**TOURIST (Stopover Arrivals)**

Stopover arrivals in August 2022 were **218,849** an increase of **42.5%** or **65,289** more arrivals over the **153,560** recorded in August 2021.

For the January to August period, arrivals increased by **89.6%**, with **1,649,253** stopovers, this is **779,472** more stopovers compared to the **869,781** in 2021.


Ontario has recorded **120,901**, and those from Quebec, were **16,326** visitors, compared to the same period in 2021.

**Europe**

The European market region has recorded an increase of **75.2%** in August 2022, with **24,127** stopover arrivals compared to the **13,771** recorded in August 2021.

**United States**

Stopover arrivals from the United States market recorded an increase of **27.7%** in August 2022, with a total of **166,246** arrivals compared to the **130,187** arrivals who visited in August 2021. All US marketing regions recorded increases in arrivals, the Northeast with **82,411** up by **19.6%**, the South with **47,835** up by **54.2%**, the Mid-West with **17,962** up by **10.9%**, and the West with **18,038** up by **28.0%**.



In the Northern European region, the main visitor producing countries; United Kingdom, recorded **20,028** arrivals, and Ireland recorded **158** arrivals.

In the South-Western European region, Germany recorded **1,077** visitor arrivals, The Netherlands with **964**, and France with **365**.

Stopover arrivals from Central-East Europe has recorded **238** arrivals.

For the January to August period, the US market region has grown by **56.0%** with **1,256,580** arrivals. The Northeast up by **46.7%**, the South up by **70.8%**, the Midwest by **64.5%** and the West region up by **47.4%**, compared to the same period in 2021.

Y-T-D January to August, 2022 period, arrivals from the regions in Europe were **183,433** stopovers, this is **152,023** more stopovers compared to the **31,410** recorded during the same period in 2021.

**Canada**

In August 2022, the Canadian market recorded an increase in arrivals of **214.1%**, with **20,761** or **14,152** more stopovers compared to the **6,609** in August 2021.

**Latin America**

Arrivals from Latin America recorded **1,715** in August 2022, compared to **463** in August 2021.

Stopover arrivals from Atlantic Canada recorded **244**; the main provinces of Newfoundland recorded **84** and Nova Scotia recorded **92**.

From the Central American region, stopover arrivals were **535** arrivals. Mexico with **210** arrivals and Panama with **132**.

Stopover arrivals from Central Canada recorded **18,779**; the leading province of Ontario recorded **16,653**, the second most important Canadian province of Quebec recorded **2,126**.

From the South American region, stopover arrivals were **1,180** arrivals. Argentina with **346** arrivals, Chile with **170**, and Brazil with **167** arrivals.

Stopover arrivals from Western Canada recorded **1,738**; the main province of Alberta recorded **887**, while the arrivals from British Columbia recorded **551**.

Cumulatively, for the January to August 2022 period, stopover arrivals from Latin America totalled **14,472** which was **10,846** more visitors compared to the **3,626** during the same period in 2021.

Cumulatively, the Canadian market has recorded **157,968** visitors or **140,960** more visitors than in 2021. The top producing provinces of

Stopovers from the Central American region was **4,596** arrivals up by **127.2%** and from the South American region was up by **516.1%** with **9,876** arrivals, compared to the same period in 2021.

## The Caribbean

Stopover arrivals to Jamaica from the Caribbean region were up **143.2%** in August 2022 with a total of **5,373** visitors, compared to **2,209** in August 2021.

The Cayman Is. and Trinidad & Tobago were the major visitor producing Caribbean countries in August 2022 with **1,549** and **898** stopover arrivals, respectively.

Year to date, stopovers for the January to August period rose by **208.4%** moving up from **10,393** in 2021 to **32,047** in 2022.

## Asia

The Asian market increased by **77.3%** in August 2022 with a total of **273** stopovers compared to **154** in August 2021.

India, China, and Japan, are the major visitor-producing countries with **106**, **65** and **44** stopovers arriving from each country, respectively.

Year to date, stopovers for the January to August period rose by **138.4%** moving up from **906** in 2021 to **2,160** in 2022.

## Other Countries

Overall, stopover arrivals from other countries rose by **212.0%** with **2,593** arrivals, for the January to August 2022 period. Of the Other Countries, Africa provided the most stop-over arrivals to Jamaica, with **900** visitors compared to **335** in 2021. This represents an increase of **168.7%**.

## Market

The market share of stopover visitors for the period January to August 2022 was as follows: USA **76.2%**; Canada **9.6%**; UK **9.4%**; Continental Europe **1.7%**, the Caribbean **1.9%**; and the others, including Latin America and Asia **1.2%**.

## Cruise Passengers

A total of **81,753** cruise passengers visited Jamaica in August 2022. A total of **38,230** visited the port of Falmouth, **31,714** visit-

ed the port of Ocho Rios, and **11,809** visited the port of Montego Bay,

Year-to-date, January to August 2022 saw **443,266** cruise passenger arrivals visiting our shores. The port in Ocho Rios reopened in August 2021 with 3,496 passengers from 2 ship calls.



## Length of Stay

The average length of stay of **Foreign National** arrivals in August 2022 was **8** nights, compared to **9** nights in August 2021. The average length of stay in hotels was **6** nights in August 2022, compared to **6.5** nights in August 2021.

The average length of stay of **Non-Resident Jamaican** arrivals in August 2022 was **15.2** nights compared to **24.7** in August 2021. The average length of stay in hotels in August 2022 was **7.7** nights, compared to **9.5** nights in August 2021.

During the January to August 2022 period, the average length of stay for Foreign National arrivals in all types of accommodations was **8.0** nights compared to **8.8** nights in 2021. For the Non-Resident Jamaican arrivals the average length of stay was **17.1** nights compared to **24.2** nights.

## Purpose of Visit

During the month of August 2022, **93.7%** or **189,331** of the **201,984 Foreign Nationals** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **1.9%** were on Business, **3.9%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.5%** did not state their purpose of travel.

A total of **14,127** or **83.8%** of the **16,865 Non-Resident Jamaicans** were visiting for Leisure, **2.8%** were on Business, **11.2%** were on Other purposes of travel and **2.2%** failed to provide a reason for travel.

Year-to-date January to August 2022, **90.4%** or a total of **1,490,611** of the total stopover arrivals of **1,649,253** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **1.8%** were on Business, **7.3%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.5%** did not state their travel purpose.

## Intended Resort Area of Stay

Of the **218,849** stopover arrivals visiting Jamaica in August 2022, the resort area of Montego Bay welcomed **84,330** arrivals or **38.5%**; Ocho Rios welcomed **45,799** or **20.9%**; Negril received **35,421** or **16.2%**, and **19,551** or **8.9%** visited Kingston. The remaining **15.4%** stayed in the Mandeville/South Coast, Port Antonio resort regions and Other areas in Jamaica.

Between January and August 2022, the combination of Montego Bay, Negril, and Ocho Rios accounted for **1,283,894** or **77.8%** of the **1,649,253** total stopover arrivals.

## Type of Airlines used

Of the **1,649,253** stopover visitors to Jamaica in the January to August 2022, **1,544,425** or **93.6%** used scheduled airlines, while **104,828** or **6.4%** used chartered flights.

During the corresponding period in 2021 the percentage distribution was: **98.7%** - used scheduled airlines and **1.3%** - used chartered flights.

## Net Promoter Score (NPS)

This is a simple metric that can be used to measure the intention to recommend/refer a travel destination and is also an indicator of overall satisfaction with the travel or customer experience.

The NPS for YTD 2022 are as follows:

January = 72      July = 61.3  
 February = 70      August = 66.0  
 March = 64  
 April = 66  
 May = 63  
 June = 65

NPS ranges from -100 (meaning everyone is a detractor) to +100 (meaning everyone is a promoter). A decent Net Promoter Score is any number >0%. Any positive NPS is good. An NPS of +50 is excellent.











