

The Caribbean

Visitors to Jamaica from the Caribbean region declined by 3% in May with a total of 5,310 visitors, compared to 5,474 in May 2007.

The major Caribbean countries which provided visitors to Jamaica in May were: the Cayman Islands (1,883), Trinidad and Tobago (815), Barbados (511), the Bahamas Is. (307), St. Lucia (228) and Bermuda (220).

Cumulatively, the Caribbean stopover arrivals to Jamaica in the January to May period increased by 11.1%, moving from 22,407 in 2007 to 24,886 in 2008. The Cayman Islands is the leading provider of visitors to Jamaica from the Caribbean region. In the period under review, they provided a total of 7,917 visitors followed by Trinidad & Tobago with 4,194, Barbados with 2,108 and the Bahamas Is. with 1,643 visitors.

Asia

The Asian market declined by 29.5% in May with a total of 491 stopovers compared to 696 in May 2007.

The major Asian countries which provided visitors to Jamaica in May were: Japan (197) down 21.2%, China (91) down 41.3%, and India (70) down 56.8%.

Year-to-date, January to May the Asian market declined by 6.7% with 3,050 arrivals compared to 3,268 arrivals in 2007.

Other Countries

Of the other countries, Australia with 455 arrivals up by 100.4% and Israel with 84 up by 10.5% in May against the 227 and 76 respectively who came in May 2007.

Market Share

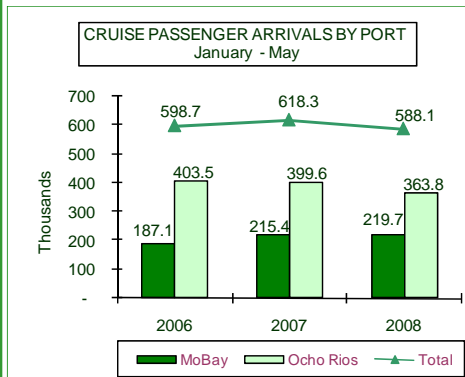
The market share of stopover visitors for the year-to-date period, January to May was as follows:

USA 64.6%; Canada 16.2%; UK 9.7%; Continental Europe 4.8%, the Caribbean 3.2%; Latin America 0.8%; Asia 0.4% and Other Countries 0.3%.

Cruise Passengers

A total of 59,860 cruise passengers visited Jamaica in May 2008. This represented a 35.7% decrease against the 93,151 recorded for May 2007.

Cumulatively, a total of 588,119 cruise passengers visited our shores in the January to May period, a decrease of 4.9% against the 618,297 recorded for the corresponding period in 2007.



A total of 38,096 cruise passengers visited the port of Ocho Rios in May, a decline of 38.4% over the 61,869 recorded for May 2007.

For the January to May period, cruise passenger arrivals to the port of Ocho Rios was 363,810, a decline of 9% against the 399,648 recorded for the corresponding period in 2007.

Montego Bay recorded a total of 21,764 cruise passengers for the month, a decrease of 30.4% against the 31,282 recorded for 2007.

Year-to-date, January to May period, cruise passenger arrivals to the port of Montego Bay was 219,744, an increase of 2% against the 215,423 recorded for the corresponding period in 2007.

Length of Stay

The average length of stay of Foreign National arrivals in May was 8.4 nights compared to the 8.6 nights in May 2007. The average length of stay in hotels was 6.5 nights compared to 6.6 nights in May 2007.

Cumulatively, the average length of stay for the January to May period was 8.5 nights as against the 9 nights recorded in

2007. In hotels the average length of stay during the period under review was 6.9 nights, same level as in 2007.

The average length of stay of Non-Resident Jamaican arrivals in May was 15.1 nights compared to the 14.9 nights in May 2007. The average length of stay in hotels was 8.3 nights compared to 7.3 nights in May 2007.

Cumulatively, the average length of stay for the January to May period was 16.1 nights as against the 15.6 nights recorded in 2007. In hotels the average length of stay during the period under review was 8.6 nights compared to 7.5 nights during 2007.

Purpose of Visit

Year-to-date, January to May 2008, 79.7% or 578,703 of the 726,255 Foreign Nationals who visited Jamaica were visiting for the purpose of Leisure, 6.3% were on Business, 7.6% were Visiting Friends & Relatives, and the remaining 6.4% were on Other purposes of travel.

A total of 17,321 or 33.9% of the 51,139 Non-Resident Jamaicans who travelled to Jamaica in January to May 2008 were visiting for Leisure, 31% were visiting Friends & Relatives, 8.6% were on Business and the remaining 26.6% were on Other purposes of travel.

Intended Resort Area of Stay

Of the 777,394 stopover arrivals visiting Jamaica year-to-date, January to May 2008, the resort area of Montego Bay welcomed 216,176 arrivals or 27.8%. Ocho Rios received 202,614 or 26.1%, Negril got 162,879 or 21%, and Kingston got 91,033 or 11.7%. The remaining 13.5% stayed in the Mandeville/Southcoast, Port Antonio resort regions and Other areas in Jamaica.

Type of Airlines used

Of the 777,394 stopover arrivals visiting Jamaica year-to-date, January to May 2008, 638,839 or 82.2% used scheduled airlines, while 138,555 or 17.8% used chartered flights.

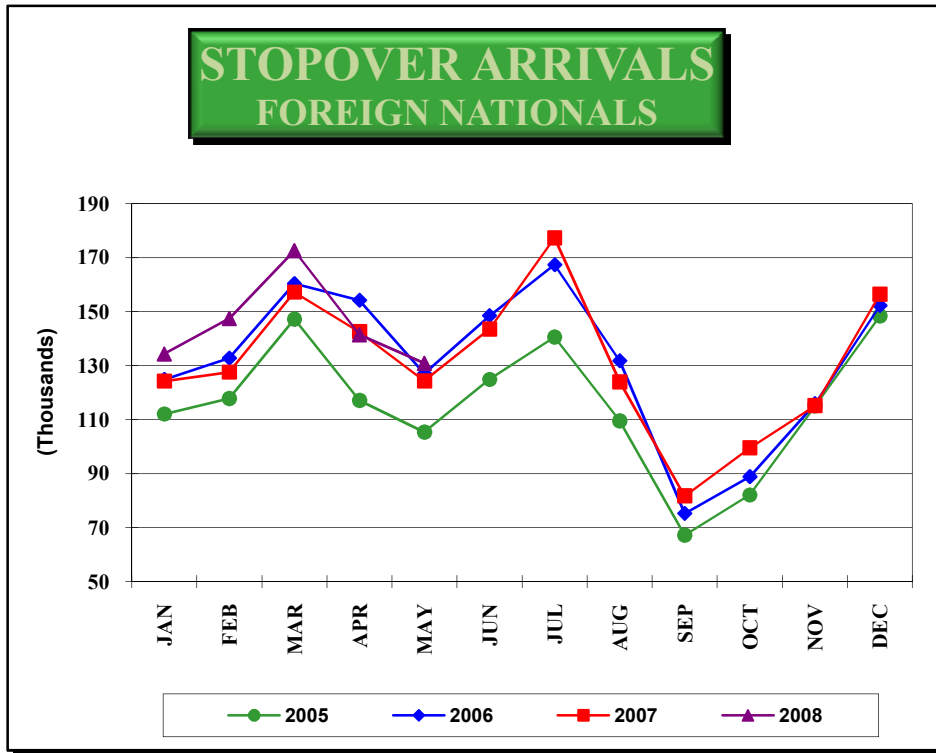

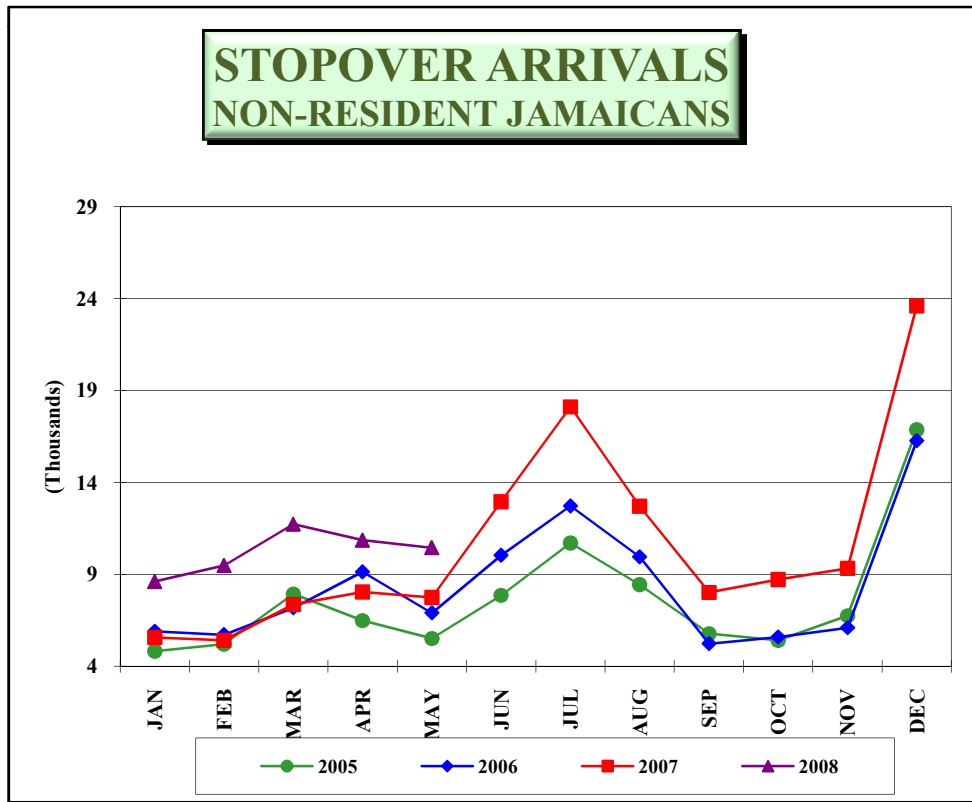

2008**

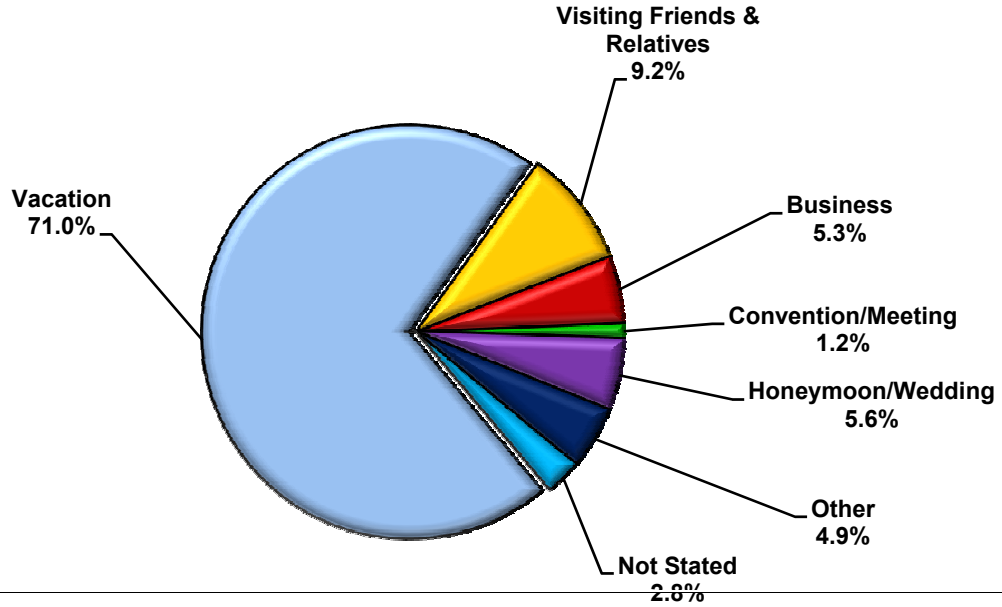

STOPOVER VISITORS BY MARKET SHARE

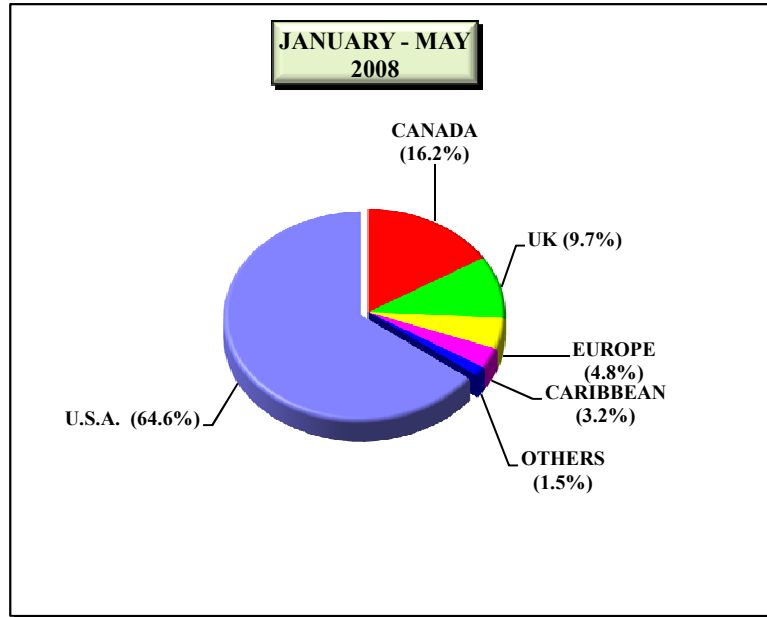

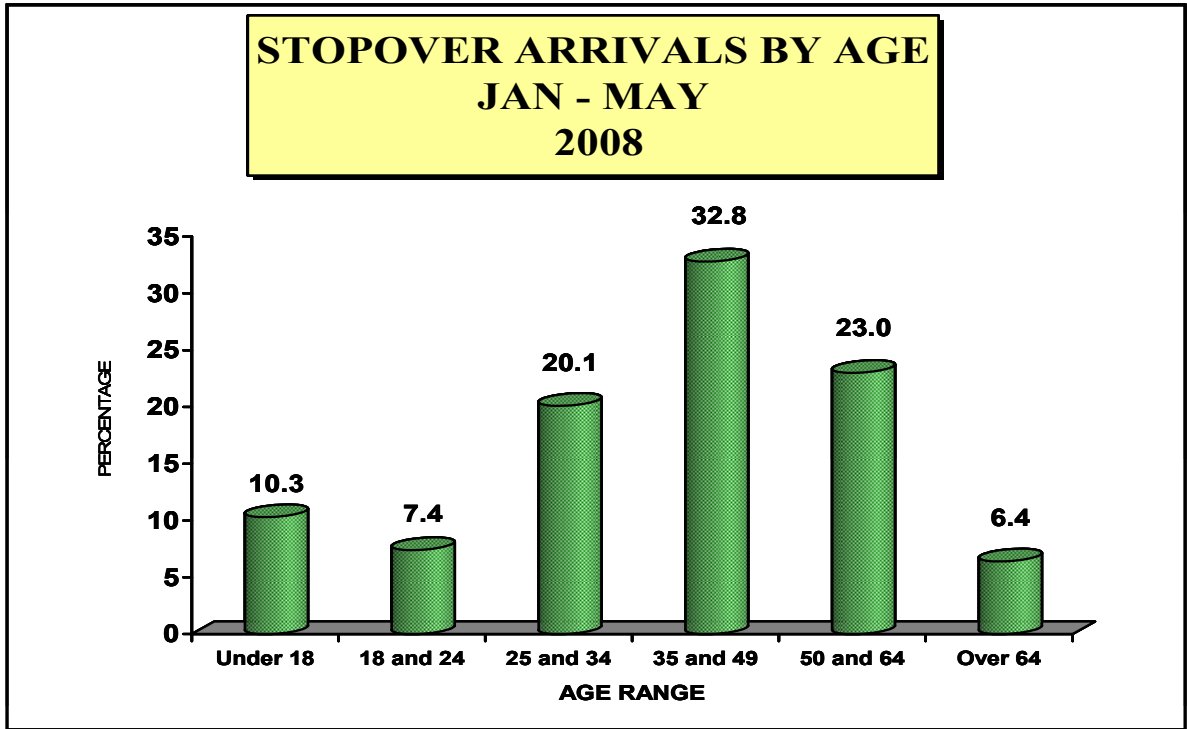

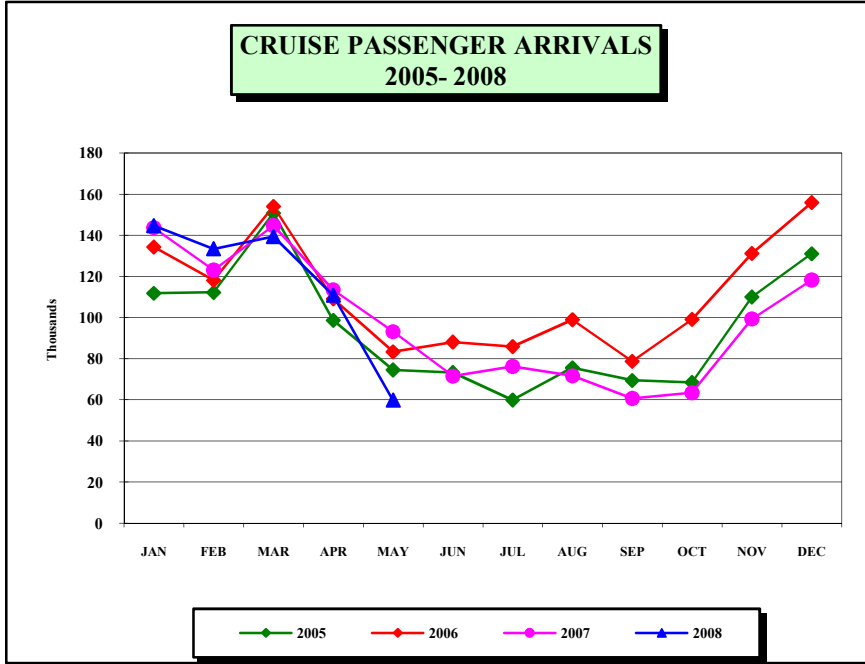

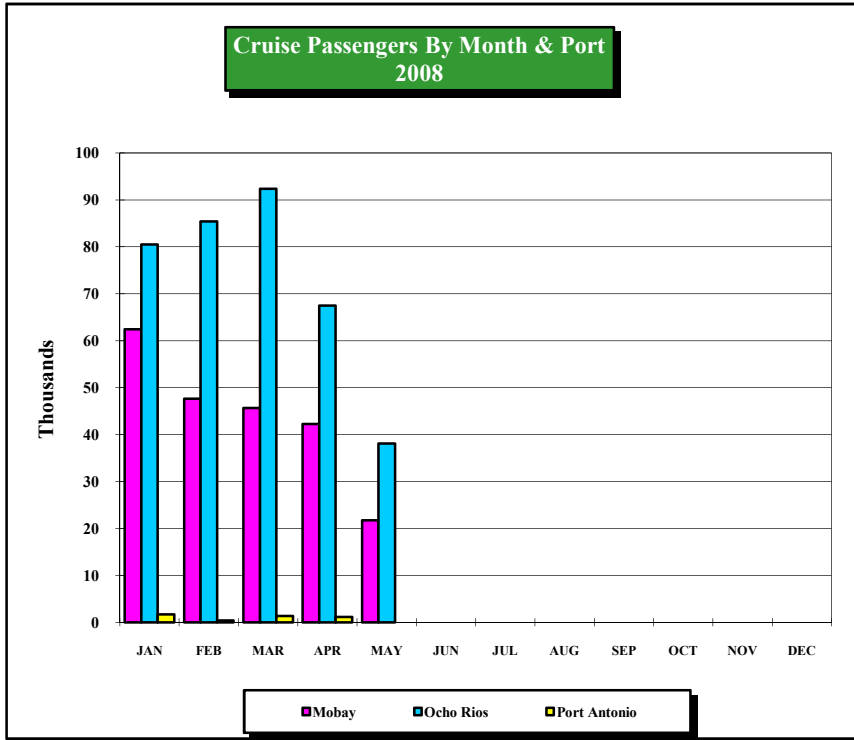

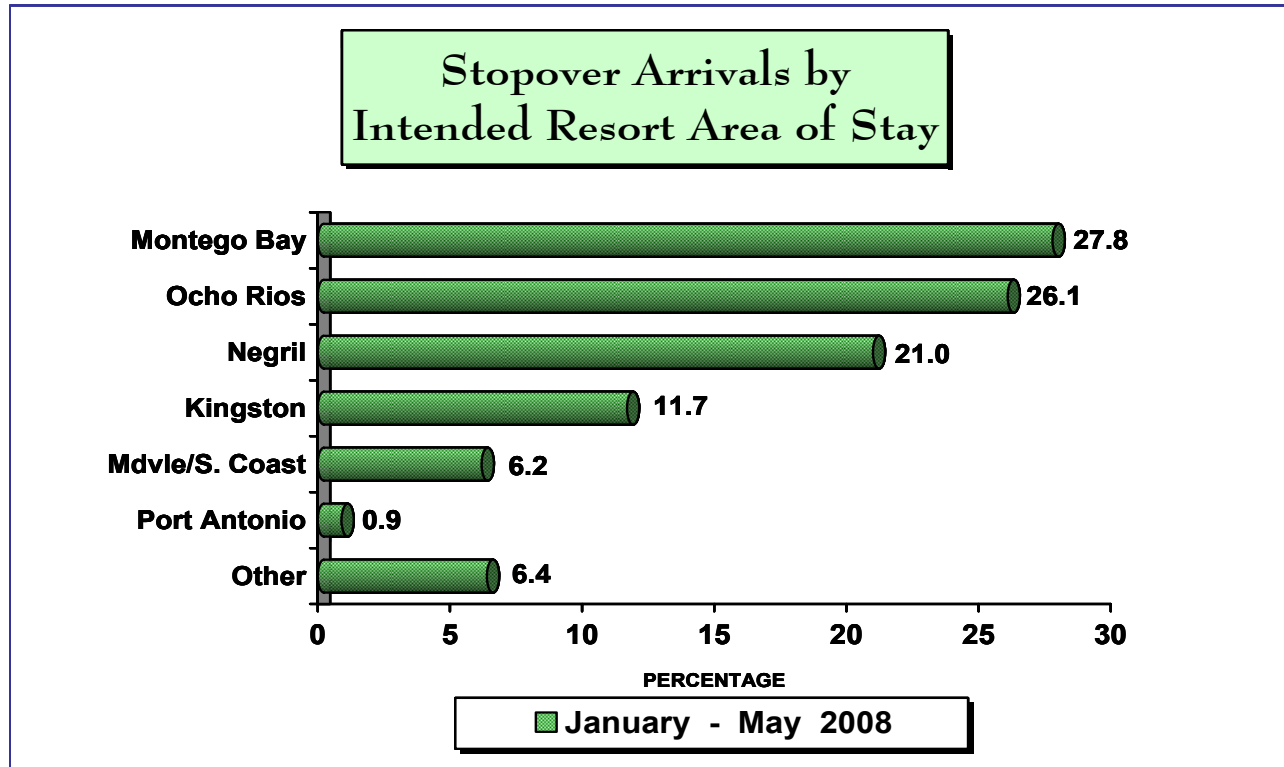
