TOURIST (Stopover Arrivals)

Stopover arrivals in February 2020 were **235,740** an increase of **7.1%** or **15,694** additional arrivals over the **220,046** recorded in February 2019.

For the January to February period, arrivals increased by 6.0%, with 462,940 stopovers compared to 436,555 in 2018.

United States

Stopover

arrivals from the United States market recorded a notable increase of **11.1%** in February 2020, with a total of **155,298** arrivals compared to the **139,843** arrivals who visited in February 2019. All the US marketing regions recorded increases in arrivals, the Northeast with **70,088** grew by **14.3%**, the Mid-West with **42,519** grew by **4.8%**, the South with **30,458** grew by **15.4%**, and the West with **12,233** grew by **6.1%**.

For the January to February period, the US market region has grown by 9.7%, with 298,758 in 2020. The northeast has grown by 15.2%, the Midwest up by 0.8%, the South up by 12.4%, and the West up by 5.6%.

Canada

In February 2020, the Canadian market recorded an increase in arrivals of **1.2%**, with **44,914** stopovers compared to **44,369** in February 2019.

Stopover arrivals from Atlantic Canada grew by **1.4%**; the main provinces of Nova Scotia decreased by **2.0%**, over February 2019 and those from New Brunswick decreased by **5.7%**.

Stopover arrivals from Central Canada increased by **3.6%**; the leading province of Ontario decreased by **1.5%**, while the second most important Canadian province of Quebec grew by **37.9%**.

Stopover arrivals from Western Canada fell by **11.4%**; the main province of Alberta recorded a decline of **7.7%**, while the arrivals from Manitoba decreased by **2.2%**.

Cumulatively, the Canadian market with **90,836** visitors recorded an increase of **1.6%** or **1,389** more visitors than in 2019. The top producing provinces of Ontario with **62,498** rose by **0.7%**, and those from Quebec, with **13,266** visitors rose by **27.8%**.

Europe

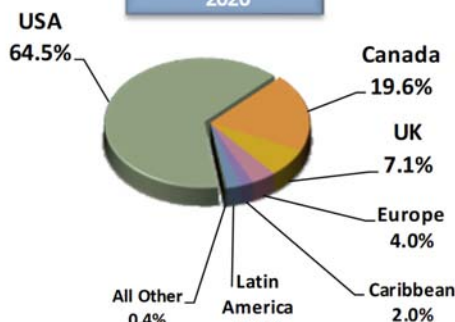
The European market region recorded a decrease of **9.4%** in February 2020, with **25,073** stopover arrivals compared to the **27,680** recorded in February 2019.

In the Northern European region, the main visitor producing countries, United Kingdom, with **15,965** arrivals, fell by **4.0%**, while Sweden with **783** arrivals fell by **4.9%**.

In the South-Western European region, Germany with **2,384** visitor arrivals decreased by **17.0%**, France with **1,329** grew by **0.2%**, Italy with **1,134** fell by **23.3%**, and the Netherlands with **832** arrivals increased by **32.5%**.

Stopover arrivals from Central-East Europe with **770** arrivals fell by **57.69%**.

For the January to February 2019 period, arrivals from the European market region fell by **9.6%**. Total stopover arrivals were **51,331** compared to **56,774** in 2019. Northern Europe fell by **2.2%**, moving from **36,073** in 2019 down to **35,277** in 2020. Arrivals from the South/West region fell by **12.6%**, with **13,861** arrivals, and those from Central/East region decreased by **54.7%** with **2,193** arrivals

Latin America

Arrivals from Latin America increased by **82.7%** in February 2020, with a total of **5,347** stopovers compared to **2,927** in February 2019.

From the Central American region, stopover arrivals grew by **22.7%** with **876** arrivals. Mexico with **365** arrivals grew by **40.9%**, and Panama with **237** grew by **19.7%**.

From the South American region, stopover arrivals increased by **102.0%** with **4,471** arrivals. Argentina with **1,402** arrivals grew by **192.1%**, Chile with **1,263** arrivals increased by **56.7%**, while Peru with **764** increased by **283.9%**.

Cumulatively, January to February 2020, stopover arrivals from Latin America increased by **58.1%**, with a total of **10,566** arrivals compared to **6,685** in 2019.

Stopover from Central America with **1,641** arrivals grew by **6.6%**. The main producing countries of Mexico and Panama increased by **14.8%** and **9.6%** respectively.

Stopovers from South America grew by **73.5%** with **8,925** arrivals. The top producing countries of Argentina with **2,959** rose by **126.7%**, Chile with **2,153** grew by **52.3%**, and Peru with **1,433** arrivals grew by **265.6%**.

The Caribbean

Stopover arrivals to Jamaica from the Caribbean region were up **4.1%** in February 2020 with a total of **4,200** visitors, compared to **4,033** in February 2019.

The Cayman Islands and Trinidad & Tobago continued to be the major visitor producing Caribbean countries in February 2020 with **1,435** and **564** stopover arrivals, respectively.

Year to date, stopovers for the January to February period grew by **6.4%** moving from 8,851 in 2019 to 9,417 in 2020.

Asia

The Asian market fell by **38.9%** in February 2020 with a total of **441** stopovers compared to **722** in February 2019.

Japan and India, are the major visitor-producing countries with **174**, and **146** stopovers arriving from each country, respectively.

For the January to February 2020 period, stopover arrivals from Asia fell by **22.4%** with **1,047** arrivals compared to **1,349** in 2019.

Other Countries

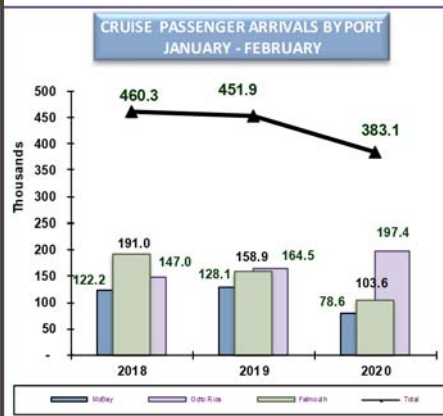
Overall, stopover arrivals from other countries fell by **10.3%** with **985** arrivals, for the January to February 2020 period. Of the Other Countries, Australia provided the most stop-over arrivals to Jamaica, with **395** visitors compared to **441** in 2019. This represents a decrease of **10.4%**.

Market

The market share of stopover visitors for the period January to February 2020 was as follows: USA **64.5%**; Canada **19.6%**; UK **7.1%**; Continental Europe **4.0%**, the Caribbean **2.0%**; and the others, including Latin America and Asia **2.7%**.

Cruise Passengers

A total of **173,981** cruise passengers visited Jamaica in February 2020. This represented a **14.2%** decrease over the **202,830** who visited in February 2019.



For February 2020, Cruise passengers visiting the port of Ocho Rios grew by **25.9%** with **92,712** passengers. Those visiting the port of Falmouth fell by **35.1%** with **44,313** passengers and those visiting the port of Montego Bay fell by **42.0%** with **35,130** passengers.

Year-to-date, January to February 2020 saw 383,144 cruise passenger arrivals visiting our shores, a decline of 15.2% or 68,712 less cruise passengers.

Length of Stay

The average length of stay of **Foreign National** arrivals in February 2020 was **7.3** nights, compared to **7.5** nights in February 2019. The average length of stay in hotels was **6.1** nights in February 2020, compared to **6.3** nights in February 2019.

The average length of stay of **Non-Resident Jamaican** arrivals in February 2020 was **13.8** nights compared to **14.5** in February 2019. The average length of stay in hotels in February 2020 was **7.4** nights, compared to **7.9** nights in February 2019.

During the January to February 2019 period, the average length of stay for Foreign National arrivals in all types of accommodations was **7.9** nights compared to **8.1** nights in 2019. For the Non-Resident Jamaican arrivals the average length of stay was **15.5** nights compared to **16.6** nights.

Purpose of Visit

During the month of February 2020, **91.8%** or **204,795** of the **223,065 Foreign Nationals** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **3.5%** were on Business, **4.3%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.4%** did not state their purpose of travel.

A total of **9,390** or **74.1%** of the **12,675 Non-Resident Jamaicans** were visiting for Leisure, **4.2%** were on Business, **18.6%** were on Other purposes of travel and **3.1%** failed to provide a reason for travel.

Year-to-date January to February 2020, **89.9%** or a total of **416,298** of the total stopover arrivals of **462,940** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **3.7%** were on Business, **5.8%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.6%** did not state their travel purpose.

Intended Resort Area of Stay

Of the **235,740** stopover arrivals visiting Jamaica in February 2020, the resort area of Montego Bay welcomed **87,405** arrivals or **37.1%**; Ocho Rios received **52,302** or **22.2%**, Negril welcomed **48,637** or **20.6%**; and **19,430** or **8.2%** visited Kingston. The remaining **11.9%** stayed in the Mandeville/South Coast, Port Antonio resort regions and Other areas in Jamaica.

Between January to February 2019, the combination of Montego Bay, Negril, and Ocho Rios accounted for **366,518** or **79.2%** of the **462,940** total stopover arrivals.

Type of Airlines used

Of the **462,940** stopover visitors to Jamaica during the period January to February 2020, **434,968** or **94.0%** used scheduled airlines, while **27,972** or **6.0%** used chartered flights.

During the corresponding period in 2019 the percentage distribution was: **92.0%** - used scheduled airlines and **8.0%** - used chartered flights.

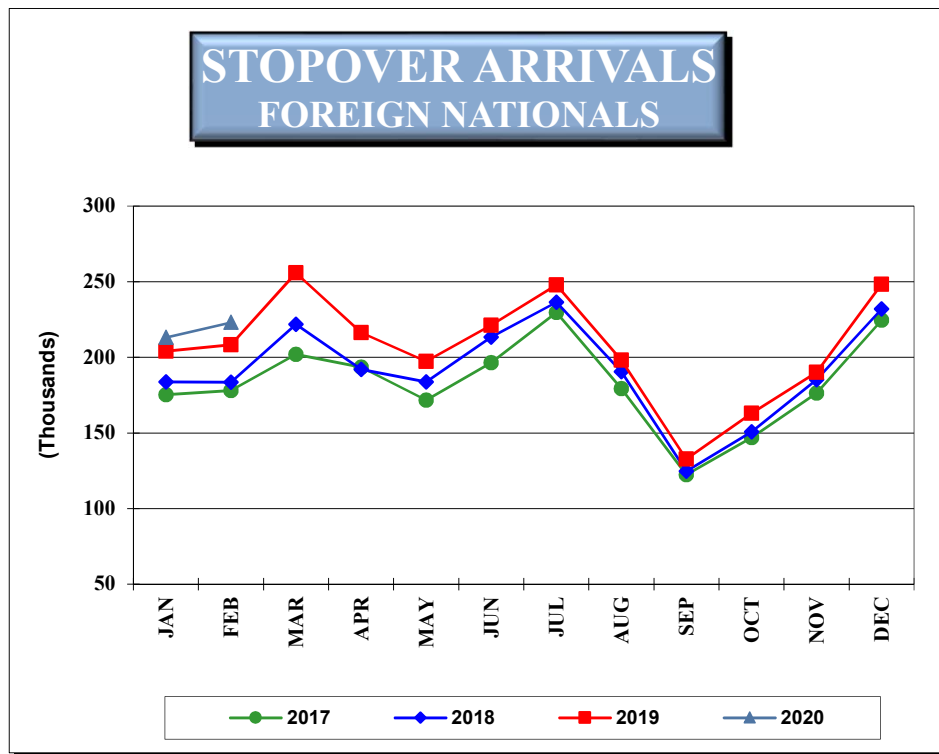

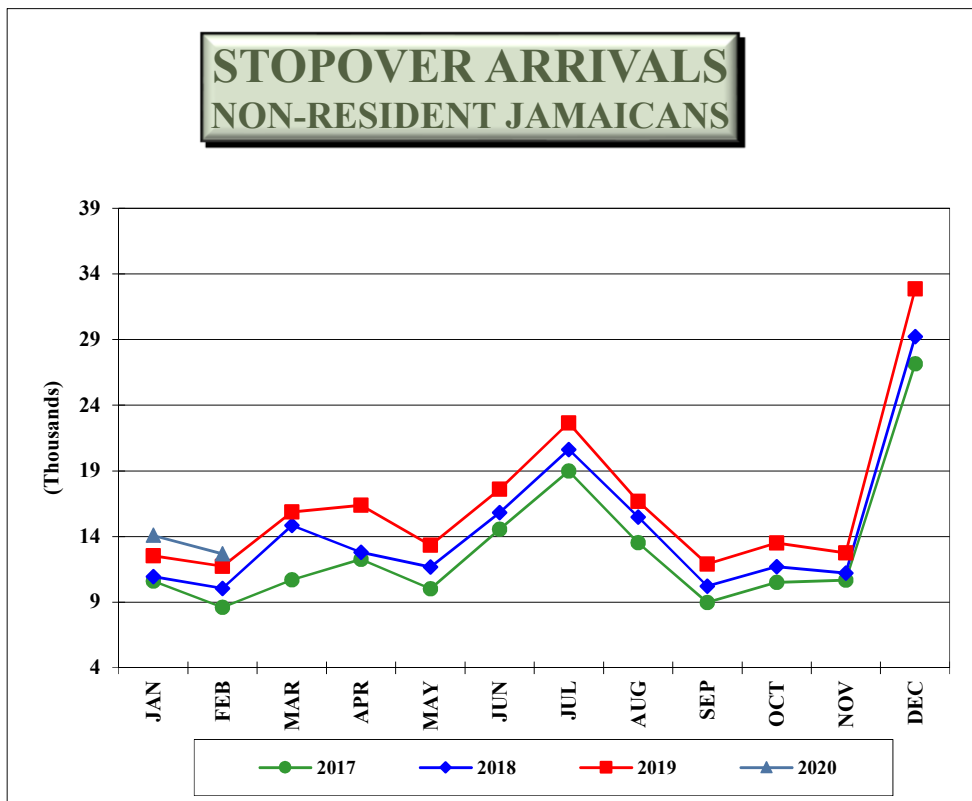

STOPOVER ARRIVALS BY PURPOSE OF VISIT JANUARY - FEBRUARY 2020

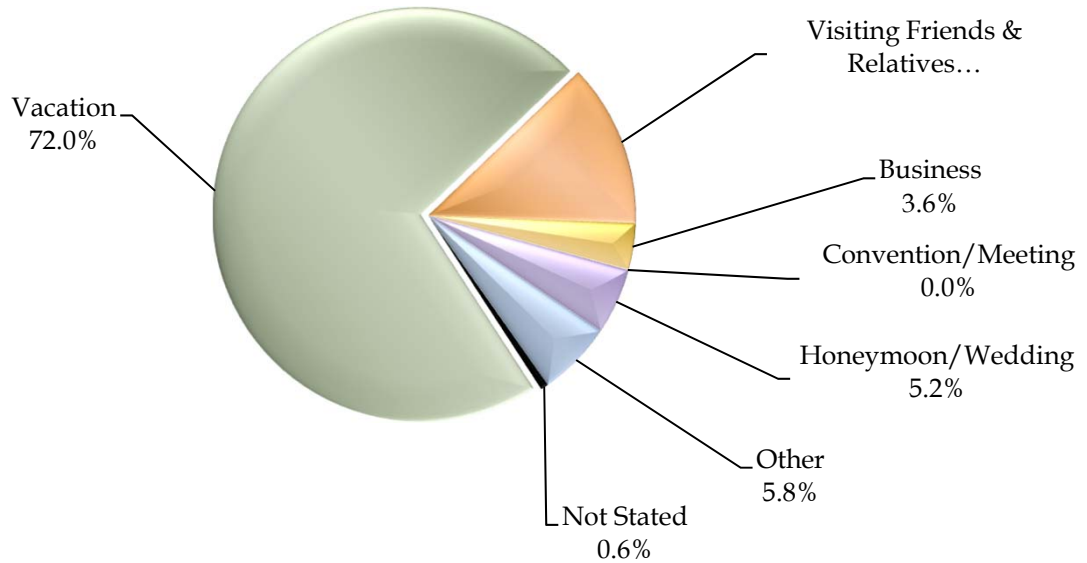

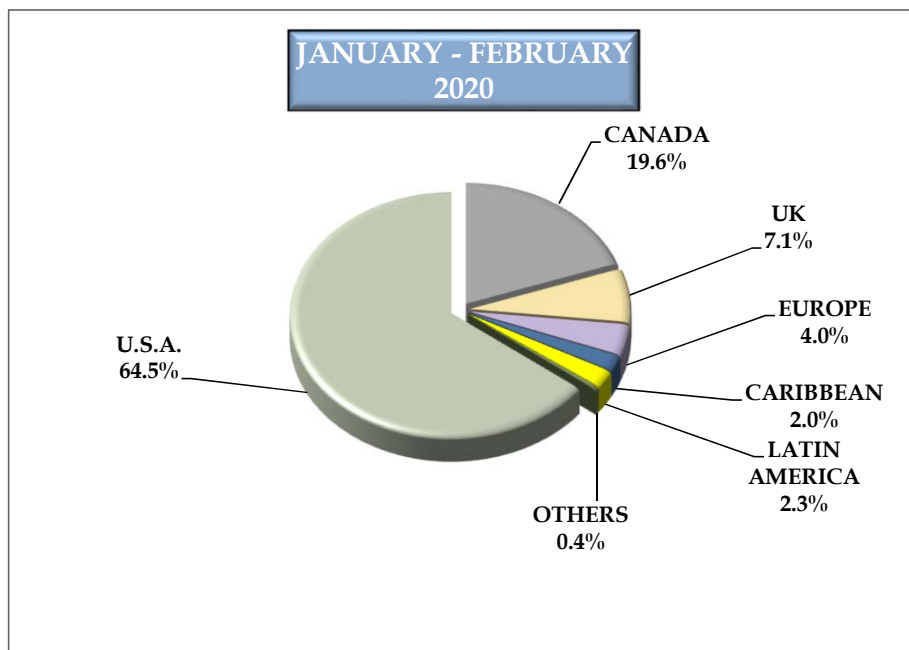

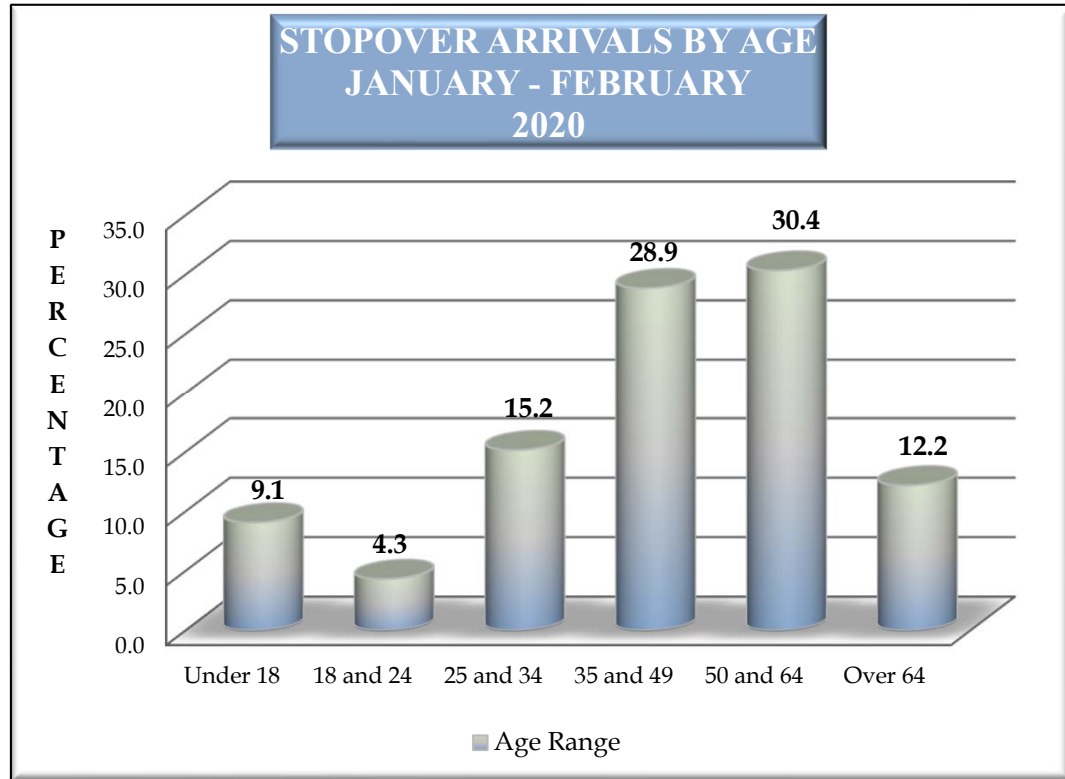

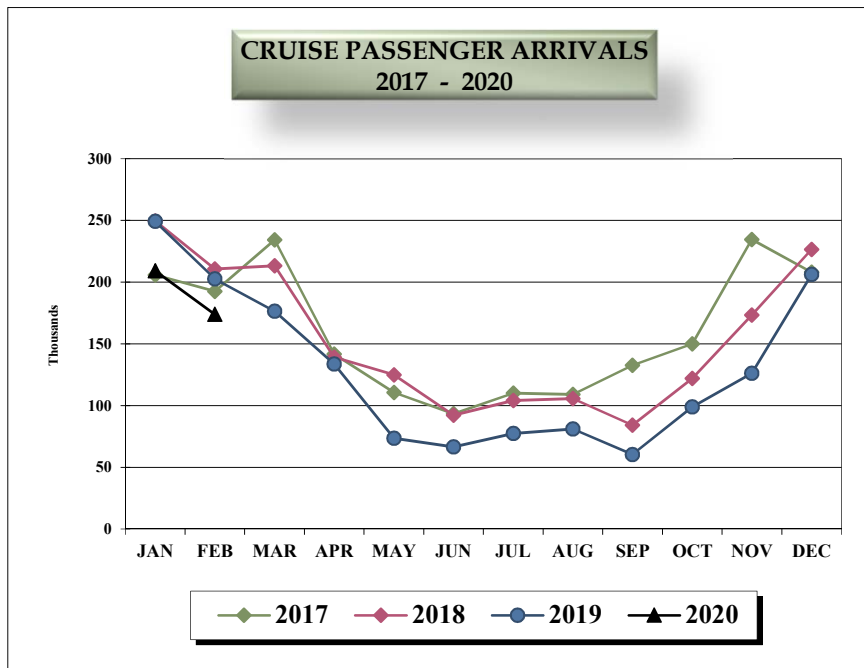

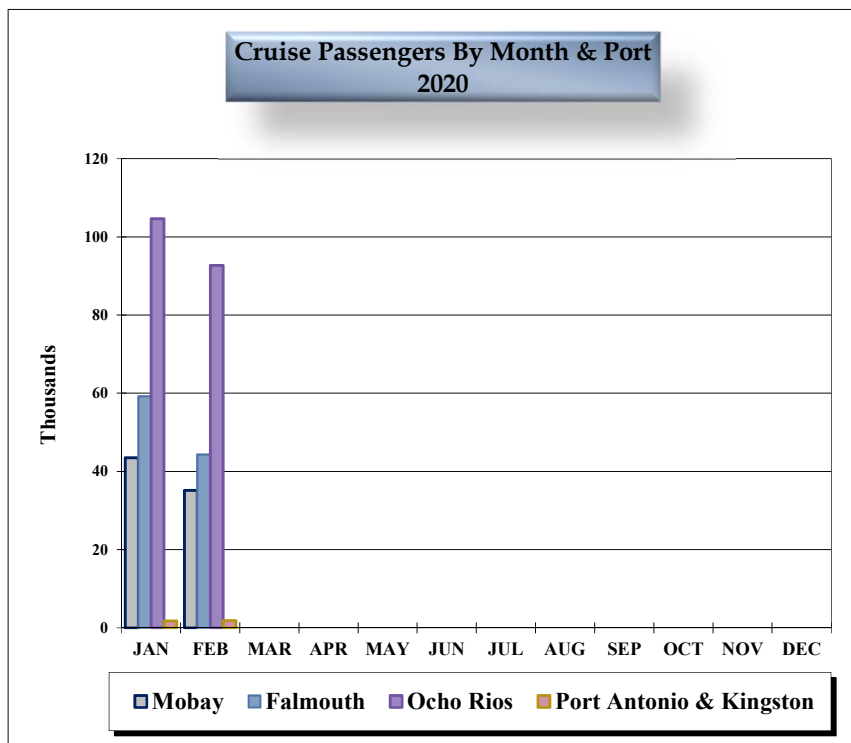

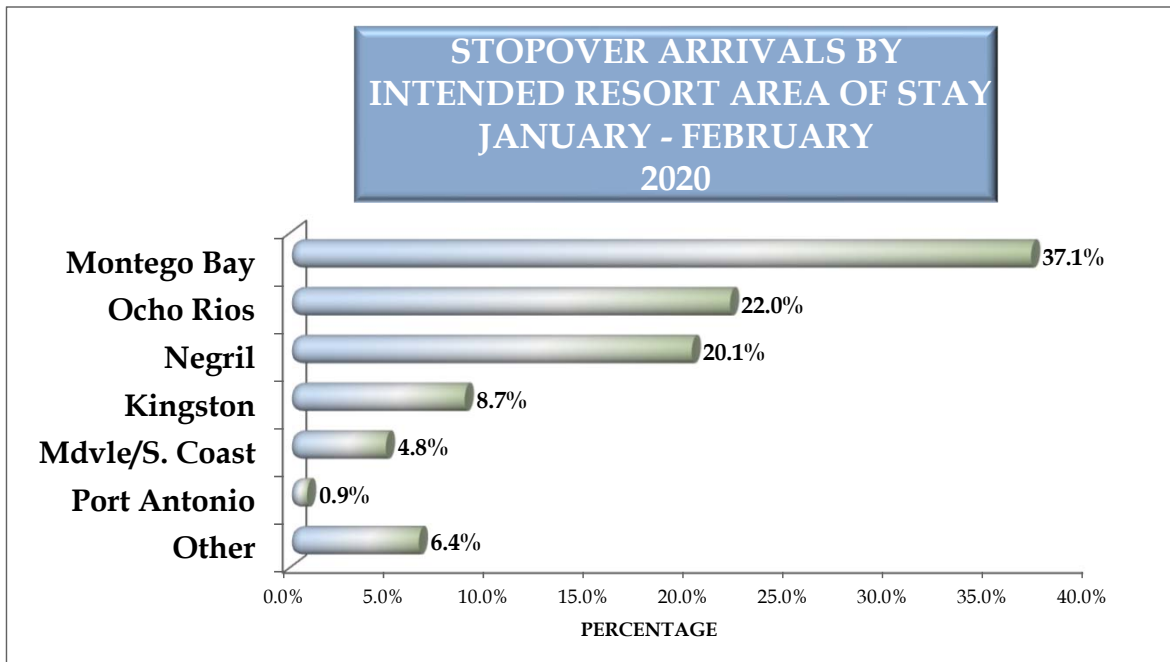
