

## JAMAICA UPDATE ON COVID-19

Dear Valued Partners,

**Jamaica's Prime Minister, the Most Hon Andrew Holness, has announced that the Jamaican borders will remain closed until May 31. This is subject to review.**

**There will be a controlled re-entry of Jamaicans who have been stuck overseas. These persons will be required to make a special request in accordance with the established protocols which include agreement to be quarantined in a government facility for 14 days. Once approved, travel will be at the cost of the individual.**

**As of Wednesday April 29, Jamaica has recorded 396 confirmed cases of COVID-19, including seven deaths. Twenty-nine persons have been completely cleared and released from hospital.**

- To date, a total of 3993 samples have been tested resulting in 3567 negative and 396 positive results, and 30 results pending.
- Bars, nightclubs and other places of entertainment will remain closed.
- Public gatherings remain limited to no more than 10 persons.
