- US Market down by 7.3%
- Canada increased by 10.7%
- Europe increased by 17.3%
- Cruise Passenger arrivals up by 11.8%

TOURIST (Stopover Arrivals)

Stopover arrivals in May 2007 were **132,044**, a decrease of **1.4%** over the **133,901** recorded in May 2006.

For the January to May period, arrivals declined by **3.3%** with **709,857** compared to **733,736** in 2006.

United States

Stopover arrivals from the United States market decreased by **7.3%** in May with a total of **93,332** visitors compared to the **100,704** visitors who came in May 2006. All marketing regions recorded decreases. The Midwest decreased by **15.2%**, the South by **10%**, the West by **7%** and the Northeast by **1.2%**.

For the January to May period, the US market has recorded a decline of **11.9%**. This is against the **18.5%** increase in visitors recorded during the same period in 2006. Total visitors from this market was **466,028** compared to **528,863** in 2006 a reduction of **62,835** visitors. All marketing regions recorded declines. The Midwest declined by **15.4%**, the South by **13.4%**, the West by **12.1%**, and the Northeast by **8.8%**.

Canada

In May, the Canadian market has continued with its positive trend with an increase of **10.7%**. Total stopovers from the Canadian market in May were **10,031** compared to **9,063** in 2006.

The leading province of Ontario increased by **13%**, while the second most important visitor-producing province of Quebec increased by **8.6%**. Other notable increases were recorded by Alberta up **52.1%** and British Columbia up **38.6%**.

Cumulatively, the Canadian market has generated **22,416** additional arrivals in the January to May period, with a total of **99,101** stopovers compared to **76,685** in

2006. The main provinces of Ontario with **59,573** and Quebec with **14,095** increased by **17.3%** and **31.7%** respectively. The provinces of Alberta, British Columbia and Saskatchewan increased by **90.7%**, **108.7%**, and **189.9%**, respectively.

Europe

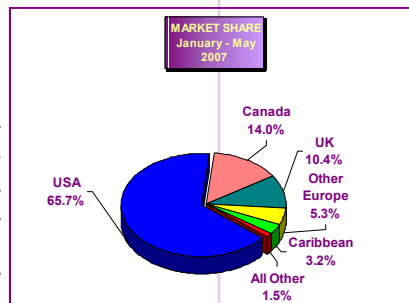
The European market recorded a **17.3%** increase in May 2007. The market provided a total of **21,013** stopover visitors compared to the **17,912** recorded in May 2006. In the Northern European market region the main visitor producing country, United Kingdom with **14,858** arrivals increased by **14.1%**, while Ireland with **277** visitors increased by **63.3%**. In the South/Western Europe region the main visitor producing countries, Germany and Spain with **1,476** and **1,191** increased **57.2%** and **22.4%** respectively. The Netherlands with **600**, and Belgium with **595** increased by **5.8%**, and **31.9%** respectively. Special mention is given to the country of Portugal which recorded a notable increase of **185.2%** with **442** visitors compared to **155** in 2006. In the third market region, Central/East Europe with **265** arrivals, increased by **6%**.

For the January to May period, the European market increased by **12.8%**. Total stopovers was **111,480** compared to **98,791** in 2006. In Northern Europe, the United Kingdom with **74,008** arrivals increased by **14%**. In South/Western Europe, Germany with **9,473** arrivals declined by **4.7%** and Italy with **7,271** declined by **15.1%**. In Central/East Europe **2,623** arrivals increased by **40.1%**.

Latin America

The Latin American market increased by **15.4%** in May with a total of **964** stopovers compared to **835** in May 2006. From the Central American region a total of **460** arrivals up by **1.3%**. From South America, **504** arrivals up by **32.3%**.

For the January to May period, The Latin American market declined by **7.2%** with a total of **4,146** visitors compared to **4,470** for the corresponding period in 2006.



The Caribbean

Visitors to Jamaica from the Caribbean region increased by **25%** in May with a total of **5,474** visitors, compared to **4,378** in May 2006.

The major Caribbean countries which provided visitors to Jamaica in May were: the Cayman Islands (**1,438**), Trinidad and Tobago (**1,151**), Barbados (**661**), and the Bahamas Is. (**509**).

Cumulatively, the Caribbean stopover arrivals to Jamaica in the January to May period increased by **13.1%**, moving from **19,808** in 2006 to **22,407** in 2007. The Cayman Islands is the leading provider of visitors to Jamaica from the Caribbean region. In the period under review, they provided a total of **7,178** visitors followed by Trinidad & Tobago with **4,002**, Barbados with **2,120** and the Bahamas Is. with **1,533** visitors.

Other Countries

Of the other countries, Japan with **250** stopovers in May declined by **3.1%** against the **258** who came in 2006. Australia with **227** up by **44.6%** against the **157** who came in 2006. India with **162** up by **113.2%** compared to the **76** who came in 2006.

Market Share

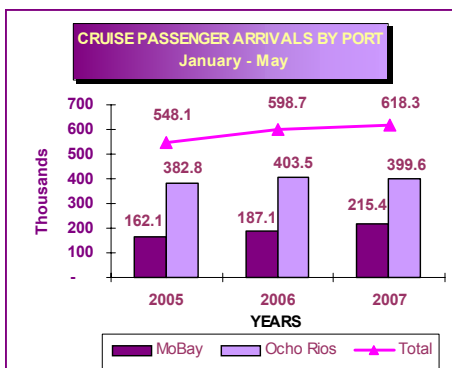
The market share of stopover visitors for the January to May period was as follows:

USA **65.7%**; Canada **14%**; UK **10.4%**; Continental Europe **5.3%**, the Caribbean **3.2%**; and Other Countries **1.5%**.

Cruise Passengers

A total of **93,151** cruise passengers visited Jamaica in May 2007. This represented a **11.8%** increase against the **83,311** recorded for May 2006.

Cumulatively, a total of **618,297** cruise passengers visited our shores in the January to May period, an increase of **3.3%** against the **598,687** recorded for the corresponding period in 2006.



A total of **61,869** cruise passengers visited the port of Ocho Rios in May, this was less than **1%** or **181** passengers more than the **61,688** recorded for May 2006.

For the January to May period, cruise passenger arrivals to the port of Ocho Rios was **399,648**, a decrease of **1%** against the **403,548** recorded for the corresponding period in 2006.

Montego Bay recorded a total of **31,282** cruise passengers for the month, an increase of **44.7%** against the **21,623** recorded for 2006.

Cumulatively, for the January to May period, cruise passenger arrivals to the port of Montego Bay was **215,423**, an increase of **15.1%** against the **187,140** recorded for the corresponding period in 2006.

Length of Stay

The average length of stay of **Foreign Nationals** in May was at the same level of **8.6** nights as in May 2006. The average length of stay in hotels was **6.6** nights compared to **6.3** nights in May 2006.

Cumulatively, the average length of stay for the January to May period was **9** nights as against the **8.8** nights recorded in 2006. In hotels the aver-

age length of stay during the period under review was **6.9** nights compared to **6.7** nights during 2006.

The average length of stay of **Non-Resident Jamaican** arrivals in May was **14.9** nights compared to the **14** nights in May 2006. The average length of stay in hotels was **7.3** nights compared to **6.9** nights in May 2006.

Cumulatively, the average length of stay for the January to May period was **15.6** nights as against the **15.5** nights recorded in 2006. In hotels the average length of stay during the period under review was **7.5** nights compared to **7.7** nights during 2006.

Purpose of Visit

During the period under review, January to May 2007, **80.6%** or **544,587** of the **675,754** Foreign Nationals who visited Jamaica were visiting for the purpose of Leisure, **6.5%** were on Business, **6.5%** were Visiting Friends & Relatives, and the remaining **6.4%** were on Other purposes of travel.

A total of **13,334** or **39.1%** of the **34,103** Non-Resident Jamaicans who travelled to Jamaica in May 2007 were visiting for Leisure, **26.2%** were visiting Friends & Relatives, **11.1%** were on Business and the remaining **23.6%** were on Other purposes of travel.

Intended Resort Area of Stay

Of the **709,857** stopover arrivals visiting Jamaica during January to May 2007, the resort area of Montego Bay welcomed **188,492** arrivals or **26.6%**. Ocho Rios received **183,598** or **25.9%**, Negril got **156,887** or **22.1%**, and Kingston got **87,145** or **12.3%**. The remaining **13.1%** stayed in the Mandeville/Southcoast, Port Antonio resort regions and Other areas in Jamaica.

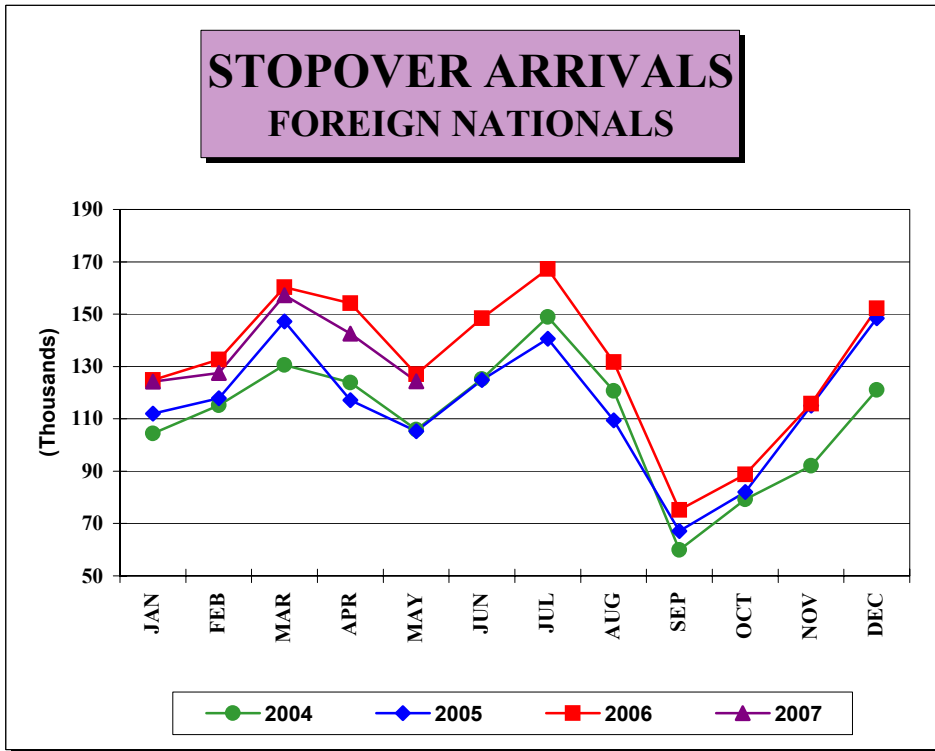

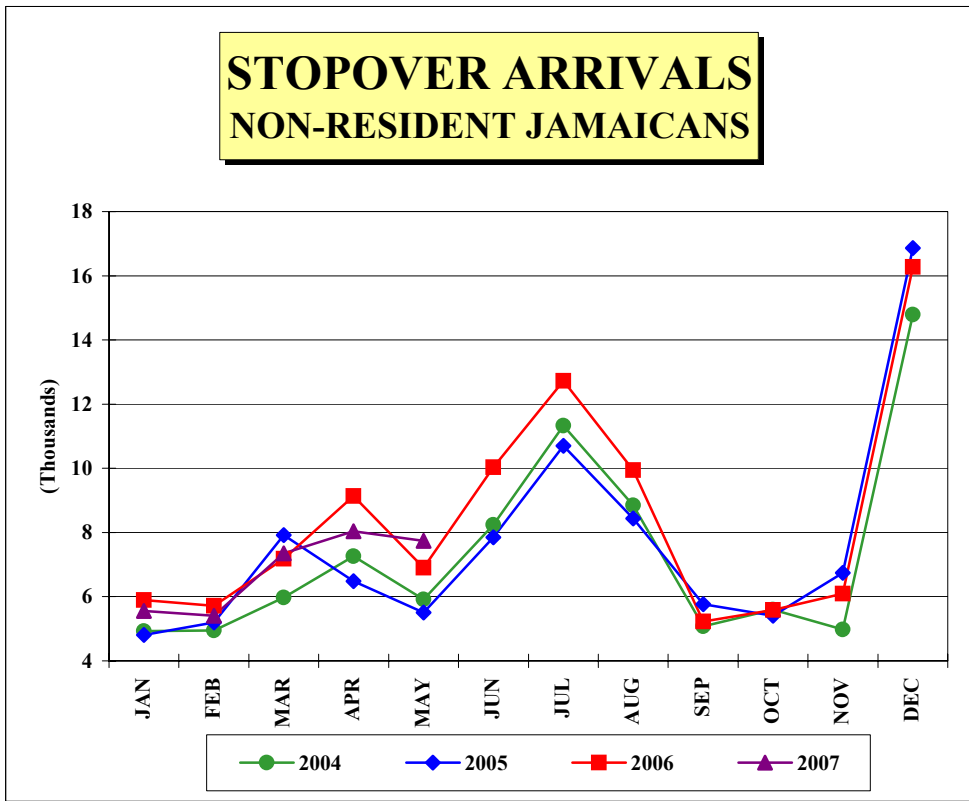

JANUARY - MAY 2007**

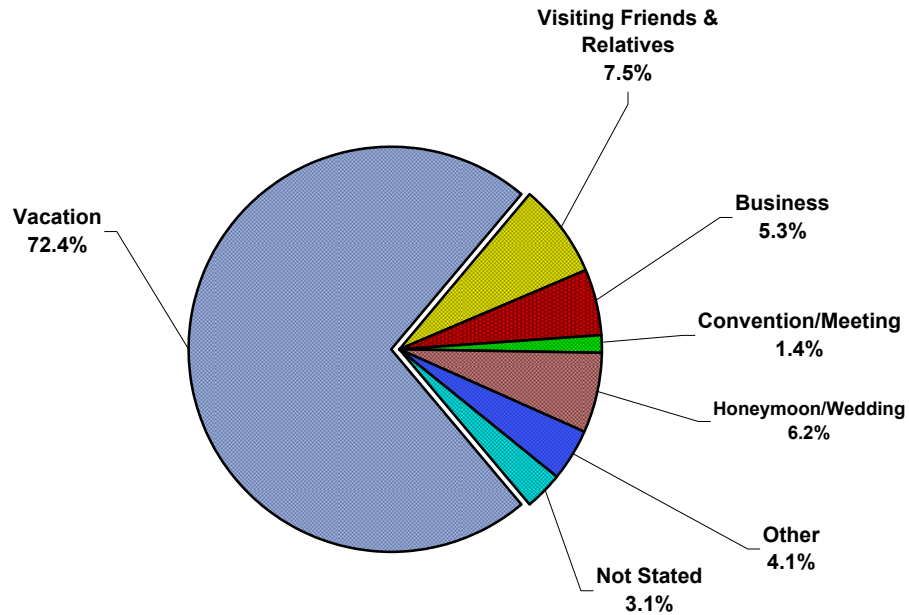

STOPOVER VISITORS BY MARKET SHARE

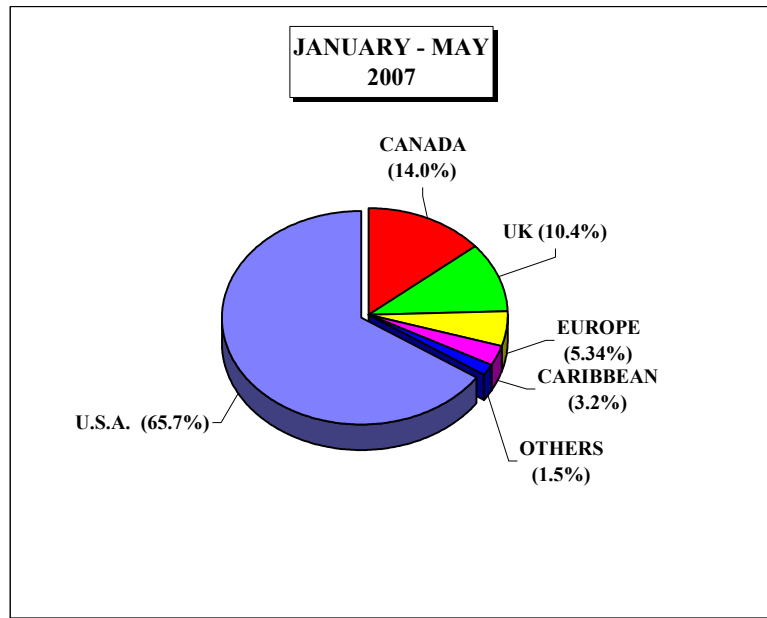

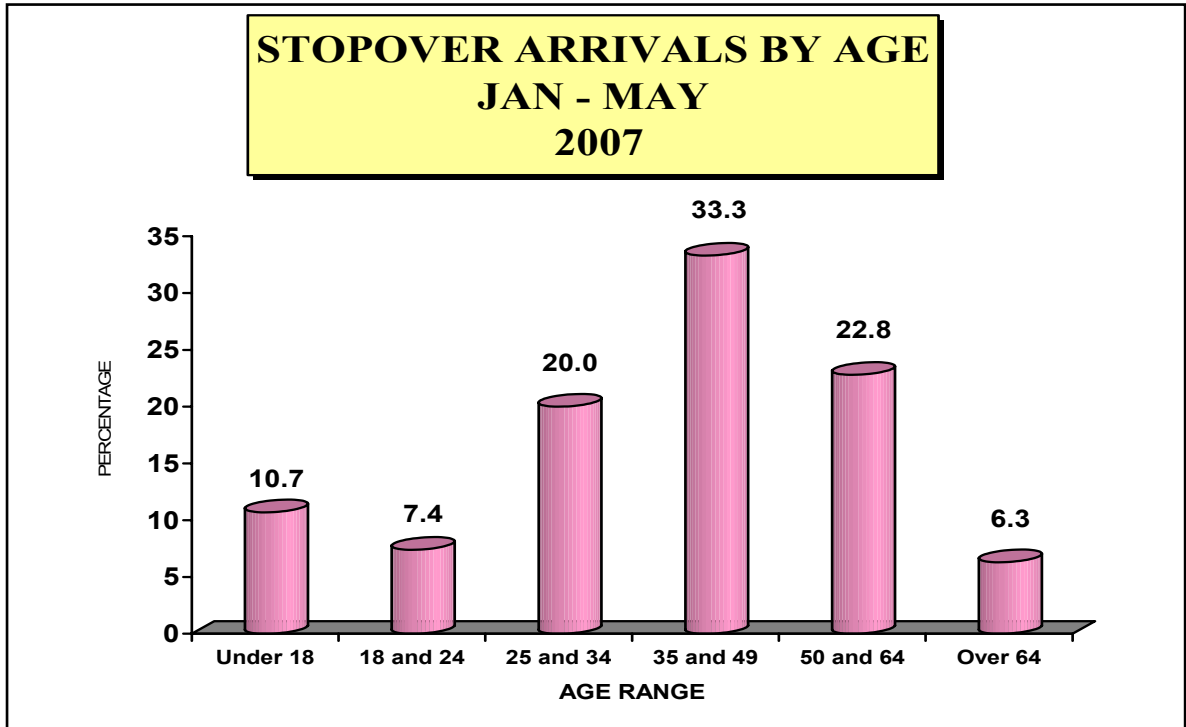

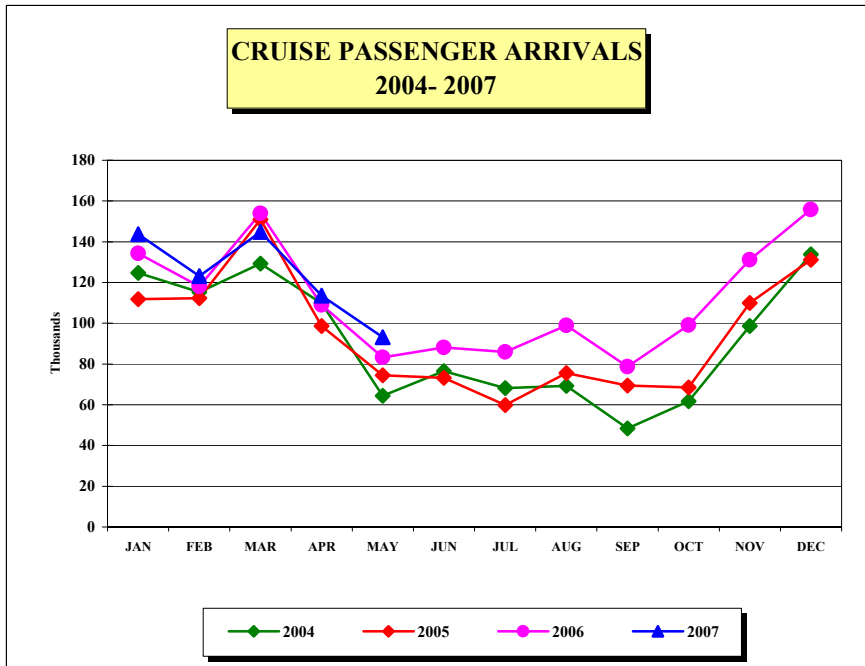

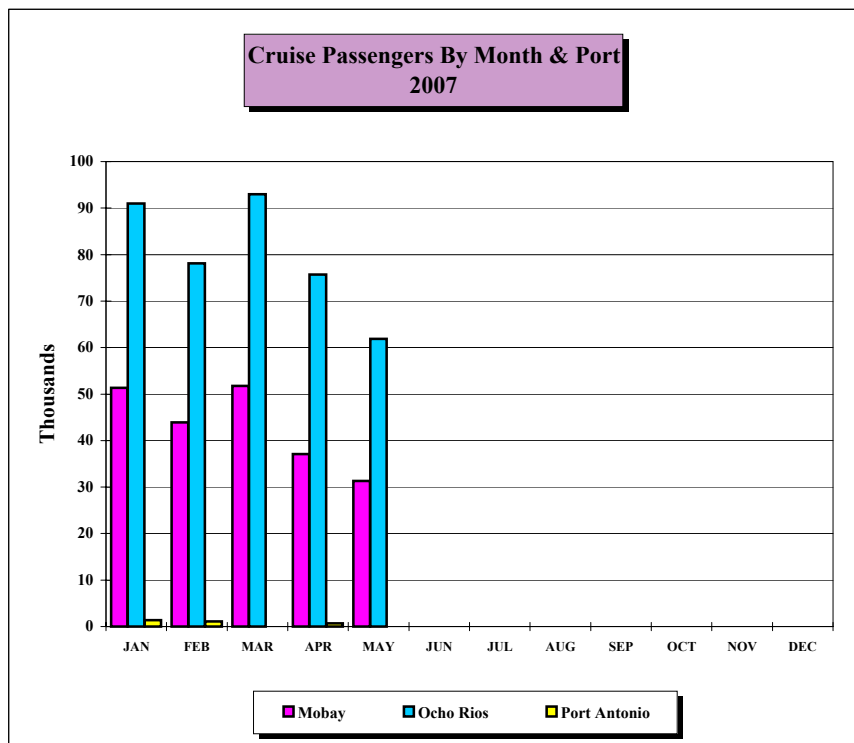

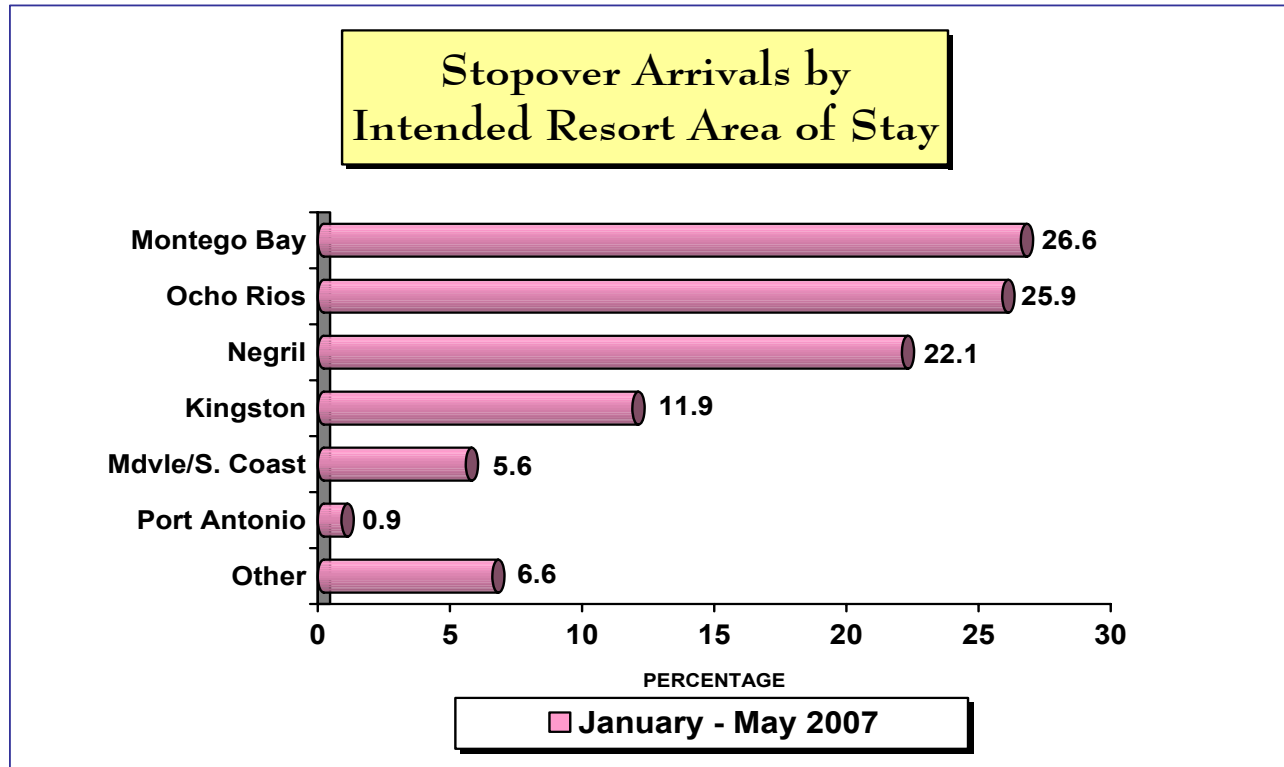
