TOURIST (Stopover Arrivals)

Jamaica recorded double digit growth for the month of September 2006, with the arrival of **80,397** stopovers. This was an increase of **10.2%** over the **72,926** recorded in September 2005.

For the first five months of summer, May to September 2006, stopover arrivals increased by **18.6%**, with a total of **694,370** compared to **585,644** for the same period in 2005.

Cumulatively, stopover arrivals for the January to September period, have grown by **17.2%** with **1,294,204** compared to **1,104,035** in 2005.

United States

Stopover arrivals from the United States market increased by **10.8%** in September, a total of **52,580** visitors compared to the **47,459** visitors who came in September 2005. All marketing regions in the United States recorded increases. The West increased by **16.8%**, the Midwest by **14.7%**, the South by **12.4%** and the Northeast by **6.6%**.

For the summer period to date, May to September, the US market recorded an increase of **18.8%**. With all marketing regions recording double digit increases, the South increased by **26.4%**, the Northeast by **16%**, the West by **14.7%** and the Midwest by **12.5%**.

For the January to September period, the US market increased by **17.9%**, with an additional **151,344** arrivals. Total visitors from this market was **937,334** compared to **795,001** for the corresponding period in 2005. All marketing regions recorded positive growth. The South increased by **29.0%**, the West by **18.8%**, the Northeast by **13.5%**, and the Midwest by **12%**.

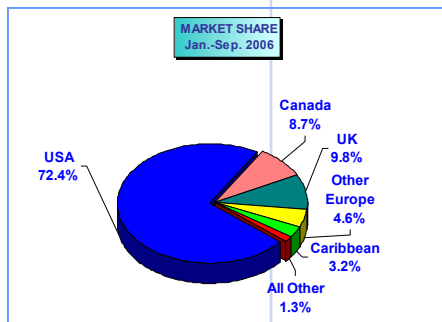
Canada

In September, the Canadian market again increased by a remarkable **32.6%**, with total stopovers arrivals from this market recording **5,453** compared to **4,112** in 2005.

The leading province of Ontario increased by **22.5%**, while the second most important visitor-producing province of Quebec increased by **141.8%**. Increases were also recorded for the provinces of Alberta up by **37.9%**, and British Columbia up by **8.1%**.

For the first five months of summer, May to September, a total of **44,631** stopovers came from this market compared to **31,163** in 2005, an increase of **43.2%**.

Cumulatively, the Canadian market has generated **26,894** additional arrivals in the January to September period with a total of **112,252** stopovers compared to **85,358** in 2005, representing an increase of **31.5%**. The main province of Ontario with **79,392** arrivals increased by **34.2%**, supplying **20,249** more arrivals compared to the **59,143** in 2005. The provinces of Quebec and Alberta increased by **20%** and **20.4%** respectively. The other notable increases were New Brunswick **78.2%**, Nova Scotia **70.6%** and Manitoba **29.4%**.



Europe

The European market recorded a **3.1%** increase in September 2006. The market provided a total of **16,491** stopover visitors compared to the **16,001** recorded in September 2005. In the Northern Europe region the main visitor producing country, United Kingdom with **11,829** arrivals increased by **4.9%**. In the South/Western Europe region the main visitor producing countries, Germany with **869** decreased by **20.9%**, Italy with **579** declined by **35.8%** and Spain with **1,019** increased by **10.6%**. Also, the countries of Portugal with **350** and Netherlands with **564**, grew by **9.7%** and **40.3%** respectively. In the third market region, Central/East Europe with **238** arrivals, increased by **4.8%**.

During the summer period, May to September, the European market increased by **9.8%** with **105,024** visitors compared to **95,624** visitors who came in the same period of 2005.

For the January to September period, the European market increased by **8.3%**. Total stopovers for the period was **185,903** compared to **171,709** in 2005. In Northern Europe, the United Kingdom with **126,509** arrivals increased by **16%**. In South/Western Europe, Germany the second leading European producing country with **13,758** visitors, increased by **1.3%**, and Italy with **13,612** arrivals decreased by **30.2%**. In the third market region, Central/East Europe with **2,749** arrivals, declined by **9.7%**.

Latin America

The Latin American market increased by **2%** in September with a total of **784** stopovers compared to **769** in September 2005. The Central American region, increased by **17.4%**, with **425** stopovers compared to **362** in September 2005. The South American countries combined declined by **11.8%**, with **359** stopovers compared to **407** in September 2005.

For the January to September period, the Latin American market increased by **32.3%** with a total of **8,376** visitors compared to **6,332** for the corresponding period in 2005.

The Caribbean

Visitors to Jamaica from the Caribbean region increased by **13%** in September with a total of **4,305** visitors, compared to **3,809** in September 2005.

The major Caribbean countries which provided visitors to Jamaica in September were: the Cayman Islands (**1,358**), Trinidad and Tobago (**669**), Barbados (**417**), and Bahamas (**217**).

Cumulatively, the Caribbean stopover arrivals to Jamaica during the January to September period were above the level achieved in 2005, moving from **37,608** in 2005 to **41,575** in 2006. The Cayman Islands is the leading provider of visitors to Jamaica from the Caribbean region. In the period under review, they provided a total of **12,406** visitors followed by Trinidad and Tobago with **6,417**, Barbados with **4,523** and The Bahamas Is. with **2,665** visitors.

Japan

The Japanese market declined by **25.2%** in September with a total of **226** stopovers compared to **302** in September 2005.

Cumulatively for the January to September period, a total of **2,963** Japanese visitors came to Jamaica. This was down from the **3,290** recorded for the corresponding period in 2005.

Other Countries

Of the other countries, Australia with **120** stopovers in September increased by **11.1%** against the **97** who came in 2005.

Market Share

The market share of stopover visitors for the period January to September 2006 was as follows:

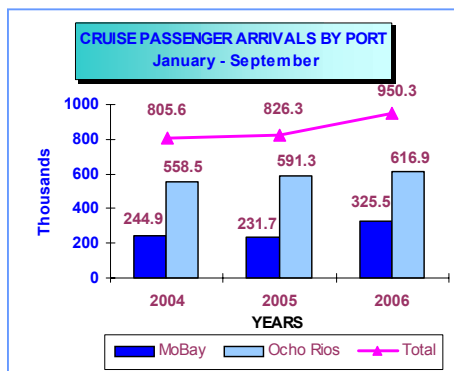
USA **72.4%**; Canada **8.7%**; UK **9.8%**; Continental Europe **4.6%**, the Caribbean **3.2%**; Latin America **0.7%**; Japan **0.2%** and Other Countries **0.4%**.

Cruise Passengers

A total of **78,702** cruise passengers visited Jamaica in September 2006. This represents a growth of **13.3%** against the **69,463** recorded for September 2005.

For the summer period to date, May to September, cruise passenger arrivals increased by **23.3%**, with a total of **434,953** passengers compared to **352,650** in 2005.

Cumulatively, a total of **950,329** cruise passengers visited our shores in the January to September period, an increase of **15%** against the **826,277** recorded for the corresponding period in 2005.



A total of **46,642** cruise passengers visited the port of Ocho Rios in September, a decrease of **20.2%** over the **58,442** recorded for September 2005.

For the January to September period, cruise passenger arrivals to the port of Ocho Rios was **616,865**, an increase of **4.3%** against the **591,294** recorded for the corresponding period in 2005.

The port of Montego Bay, more than doubled the arrival of cruise passengers for the month of September with **32,060** passengers, an increase of **190.9%** against the **11,021** recorded for 2005. The main contributing factor to this extraordinary increase is the visit of the Freedom of the Sea which began calling at the port of Montego Bay in June.

Cumulatively, for the January to September period, cruise passenger arrivals to the port of Montego Bay was **325,465**, an increase of **40.5%** against the **231,674** recorded for the same period in 2005.

Length of Stay

The average length of stay of **Foreign National** arrivals in September was **10.5** nights, which is the same level recorded in September 2005.

Cumulatively, the average length of stay for the January to September period was **9.5** nights, compared to **9.6** nights recorded in 2005.

The average length of stay of **Non-Resident Jamaican** arrivals in September was **16.9** nights compared to the **17** nights in September 2005. Cumulatively, the average length of stay for the January to September period was **16.7** nights, compared to **20.1** nights in 2005.

Purpose of Visit

During the period under review, January to September 2006, **82.6%** or **1,009,054** of the **1,221,452** Foreign Nationals who visited Jamaica were visiting for the purpose of Leisure, **5.7%** were on Business, **6.1%** were Visiting Friends & Relatives, and the remaining **5.6%** were on Other purposes of travel.

A total of **35,588** or **48.9%** of the **72,752** Non-Resident Jamaicans who travelled to Jamaica in this period January to September 2006 were visiting for Leisure, **21.7%** were Visiting Friends & Relatives, **10.2%** were on Business and the remaining **19.2%** were on Other Purposes of travel.

Intended Resort Area of Stay

Of the **1,294,204** stopover arrivals visiting Jamaica during January and September 2006, the resort area of Montego Bay welcomed **353,689** arrivals or **27.3%**. Ocho Rios received **310,070** or **24%**, Negril got **272,478** or **21.1%**, and Kingston received **166,121** or **12.8%**. The remaining **14.8%** stayed in the Mandeville/Southcoast, Port Antonio resort regions and Other areas in Jamaica.

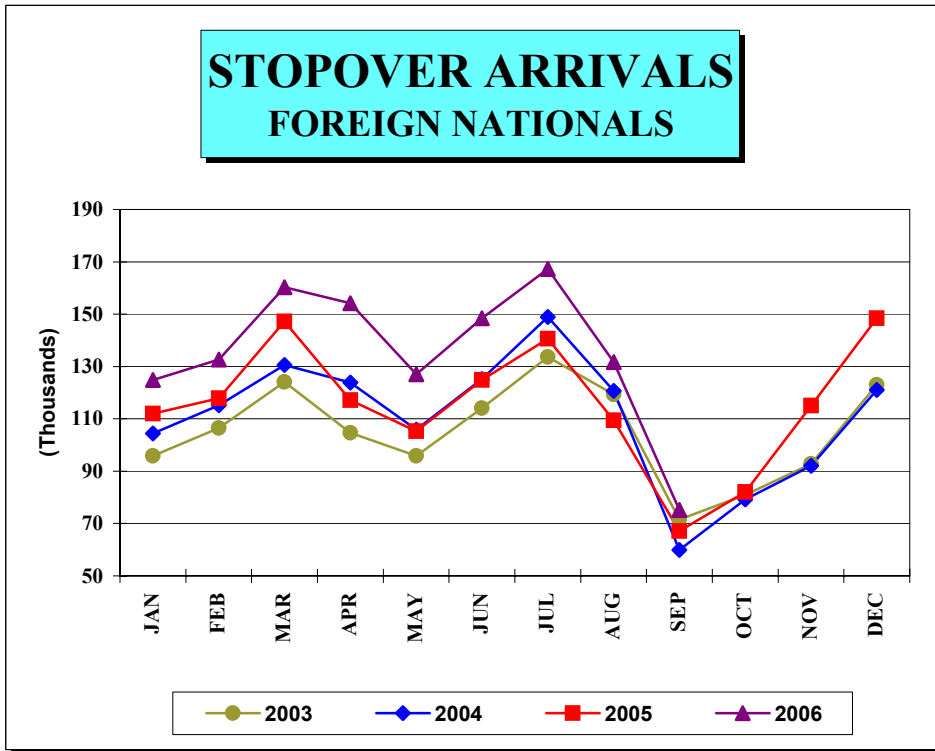

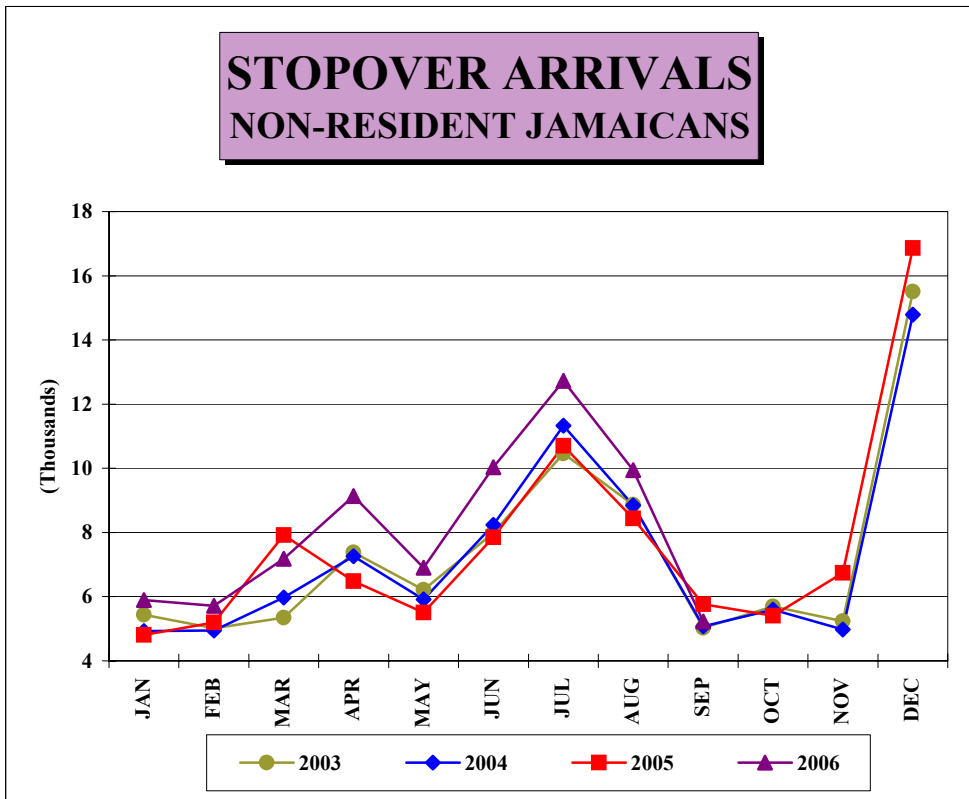

JAN - SEPTEMBER 2006**

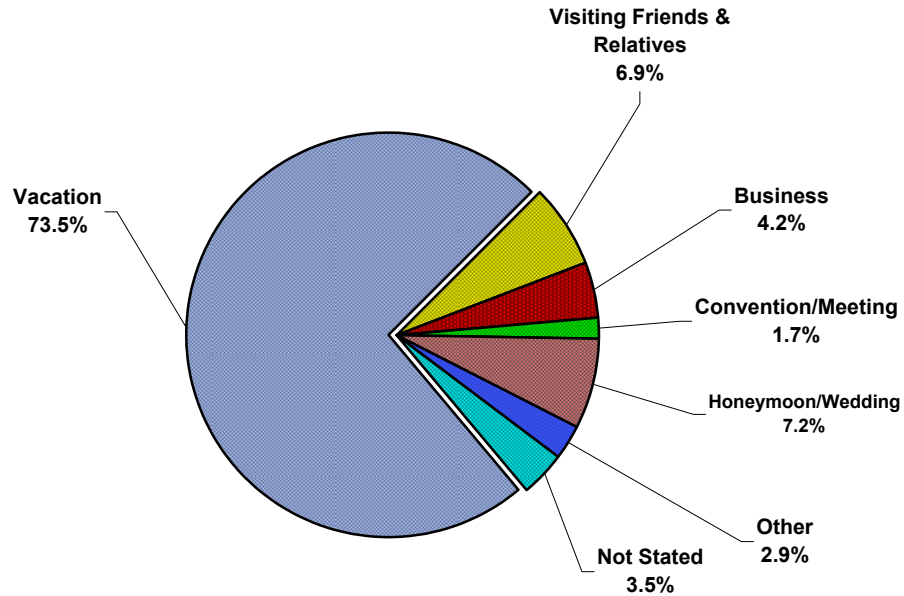

STOPOVER VISITORS BY MARKET SHARE

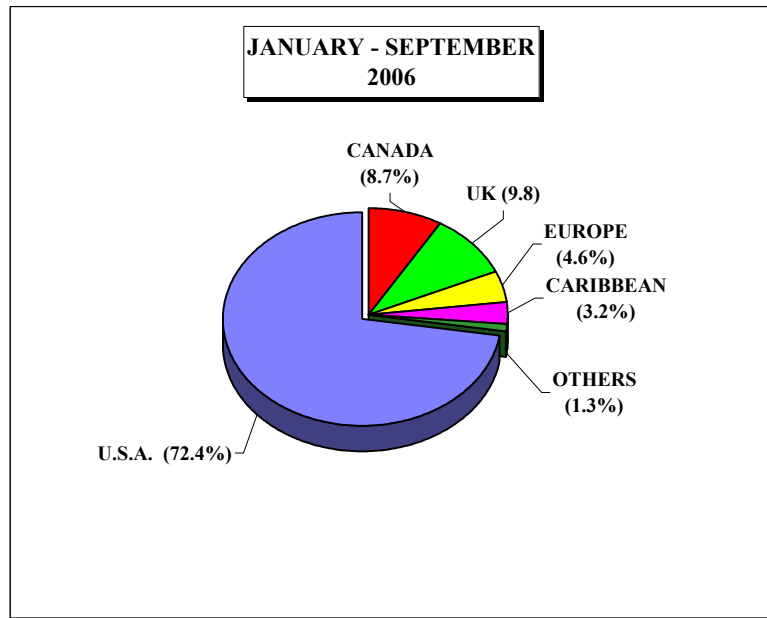

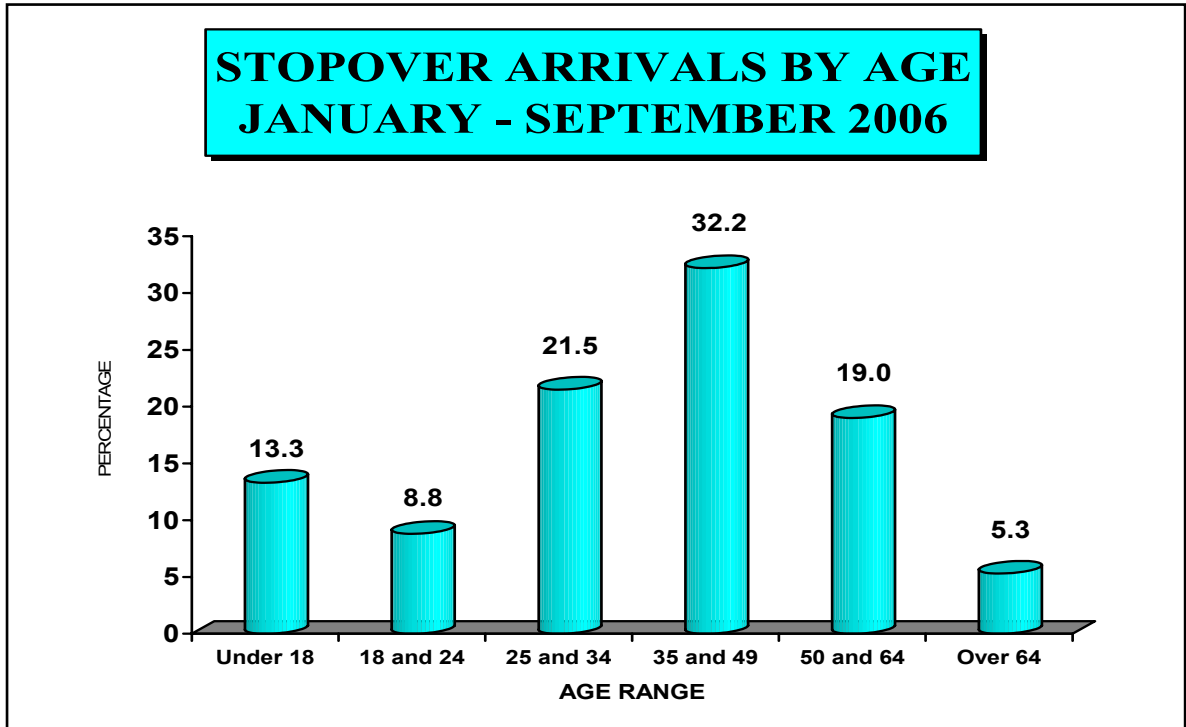

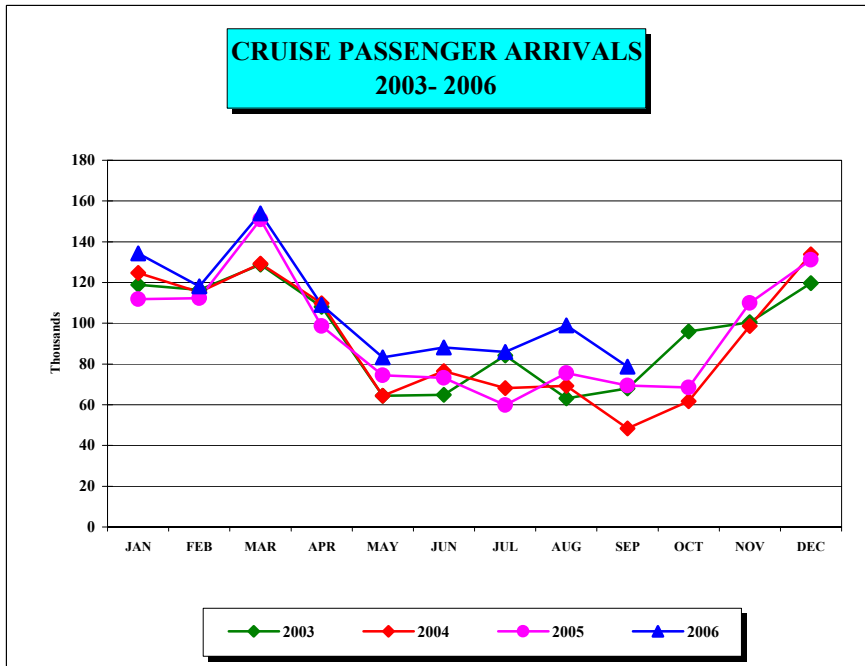

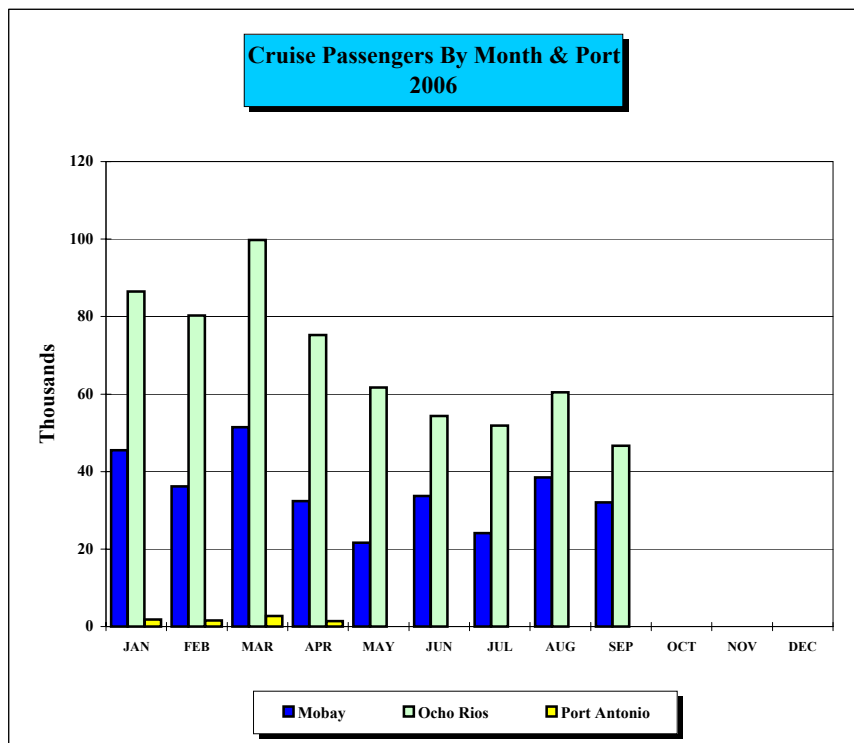

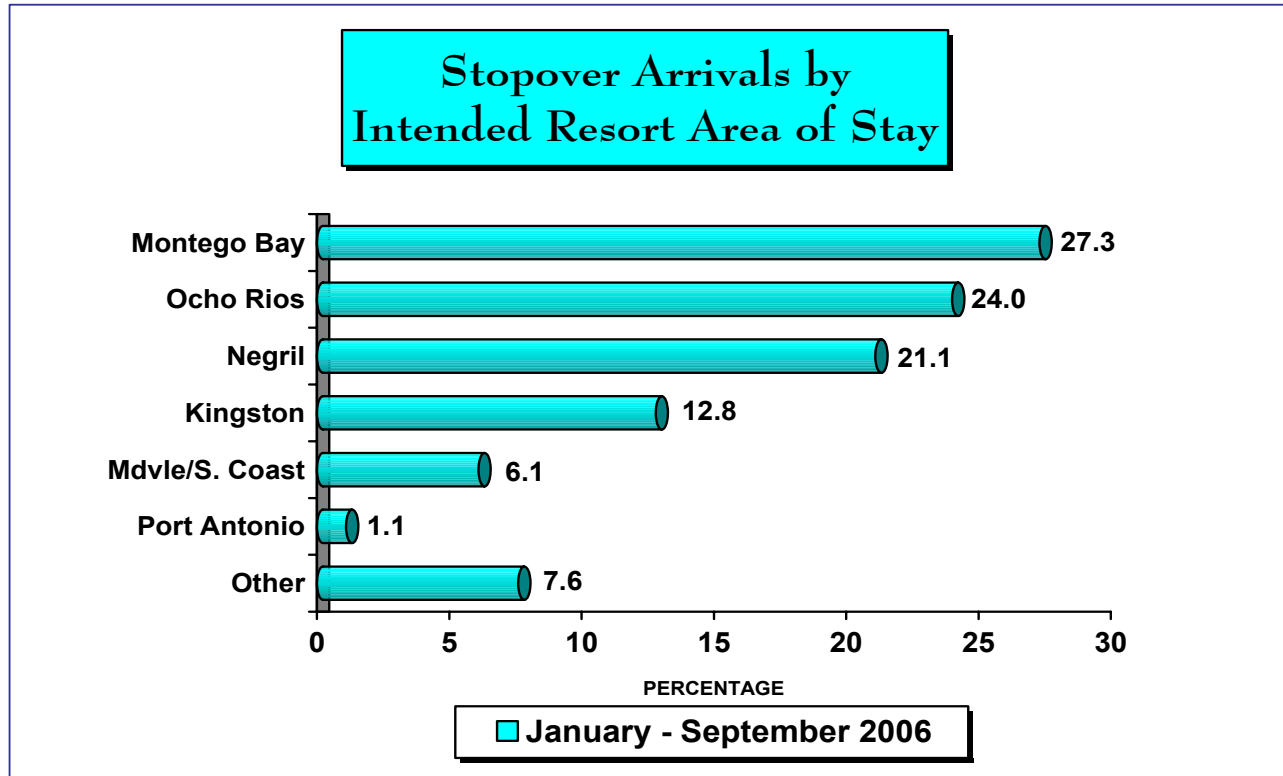
