TOURIST (Stopover Arrivals)

Stopover arrivals in December 2016 were a record **230,453**, an increase of **5.2%** when compared to the **219,096** recorded in December 2015.

For the Summer 2016 period, May to December, arrivals were up **3.1%**, with **1,408,576** stopovers compared to **1,366,579** in 2015.

Year to date, January to December 2016, arrivals increased by **2.8%**, with **2,181,684** stopovers compared to **2,123,042** in 2015.

United States

Stopover arrivals from the United States market recorded a **6.6%** increase in December 2016 with a total of **143,260** arrivals compared to the **134,387** arrivals who visited in December 2015. All US marketing regions recorded increases in arrivals. The Northeast region increased by **3.2%** with **61,833** arrivals, the South with **37,441** rose by **8.5%**, the Mid-west with **25,979** increased by **10.2%**, and the West with **18,007** increased by **9.9%**.

For the Summer 2016 period, May to December, the US market region recorded a **3.9%** increase in arrivals, with **934,487** visitors compared to the **899,044** visitors during the same period in 2015. The Northeast was down **0.8%**, the South was up **6.1%**, the Midwest was up **7.1%** and the West up **11.8%**.

Year-to-date, January to December 2016, the US market region has grown by **4.6%**, with **1,406,058** visitors compared to the **1,344,149** visitors during the same period in 2015. This was **61,909** more arrivals than in 2015, as well as, **109,601** more than in 2014. The Northeast was up by **1.1%**, the Mid-west up by **5.4%**, the South up by **6.1%**, and the West was up **13.5%**.

Canada

In December 2016, the Canadian market recorded an increase in arrivals of **2.9%**, with **45,007** stopovers compared to **43,745** in December 2015.

Stopover arrivals from Atlantic Canada grew by **5.0%**, the main provinces of Nova Scotia rose by **27.5%** and those from New Brunswick fell by **7.4%**, over December 2015.

Stopover arrivals from Central Canada grew by **3.8%**, the leading province of Ontario grew by **5.1%**, and the second most important Canadian province of Quebec recorded a decrease of **4.0%**.

Stopover arrivals from Western Canada fell by **1.7%**, Alberta recorded an increase of **3.4%**, and arrivals from British Columbia rose by **5.1%**.

For the Summer 2016 period, May to December, arrivals from Canada grew by **1.0%** with **209,290** stopovers compared to **207,172** during the same time in 2015.

Cumulatively, the Canadian market with **372,137** visitors recorded a decline of **4.9%** or **19,272** less visitors than in 2015. The top producing provinces of Ontario with **255,142** fell by **2.6%**, and Quebec, with **42,265** visitors fell by **13.3%**.

Europe

The European market region recorded a growth of **0.7%** in December 2016, with **30,884** stopover arrivals compared to the **30,659** recorded in December 2015.

In the Northern European region, the main visitor producing countries, United Kingdom, with **20,077** arrivals, grew by **3.3%** and Sweden with **1,819** arrivals declined by **33.4%**.

In the South-Western European region, Germany with **2,388** visitor arrivals grew by **2.1%**, Italy with **1,864** arrivals rose by **21.6%**, the Netherlands with **811** visitors rose by **29.8%**, and Belgium with **663** arrivals rose by **13.1%**.

Stopover arrivals from Central-East Europe with **1,247** arrivals grew by **92.1%**. The main visitor producing country, Poland with **754** arrivals, grew by **427.3%**

For the Summer 2016 period, May to December, arrivals from Europe grew by **3.4%**, with **190,329** arrivals compared to **184,155** in 2015.

Year-to-date, January to December 2016 period, arrivals from the European market grew by **5.5%**. Total stopover arrivals were **294,709** this was **15,377** more arrivals than the **279,332** recorded in 2015. Northern Europe grew by **4.9%**, moving from **215,830** in 2015 to **226,500** in 2016. Arrivals from the South/West region increased by **8.3%** with **61,544** arrivals, and those from the Central/East region declined by **0.1%** with **6,665** arrivals.

Latin America

Arrivals from Latin America grew by **10.2%** in December 2016, with a total of **2,363** stopovers compared to **2,144** in December 2015.

From the Central American region, stopover arrivals fell by **9.1%** with **693** arrivals. Mexico with **321** arrivals fell by **7.2%**, and Panama with **161** rose by **16.7%**.

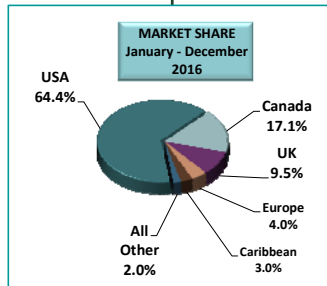
From the South American region, stopover arrivals grew by **20.8%** with **1,670** arrivals. Brazil with **584** arrivals rose by **110.8%** and Chile with **302** arrivals grew by **2.4%**.

For the Summer 2016 period, May to December arrivals from Latin America declined by **9.9%**, with **18,082** stopovers compared to **20,067** in 2015.

Cumulatively, January to December 2016, stopover arrivals from Latin America decreased by **5.7%**, with a total of **27,726** arrivals compared to **29,387** in 2015.

Stopovers from Central America increased by **8.4%**. The main Central American countries of Mexico, Costa Rica and Panama recorded increases of **5.0%**, **78.5%** and a decrease of **18.7%** respectively.

Stopovers from South America decreased by **12.5%** with **17,271** arrivals, The top producing countries of Chile with **4,350** arrivals fell by **18.7%**, and Argentina with **3,269** arrivals fell by **4.7%**.



The Caribbean

Stopover arrivals to Jamaica from the Caribbean region grew by **11.3%** in December 2016 with a total of **7,352** visitors, compared to **6,604** in December 2015.

The Cayman Islands and Trinidad & Tobago continued to be the major visitor producing Caribbean countries in December 2016 with **2,460** and **979** stopover arrivals, respectively.

Cumulatively, stopovers for the January - December 2016 period grew by **4.8%** moving from **62,612** in 2015 to **65,592** in 2016.

Asia

The Asian market decreased by **3.9%** in December 2016 with a total of **809** stopovers compared to **842** in December 2015.

China, Japan and India are the major visitor-producing countries with **318**, **239** and **125** stopovers arriving from each country, respectively.

For the January to December 2016 period, stopover arrivals from Asia fell by **3.1%**, with **8,949** arrivals compared to **9,238** arrivals in 2015.

Other Countries

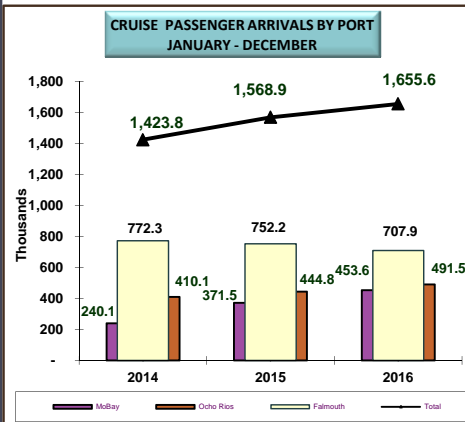
Overall, stopover arrivals from other countries decreased by **5.8%** for the period January to December 2016. Of the Other Countries, Australia provided the most stop-over arrivals to Jamaica, with **2,692** visitors in 2016 compared to **2,999** in 2015. This represents a decrease of **10.2%**.

Market Share

The market share of stopover visitors for the January to December 2016 was as follows: USA **64.4%**; Canada **17.1%**; UK **9.5%**; Continental Europe **4.0%**, the Caribbean **3.0%**; and the others, including Latin America and Asia **2.0%**.

Cruise Passengers

A total of **182,341** cruise passengers visited Jamaica in December 2016. This represented a **20.4%** decrease over the **229,020** for December 2015.



For December 2016, all major ports recorded declines in Cruise passenger arrivals. The Ocho Rios port decreased by **34.6%**, those visiting Montego Bay decreased by **2.4%**, and Cruise passengers visiting the port of Falmouth port decreased by **22.6%**.

For the Summer period, May to December 2016, cruise passengers visiting Jamaica decreased by **0.4%**, with **910,345** passengers compared to **914,138** during the same period in 2015.

Year to date, January to December 2016 period saw **1,655,565** cruise passenger arrivals at the three major ports, an increase of **86,863** passengers or **5.5%**.

Length of Stay

The average length of stay of **Foreign National** arrivals in December 2016 was **10.2** nights, compared to **10.3** nights in 2015. The average length of stay in hotels was **7.3** nights in December 2016, this was the same level as in December 2015.

The average length of stay of **Non-Resident Jamaican** arrivals in December 2016 was **19.2** nights, compared to **19** nights in December 2015. The average length of stay in hotels in December 2016 was **10.2** nights, compared to **10** nights in December 2015.

During the January to December 2016 period the average length of stay of For-

ign National arrivals in all types of accommodations was **8.8** nights, this was the same level as in 2015. For the Non-Resident Jamaican arrivals the average length of stay was **16.8** nights compared to **16.4** nights in 2015.

Purpose of Visit

During the period January to December 2016, **90.5%** or **1,828,223** of the **2,020,381** **Foreign Nationals** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **4.6%** were on Business, **4.3%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.6%** did not state their purpose of travel.

A total of **131,073** or **81.3%** of the **161,303** **Non-Resident Jamaicans** were visiting for Leisure, **3.6%** were on Business, **12.1%** were on Other purposes of travel and **3.1%** failed to provide a reason for travel.

Year to date January to December 2016, **89.8%** or a total of **1,959,296** of the total stopover arrivals of **2,181,684** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **4.5%** were on Business, **4.9%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.8%** did not state their purpose of travel.

Intended Resort Area of Stay

Of the **230,453** stopover arrivals visiting Jamaica in December 2016, the resort area of Montego Bay welcomed **73,912** arrivals or **32.1%**; Ocho Rios welcomed **46,913** or **20.4%**; Negril received **40,434** or **17.5%**, and **26,157** or **11.4%** visited Kingston. The remaining **18.7%** stayed in the Mandeville/South Coast, Port Antonio resort regions and Other areas in Jamaica.

Between January and December 2016, the pattern remained the same. Montego Bay, Ocho Rios, and Negril accounted for **1,649,709** or **75.6%** of the stopover arrivals.

Type of Airlines used

Of the **2,181,684** stopover visitors to Jamaica in the January to December 2016, **2,039,066** or **93.5%** used scheduled airlines, while **142,618** or **6.5%** used chartered flights.

During the corresponding period in 2015 the percentage distribution was: **93.6%** - used scheduled airlines and **6.4%** - used chartered flights.

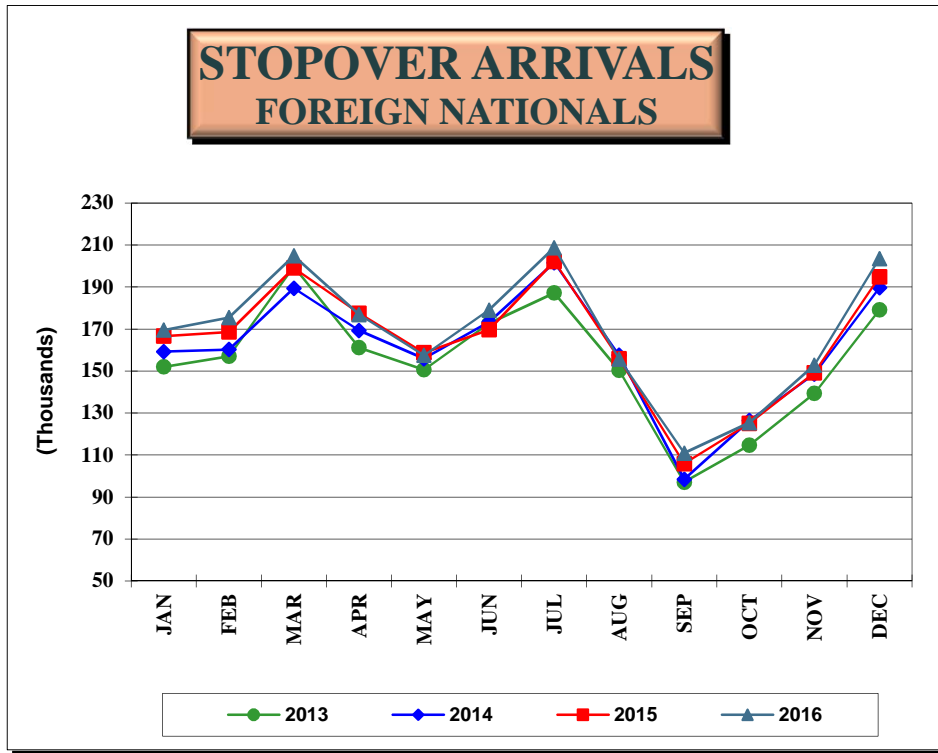

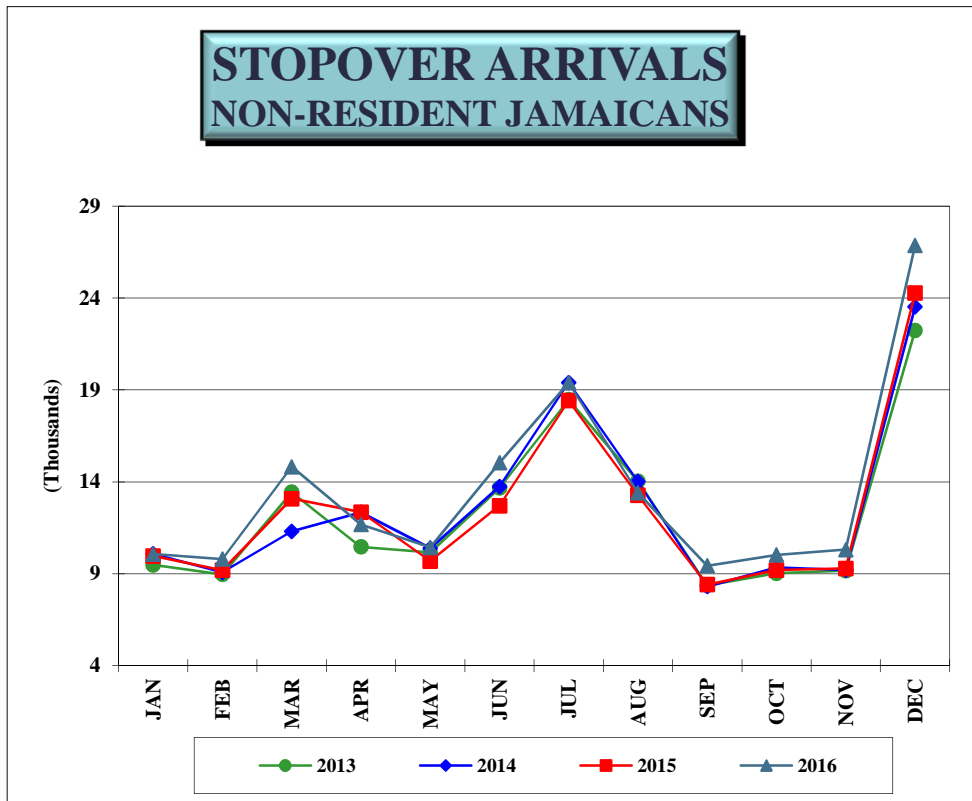

STOPOVER ARRIVALS BY PURPOSE OF VISIT JANUARY - DECEMBER 2016

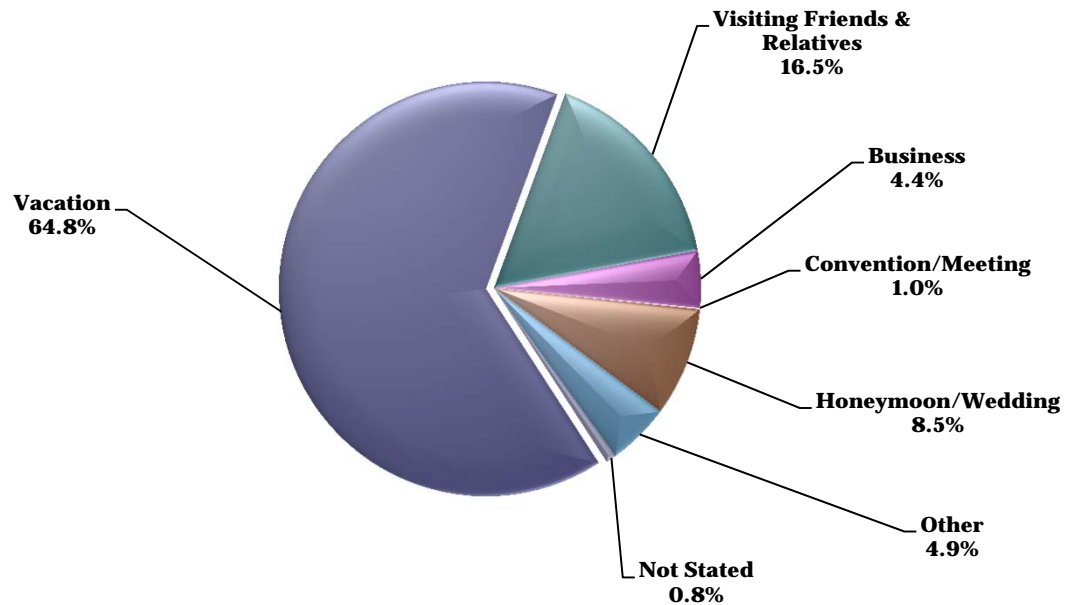

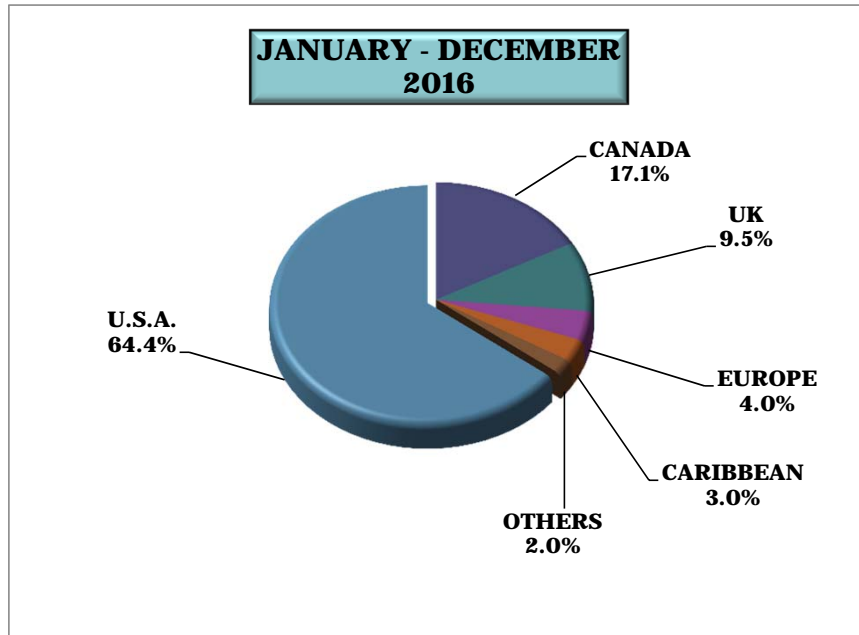

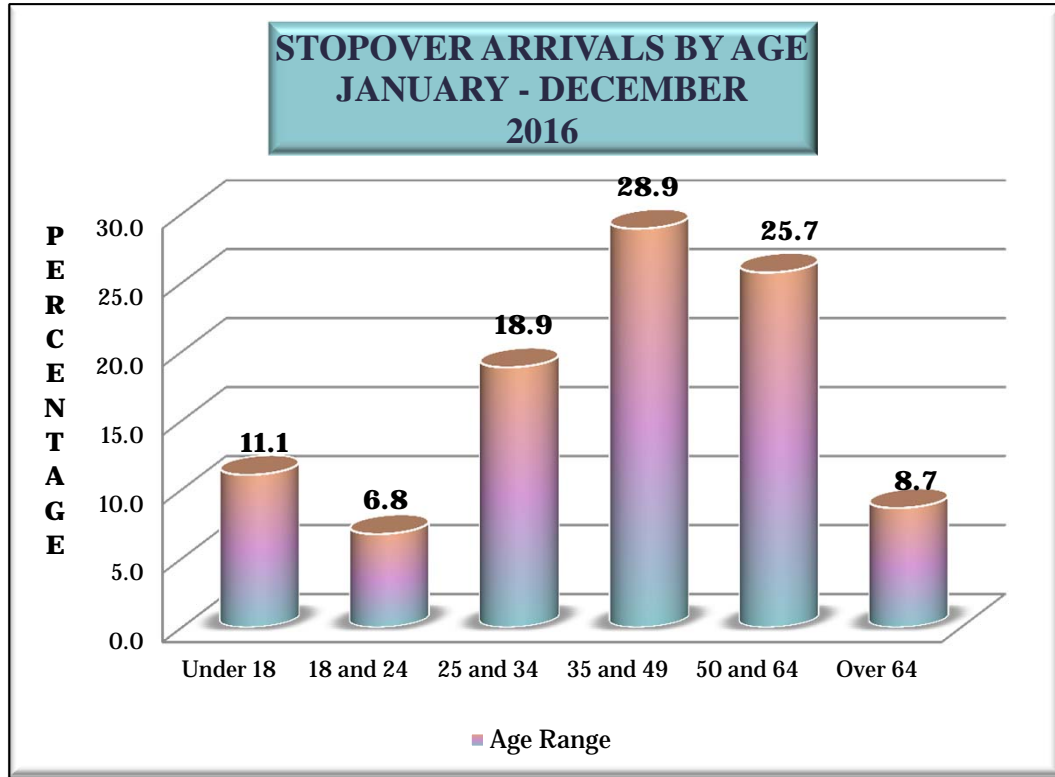

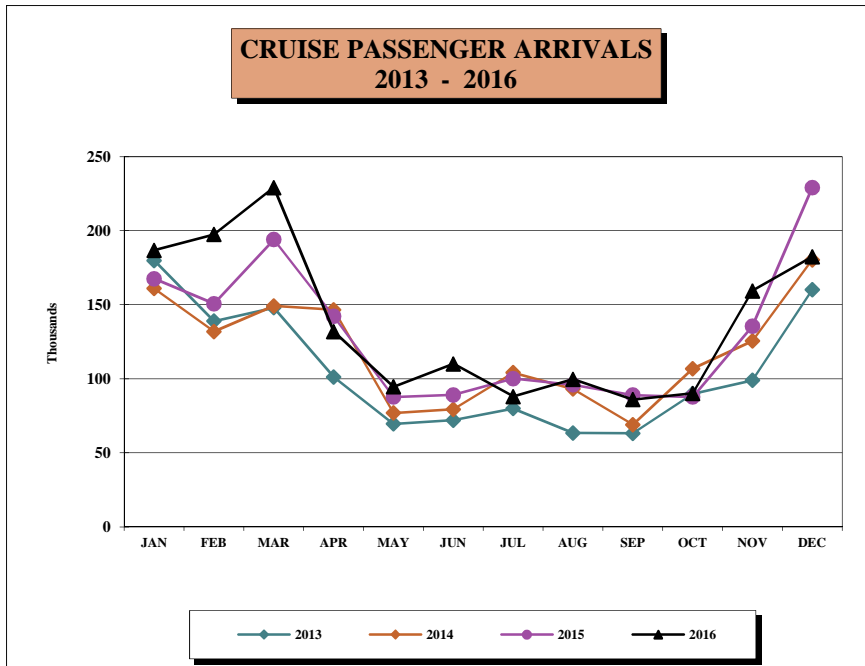

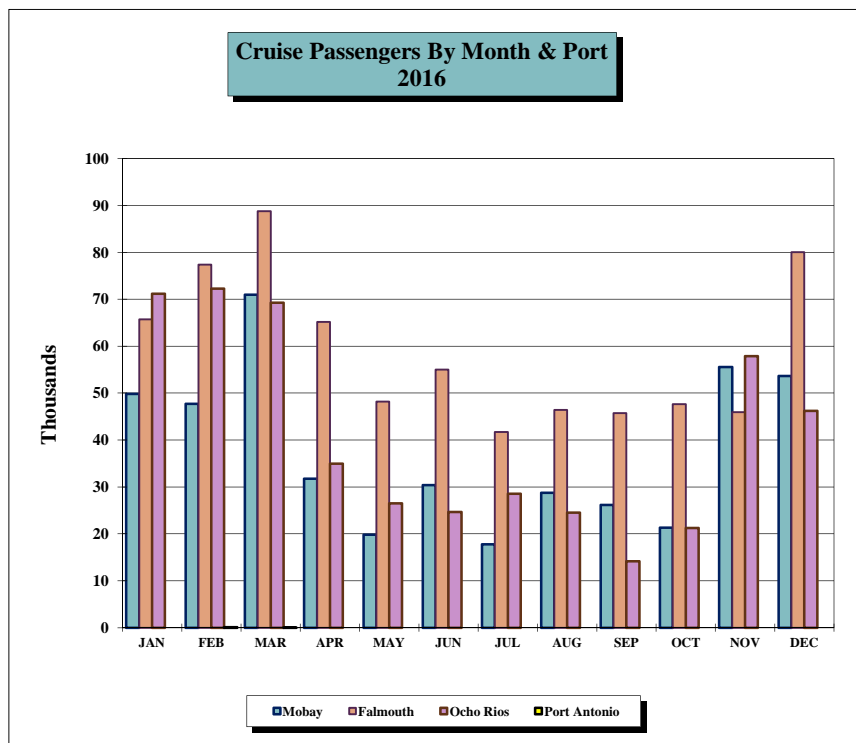

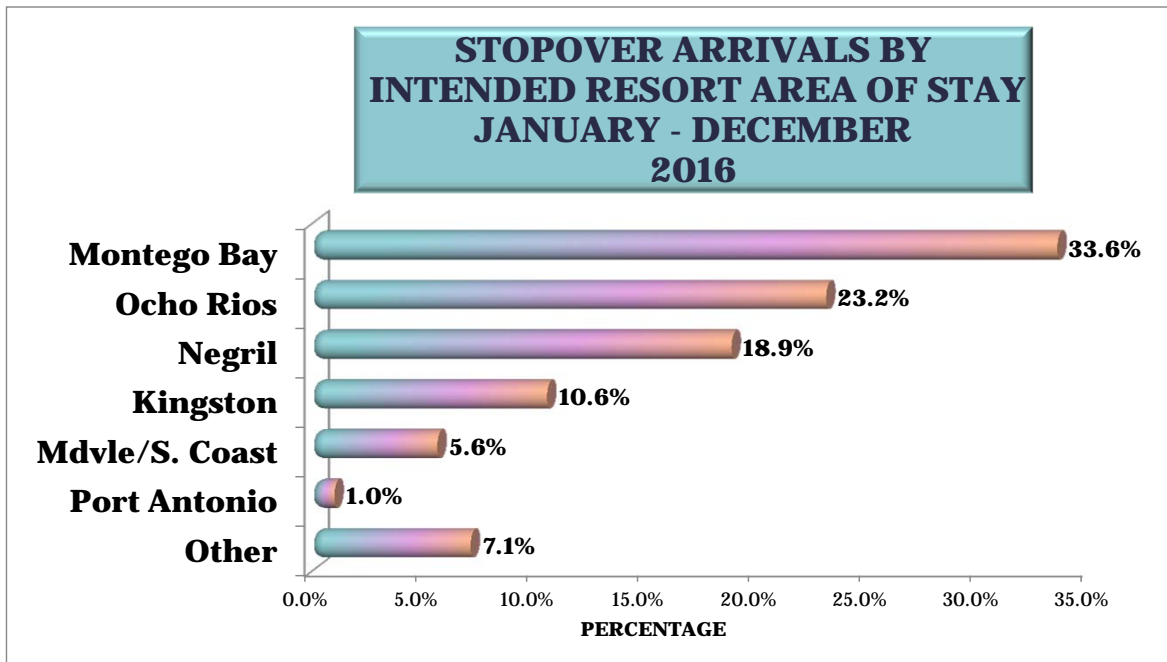
