TOURIST (Stopover Arrivals)

Stopover arrivals for the fifth month in a row of 2006 have reached record levels. In May 2006, arrivals were **133,902**, a notable increase of **20.8%** over the **110,821** recorded in May 2005.

Cumulatively, stopover arrivals for the January to May period, has grown by **16.6%** with **733,736** compared to **629,368** in 2005.

United States

Stopover arrivals from the United States market has recorded exceptional growth with an increase of **25.5%** in May. A total of **100,704** visitors compared to the **80,237** visitors who came in May 2005. All marketing regions in the United States recorded increases. The South increased by **38.8%**, the West by **23.3%**, the Midwest by **19.5%** and the Northeast by **17.7%**.

For the January to May period, the US market increased by **18.5%**, with an additional **82,394** arrivals. Total visitors from this market was **528,863** compared to **446,469** for the corresponding period in 2005. All marketing regions recorded double digit growth. The South increased by **34.7%**, the West by **25.2%**, the Midwest by **12.7%**, and the Northeast by **11.8%**.

Canada

In May, the Canadian market increased by an impressive **34.2%**, with total stopovers arrivals from this market recording **9,064** compared to **6,752** in 2005.

The leading province of Ontario increased by **40.7%**, while the second most important visitor-producing province of Quebec declined by **4.4%**. Increases were also recorded for the provinces of Nova Scotia up by **126.9%**, Alberta up by **32.2%**, and British Columbia up by **20.9%**.

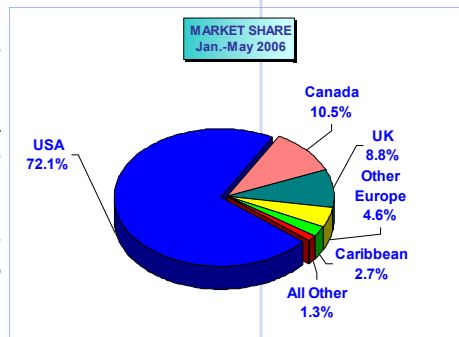
Cumulatively, the Canadian market has generated **15,738** additional arrivals, in the January to May period with a total of **76,685** stopovers compared to **60,947** in 2005, representing an

increase of **25.8%**. The main province of Ontario with **50,773** arrivals increased by **27.6%**, supplying **10,983** more arrivals compared to the **39,790** in 2005. The provinces of Quebec and Alberta increased by **15.2%** and **13.9%** respectively. The other notable increases were New Brunswick **85.3%**, Nova Scotia **77.8%** and Manitoba **28%**.

Europe

The European market recorded a **1.3%** decrease in May 2006. The market provided a total of **17,912** stopover visitors compared to the **18,154** recorded in May 2005. In the Northern Europe region the main visitor producing country, United Kingdom with **13,019** arrivals increased by **5.6%**. In the South/Western Europe region the main visitor producing countries, Germany with **939** decreased by **25.9%** and Italy with **780** declined by **29.8%**. In the third market region, Central/East Europe with **250** arrivals, increased by **13.1%**.

For the January to May period, the European market increased by **4.8%**. Total stopovers for the period was **98,791** compared to **94,239** in 2005. In Northern Europe, the United Kingdom with **64,893** arrivals increased by **12.4%**. In South/Western Europe, Germany the second leading European producing country with **9,937** visitors, increased by **12.1%**, and Italy with **8,564** arrivals declined by **26.8%**. In the third market region, Central/East Europe with **1,872** arrivals, declined by **2.3%**.



Latin America

The Latin American market increased by **16.9%** in May with a total of **835** stopovers compared to **714** in May 2005. From the Central American region, albeit from small bases, Mexico with **190** arrivals increased by **18.0%** and Panama with **97** increased by **10.2%**. From South America, Brazil with **98** arrivals increased by **46.3%**, Argentina with **91** arrivals increased by **18.2%** and Peru with **48** increased by **50%**.

For the January to May period, the Latin American market increased by **33.6%** with a total of **4,470** visitors compared to **3,346** for the corresponding period in 2005.

The Caribbean

Visitors to Jamaica from the Caribbean region increased by **6.7%** in May with a total of **4,378** visitors, compared to **4,105** in May 2005.

The major Caribbean countries which provided visitors to Jamaica in May were: the Cayman Islands (**1,216**), Trinidad and Tobago (**751**), Barbados (**636**), and Bahamas (**295**).

Cumulatively, the Caribbean stopovers arrivals to Jamaica during the January to May period was above the level achieved in 2005, moving from **19,525** in 2005 to **19,808** in 2006. The Cayman Islands is the leading provider of visitors to Jamaica from the Caribbean region. In the period under review, they provided a total of **5,829** visitors followed by Trinidad and Tobago with **3,309**, Barbados with **2,320** and The Bahamas Is. with **1,184** visitors.

Japan

The Japanese market declined by **21.6%** in May with a total of **258** stopovers compared to **329** in May 2005.

Cumulatively for the January to May period, a total of **1,924** Japanese visitors came to Jamaica. This was down from the **2,037** recorded for the corresponding period in 2005.

Other Countries

Of the other countries, Australia with **157** stopovers in May increased by **18.9%** against the **132** who came in 2005.

Market Share

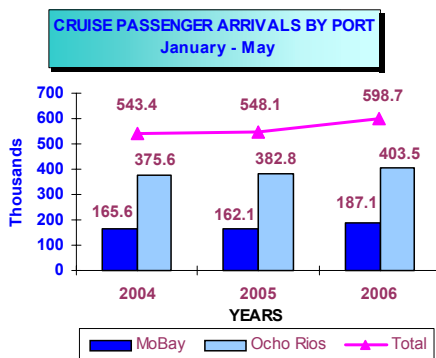
The market share of stopover visitors for the period January—May 2006 were as follows:

USA **72.1%**; Canada **10.5%**; UK **8.8%**; Continental Europe **4.6%**, the Caribbean **2.6%**; Latin America **0.6%**; Japan **0.3%** and Other Countries **0.5%**.

Cruise Passengers

A total of **83,311** cruise passengers visited Jamaica in May 2006. This represents an **11.8%** increase against the **74,505** recorded for May 2005.

Cumulatively, a total of **598,687** cruise passengers visited our shores in the January to May period, an increase of **9.2%** against the **548,132** recorded for the corresponding period in 2005.



A total of **61,688** cruise passengers visited the port of Ocho Rios in May, an increase of **7.6%** over the **57,345** recorded for May 2005.

For the January to May period, cruise passenger arrivals to the port of Ocho Rios was **403,548**, an increase of **5.4%** against the **382,772** recorded for the corresponding period in 2005.

Montego Bay recorded a total of **21,623** cruise passengers for the month, an increase of **26%** against the **17,160** recorded for 2005.

Cumulatively, for the January to May period, cruise passenger arrivals to the port of Montego Bay was **187,140**, an increase of **15.5%** against the **162,051** recorded for the same period in 2005.

Length of Stay

The average length of stay of **Foreign National** arrivals in May was **8.6** nights compared to **8.9** nights in May 2005.

Cumulatively, the average length of stay for the January to May period was **8.8** nights, compared to **9** nights recorded in 2005.

The average length of stay of **Non-Resident Jamaican** arrivals in May was **14** nights compared to the **18.6** nights in May 2005. Cumulatively, the average length of stay for the January to May period was **15.5** nights, compared to **19.9** nights in 2005.

Purpose of Visit

During the period under review, January to May 2006, **83.6%** or **584,632** of the **698,912** Foreign Nationals who visited Jamaica were visiting for the purpose of Leisure, **5.8%** were on Business, **5.4%** were Visiting Friends & Relatives, and the remaining **5.2%** were on Other purposes of travel.

A total of **15,771** or **45.3%** of the **34,824** Non-Resident Jamaicans who travelled to Jamaica in this period January to May 2006 were visiting for Leisure, **23.1%** were Visiting Friends & Relatives, **11.8%** were on Business and the remaining **19.8%** were on Other purposes of travel.

Intended Resort Area of Stay

Of the **733,736** stopover arrivals visiting Jamaica during January and May 2006, the resort area of Montego Bay welcomed **212,126** arrivals or **28.9%**. Ocho Rios received **177,237** or **24.2%**, Negril got **165,157** or **22.5%**, and Kingston received **84,794** or **11.6%**. The remaining **12.9%** stayed in the Mandeville/Southcoast, Port Antonio resort regions and Other ar-

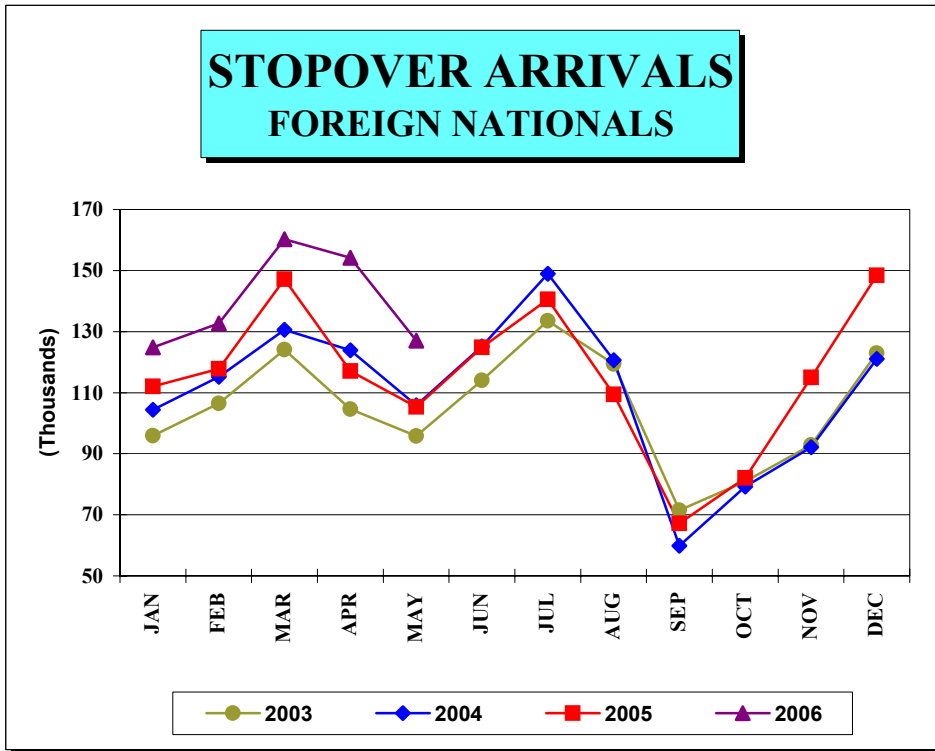

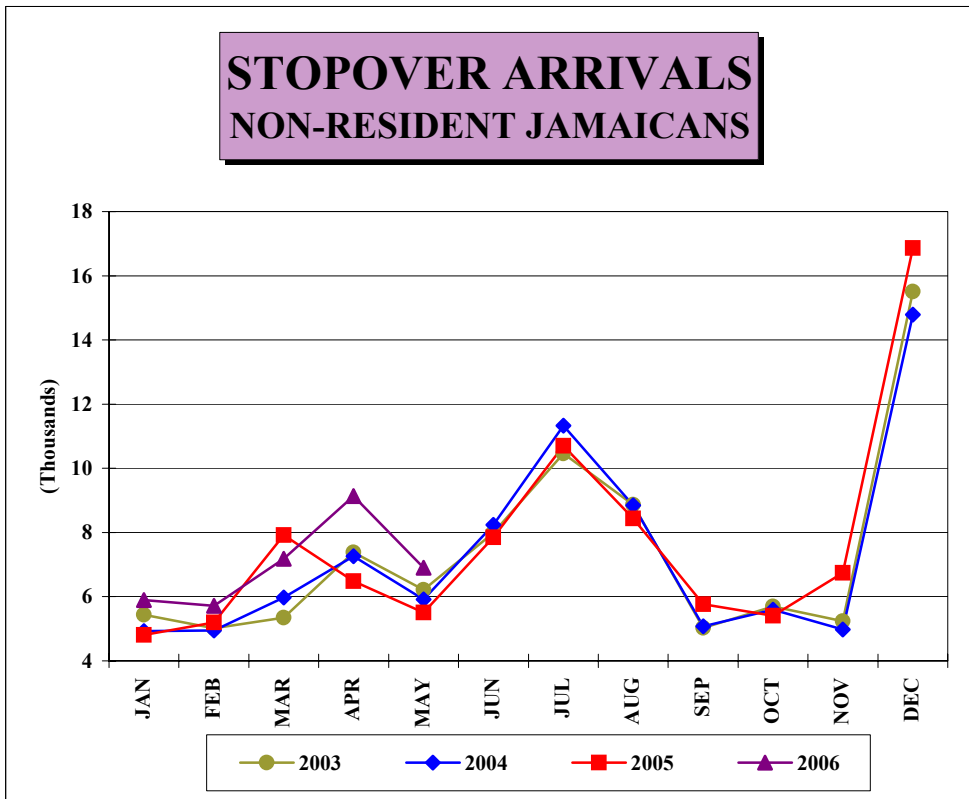

JAN - MAY 2006**

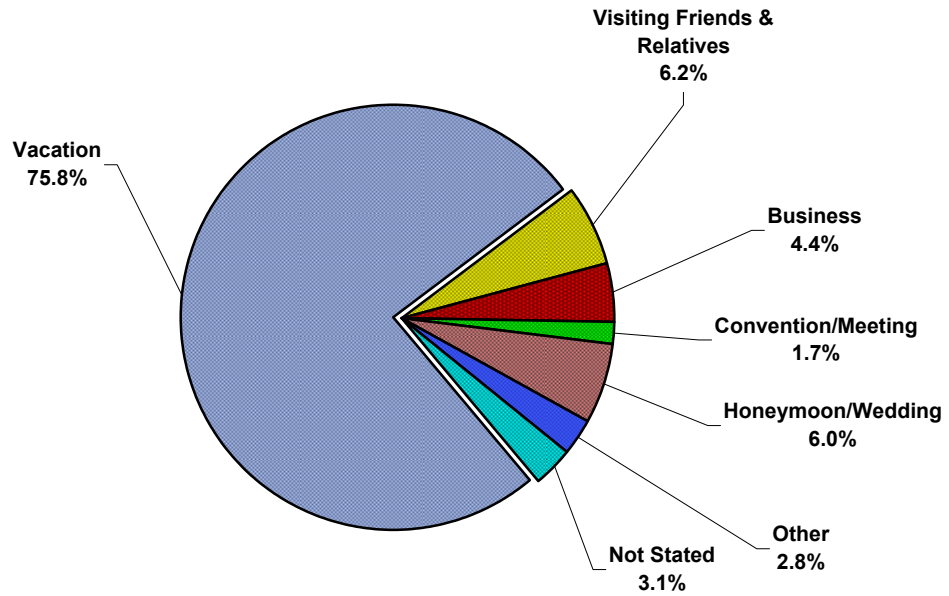

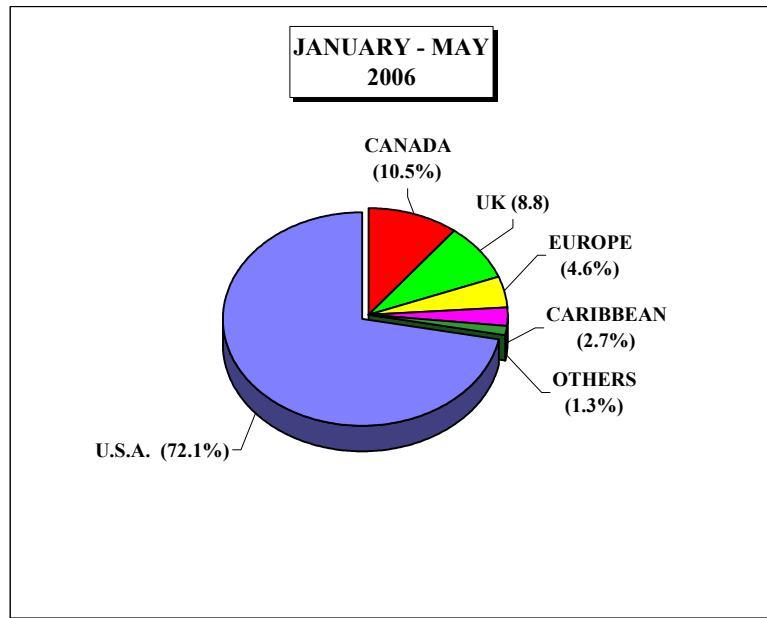

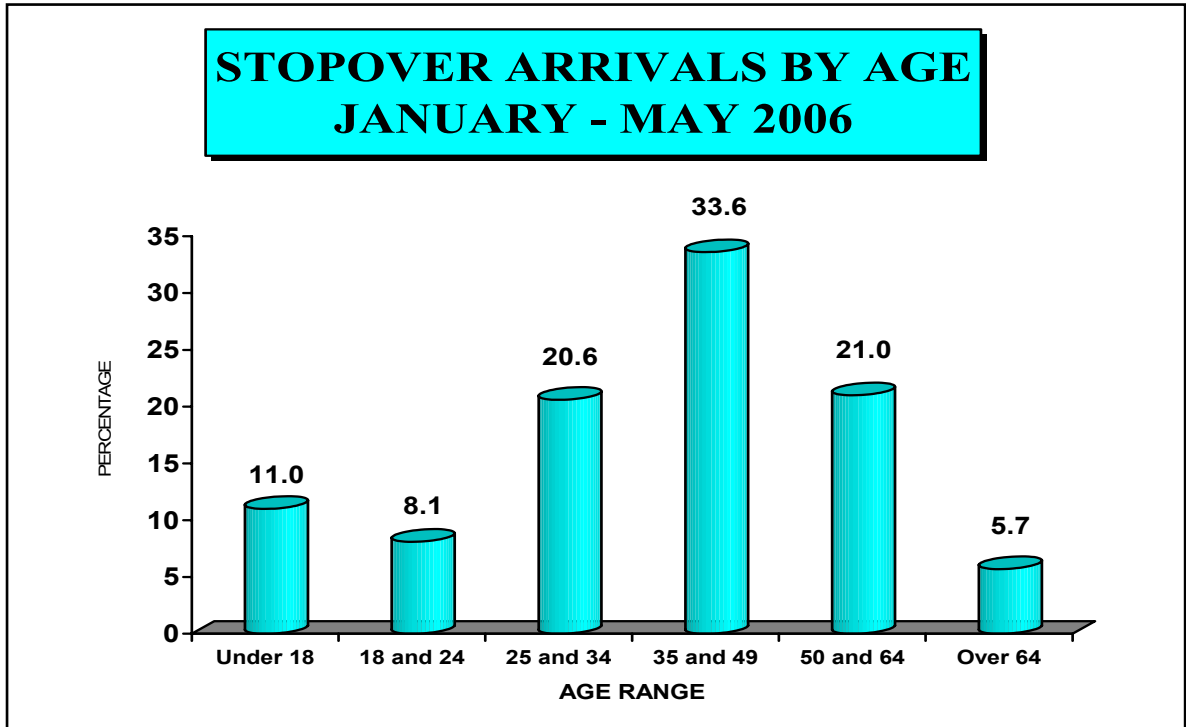

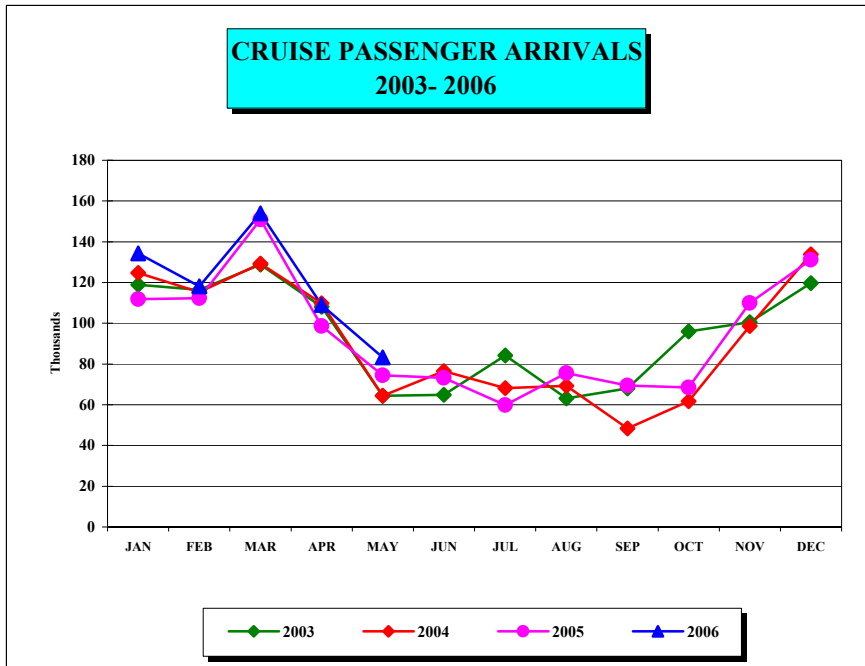

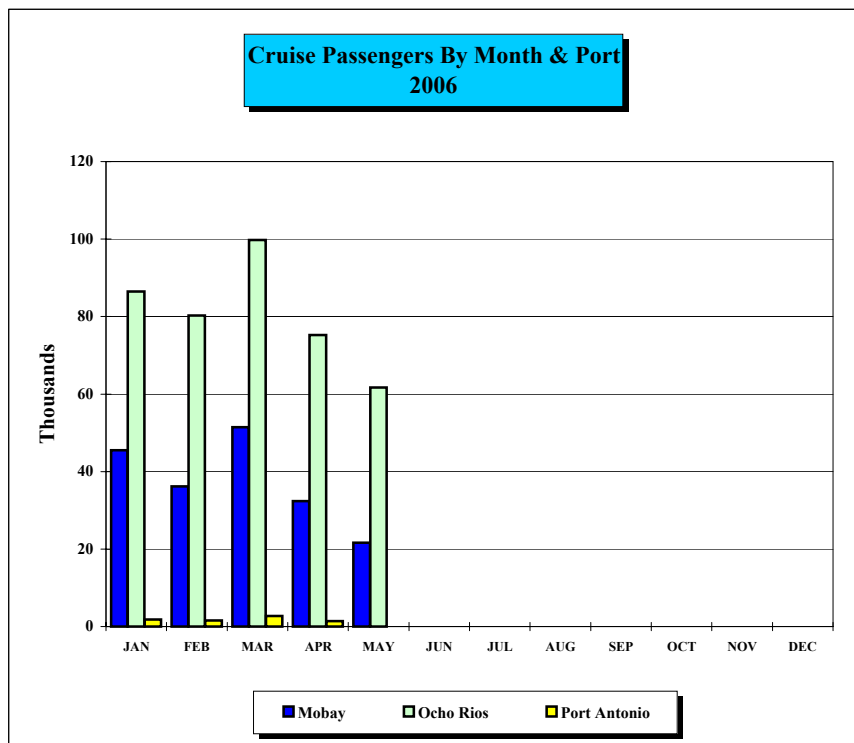

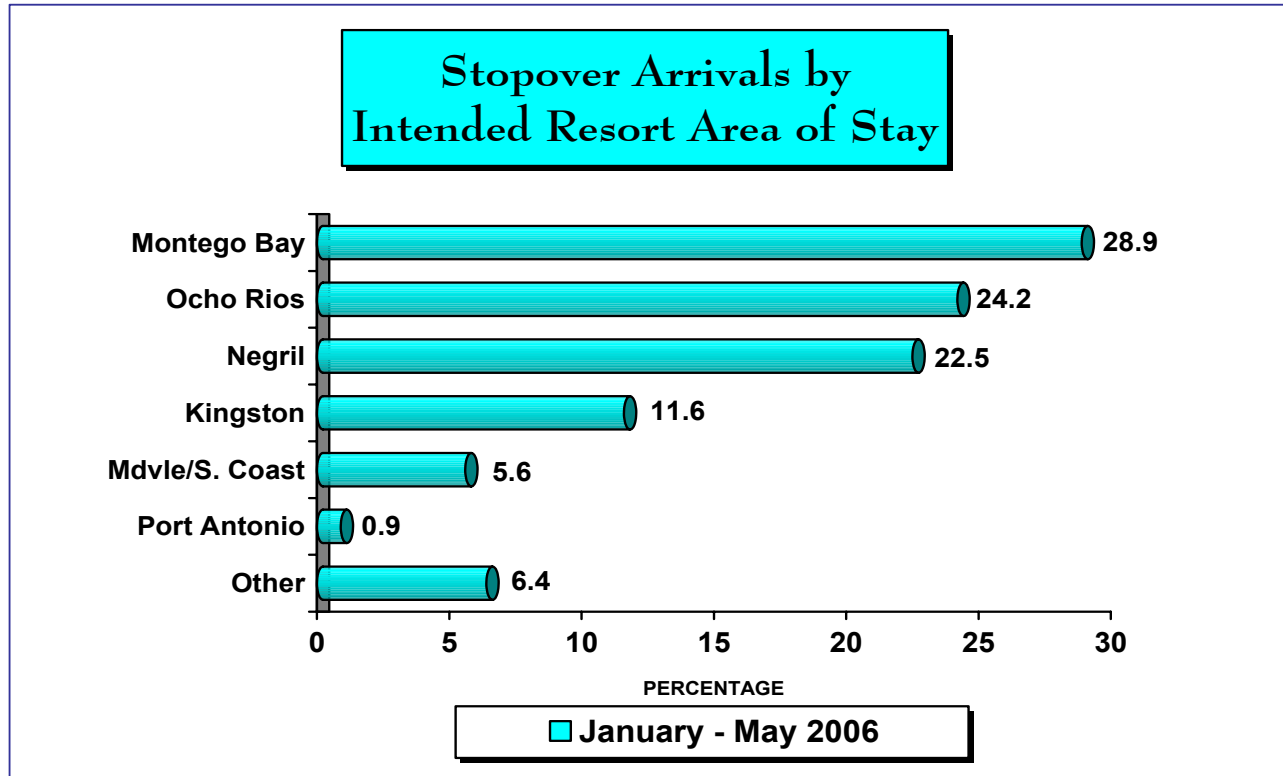
