TOURIST (Stopover Arrivals)

Stopover arrivals in August 2017 were a record **192,878**, an increase of **14.1%** over the **169,023** recorded in August 2016.

For the first four months of summer, May to August, arrivals increased by **9.9%**, with **834,292** stopovers compared to **759,164** in 2016.

Cumulatively, January to August 2017, stopover arrivals increased by **6.1%**, with **1,625,257** arrivals compared to **1,532,272** in 2016.

United States

Stopover arrivals from the United States market recorded a **16.7%** increase in August 2017, with a total of **130,421** arrivals compared to the **111,726** arrivals who visited in August 2016. All marketing regions recorded increased arrivals, the Northeast with **67,992** grew by **16.8%**, the South with **30,890** grew by **20.2%**, the Mid-West with **15,721** grew by **14.2%**, and the West with **15,818** grew by **12.5%**.

For the summer period, May to August 2017, the US market region recorded a **9.6%** increase in arrivals, with **587,963** visitors compared to the **536,370** visitors during the same period in 2016. The Northeast increased by **10.2%**, the South grew by **9.8%**, the Midwest increased by **7.6%** and the West increased by **9.5%**.

Year-to-date, January to August 2017, the US market region has grown by **5.5%**, with **1,063,435** visitors compared to the **1,007,941** visitors during the same period in 2016. The Northeast grew by **3.3%**, the South grew by **7.6%**, the Mid-west increased by **7.1%**, and the West up by **6.6%**.

Canada

In August 2017, the Canadian market recorded an increase in arrivals of **3.0%**, with **24,099** stopovers compared to **23,406** in August 2016.

Stopover arrivals from Atlantic Canada grew by **15.6%**; the main provinces of Newfoundland decreased by **6.5%**, over August 2016 and those from Nova Scotia increased by **76.6%**.

Stopover arrivals from Central Canada increased by **4.1%**; the leading province of Ontario increased by **3.0%**, and the second most important Canadian province of Quebec grew by **10.9%**.

Stopover arrivals from Western Canada fell by **8.9%**; the main province of Alberta recorded a decrease of **2.9%**, and arrivals from British Columbia decreased by **21.7%**.

For the four months of Summer 2016, May to August, arrivals from Canada were up **7.3%** with **99,346** stopovers compared to **92,567** during the same time in 2016.

Cumulatively, the Canadian market with **273,423** visitors recorded an increase of **6.3%** or **16,009** more visitors than in 2016. The top producing provinces of Ontario with **187,618** has grown by **8.8%**, and Quebec, with **32,024** visitors grew by **6.5%**.

Europe

The European market region recorded a significant increase of **25.8%** in August 2017, with **29,177** stopover arrivals compared to the **23,185** recorded in August 2016.

In the Northern European region, the main visitor producing countries, United Kingdom, with **19,558** arrivals, grew by **10.9%** and Ireland with **152** arrivals fell by **18.3%**.

In the South-Western European region, Germany with **2,421** visitor arrivals increased by **98.1%**, Spain with **1,842** increased by an outstanding **416.0%**, Italy with **1,672** arrivals rose by **7.3%**, Portugal with **956** visitors increased by **2,176.2%** and the Netherlands with **587** arrivals increased by **26.8%**.

Stopover arrivals from Central-East Europe with **283** arrivals grew by **8.0%**.

For the summer period, May to August 2017, arrivals from Europe grew by **16.8%**, with **106,550** arrivals compared to **91,216** in 2016.

Year-to-date, January to August 2017, arrivals from the European market has grown by **10.1%**. Total stopover arrivals were **215,309** compared to **195,596** in 2016. Northern Europe was up **2.1%**, moving from **151,968** in 2016 to **155,141** in 2017. Arrivals from the South/West region increased by **36.5%** with **54,599** arrivals, and those from the Central/East region increased by **53.7%** with **5,569** arrivals.

Latin America

Arrivals from Latin America decreased by **1.6%** in August 2017, with a total of **2,619** stopovers compared to **2,661** in August 2016.

From the Central American region, stopover arrivals decreased by **38.9%** with **568** arrivals. Mexico with **207** arrivals fell by **63.6%**, while Panama with **147** grew by **21.5%**.

From the South American region, stopover arrivals increased by **18.4%** with **2,051** arrivals. Argentina with **376** arrivals grew by **58.6%**, Chile with **372** decreased by **7.0%**, and Brazil with **364** arrivals increased by **149.3%**.

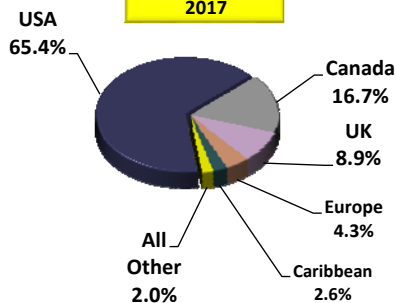
For the summer period, May to August 2017, arrivals from Latin America grew by **26.0%**, with **11,308** arrivals compared to **8,975** in 2016.

Cumulatively, January to August 2017, stopover arrivals from Latin America increased by **17.3%**, with a total of **21,848** arrivals compared to **18,619** in 2016.

Stopovers from Central America declined by **16.8%**. The main Central American countries of Mexico declined by **15.5%** and Panama increased by **24.8%**.

Stopovers from South America increased by **38.8%** with **15,865** arrivals, The top producing countries of Argentina with **3,993** arrivals grew by **77.7%**, Chile with **3,778** arrivals grew by **19.1%**, and Brazil with **3,280** increased by **120.9%**.

The Caribbean

Stopover arrivals to Jamaica from the Caribbean region decreased by **18.5%** in August 2017 with a total of **5,577** visitors, compared to **6,847** in August 2016.

The Cayman Islands and Trinidad & Tobago continued to be the major visitor producing Caribbean countries in August 2017 with **1,625** and **1,150** stopover arrivals, respectively.

Cumulatively, stopovers for the January - August 2017 period were down **4.2%** moving from **44,272** in 2016 to **42,417** in 2017.

Asia

The Asian market decreased by **34.5%** in August 2017 with a total of **460** stopovers compared to **702** in August 2016.

Japan, China, and India, are the major visitor-producing countries with **147**, **141** and **65** stopovers arriving from each country, respectively.

For the January to August 2017 period, stopover arrivals from Asia grew by **4.6%**, with **6,426** arrivals compared to **6,141** arrivals in 2016.

Other Countries

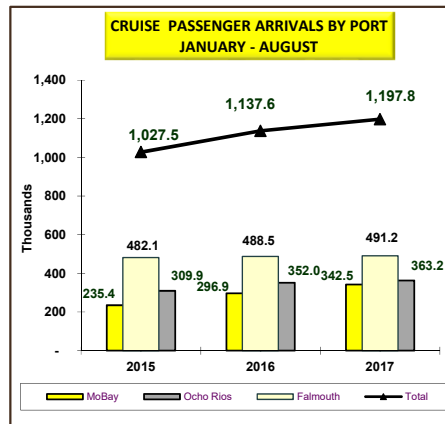
Overall, stopover arrivals from other countries increased by **2.6%** in the January to August 2017 period. Of the Other Countries, Australia provided the most stopover arrivals to Jamaica, with **1,729** visitors in 2017 compared to **1,793** in 2016. This represents a decrease of **3.6%**.

Market Share

The market share of stopover visitors for the period January to August 2017 was as follows: USA **65.4%**; Canada **16.7%**; UK **8.9%**; Continental Europe **4.3%**, the Caribbean **2.6%**; and the others, including Latin America and Asia **2.0%**.

Cruise Passengers

A total of **109,074** cruise passengers visited Jamaica in August 2017. This represented a **9.4%** increase over the **99,677** for August 2016.



For August 2017, Cruise passengers visiting the port of Falmouth grew by **5.4%**. Cruise passengers visiting the port of Ocho Rios rose by **34.7%** and those visiting the port of Montego Bay decreased by **5.7%**.

For the first four months of summer, May to August 2016, cruise passengers visiting Jamaica were up by **7.9%**, with **423,273** passengers compared to **392,355** during the same period in 2016.

Year-to-date, January to August 2017 saw **1,197,792** cruise passenger arrivals visiting the three major ports, an increase of **60,220** passengers or **5.3%**.

Length of Stay

The average length of stay of **Foreign National** arrivals in August 2017 was **8.3** nights compared to **8.9** nights in August 2016. The average length of stay in hotels was **6.3** nights in August 2017, compared to **6.9** nights in August 2016.

The average length of stay of **Non-Resident Jamaican** arrivals in August 2017 was **15.6** nights compared to **15.0** in August 2016. The average length of stay in hotels in August 2017 was **8.5** nights, which is the same level as in August 2016.

During the January to August 2016 period the average length of stay of Foreign National arrivals in all types of accommo-

dations was **8.3** nights compared to **8.6** nights in 2016. For the Non-Resident Jamaican arrivals the average length of stay was **16.2** nights compared to **16.0** nights in 2016.

Purpose of Visit

During the period January to August 2017, **91.7%** or **1,398,861** of the **1,525,979** **Foreign Nationals** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **4.0%** were on Business, **3.9%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.5%** did not state their purpose of travel.

A total of **79,702** or **80.3%** of the **99,278** **Non-Resident Jamaicans** were visiting for Leisure, **3.9%** were on Business, **13.1%** were on Other purposes of travel and **2.7%** failed to provide a reason for travel.

Year-to-date January to August 2017, **91.0%** or a total of **1,478,563** of the total stopover arrivals of **1,625,257** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **3.9%** were on Business, **4.5%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.6%** did not state their purpose of travel.

Intended Resort Area of Stay

Of the **192,878** stopover arrivals visiting Jamaica in August 2017, the resort area of Montego Bay welcomed **68,553** arrivals or **35.5%**; Ocho Rios received **43,235** or **22.4%**, Negril welcomed **36,556** or **19.0%**; and **18,533** or **9.6%** visited Kingston. The remaining **13.6%** stayed in the Mandeville/South Coast, Port Antonio resort regions and Other areas in Jamaica.

Between January and August 2017, the pattern remained the same. Montego Bay, Negril, and Ocho Rios accounted for **1,267,920** or **78.0%** of the stopover arrivals.

Type of Airlines used

Of the **1,625,257** stopover visitors to Jamaica in the period January to August 2017, **1,502,854** or **92.5%** used scheduled airlines, while **122,403** or **7.5%** used chartered flights.

During the corresponding period in 2016 the percentage distribution was: **93.4%** - used scheduled airlines and **6.6%** - used chartered flights.

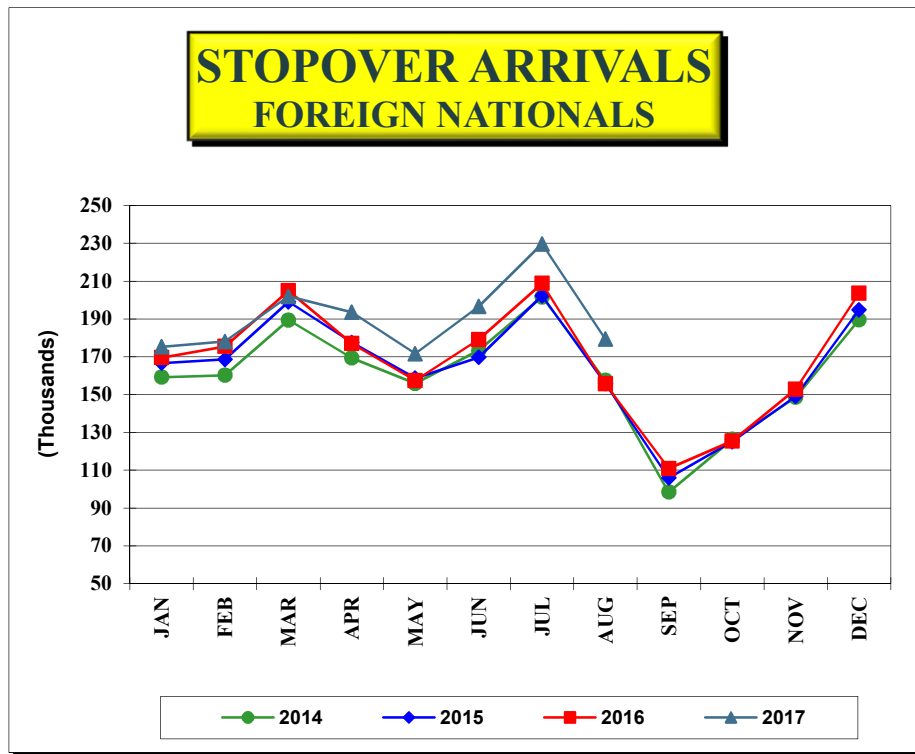

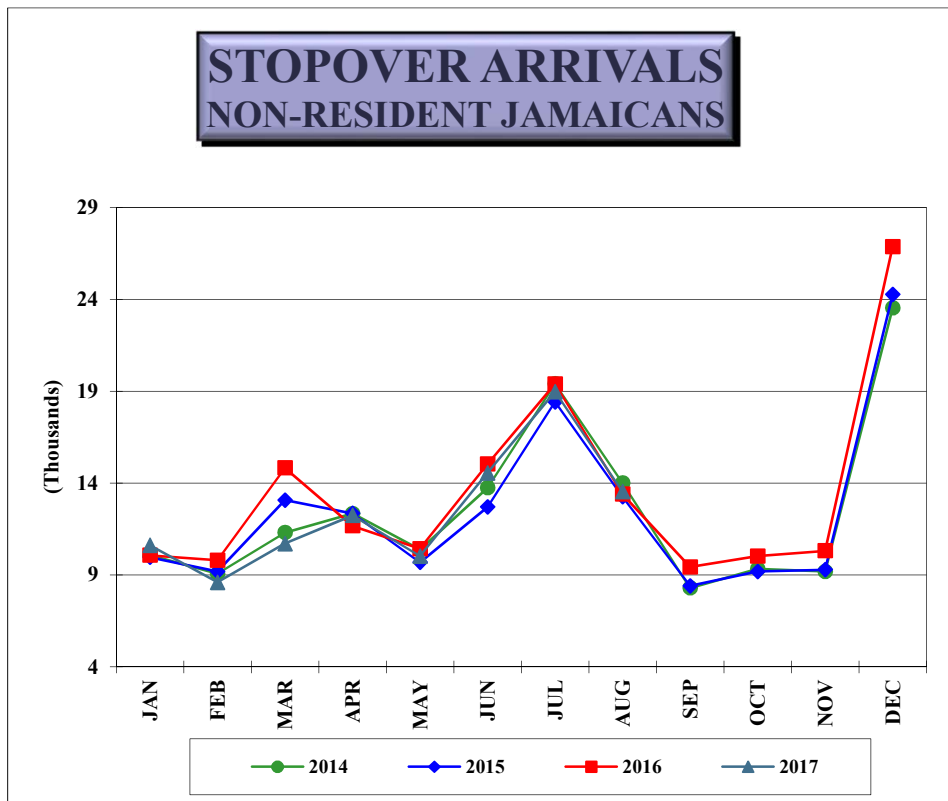

STOPOVER ARRIVALS BY PURPOSE OF VISIT JANUARY - AUGUST 2017

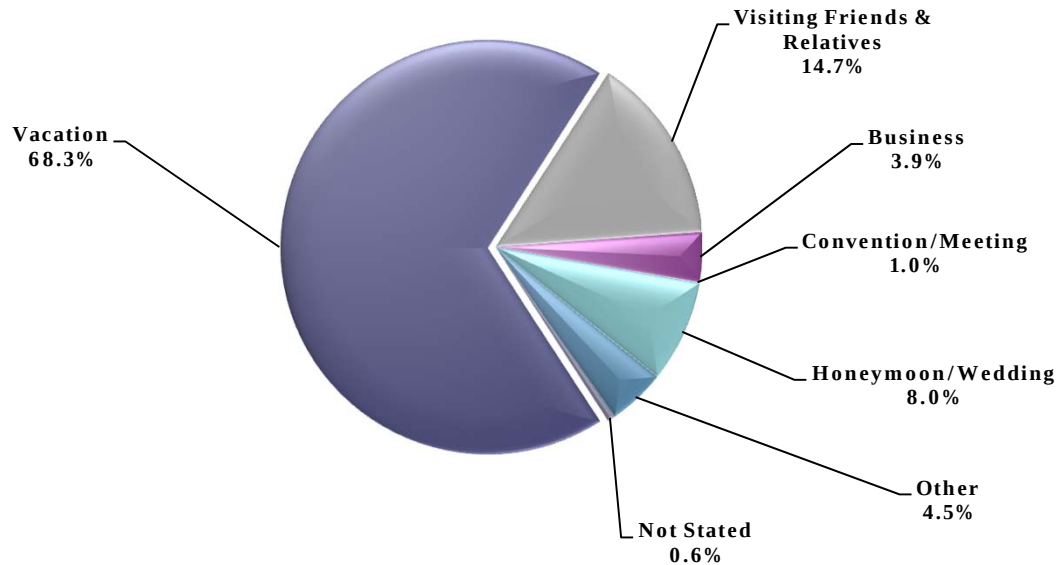

STOPOVER VISITORS BY MARKET SHARE

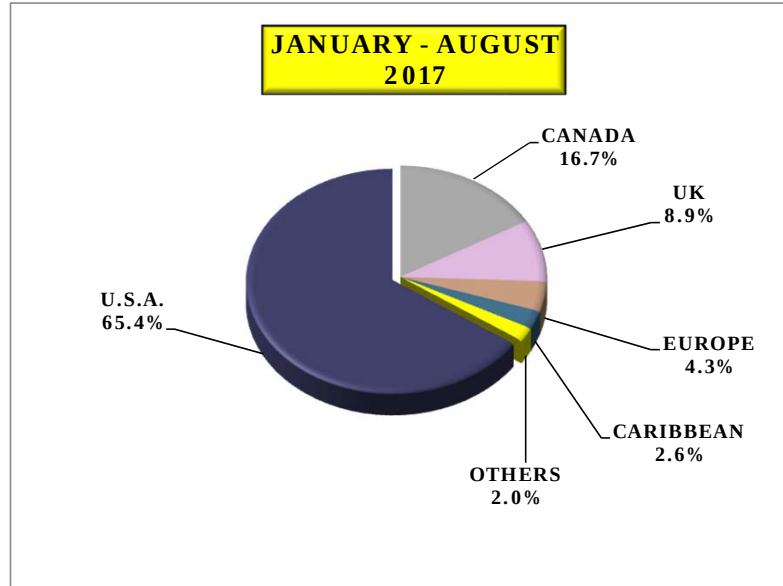

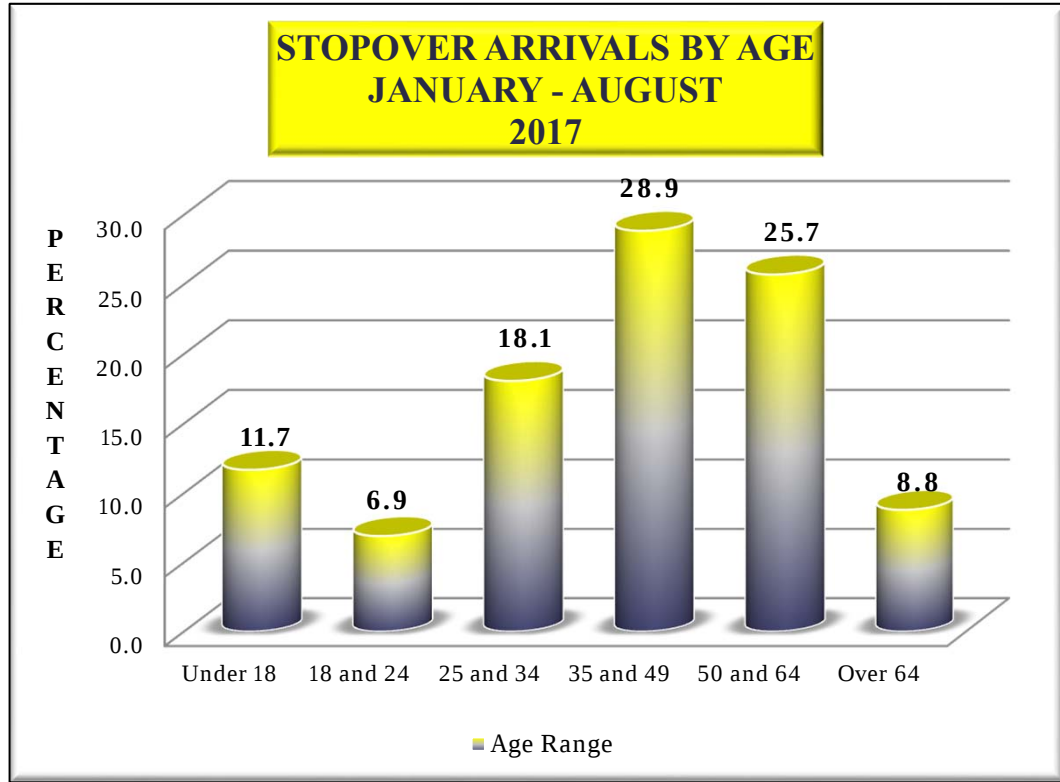

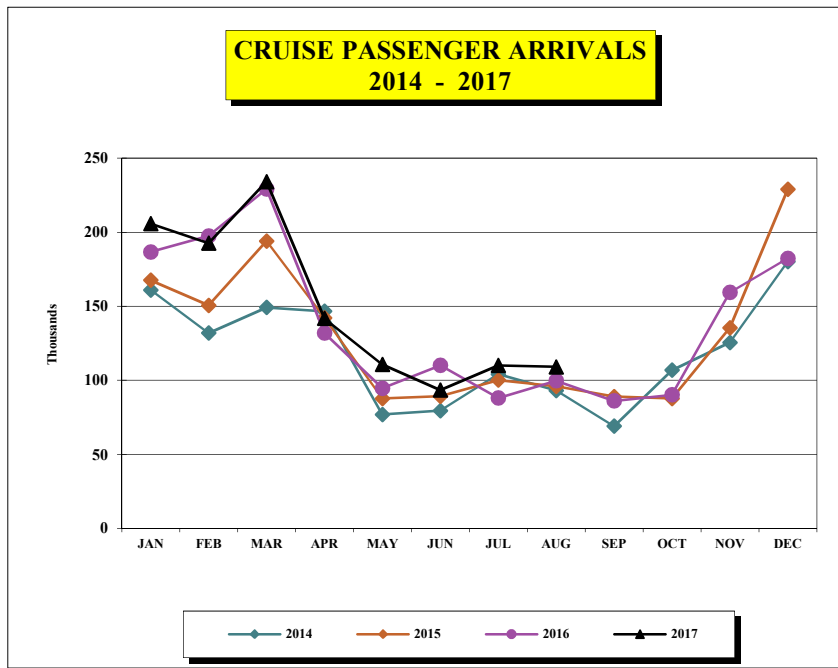

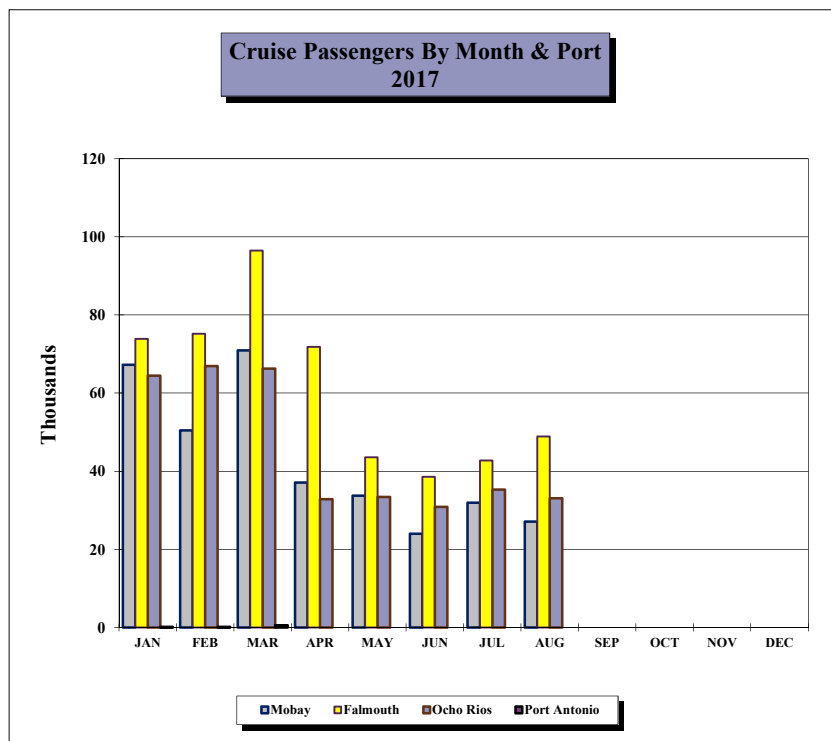

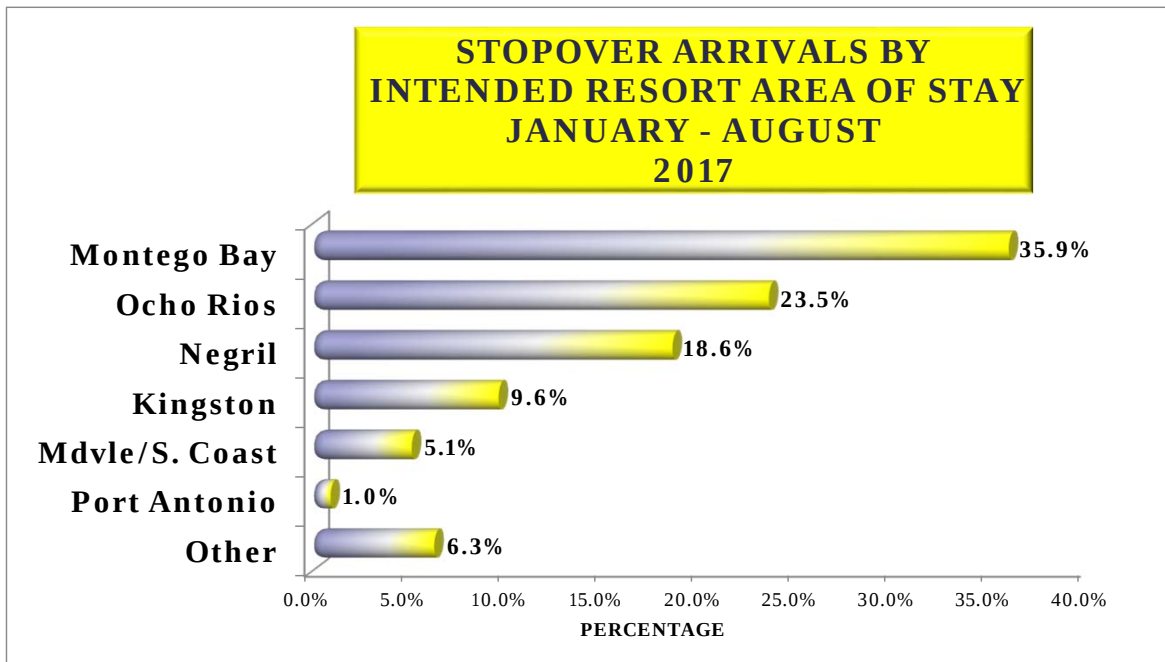
