21,558** stopover arrivals compared to the **17,037** recorded in April 2010.

United States

Stopover arrivals from the United States market recorded a **3.1%** decrease in April 2011 with a total of **111,730** arrivals compared to the **115,316** arrivals who visited in April 2010. The Northeastern region recorded a **1.3%** increase. The Western, Mid-Western and Southern regions recorded decreases of **6.1%**, **6.2%** and **8.1%**, respectively.

For the January to April period, the US market recorded a **1.5%** decrease, with **420,850** visitors compared to **427,320** in 2010. The Mid-West increased by **4.8%**, while the South, North-East and West decreased by **1.0%**, **4.3%** and **5.2%**, respectively.



In the Northern market, the main visitor-producing country, United Kingdom, with **15,293** visitors, arrivals rose by **32.8%**. In the South-Western European region, visitor arrivals rose by **9.9%** and those from Central-East Europe grew by **30.9%**.

For the January to April 2011 period, arrivals from the European market fell by **1.4%**. Total stopover arrivals were **84,107** compared to **85,303** in 2010. The Northern Europe market increased by **1.3%**, moving from **57,962** in 2010 to **58,688** in 2011. From the South/Western region, arrivals declined by **8.0%** and those from the Central/East region rose by **1.5%**.

Canada

In April 2011, the Canadian market recorded an increase of **34.1%**, with **37,644** Stopover arrivals compared to **28,079** in April 2010.

Stopover arrivals from the leading province of Ontario increased by **29.8%**, over April 2010 while those from the second most important visitor-producing province of Quebec increased by **34.5%**. All provinces had positive growth in tourist stopover arrivals during April 2011, with the exception of the Northwestern territories, which experienced a decline of **31.0%**.

Cumulatively, the Canadian market continued to grow in the January to April 2011 period with **25.3%** more visitors than in the corresponding period of 2010. Between January and April 2011, **199,787** Canadian visitors stayed in Jamaica, while only **159,428** stayed during the same period in 2010. The top visitor producing provinces of Ontario and Quebec,

Latin America

Arrivals from Latin America increased by **16.2%** in April 2011, with a total of **1,070** stopovers compared to **921** in April 2010. From the Central American region, stopover arrivals fell by **4.5%** and from the South American region they grew by **37.5%**.

Between January and April 2011, stopover arrivals from Latin America increased by **7.3%**. Central American stopovers increased by **9.7%** and those from South America also increased by **5.7%**.

The Caribbean

Stopover arrivals to Jamaica from the Caribbean region rose by **37.5%** in April 2011 with a total of **6,528** visitors, compared to **4,748** in April 2010.

The Cayman Islands and Trinidad and Tobago continued to be the major visitor producing Caribbean countries in April 2011 with **1,914** and **1,500** stopover arrivals, respectively.

Cumulatively, stopovers for January to April 2011 increased by **16.3%**, moving from **17,050** in 2010 to **19,831** in 2011.

Asia

The Asian market improved by **6.5%** in April 2011 with a total of **526** stopovers compared to **494** in April 2010. Japan, China and India continued to be the major visitor-producing countries with **181**, **136** and **117** stopovers arriving from each country, respectively.

For the January to April 2011 period, stopovers from Asia increased by **10.0%**, with **2,125** arrivals in 2011 compared to **1,931** in 2010.

Other Countries

Overall, stopover arrivals from other countries rose by **7.8%** in April 2011, with **388** arrivals in 2011 compared to **360** in 2010. Of the Other Countries, Australia provided the greatest percentage of stopover arrivals to Jamaica, with **150** visitors in April 2011 compared to **164** in April 2010. This represents an **8.5%** decrease over April 2010.

Market Share

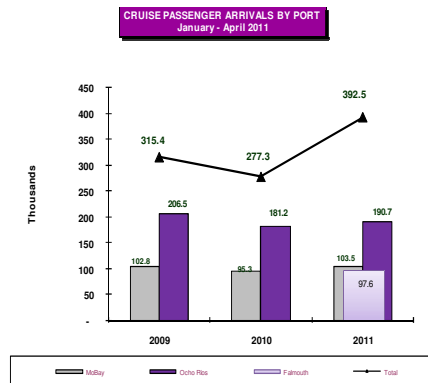
The market share of stopover visitors for April 2011 was as follows: USA **62.3%**; Canada **21.0%**; UK **8.5%**; Continental Europe **3.5%**, the Caribbean **3.6%**; and the others, including Latin America and Asia **1.1%**.

For the January to April 2011 period, the distribution of market shares for

the market regions, in the same order was: **57.4%**, **27.3%**, **7.7%**, **3.8%**, **2.7%** and **1.1%**

Cruise Passengers

A total of **100,977** cruise passengers visited Jamaica in April 2011. This represents an increase of **26.0%** over the **80,116** pas-



sengers recorded for April 2010.

For April 2011, Cruise passengers visiting the port of Ocho Rios decreased by **31.4%** and those visiting Montego Bay declined by **47.9%**. During the month of April, the Falmouth port received **50,836** arrivals from 14 calls.

The January to April 2011 period saw **392,530** cruise passengers arrivals at the three major ports, a **9.8%** increase over 2010.

Length of Stay

The average length of stay of **Foreign National** arrivals in January to April 2011 was **8.2** nights compared to **8.4** nights recorded in the same period of 2010. The average length of stay in hotels during the same period was **6.9** nights in 2011, the same figure recorded for January to April 2010.

The average length of stay of **Non-Resident Jamaican** arrivals between January and April 2011 was **14.2** nights compared to **14.7** nights in the corresponding period of 2010. The average length of stay in hotels during January to April 2011 was **7.7**, the same figure recorded for January to April 2010.

Non-Resident Jamaicans spent more time in all types of accommodation (including hotels) than Foreign nationals.

Purpose of Visit

In the January to April 2011 period, **89.3%** or **614,336** of the **688,033 Foreign Nationals** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **5.3%** were on Business, **3.9%** were on Other purposes of travel and **1.6%** did not state their purpose of travel.

A total of **29,058** or **65.0%** of the **44,715 Non-Resident Jamaicans** were visiting for Leisure, **6.9%** were on Business, **12.6%** were on Other purposes of travel and **15.5%** failed to provide a reason for travel.

Intended Resort Area of Stay

Of the **179,444** stopover arrivals visiting Jamaica in April 2011, the resort area of Montego Bay welcomed **56,258** arrivals or **31.4%**; Ocho Rios welcomed **39,763** or **22.2%**; Negril received **38,860** or **21.7%**, and **20,086** or **11.2%** visited Kingston. The remaining **13.5%** stayed in the Mandeville/South Coast, Port Antonio resort regions and Other areas in Jamaica.

Between January and April 2011, the pattern remained the same. Montego Bay, Ocho Rios, Negril and Kingston welcomed **642,952 (87.7%)** stopover arrivals. While the remaining **12.3%** visited the Mandeville/South Coast, Port Antonio and other regions.

Type of Airlines used

Of the **732,748** stopover visitors to Jamaica in January to April 2011, **658,512** or **89.9%** used scheduled airlines, while **74,236** or **10.1%** used chartered flights.

During the corresponding period in 2010 the percentage distribution was: Scheduled flights— **84.0%** and Chartered flights— **16.0%**.

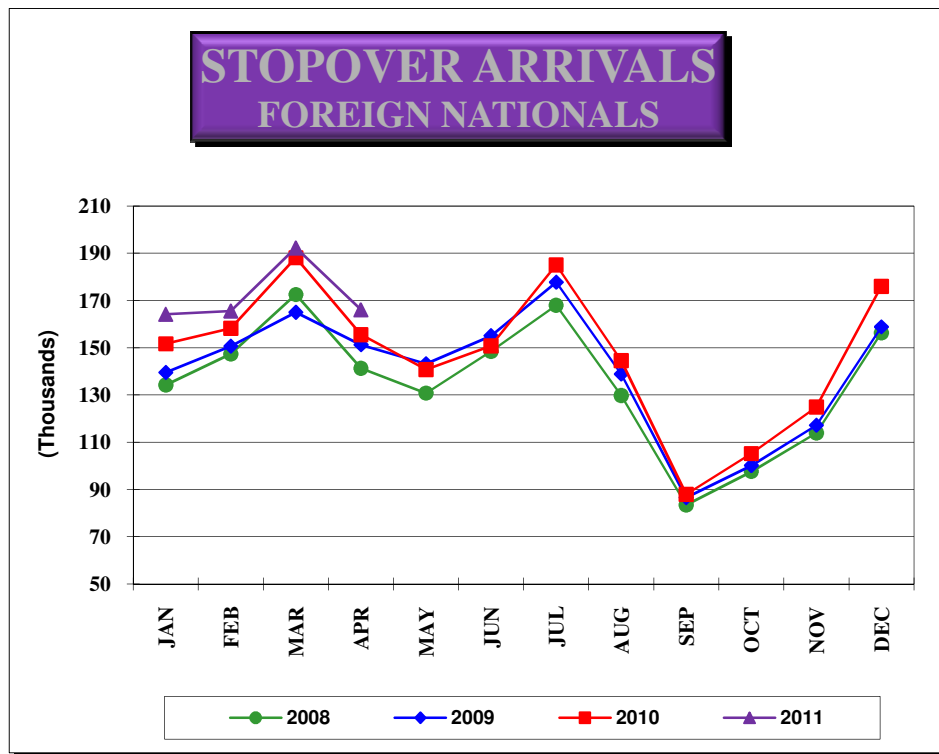

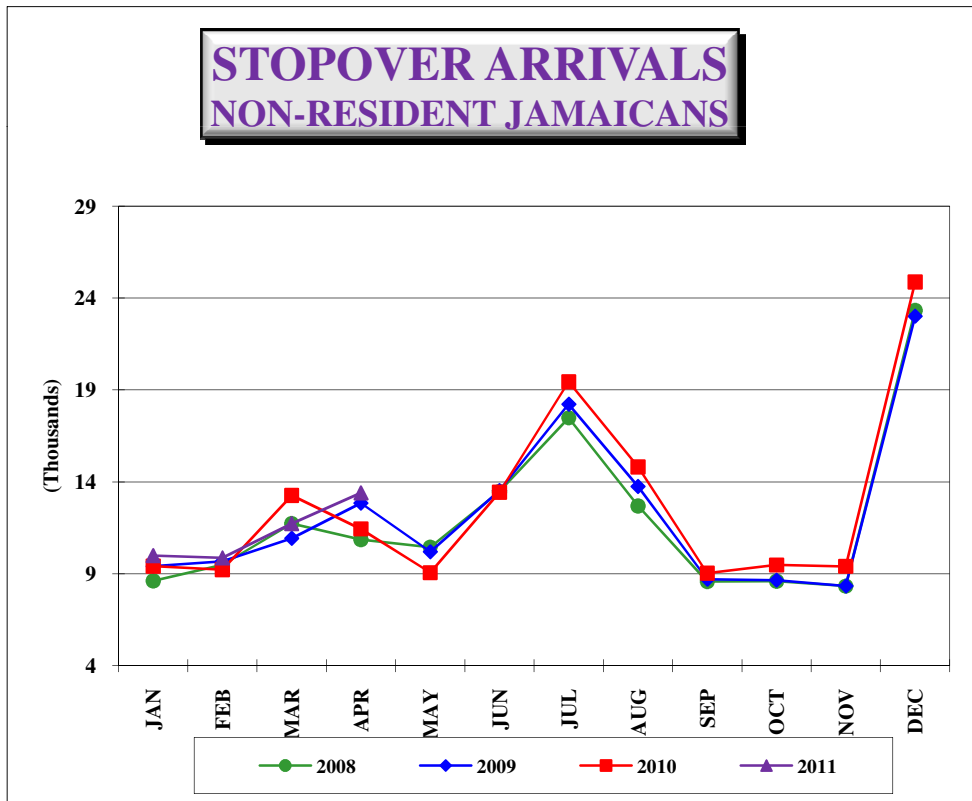

2011**

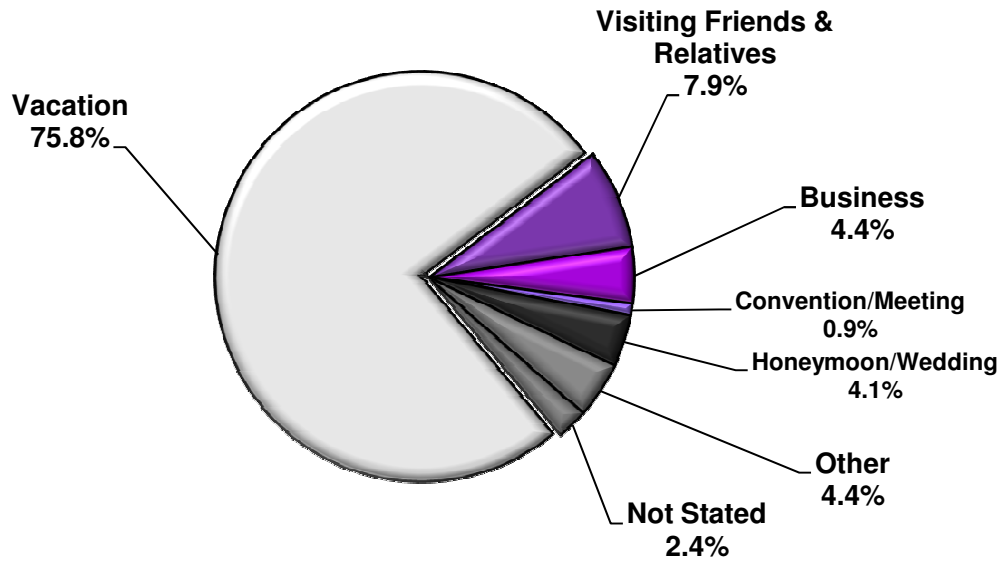

STOPOVER VISITORS BY MARKET SHARE

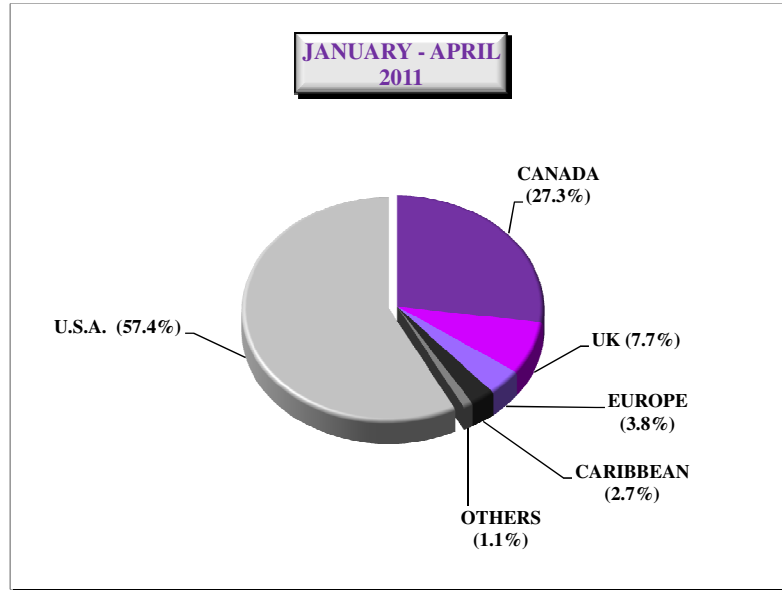

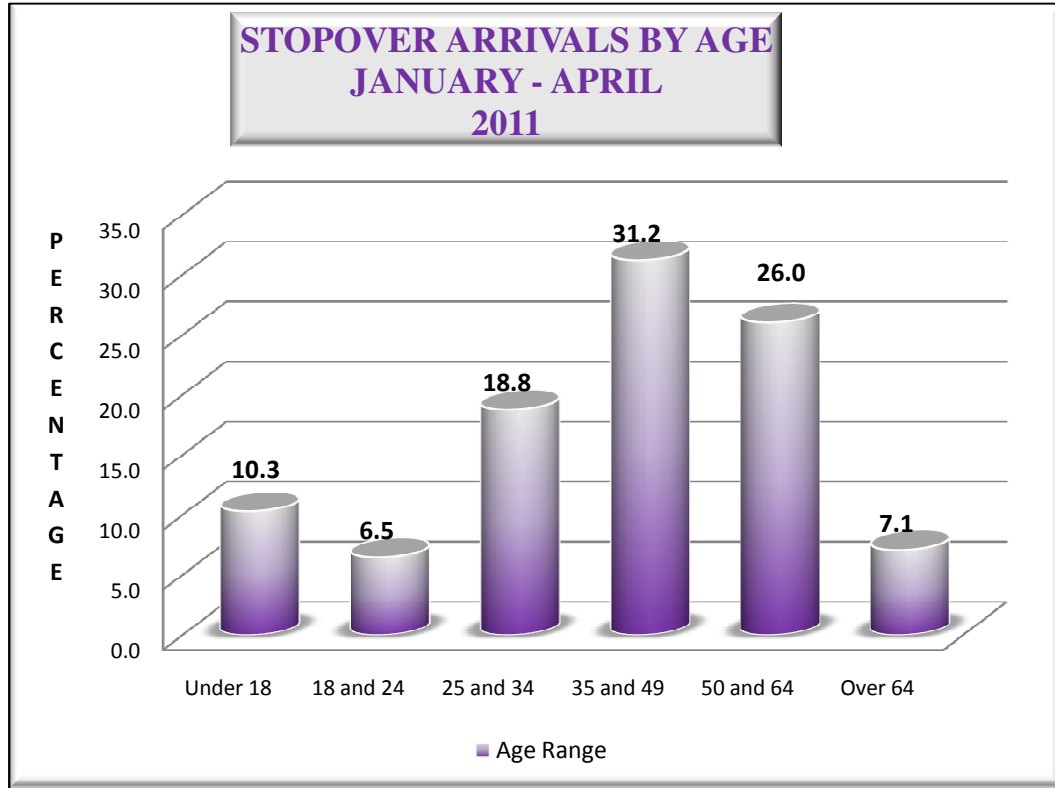

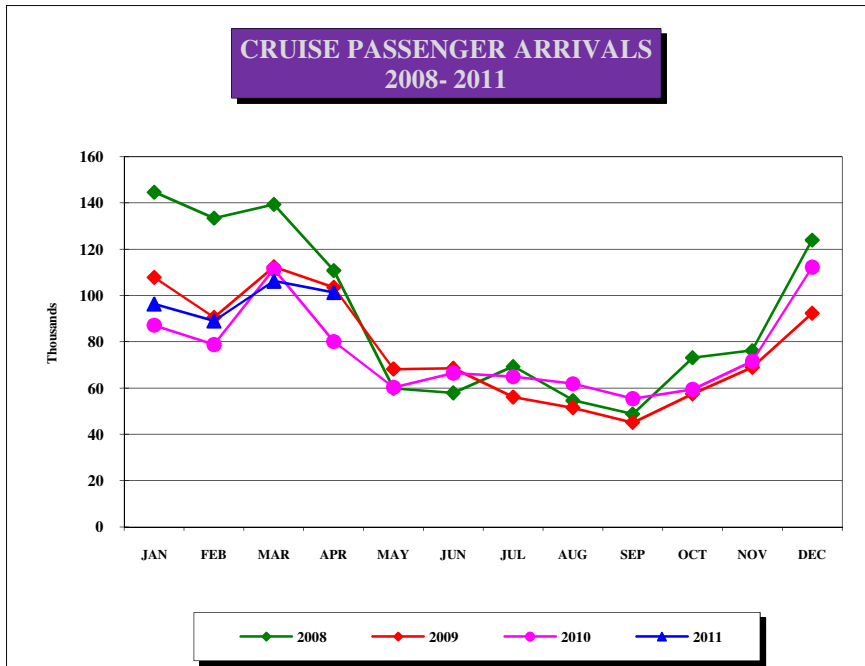

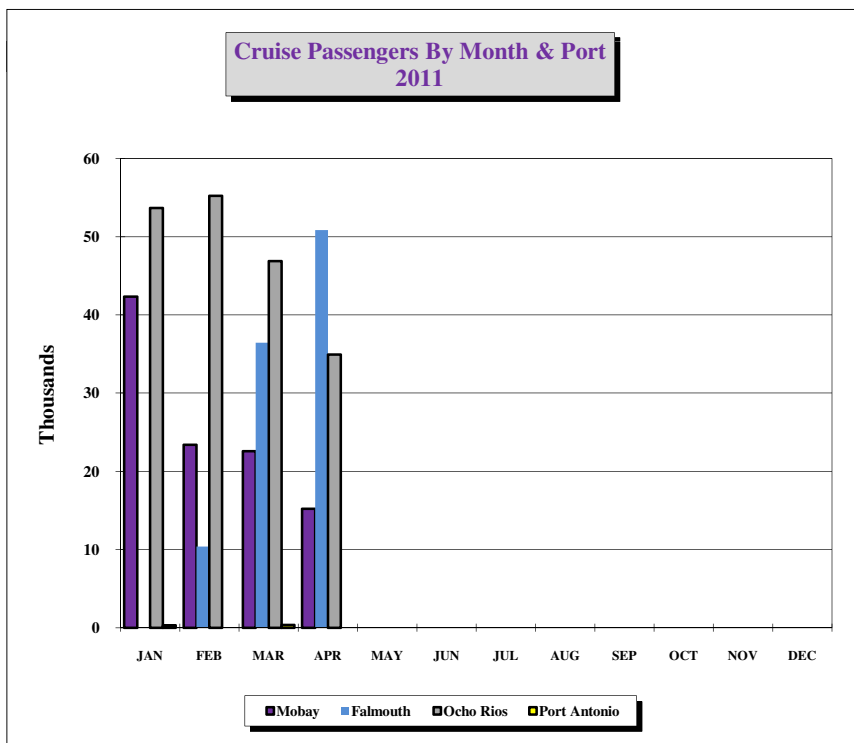

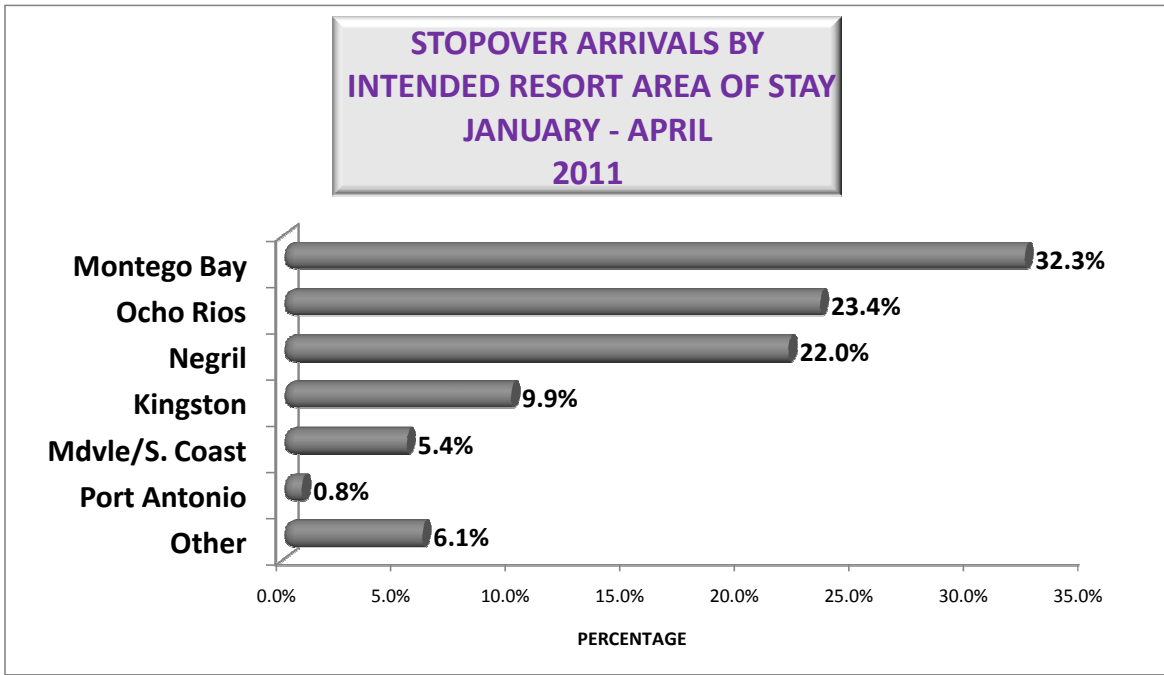
