

JAMAICA NOW REQUIRES PRE-TESTS FROM SELECTED TRAVELLERS

Dear Valued Partners,

As Jamaica continues to assess the risks related to COVID-19, adjustments are being made to the established Orders to facilitate safe, secure and seamless travel to the destination.

These most recent updates are:

- All persons intending to travel to Jamaica from high risk areas must now upload a negative PCR Test result when applying for a Travel Authorization to visit the island.
 - Areas currently classified as high risk are Arizona, Florida, New York and Texas. This list will be reviewed from time to time.
 - Uploading to visitjamaica.com/travelauthorization begins on July 10.
 - Travellers must have, and present, the original negative certificate on arrival in Jamaica.
- Business Travellers are not required to upload a negative result as they will continue to be tested on arrival.
- Travel Authorizations can now be applied for up to five (5) days prior to arrival on the island.
 - Applications from persons in the high-risk areas will be manually processed. Approvals could therefore take up to 48 hours for availability.
- Travel Authorizations issued to persons from high risk areas will be valid for 11 days. For all other travellers, the Travel Authorization will be valid for 7 days.
