JAMAICA UPDATE ON COVID-19

Dear Valued Partners,

Jamaica has recorded 36 confirmed cases of COVID-19, including one death.

- In terms of the classification of cases, 24 of the cases were imported, 10 are importrelated (close contacts of the imported cases) and 2 are being investigated to determine how they contracted the disease.
- Since the closure of the air and sea ports to all incoming passengers, airlines have been allowed to land at the airports to repatriate passengers to their home countries.

This week, the current schedule shows JetBlue, Delta and Condor will arrive into Sangster International to pick up passengers; while JetBlue will fly into the Norman Manley Airport to pick up passengers

- Bars, nightclubs and other places of entertainment will remain closed until mid-April.
- Public gatherings are limited to no more than 10 persons.
