JAMAICA WELCOMES INAUGURAL FLAIR AIRLINES FLIGHT TO KINGSTON

New direct service from Toronto to bring more than 23,000 passengers to Kingston, Jamaica this winter

KINGSTON, JAMAICA – DECEMBER 18, 2023 – The [Jamaica Tourist Board](#) (JTB) arranged a warm island welcome for Flair Airlines' inaugural flight from Toronto to Kingston over the weekend. Upon landing in Jamaica on Saturday, December 16, passengers, flight crew and Flair executive team members were greeted with a celebratory water welcome on the runway followed by a special reception hosted by Jamaica's Minister of Tourism, Hon. Edmund Bartlett.

The new non-stop service from Toronto Pearson International airport (YYZ) to Norman Manley International Airport (KIN) is expected to bring more than 23,000 passengers into the destination over the winter season. The flight will operate three times per week with departures on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday until May 4, before switching to Monday, Wednesday and Friday departures for the summer period.
