



IN FEBRUARY 2021...

- Stopover arrivals down 81.4%
- US Market down 73.1%
- Canada down 99.6%
- Europe down 99.1%
- Cruise ports remain closed

TOURIST (Stopover Arrivals)

Stopover arrivals in February 2021 were **43,798** a decrease of **81.4%** or **191,942** less arrivals over the **235,740** recorded in February 2020.

For the January to February period, arrivals decreased by **81.1%**, with **87,629** stopovers, this is **375,311** less stopovers compared to the **462,940** in 2020.

United States

Stopover arrivals from the United States market recorded a decrease of **73.1%** in February 2021, with a total of **41,813** arrivals compared to the **155,298** arrivals who visited in February 2020. All US marketing regions recorded decreases in arrivals, the Northeast with **19,653** fell by **72.0%**, the South with **10,894** fell by **64.2%**, the Mid-West with **7,484** fell by **82.4%**, and the West with **3,782** fell by **69.1%**.

For the January to February period, the US market region has declined by **73.1%** with **80,313** arrivals. The Northeast fell by **73.0%**, the South fell by **62.7%**, the Midwest by **81.6%** and the West region fell by **72.4%**.

Canada

Air service was restricted in February 2021 with repatriation flights only from the gateway of YYZ Toronto. The Canadian market recorded a decrease in arrivals of **99.6%**, with **199** or **44,9715** less stopovers compared to **44,914** in February 2020.

Stopover arrivals from Atlantic Canada with **3** arrivals fell by **99.8%**; from Central Canada with **170** arrivals fell by **99.5%**; and from Western Canada with **26** arrivals fell by **99.6%**.

Cumulatively, the Canadian market with **3,473** visitors has recorded a decrease of **96.2%** or **87,363** less visitors than in 2020. The top producing provinces of Ontario with **2,897** fell by **95.4%**, and those from Quebec, with **245** visitors fell by **98.2%**.

Europe

Air service was also restricted with repatriation flights only from the gateway of LGW, London Gatwick during February 2021. The European market region recorded a decrease of **99.1%** in February 2021, with **233** stopover arrivals compared to the **25,073** recorded in February 2020.

From the Northern European region, **80** visitors was recorded, a decline of **99.5%**. From the South-Western European region with **103** visitors, a decline of **98.6%**, and from Central-East Europe with **50**, a decline of **93.5%**.

For the January to February period, arrivals decreased by **98.9%**, with **540** stopovers, this is **50,791** less stopovers compared to the **51,331** recorded during the same period in 2020.

Latin America

Arrivals from Latin America decreased by **90.1%** in February 2021, with a total of **528** stopovers compared to **5,347** in February 2020.

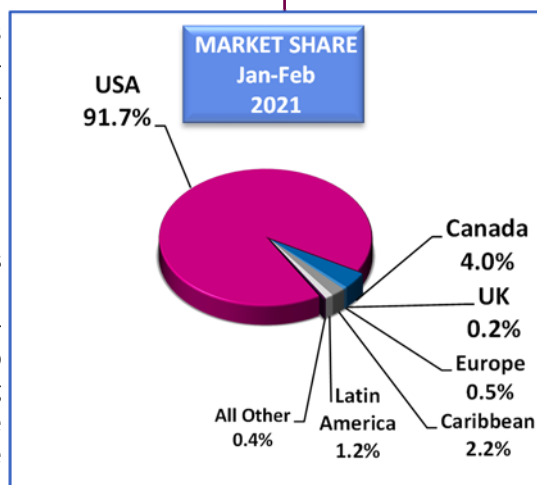
From the Central American region, stopover arrivals fell by **84.6%** with **135** arrivals. Mexico with **49** arrivals fell by **86.6%**, and Panama with **39** fell by **83.5%**.

From the South American region, stopover arrivals decreased by **91.2%** with **393** arrivals. Chile with **107** arrivals decreased by **91.5%**, Colombia with **93** arrivals fell by **60.8%**, while Brazil with **59** arrivals fell by **90.1%**.

Cumulatively, January to February 2021, stopover arrivals from Latin America declined by **89.7%**, with a total of **1,093** arrivals, which was **9,473** less visitors compared to the same period in 2020.

Stopovers from Central America with **306** arrivals fell by **81.4%**.

Stopover arrivals from South America fell by **91.2%** with **787** arrivals.



The Caribbean

Stopover arrivals to Jamaica from the Caribbean region were down **80.2%** in February 2021 with a total of **833** visitors, compared to **4,200** in February 2020.

The Cuba and Bahamas were the major visitor producing Caribbean countries in February 2021 with **182** and **157** stopover arrivals, respectively.

Year to date, stopovers for the January to February period fell by **79.8%** moving down from **9,417** in 2020 to **1,903** in 2021.

Asia

The Asian market fell by **67.3%** in February 2021 with a total of **144** stopovers compared to **441** in February 2020.

India, China, and the Philippines, are the major visitor-producing countries with **79**, **37** and **19** stopovers arriving from each country, respectively.

Year to date, stopovers for the January to February period fell by **80.2%** moving down from **1,047** in 2020 to **207** in 2021.

Other Countries

Overall, stopover arrivals from other countries fell by **89.8%** with **100** arrivals, for the January to February 2021 period. Of the Other Countries, Africa provided the most stop-over arrivals to Jamaica, with **53** visitors compared to **238** in 2020. This represents a decrease of **77.7%**.

Markets

The market share of stopover visitors for the period January to February 2021 was as follows: USA **91.7%**; Canada **4.0%**; UK **0.2%**; Continental Europe **0.5%**, the Caribbean **2.2%**; and the others, including Latin America and Asia **1.6%**.

Length of Stay

The average length of stay of **Foreign National** arrivals in February 2021 was **9.7** nights, compared to **7.3** nights in February 2020. The average length of stay in hotels was **6.7** nights in February 2021, compared to **6.1** nights in February 2020.

The average length of stay of **Non-Resident Jamaican** arrivals in February 2021 was **23.7** nights compared to **13.8** in February 2020. The average length of stay in hotels in February 2021 was **8.1** nights, compared to **7.4** nights in February 2020.

During the January to February 2021 period, the average length of stay for Foreign National arrivals in all types of accommodations was 11.7 nights compared to 7.9 nights in 2020. For the Non-Resident Jamaican arrivals the average length of stay was 26.0 nights compared to 15.5 nights.

Purpose of Visit

During the month of February 2021, **74.4%** or **28,856** of the **38,804 Foreign Nationals** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **1.1%** were on Business, **24.5%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.03%** did not state their purpose of travel.

A total of **1,984** or **39.7%** of the **4,994 Non-Resident Jamaicans** were visiting for Leisure, **2.7%** were on Business, **57.5%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.5%** failed to provide a reason for travel.

Year-to-date January to February 2021, **68.7%** or a total of **60,181** of the total stopover arrivals of **87,629** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **1.5%** were on Business, **29.7%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.1%** did not state their travel purpose.

Intended Resort Area of Stay

Of the **43,798** stopover arrivals visiting Jamaica in February 2021, the resort area of Montego Bay welcomed **16,367** arrivals or **37.4%**; Negril welcomed **8,591** or **19.6%**; Ocho Rios received **6,764** or **15.4%**, and **4,406** or **10.1%** visited Kingston. The remaining **17.5%** stayed in the Mandeville/South Coast, Port Antonio resort regions and Other areas in Jamaica.

Between January and February 2020, the combination of Montego Bay, Negril, and Ocho Rios accounted for **60,986** or **69.6%** of the **87,629** total stopover arrivals.

Type of Airlines used

Of the **87,629** stopover visitors to Jamaica during the period January to February 2021, **86,710** or **98.9%** used scheduled airlines, while **919** or **1.1%** used chartered flights.

During the corresponding period in 2020 the percentage distribution was: **94.0%** - used scheduled airlines and **6.0%** - used chartered flights.

Cruise Passengers

The cruise ship piers were all closed in April 2020 and remain closed.

Net Promoter Score

This is a simple metric that can be used to measure the intention to recommend/refer a travel destination and is also an indicator of overall satisfaction with the travel or customer experience.

The NPS for January and February are as follows:

January = 51

February = 67

NPS ranges from -100 (meaning everyone is a detractor) to +100 (meaning everyone is a promoter). A decent Net Promoter Score is any number >0%. Any positive NPS is good. An NPS of +50 is excellent.

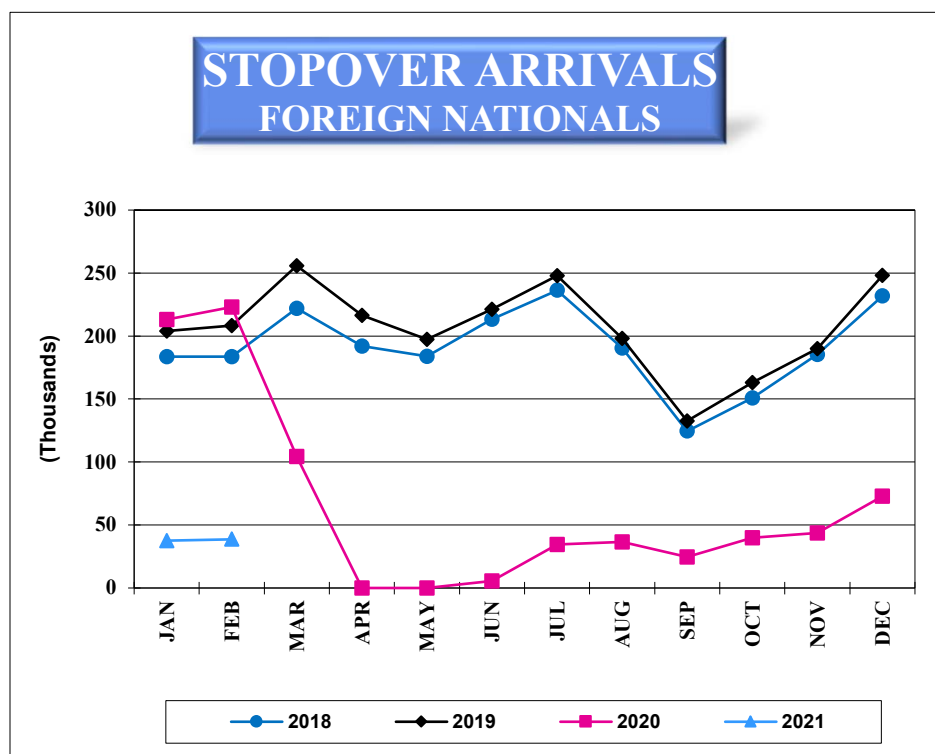

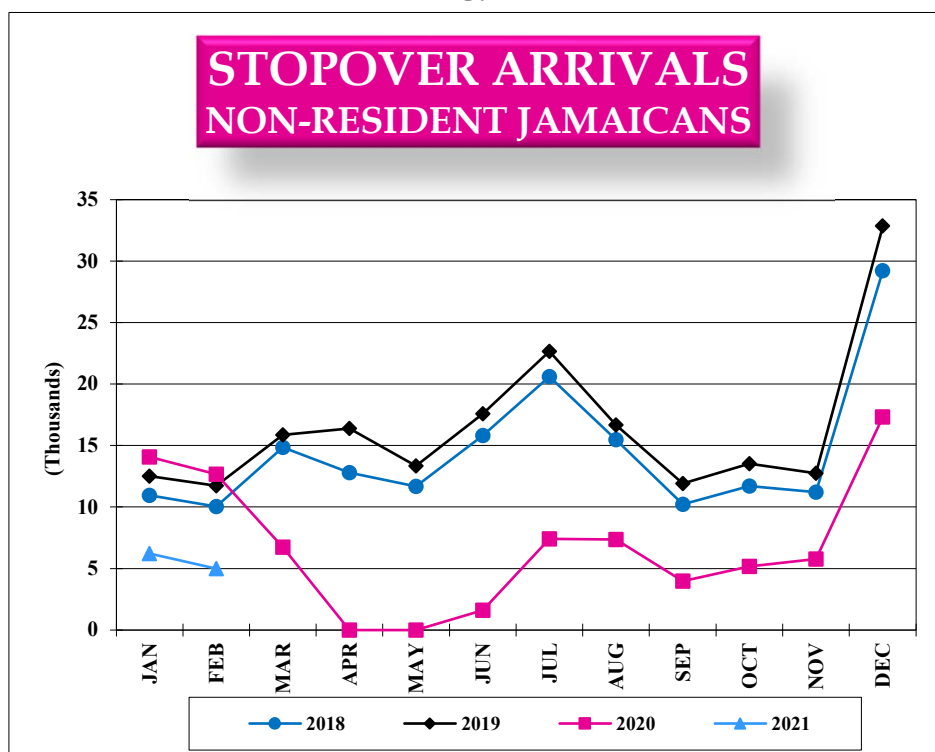

STOPOVER ARRIVALS BY PURPOSE OF VISIT JANUARY - FEBRUARY 2021

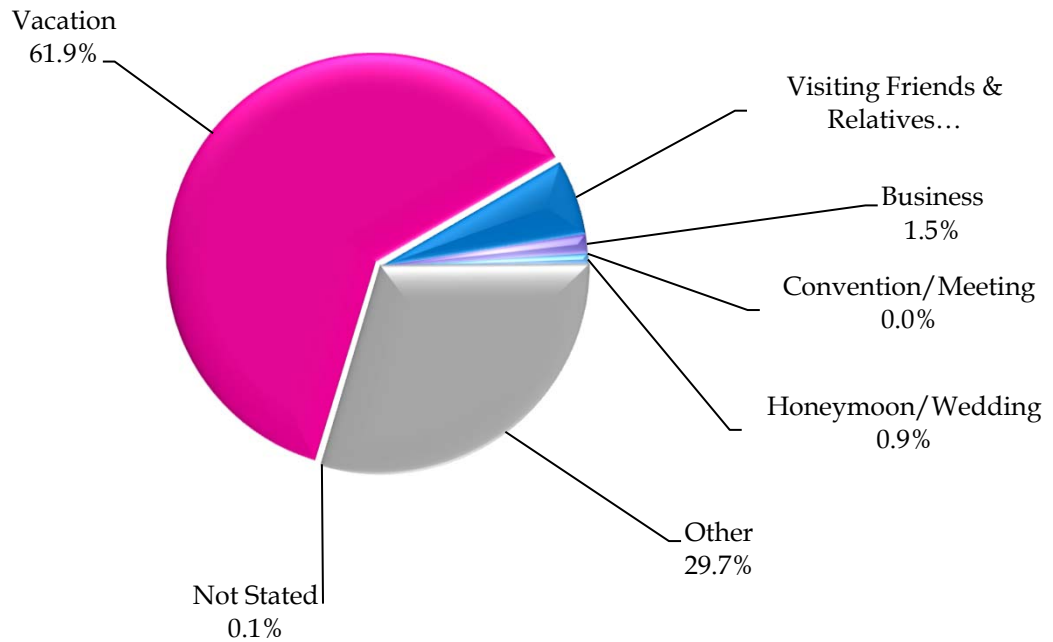

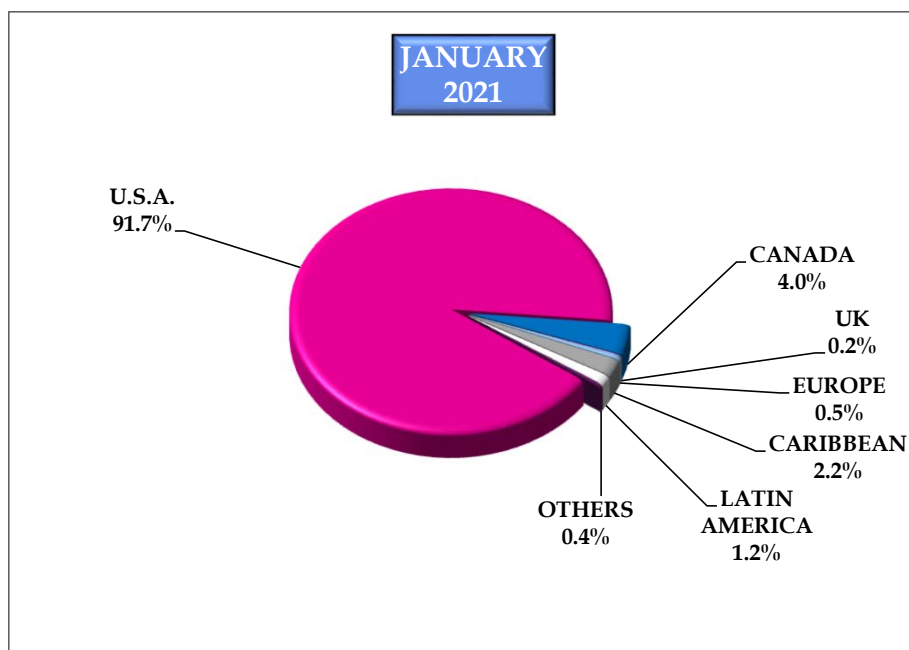

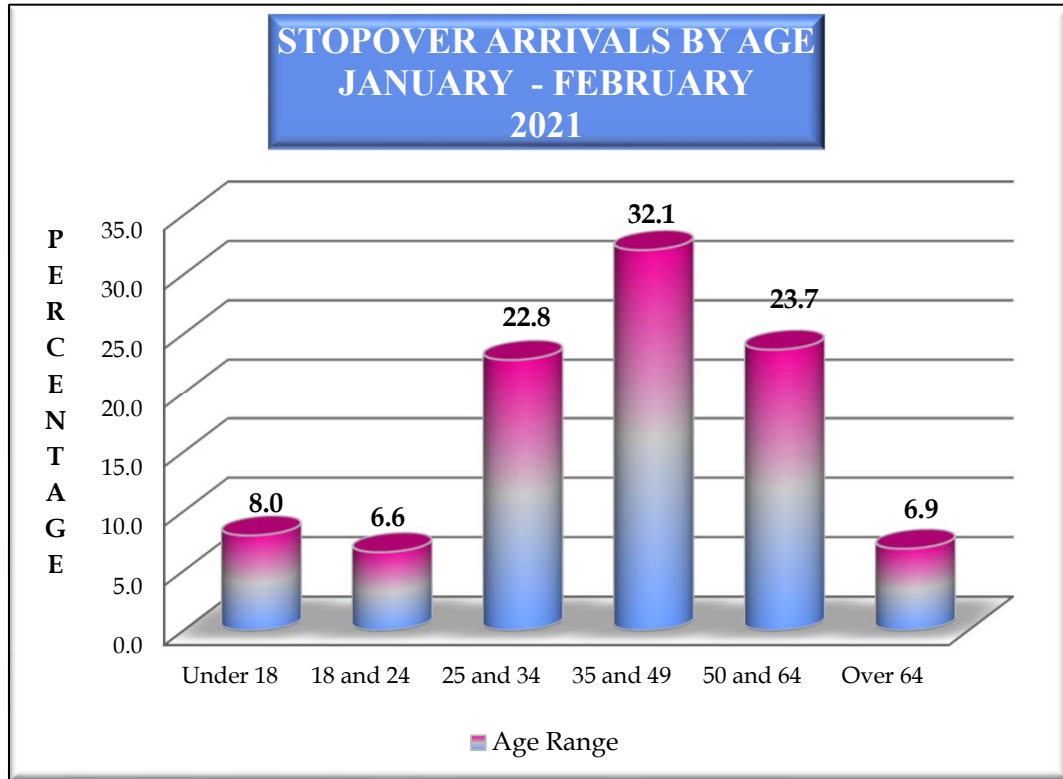

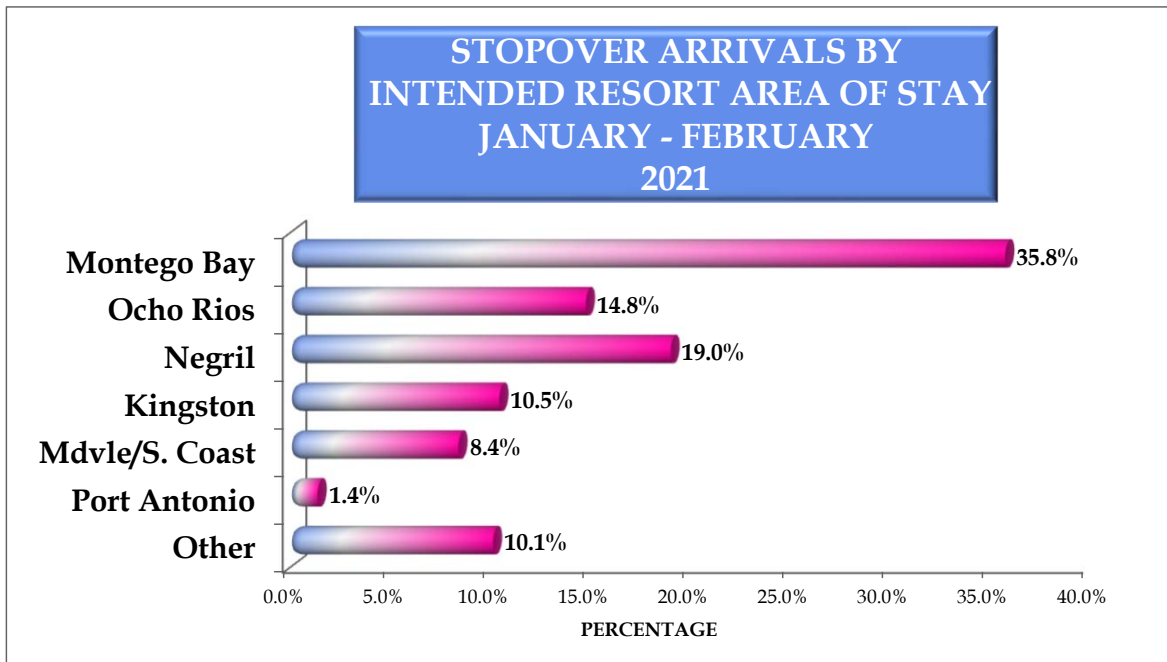
