

# JAMAICA TOURIST BOARD

**IN FEBRUARY 2019...**

- **Stopover arrivals up 13.7%**
- **US Market up 20.0%**
- **Canada up 5.8%**
- **Europe up 2.1%**
- **Cruise Passenger down by 3.8%**

## TOURIST (Stopover Arrivals)

Stopover arrivals in February 2019 were **220,046** an increase of **13.7%** or **26,471** additional arrivals over the **193,575** recorded in February 2018.

For the January to February period, arrivals increased by **12.5%**, with **436,555** stopovers compared to 388,184 in 2018.

### United States

Stopover arrivals from the United States market recorded a remarkable **20.0%** increase in February 2019, with a total of **139,843** arrivals compared to the **116,512** arrivals who visited in February 2018. All the US marketing regions recorded double digit increases in arrivals, the Northeast with **61,337** grew by **24.1%**, the Mid-West with **40,588** grew by **17.9%**, the South with **26,387** grew by **16.3%**, and the West with **11,531** grew by **16.0%**.

For the January to February period, the US market region has grown by **20.0%**, with **272,351** visitors compared to **226,908** visitors during the same period in 2018. The northeast has grown by **24.8%**, the Midwest up by **15.1%**, the South up by **17.5%**, and the West up by **20.0%**.

### Canada

In February 2019, the Canadian market recorded an increase in arrivals of **5.8%**, with **44,369** stopovers compared to **41,925** in February 2018.

Stopover arrivals from Atlantic Canada rose by **22.1%**; the main provinces of Nova Scotia increased by **32.8%**, over February 2018 and those from New Brunswick increased by **12.2%**.

Stopover arrivals from Central Canada increased by **4.1%**; the leading province of Ontario increased by **5.0%**, while the second most important Canadian province of Quebec fell by **1.6%**.

Stopover arrivals from Western Canada grew by **11.0%**; the main province of Alberta recorded an increase of **29.0%**, and arrivals from Saskatchewan increased by **13.6%**.

Cumulatively, the Canadian market with **89,447** visitors recorded an increase of **0.8%** or 707 more visitors than in 2018. The top producing provinces of Ontario with **62,069** rose by **0.7%**, and those from Quebec, with **10,380** visitors rose by **2.7%**.

### Europe

The European market region recorded an increase of **2.1%** in February 2019, with **27,680** stopover arrivals compared to the **27,106** recorded in February 2018.

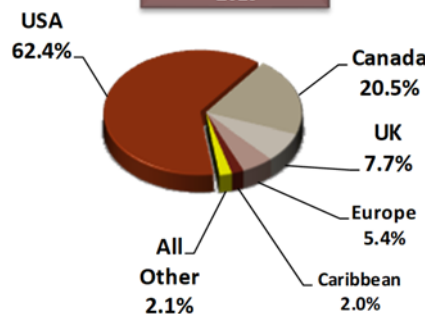
In the Northern European region, the main visitor producing countries, United Kingdom, with **16,630** arrivals, grew by **7.3%**, while Sweden with **823** arrivals fell by **11.3%**.

In the South-Western European region, Germany with **2,874** visitor arrivals decreased by **1.6%**, Italy with **1,478** fell by **11.8%**, France with **1,327** rose by **2.7%**, and the Netherlands with **628** arrivals decreased by **30.8%**.

Stopover arrivals from Central-East Europe with **1,818** arrivals grew by **2.3%**.

For the January to February 2019 period, arrivals from the European market region grew by **1.3%**. Total stopover arrivals were **56,774** compared to **56,034** in 2018. Northern Europe rose by **3.1%**, moving from **34,981** in 2018 to **36,073** in 2019. Arrivals from the South/West region fell by **5.9%**, with 15,862 arrivals, and those from Central/East region increased by **15.5%** with **4,839** arrivals.

### Latin America

Arrivals from Latin America decreased by **3.2%** in February 2019, with a total of **2,927** stopovers compared to **3,023** in February 2018.

From the Central American region, stopover arrivals grew by **9.7%** with **714** arrivals. Mexico with **259** arrivals fell by **10.4%**, and Panama with **198** rose by **38.5%**.

From the South American region, stopover arrivals fell by **6.7%** with **2,213** arrivals. Chile with **806** arrivals increased by **13.5%**, Argentina with **480** arrivals fell by **12.2%**, and Brazil with **340** fell by **40.1%**.

Cumulatively, January to February 2019, stopover arrivals from Latin America increased by **6.9%**, with a total of **6,685** arrivals compared to **6,252** in 2018.

Stopover from Central America with **1,540** arrivals grew by **25.8%**. The main producing countries of Mexico and Panama increased by **14.0%** and **45.1%** respectively.

Stopovers from South America grew by **2.3%** with **5,145** arrivals. The top producing countries of Chile with **1,414** grew by **27.3%**, Argentina with **1,305** fell by **18.3%**, and Brazil with **900** arrivals fell by **24.6%**.

## The Caribbean

Stopover arrivals to Jamaica from the Caribbean region were up **2.9%** in February 2019 with a total of **4,033** visitors, compared to **3,919** in February 2018.

The Cayman Islands and Trinidad & Tobago continued to be the major visitor producing Caribbean countries in February 2019 with **1,328** and **589** stopover arrivals, respectively.

Year to date, stopovers for the January to February period grew by **10.7%** moving from **7,994** in 2018 to **8,851** in 2019.

## Asia

The Asian market rose by **12.8%** in February 2019 with a total of **722** stopovers compared to **640** in February 2018.

China, Japan, and India, are the major visitor-producing countries with **284**, **161** and **92** stopovers arriving from each country, respectively.

For the January to February 2019 period, stopover arrivals from Asia grew by **6.3%** with **1,349** arrivals compared to **1,269** in 2018.

## Other Countries

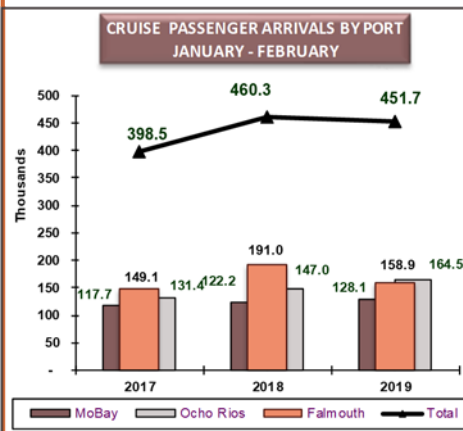
Overall, stopover arrivals from other countries grew by **11.2%** with **1,098** arrivals, for the January to February 2019 period. Of the Other Countries, Australia provided the most stop-over arrivals to Jamaica, with **441** visitors compared to **398** in 2018. This represents an increase of **10.8%**.

## Market Share

The market share of stopover visitors for January to February 2019 was as follows: USA **62.4%**; Canada **20.5%**; UK **7.7%**; Continental Europe **5.4%**, the Caribbean **2.0%**; and the others, including Latin America and Asia **2.1%**.

## Cruise Passengers

A total of **202,712** cruise passengers visited Jamaica in February 2019. This represented a **3.8%** decrease over the **210,667** who visited in February 2018.



For February 2019, Cruise passengers visiting the port of Ocho Rios grew by **5.0%** with **73,618** passengers. Those visiting the port of Falmouth fell by **18.7%** with **68,270** passengers and those visiting the port of Montego Bay grew by **7.1%** with **60,611** passengers.

Year-to-date, January to February 2019 saw **451,738** cruise passenger arrivals visiting our shores, a decline of **1.9%** or **8,564** less cruise passengers.

## Length of Stay

The average length of stay of **Foreign National** arrivals in February 2019 was **7.5** nights, compared to **7.7** nights in February 2018. The average length of stay in hotels was **6.3** nights in February 2019, compared to **6.5** nights in February 2018.

The average length of stay of **Non-Resident Jamaican** arrivals in February 2019 was **14.6** nights compared to **16.0** in February 2018. The average length of stay in hotels in February 2019 was **7.9** nights, compared to **7.6** nights in February 2018.

During the January to February 2019 period, the average length of stay for Foreign National arrivals in all types of accommodations was **8.1** nights compared to **8.4** nights in 2018. For the Non-Resident Jamaican arrivals the average length of stay was **16.6** nights compared to **17.8** nights.

## Purpose of Visit

During the month of February 2019, **91.4%** or **190,469** of the **208,317 Foreign Nationals** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **4.1%** were on Business, **4.0%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.6%** did not state their purpose of travel.

A total of **8,753** or **74.6%** of the **11,729 Non-Resident Jamaicans** were visiting for Leisure, **4.1%** were on Business, **17.7%** were on Other purposes of travel and **3.5%** failed to provide a reason for travel.

Year-to-date January to February 2019, **89.8%** or a total of **392,067** of the total stopover arrivals of **436,555** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **4.3%** were on Business, **5.0%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.8%** did not state their travel purpose.

## Intended Resort Area of Stay

Of the **219,762** stopover arrivals visiting Jamaica in February 2019, the resort area of Montego Bay welcomed **82,043** arrivals or **37.3%**; Ocho Rios received **48,751** or **22.2%**, Negril welcomed **46,112** or **21.0%**; and **18,210** or **8.3%** visited Kingston. The remaining **11.2%** stayed in the Mandeville/South Coast, Port Antonio resort regions and Other areas in Jamaica.

Between January to February 2019, the combination of Montego Bay, Negril, and Ocho Rios accounted for **350,429** or **80.3%** of the total stopover arrivals.

## Type of Airlines used

Of the **436,555** stopover visitors to Jamaica in the January to February 2019, **398,213** or **91.2%** used scheduled airlines, while **38,342** or **8.8%** used chartered flights.

During the corresponding period in 2018 the percentage distribution was: **92.0%** - used scheduled airlines and **8.0%** - used chartered flights.

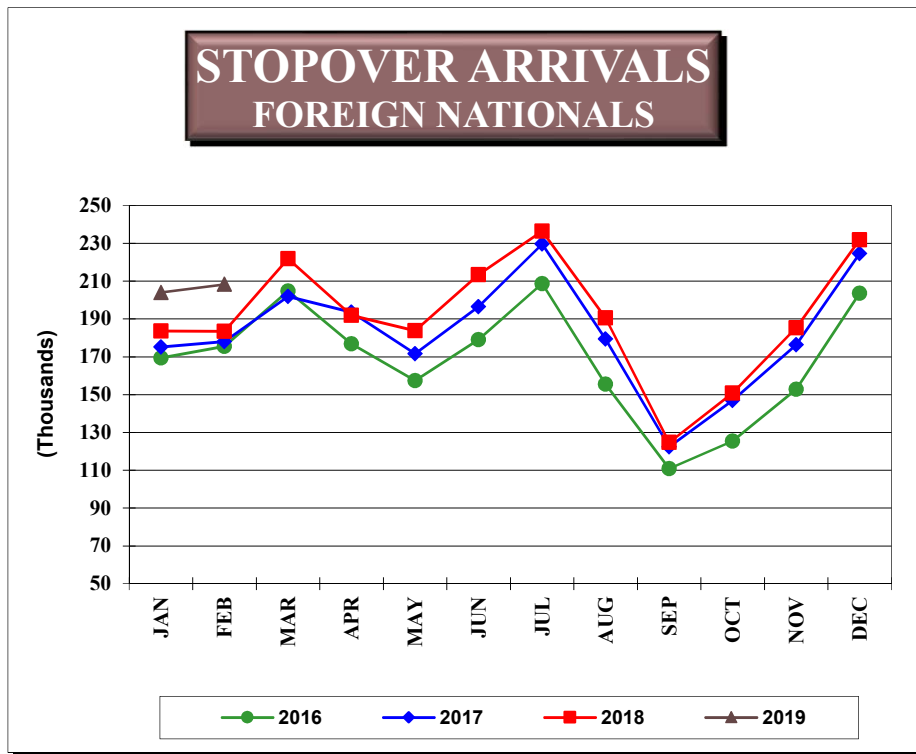

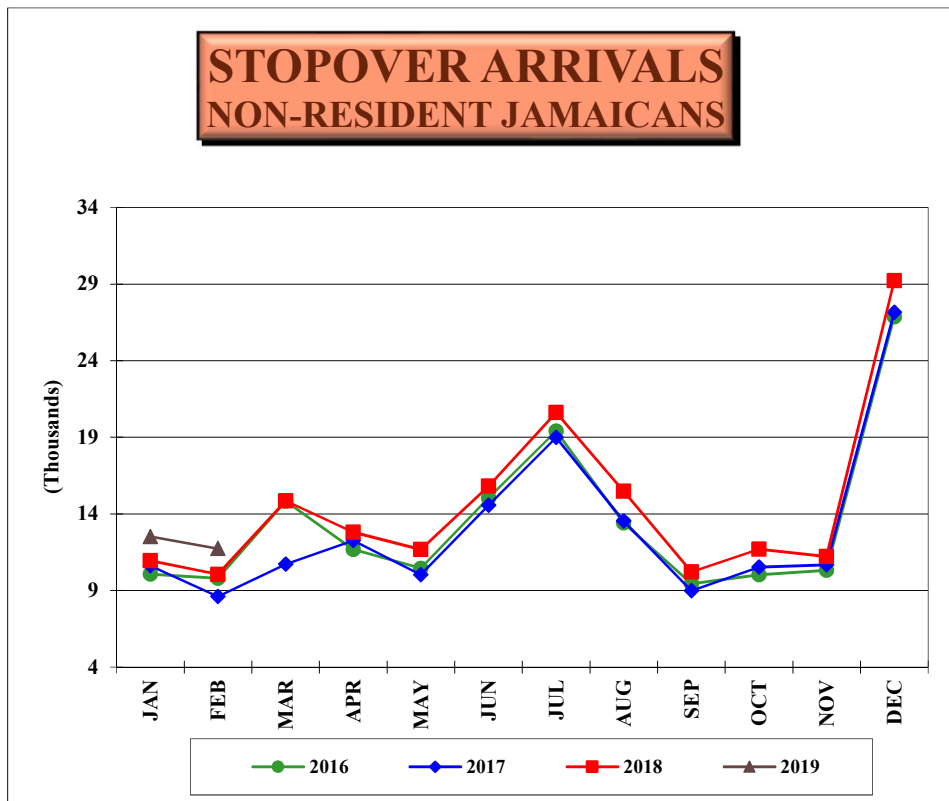
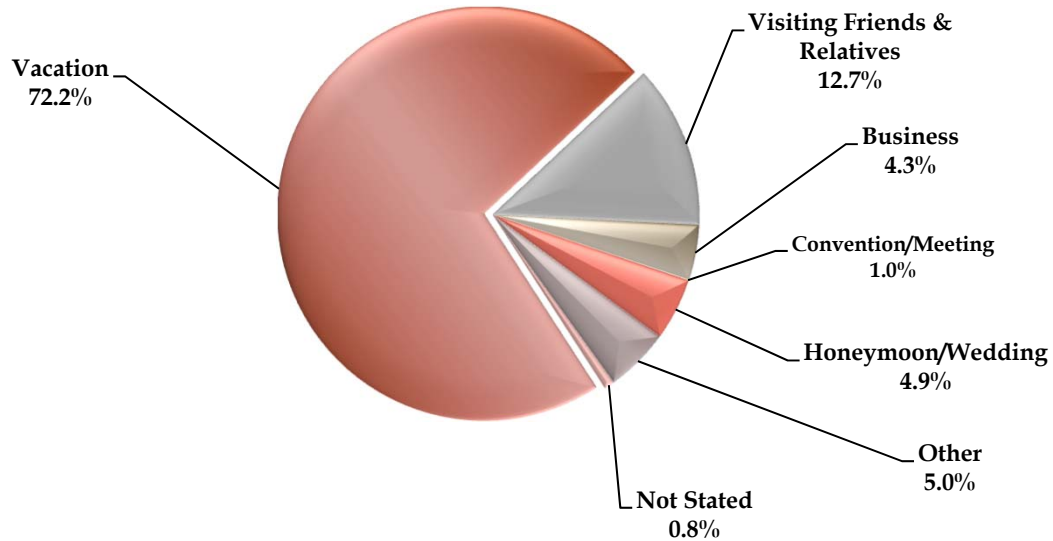

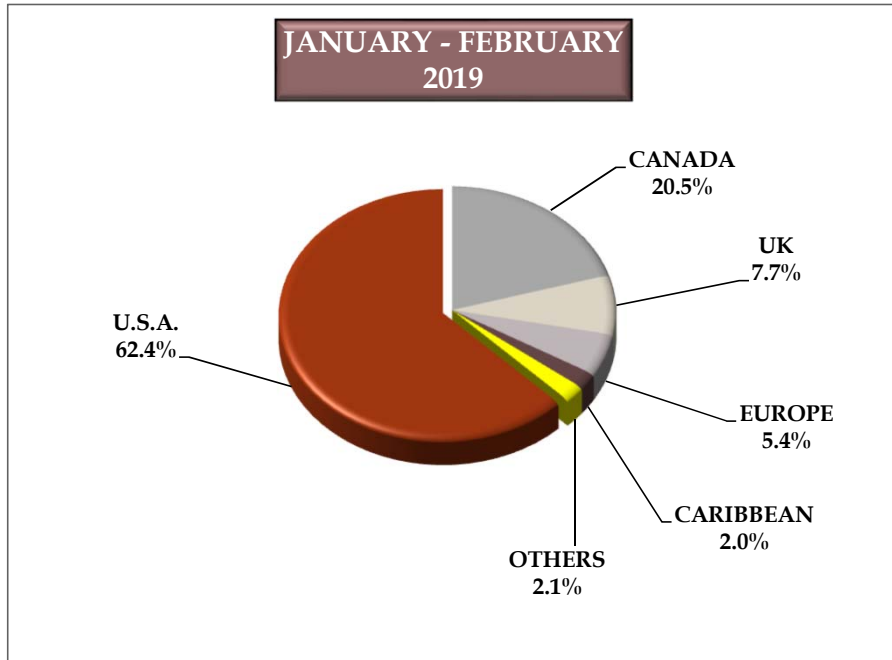

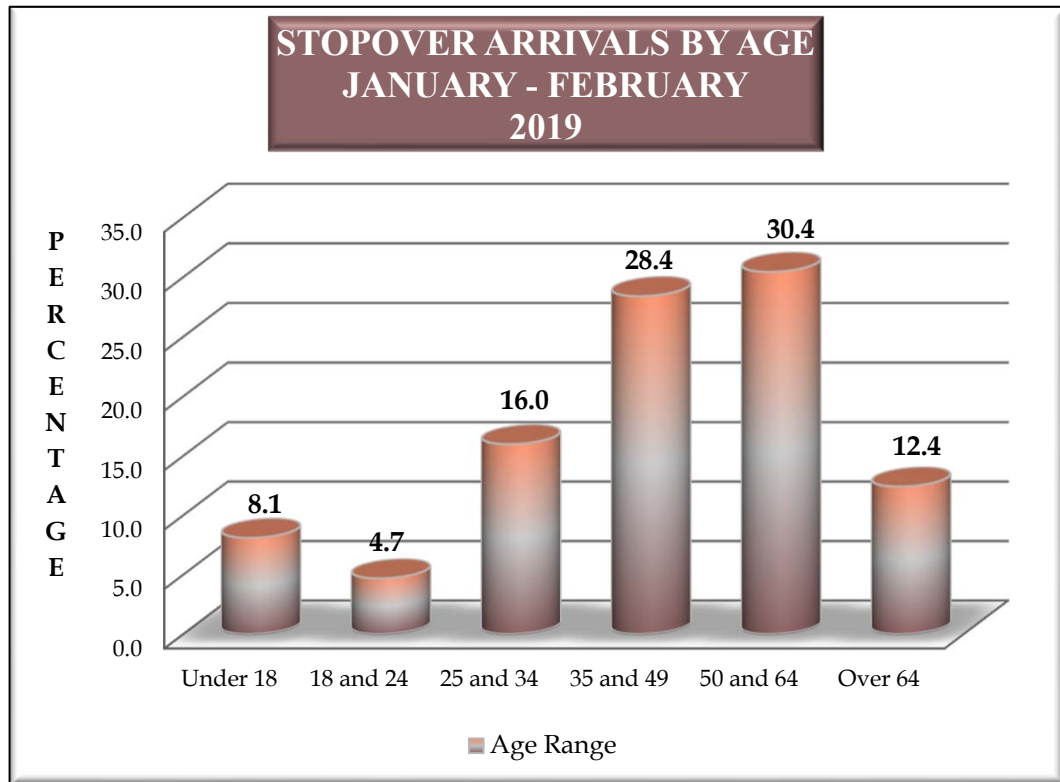

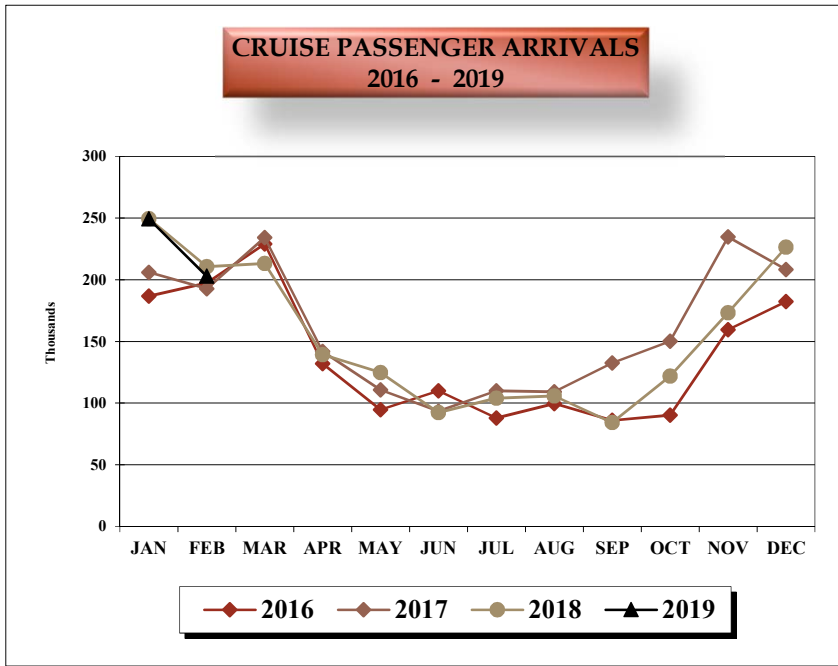

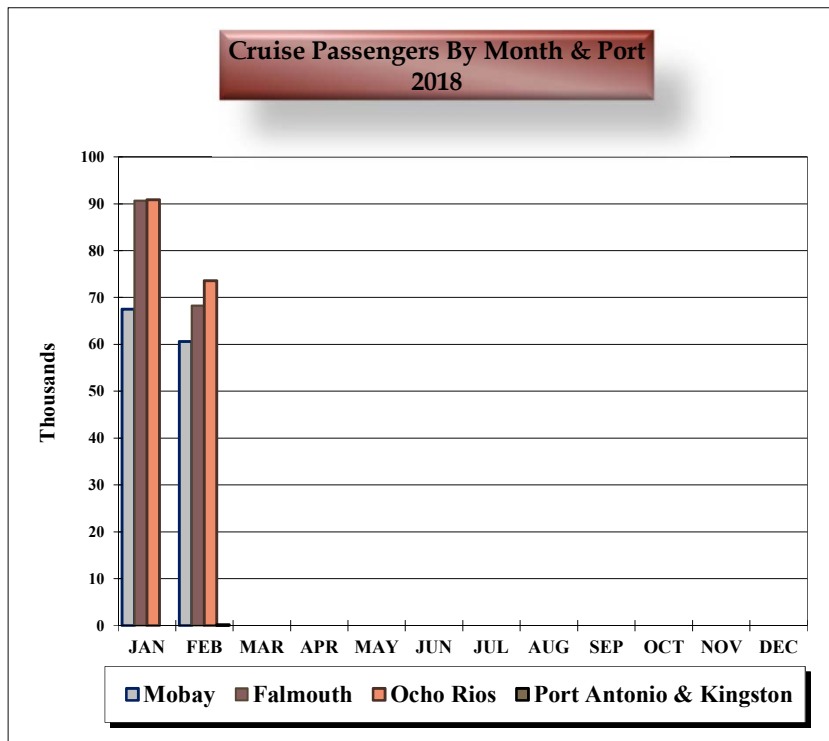

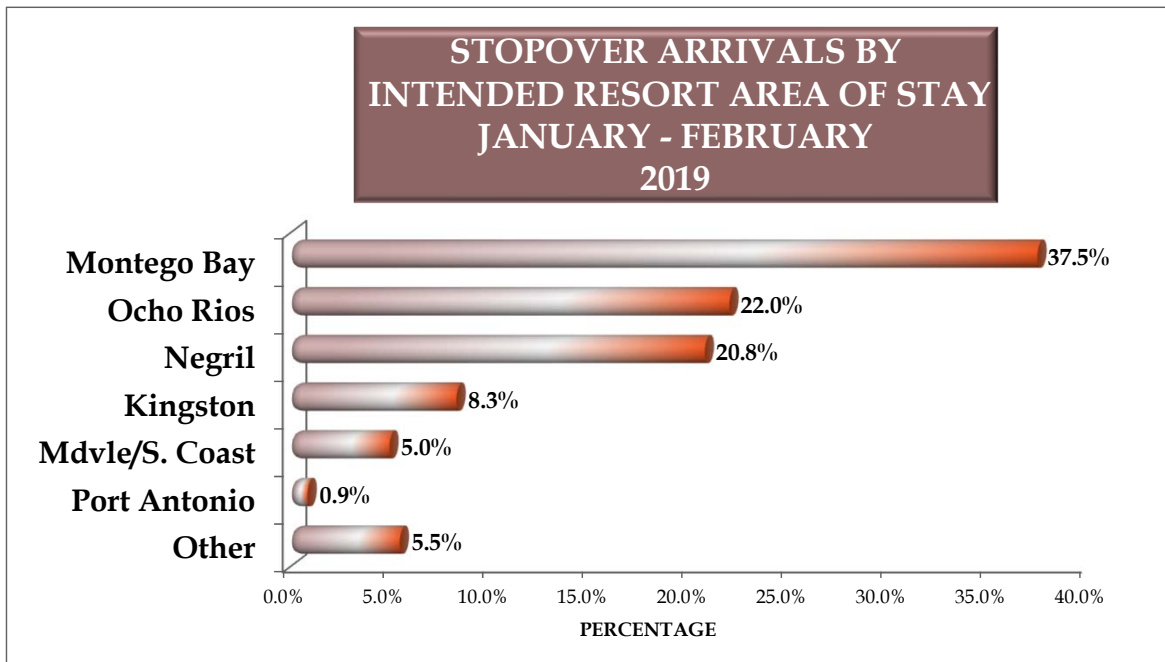
