TOURIST (Stopover Arrivals)

Stopover arrivals to Jamaica continues on its upward trend for 2006. For the month of June 2006, arrivals were **158,425** a remarkable increase of **19.4%** over the **132,710** recorded in June 2005.

Cumulatively, stopover arrivals for the first half of 2006, January to June period, has grown by **17.1%** with **892,161** compared to **762,078** in 2005.

United States

Stopover arrivals from the United States market has recorded exceptional growth with an increase of **19.8%** in June. A total of **124,709** visitors compared to the **104,097** visitors who came in June 2005. All marketing regions in the United States recorded increases. The South increased by **25.2%**, the Northeast by **20.5%**, the West by **16.7%** and the Midwest by **9%**.

For the January to June period, the US market increased by **18.7%**, with an additional **103,006** arrivals. Total visitors from this market was **653,572** compared to **550,566** for the corresponding period in 2005. All marketing regions recorded double digit growth. The South increased by **32.2%**, the West by **23.1%**, the Northeast by **13.2%**, and the Midwest by **12.2%**.

Canada

In June, the Canadian market increased by an impressive **33.3%**, with total stopovers arrivals from this market recording **7,855** compared to **5,892** in 2005.

The leading province of Ontario increased by **35.7%**, while the second most important visitor-producing province of Quebec increased by **15.4%**. Increases were also recorded for the provinces of Alberta up by **59.8%**, and British Columbia up by **60.3%**.

Cumulatively, the Canadian market has generated **17,701** additional arrivals, in the January to June period with a total of **84,540** stopovers compared to **66,839** in 2005, represent-



ing an increase of **26.5%**. The main province of Ontario with **57,079** arrivals increased by **28.5%**, supplying **12,643** more arrivals compared to the **44,436** in 2005. The provinces of Quebec and Alberta increased by **15.2%** and **15.9%** respectively. The other notable increases were New Brunswick **82.5%**, Nova Scotia **73.5%** and Manitoba **27.8%**.

Europe

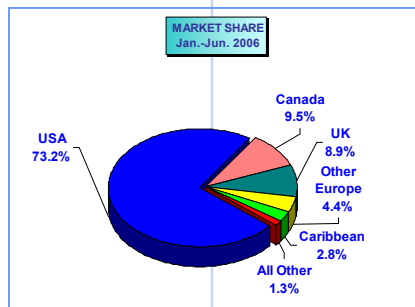
The European market recorded a **11.2%** increase in June 2006. The market provided a total of **19,158** stopover visitors compared to the **17,226** recorded in June 2005. In the Northern Europe region the main visitor producing country, United Kingdom with **14,041** arrivals increased by **15.7%**. In the South/Western Europe region the main visitor producing countries, Germany with **942** decreased by **12%** and Italy with **701** declined by **36.7%**. In the third market region, Central/East Europe with **179** arrivals, decreased by **21.5%**.

For the January to June period, the European market increased by **5.8%**. Total stopovers for the period was **117,949** compared to **111,465** in 2005. In Northern Europe, the United Kingdom with **78,934** arrivals increased by **13%**. In South/Western Europe, Germany the second leading European producing country with **10,879** visitors, increased by **9.5%**, and Italy with **9,265** arrivals declined by **27.7%**. In the third market region, Central/East Europe with **2,051** arrivals, declined by **4.3%**.

Latin America

The Latin American market increased by **28.3%** in June with a total of **820** stopovers compared to **639** in June 2005. From the Central American region, albeit from small bases, Mexico with **160** arrivals increased by **28%** and Panama with **92** increased by **55.9%**. From South America, Brazil with **110** arrivals increased by **34.1%**, and Colombia with **81** arrivals increased by **200%**.

For the January to June period, the Latin American market increased by **32.7%** with a total of **5,290** visitors compared to **3,985** for the corresponding period in 2005.



The Caribbean

Visitors to Jamaica from the Caribbean region increased by **20.7%** in June with a total of **4,822** visitors, compared to **3,996** in June 2005.

The major Caribbean countries which provided visitors to Jamaica in June were: the Cayman Islands (**1,481**), Trinidad and Tobago (**633**), Barbados (**510**), and Bahamas (**370**).

Cumulatively, the Caribbean stopovers arrivals to Jamaica during the January to June period was above the level achieved in 2005, moving from **23,521** in 2005 to **24,630** in 2006. The Cayman Islands is the leading provider of visitors to Jamaica from the Caribbean region. In the period under review, they provided a total of **7,310** visitors followed by Trinidad and Tobago with **3,942**, Barbados with **2,830** and The Bahamas Is. with **1,554** visitors.

Japan

The Japanese market declined by **16.7%** in June with a total of **285** stopovers compared to **342** in June 2005.

Cumulatively for the January to June period, a total of **2,209** Japanese visitors came to Jamaica. This was down from the **2,379** recorded for the corresponding period in 2005.

Other Countries

Of the other countries, Australia with **212** stopovers in June increased by **94.5%** against the **109** who came in 2005.

Market Share

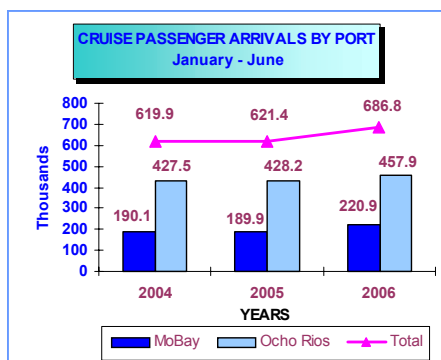
The market share of stopover visitors for the period January to June 2006 was as follows:

USA **73.3%**; Canada **9.5%**; UK **8.8%**; Continental Europe **4.4%**, the Caribbean **2.8%**; Latin America **0.6%**; Japan **0.2%** and Other Countries **0.4%**.

Cruise Passengers

A total of **88,087** cruise passengers visited Jamaica in June 2006. This represents a **20.3%** increase against the **73,246** recorded for June 2005.

Cumulatively, a total of **686,774** cruise passengers visited our shores in the January to June period, an increase of **10.5%** against the **621,378** recorded for the corresponding period in 2005.



A total of **54,369** cruise passengers visited the port of Ocho Rios in June, an increase of **19.7%** over the **45,439** recorded for June 2005.

For the January to June period, cruise passenger arrivals to the port of Ocho Rios was **457,917**, an increase of **6.9%** against the **428,211** recorded for the corresponding period in 2005.

Montego Bay recorded a total of **33,718** cruise passengers for the month, an increase of **21.3%** against the **27,807** recorded for 2005.

Cumulatively, for the January to June period, cruise passenger arrivals to the port of Montego Bay was **220,858**, an increase of **16.3%** against the **189,858** recorded for the same period in 2005.

Length of Stay

The average length of stay of **Foreign National** arrivals in June was **10.2** nights, same level as that recorded in June 2005.

Cumulatively, the average length of stay for the January to June period was **9** nights, compared to **9.2** nights recorded in 2005.

The average length of stay of **Non-Resident Jamaican** arrivals in June was **16.5** nights compared to the **21.9** nights in June 2005. Cumulatively, the average length of stay for the January to June period was **15.8** nights, compared to **20.4** nights in 2005.

Purpose of Visit

During the period under review, January to June 2006, **83.4%** or **706,761** of the **847,304** Foreign Nationals who visited Jamaica were visiting for the purpose of Leisure, **5.7%** were on Business, **5.6%** were Visiting Friends & Relatives, and the remaining **5.3%** were on Other purposes of travel.

A total of **20,817** or **46.4%** of the **44,857** Non-Resident Jamaicans who travelled to Jamaica in this period January to June 2006 were visiting for Leisure, **22.6%** were Visiting Friends & Relatives, **11.3%** were on Business and the remaining **19.7%** were on Other purposes of travel.

Intended Resort Area of Stay

Of the **892,161** stopover arrivals visiting Jamaica during January and June 2006, the resort area of Montego Bay welcomed **253,498** arrivals or **28.4%**. Ocho Rios received **215,044** or **24.1%**, Negril got **196,285** or **22%**, and Kingston received **107,051** or **12%**. The remaining **13.4%** stayed in the Mandeville/Southcoast, Port Antonio resort regions and Other areas in Jamaica.

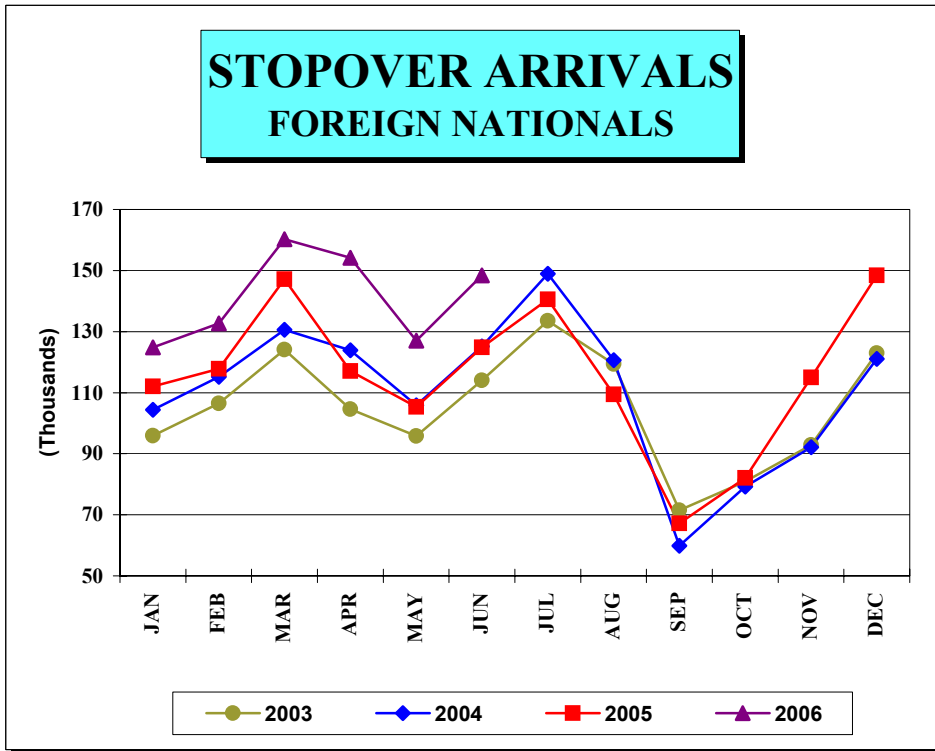

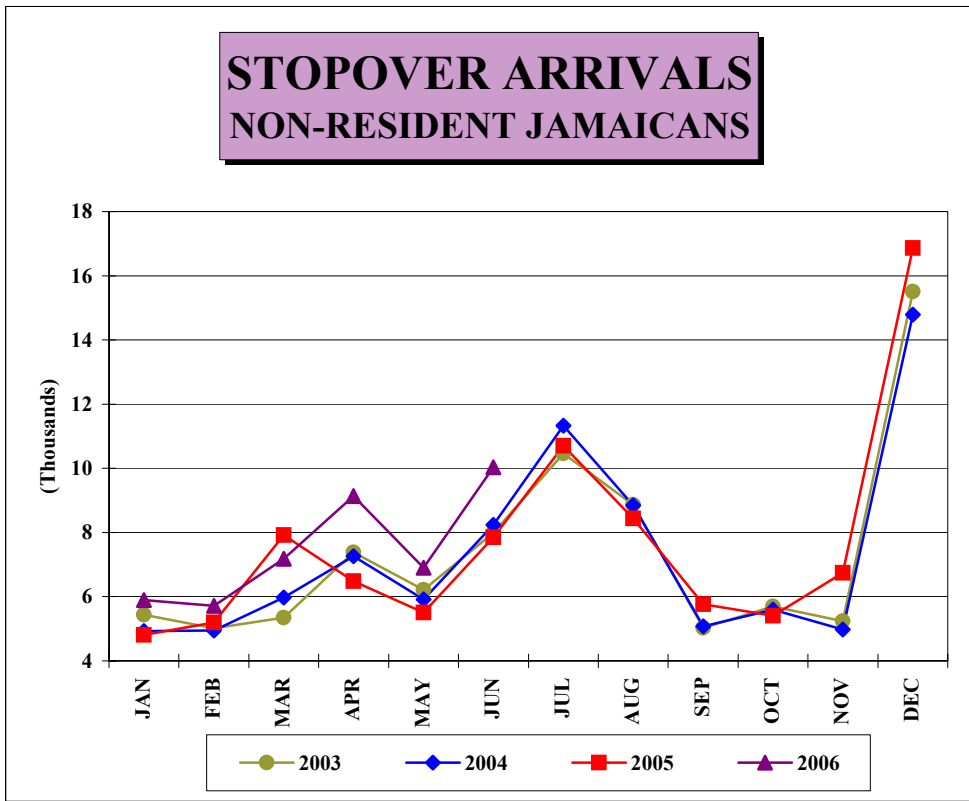

JAN - JUNE 2006**

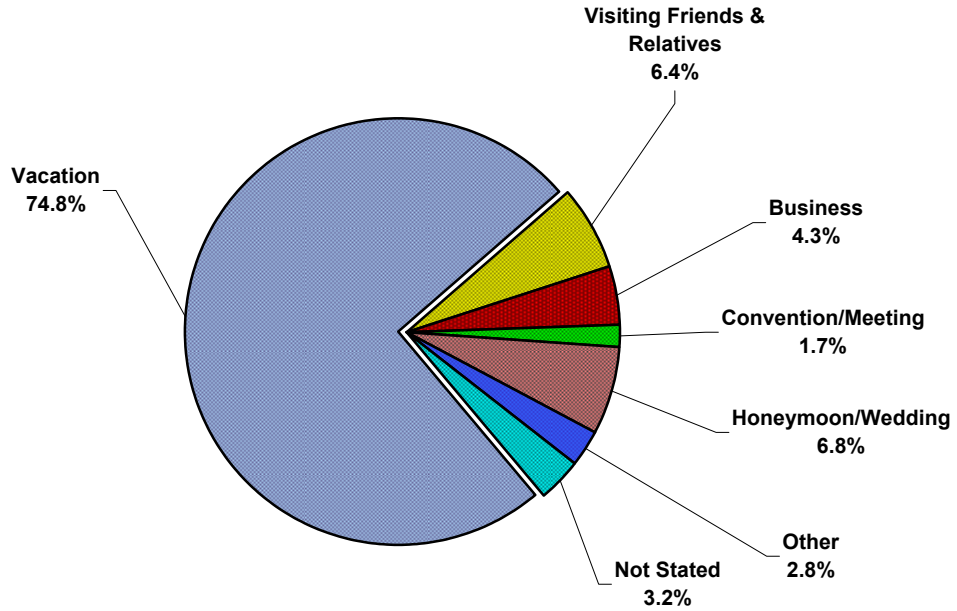

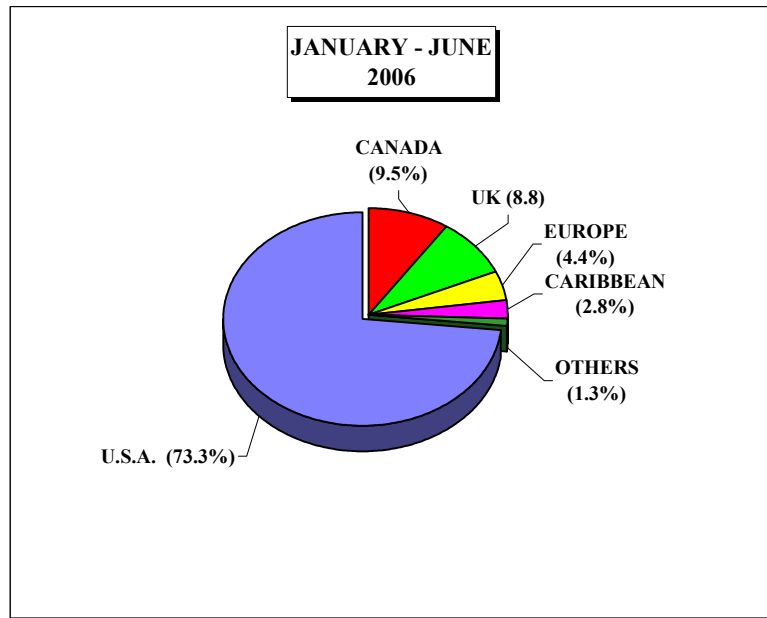

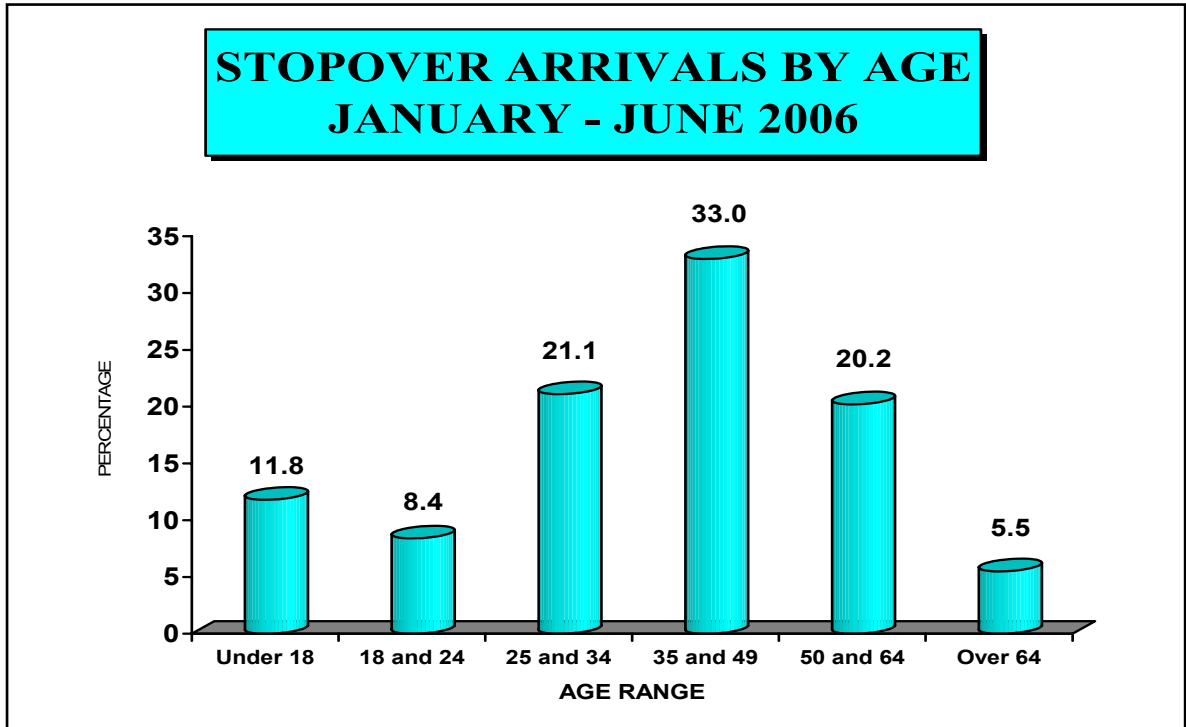

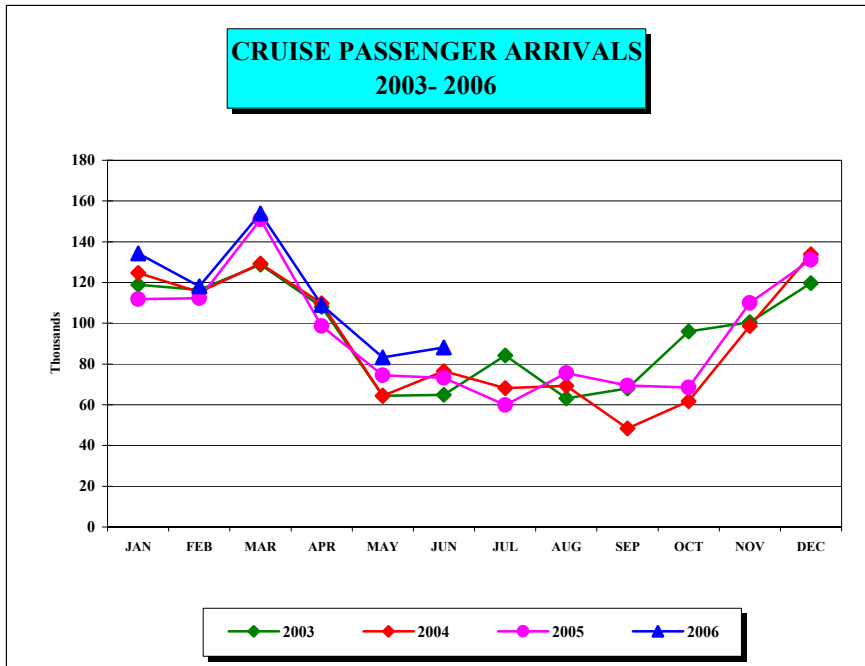

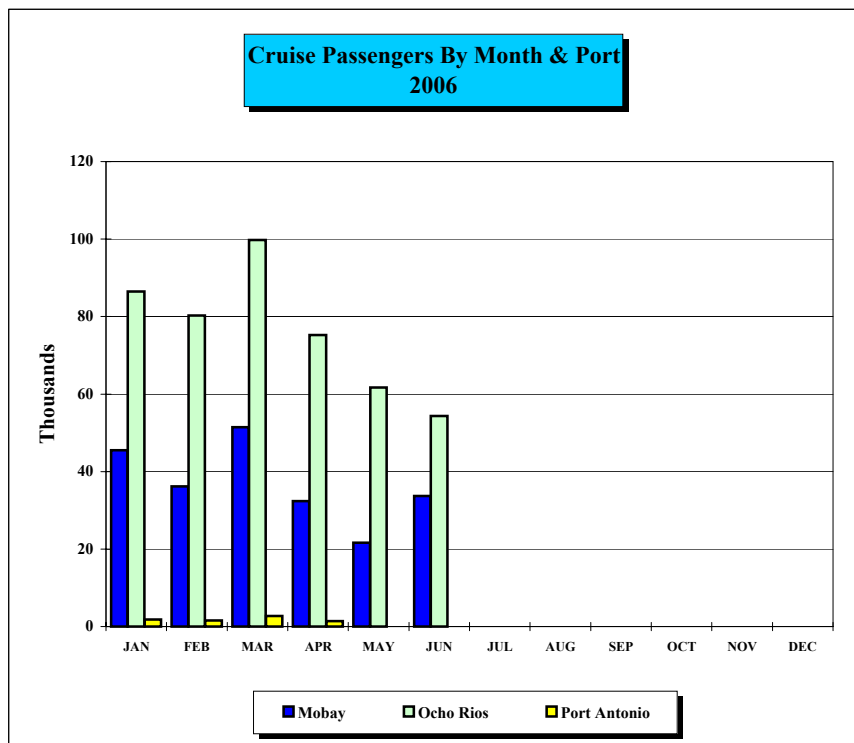

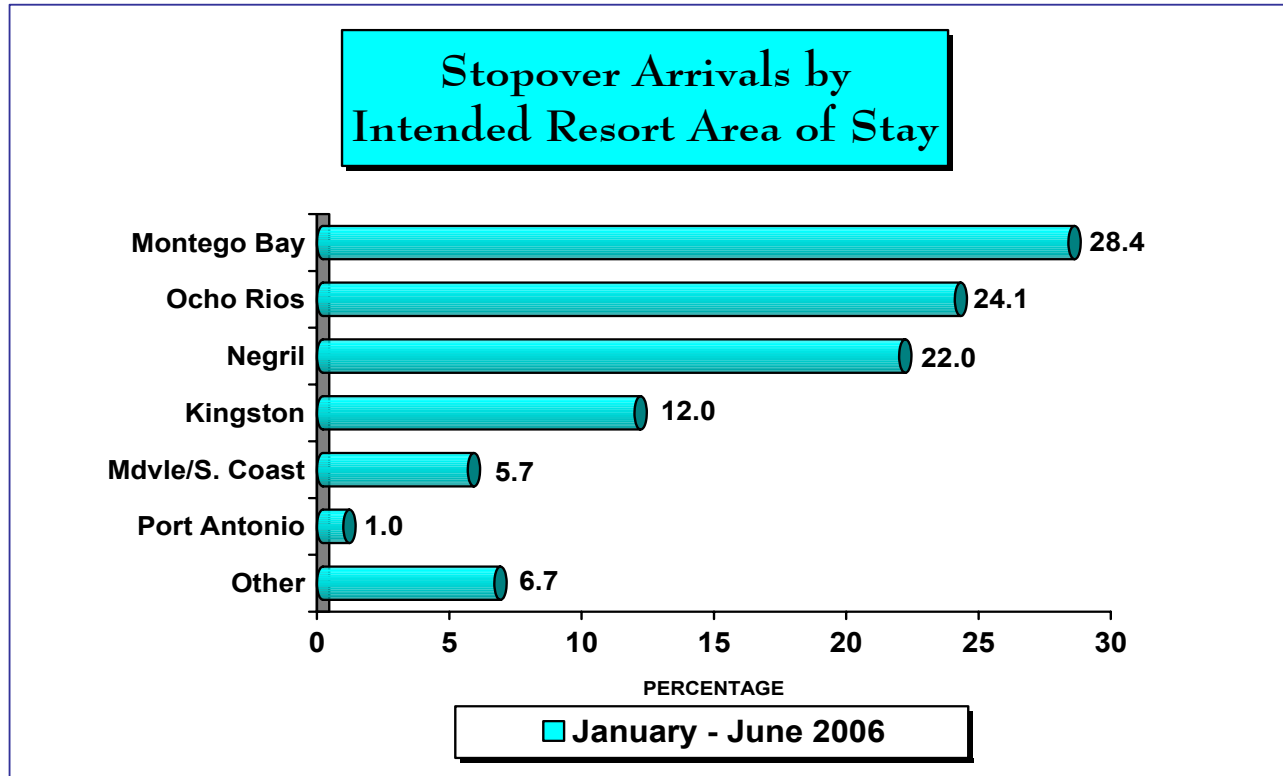
