## TOURIST (Stopover Arrivals)

Stopover arrivals in June 2018 were **229,261**, an increase of **8.6%** over the **211,119** recorded in June 2017 and a **18.1%** increase over the **194,088** in 2016.

For the first two months of summer, May to June, arrivals increased by **8.1%**, with **424,752** stopovers compared to **392,788** in 2017.

For the January to June period, arrivals increased by **6.0%**, with **1,254,488** stopovers compared to **1,183,753** in 2017.

## United States

Stopover arrivals from the United States market recorded a notable increase of **10.5%** in June 2018, with a total of **173,109** arrivals compared to the **156,664** arrivals who visited in June 2017. All the US marketing regions recorded increases in arrivals, the Northeast with **63,703** up by **12.1%**, the South with **53,290** up by **6.0%**, the Mid-West with **28,059** up by **17.7%**, and the West with **28,057** up by **9.0%**.

For the summer period, May to June 2018, the US market region recorded a **10.1%** increase in arrivals, with **307,296** visitors compared to the **279,110** visitors during the same period in 2017. The Northeast increased by **9.0%**, the South grew by **9.8%**, the Midwest increased by **13.3%** and the West increased by **10.0%**.

Year-to-date, January to June 2018, the US market region has grown by **8.4%**, with **817,898** visitors, which is **63,316** more visitors compared to the **754,582** visitors that arrived in 2017 and **85,915** or **11.7%** more than the **731,983** in 2016. The Northeast has grown by **7.2%**, the Midwest up by **9.6%**, the South up by **9.2%**, and the West up by **8.8%**.

## Canada


In June 2018, the Canadian market recorded an increase in arrivals of **6.1%**, with **22,364** stopovers compared to **21,080** in June 2017.

Stopover arrivals from Atlantic Canada fell by **9.9%**; the main provinces of Newfoundland decreased by **21.6%**, over June 2017 and those from Nova Scotia increased by **32.3%**.

Stopover arrivals from Central Canada increased by **9.4%**; the leading province of Ontario increased by **6.6%**, while the second most important Canadian province of Quebec grew by **24.9%**.

Stopover arrivals from Western Canada fell by **15.1%**; the main province of Alberta recorded a decline of **10.7%**, and the arrivals from British Columbia declined by **23.8%**.

For the first two months of Summer 2018, May to June, arrivals from Canada are up **4.3%** with **50,562** stopovers compared to **48,474** during the same period in 2017.



Cumulatively, the Canadian market with **222,614** has grown by **0.9%** above the **220,551** visitors in 2017. The top producing provinces of Ontario with **153,243** rose by **2.5%**, and Quebec, with **28,036** visitors rose by **13.4%**.

## Europe

The European market region recorded an increase of **3.2%** in June 2018, with **24,073** stopover arrivals compared to the **23,316** recorded in June 2017.

In the Northern European region, the main visitor producing country, the United Kingdom, with **17,355** arrivals, grew by **3.0%**.

In the South-Western European region, Germany with **2,018** visitor arrivals increased by **55.8%**, Italy with **924** rose by **40.6%**, Portugal with **760** arrivals decreased by **11.8%**, while the Netherlands with **617** fell by **1.6%**.

Stopover arrivals from Central-East Europe with **468** arrivals grew by **40.5%**.

For the summer period, May to June 2018, arrivals from Europe grew by **4.9%**, with **48,046** arrivals compared to **45,797** in 2017.

## Latin America

Arrivals from Latin America increased by **2.3%** in June 2018, with a total of **2,712** stopovers compared to **2,652** in June 2017.

From the Central American region, stopover arrivals fell by **9.8%** with **781** arrivals. Mexico with **314** arrivals fell by **21.9%**, and Panama with **214** grew by **10.3%**.

From the South American region, stopover arrivals increased by **8.1%** with **1,931** arrivals. Chile with **500** increased by **20.2%**, Argentina with **417** arrivals fell by **3.5%**, and Brazil with **378** arrivals decreased by **8.5%**.

For the summer period, May to June 2018, arrivals from Latin America grew by **3.0%**, with **5,704** arrivals compared to **5,537** in 2017.

Cumulatively, January to June 2018, stopover arrivals from Latin America increased by **8.8%**, with a total of **17,496** arrivals compared to **16,077** in 2017.

Stopovers from Central America fell by **3.1%**. The main producing countries of Mexico declined by **9.6%** and Panama increased by **4.0%**.

Stopover from South America increased by **13.6%** with **13,065** arrivals. The top producing countries of Argentina with **3,791** grew by **23.3%**, Brazil with **3,181** grew by **24.6%**, while Chile with **2,651** fell by **5.7%**.

## The Caribbean

Stopover arrivals to Jamaica from the Caribbean region were down **5.4%** in June 2018 with a total of **5,793** visitors, compared to **6,122** in June 2017.

The Cayman Islands and Trinidad & Tobago continued to be the major visitor producing Caribbean countries in June 2018 with **1,528** and **963** stopover arrivals, respectively.

Year to date, stopovers for the January - June period grew by **3.5%** moving up from **29,776** in 2017 to **30,828** in 2018

## Asia

The Asian market fell by **2.8%** in June 2018 with a total of **669** stopovers compared to **688** in June 2017.

China, India, and Japan, are the major visitor-producing countries with **271**, **185** and **73** stopovers arriving from each country, respectively.

For the January - June 2018 period, stopover arrivals from Asia fell by **21.8%**, with **3,945** arrivals compared to **5,043** arrivals in 2017.

## Other Countries


Overall, stopover arrivals from other countries decreased by **3.4%** with **3,060** arrivals, for the January - June 2018 period. Of the Other Countries, Australia provided the most stopover arrivals to Jamaica, with **1,104** visitors in 2018 compared to **1,246** in 2017. This represents a decrease of **11.4%**.

## Market Share

The market share of stopover visitors for January to June 2018 was as follows: USA **65.2%**; Canada **17.7%**; UK **8.2%**; Continental Europe **4.5%**, the Caribbean **2.5%**; and the others, including Latin America and Asia **2.0%**.

## Cruise Passengers

A total of **92,323** cruise passengers visited Jamaica in June 2018. This represented a **1.2%** decrease over the **93,453** who visited in June 2017.



For June 2018, Cruise passengers visiting the port of Ocho Rios grew by **4.3%** with **32,224** passengers. Those visiting the port of Falmouth fell by **22.6%** with **29,853** passengers and Montego Bay grew by **24.2%** with **29,775** passengers.

The period January - June 2018 saw **1,029,881** cruise passenger arrivals visiting the three major ports, an increase of **51,197** passengers or **5.2%**.

## Length of Stay

The average length of stay of **Foreign National** arrivals in June 2018 was **8.0** nights, compared to **8.2** nights in June 2017. The average length of stay in hotels was **5.9** nights in June 2018, compared to **6.0** nights in June 2017.

The average length of stay of **Non-Resident Jamaican** arrivals in June 2018 was **19.0** nights compared to **18.5** in June 2017. The average length of stay in hotels in June 2018 was **8.2** nights, the same level as in June 2017.

Year to date, January to June 2018, the average length of stay for Foreign Nationals in all types of accommodation was **7.7** nights compared to **8.2** nights during the same period in 2017. For the Non-Resident Jamaican arrivals the average length of stay was **16.3** nights compared to **15.8** nights in 2017.

## Purpose of Visit

During the month of June 2018, **92.3%** or **197,093** of the **213,439** **Foreign Nationals** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **3.4%** were on Business, **3.7%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.5%** did not state their purpose of travel.

A total of **12,956** or **81.9%** of the **11,672** **Non-Resident Jamaicans** were visiting for Leisure, **3.5%** were on Business, **12.0%** were on Other purposes of travel and **2.7%** failed to provide a reason for travel.

Year to date January to June 2018, **90.9%** or a total of **1,140,400** of the total stopover arrivals of **1,254,488** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **3.9%** were on Business, **4.6%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.6%** did not state their purpose of travel.

## Intended Resort Area of Stay

Of the **229,261** stopover arrivals visiting Jamaica in June 2018, the resort area of Montego Bay welcomed **79,637** arrivals or **34.7%**; Ocho Rios received **55,566** or **24.2%**, Negril welcomed **42,445** or **18.5%**; and **22,377** or **9.8%** visited Kingston. The remaining **12.8%** stayed in the Mandeville/South Coast, Port Antonio resort regions and Other areas in Jamaica.

Between January and June 2018, the distribution remain the same and the combination of Montego Bay, Negril, and Ocho Rios accounted for **987,267** or **78.7%** of the stopover arrivals.

## Type of Airlines used

Of the **1,254,488** stopover visitors to Jamaica in the period of January to June 2018, **1,163,585** or **92.7%** used scheduled airlines, while **90,903** or **7.3%** used chartered flights.

During the corresponding period in 2017 the percentage distribution was: **92.6%** - used scheduled airlines and **7.4%** - used chartered flights.
















