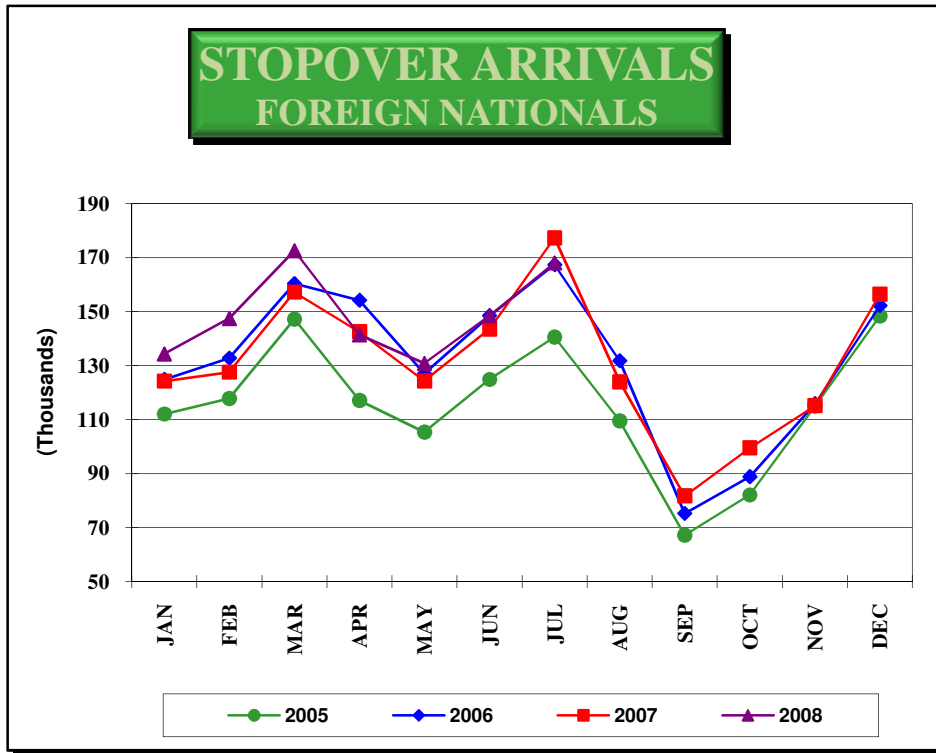

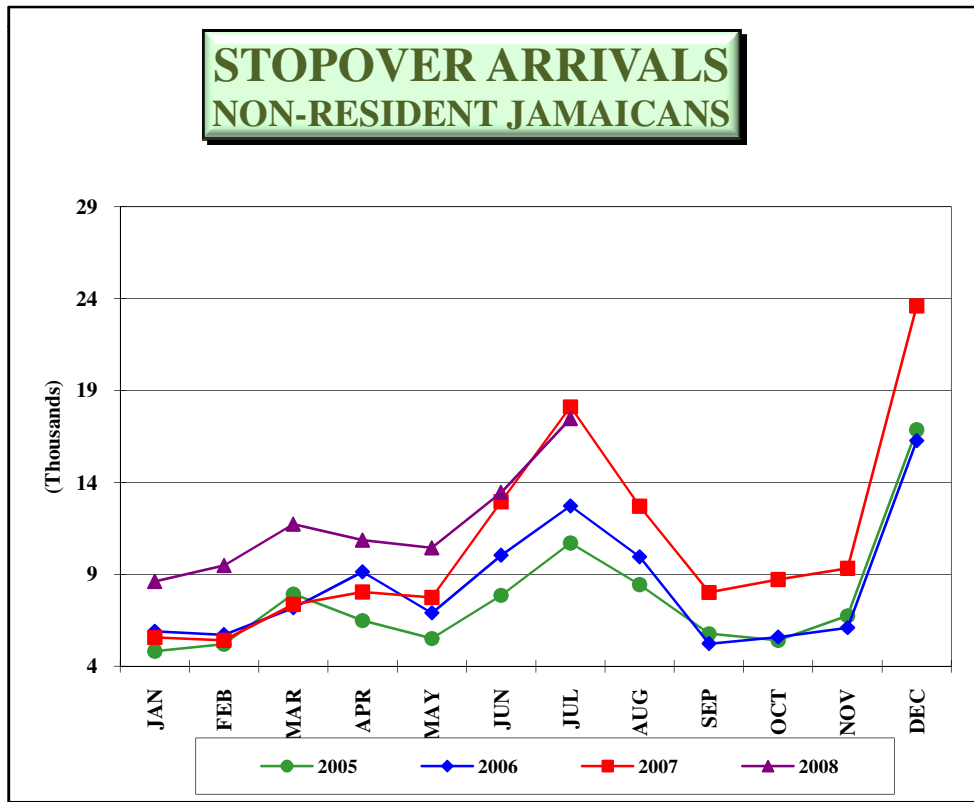
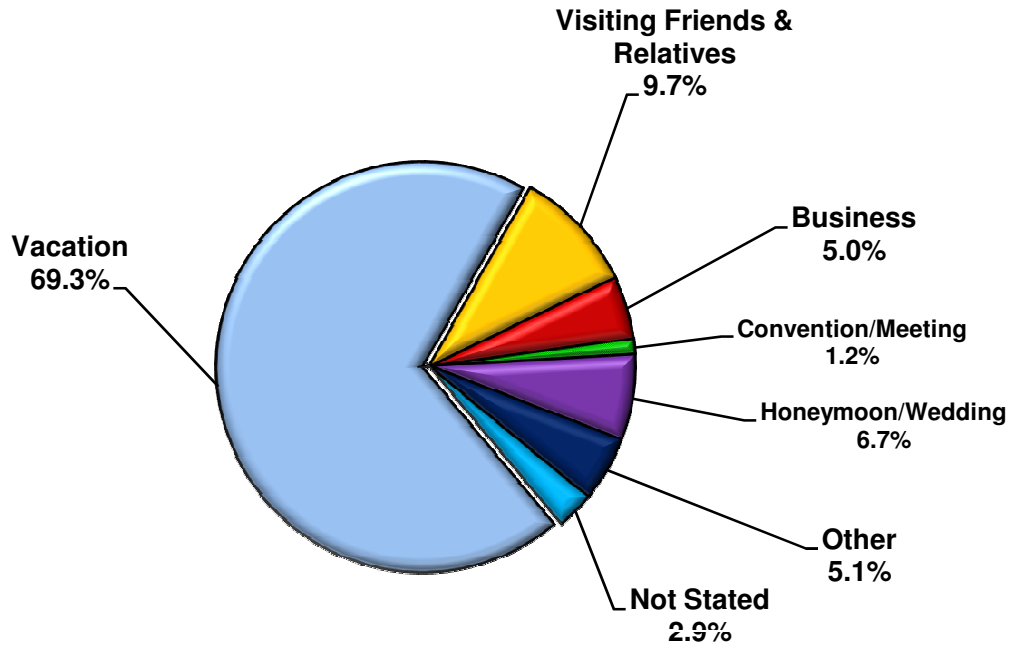

## STOPOVER VISITORS BY MARKET SHARE

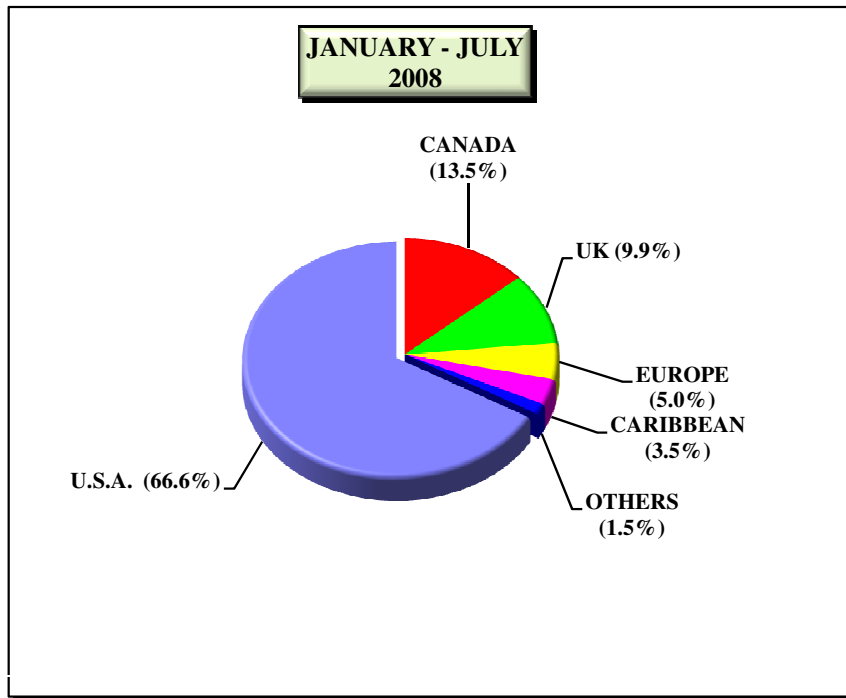

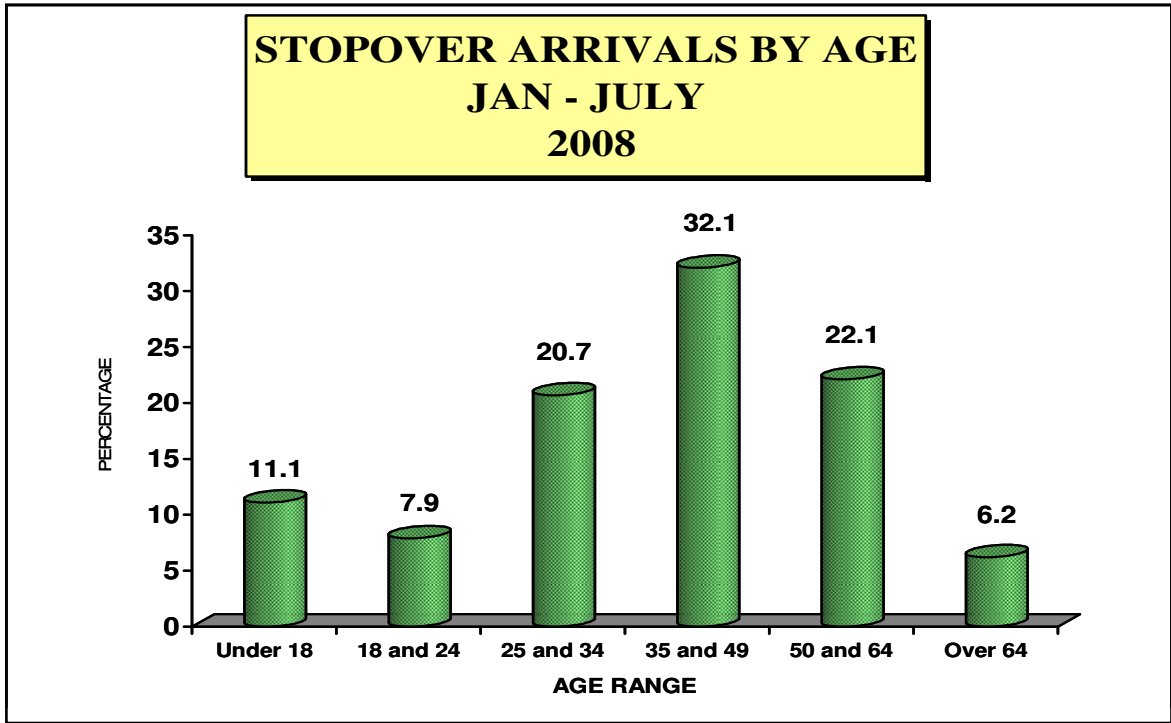

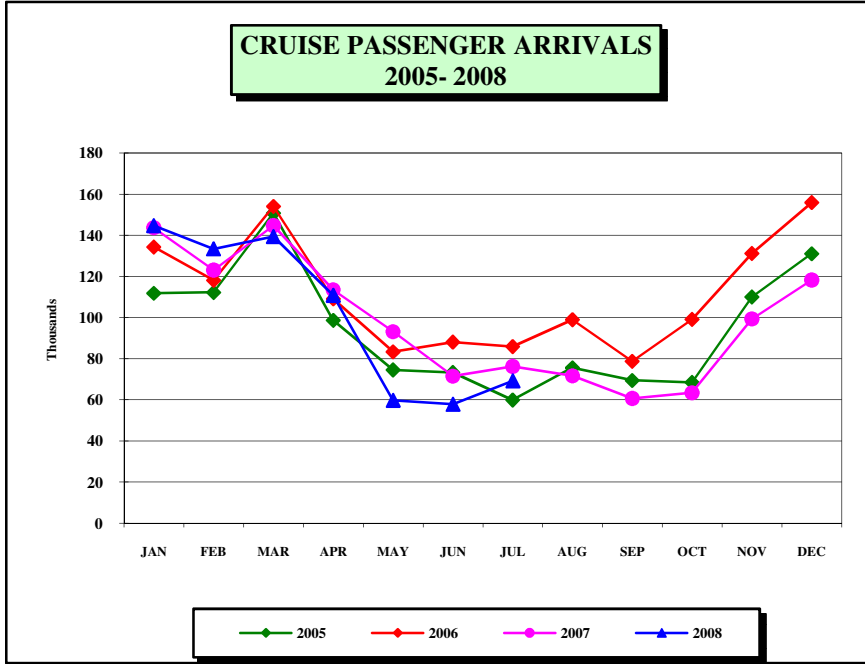

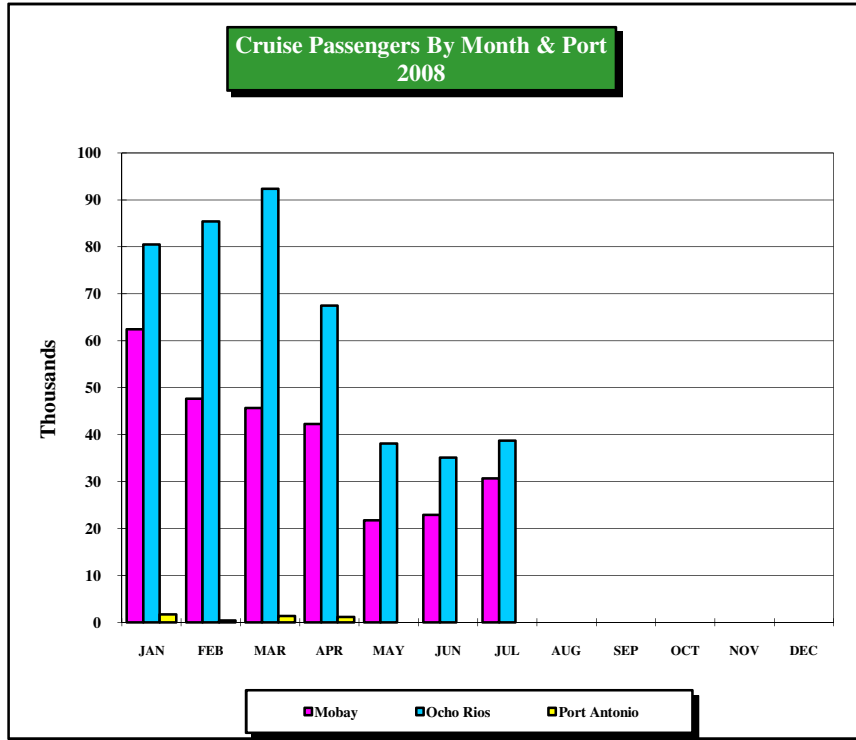

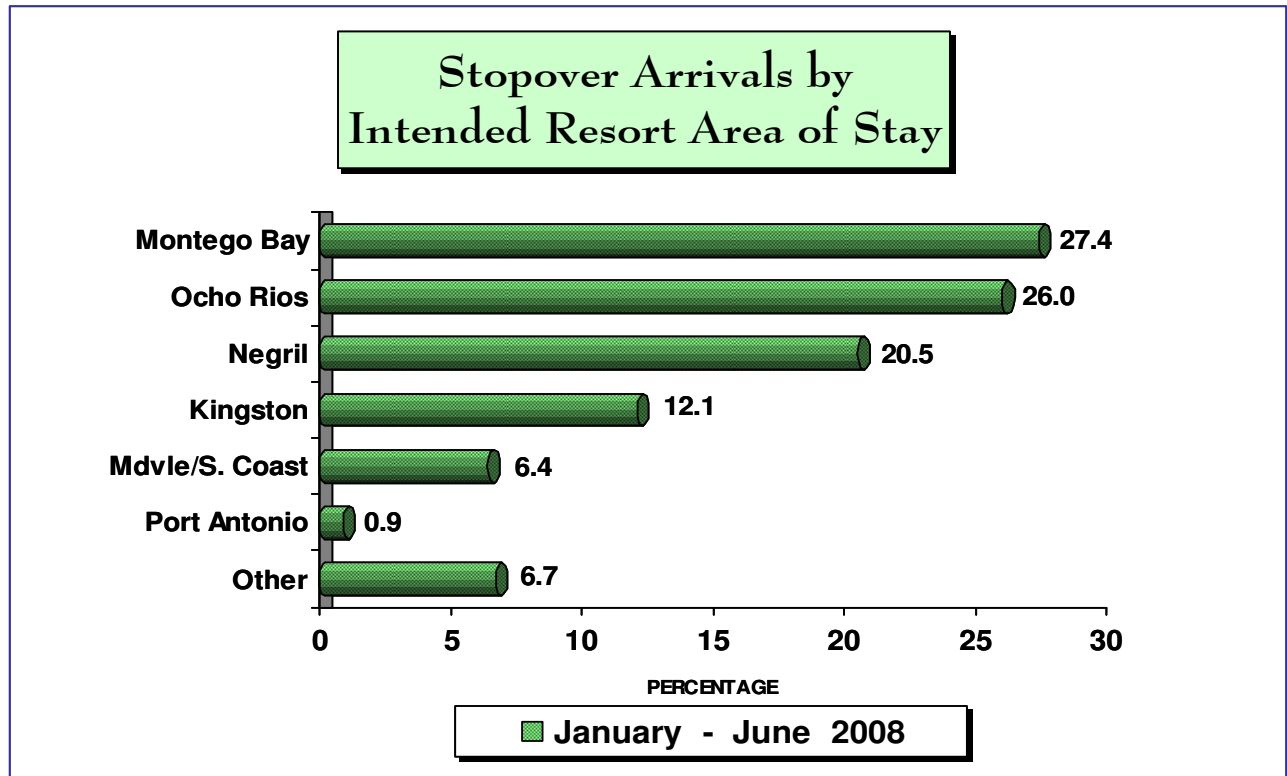
