TOURIST (Stopover Arrivals)

Stopover arrivals in January 2022 were **131,730** an increase of **200.5%** or **87,899** more arrivals over the **43,831** recorded in January 2021.

United States

Stopover arrivals from the United States market recorded an increase **156.7%** in January 2022, with a total of **98,827** arrivals compared to the **38,500** arrivals who visited in January 2021. All US marketing regions recorded increases in arrivals, the Northeast with **41,113** up by **146.5.0%**, the South with **25,078** up by **119.4%**, the Mid-West with **22,158** up by **222.4%**, and the West with **10,478** up by **198.1%**.

Canada

In January 2022, the Canadian market recorded an increase in arrivals of **199.2%**, with **9,795** or **6,521** more stopovers compared to **3,274** in January 2021.


Stopover arrivals from Atlantic Canada rose by **364.9%**; the main provinces of Nova Scotia increased by **326.3%**, over January 2021 and those from New Brunswick increased by **685.7%**.

Stopover arrivals from Central Canada increased by **176.1%**; the leading province of Ontario increased by **163.0%**, while the second most important Canadian province of Quebec rose by **329.8%**.

Stopover arrivals from Western Canada rose by **434.3%**; the main province of Alberta recorded an increase of **433.3%**, while the arrivals from British Columbia increased by **304.1%**.

Europe

The European market region recorded an increase of **581.4%** in January 2022, with **18,148** stopover arrivals compared to the **307** recorded in January 2021.



In the Northern European region, the main visitor producing countries, United Kingdom, with **15,051** arrivals, up by **22704.5%**, while Ireland with **129** arrivals up by **760.0%**.

In the South-Western European region, Germany with **1,201** visitor arrivals increased by **2902.5%**, Switzerland with **251** rose by **1468.8%**, France with **206** rose by **1371.4%** and Belgium with **142** rose by **7000.0%**.

Stopover arrivals from Central-East Europe with **545** arrivals increased by **713.4%**.

Latin America

Arrivals from Latin America increased by **192.2%** in January 2022, with a total of **1,651** stopovers compared to **565** in January 2021.

From the Central American region, stopover arrivals rose by **249.7%** with **598** arrivals. Mexico with **287** arrivals up by **287.8%**, and Panama with **110** up by **214.3%**.

From the South American region, stopover arrivals increased by **167.3%** with **1,053** arrivals. Argentina with **284** arrivals increased by **330.3%**, Chile with **235** arrivals rose by **155.4%**, and Colombia with **204** arrivals up by **195.7%**.

The Caribbean

Stopover arrivals to Jamaica from the Caribbean region were up **176.9%** in January 2022 with a total of **2,963** visitors, compared to **1,070** in January 2021.

The Cuba and Cayman Is. were the major visitor producing Caribbean countries in January 2022 with **649** and **604** stopover arrivals, respectively.

Asia

The Asian market increased by **184.1%** in January 2022 with a total of **179** stopovers compared to **63** in January 2021.

India, China, and Japan, are the major visitor-producing countries with **85**, **26** and **24** stopovers arriving from each country, respectively.

Other Countries


Overall, stopover arrivals from other countries rose by **221.2%** with **167** arrivals, for January 2022. Of the Other Countries, Africa provided the most stop-over arrivals to Jamaica, with **59** visitors compared to **27** in January 2021. This represents a increase of **118.5%**.

Market

The market share of stopover visitors for the month of January 2022 was as follows: USA **75.0%**; Canada **7.4%**; UK **11.4%**; Continental Europe **2.4%**, the Caribbean **2.2%**; and the others, including Latin America and Asia **1.6%**.

Cruise Passengers

A total of 21,110 cruise passengers visited Jamaica in January 2022. A total of 11,557 visited the port of Ocho Rios, 6,867 visited the port of Falmouth, 1,801 visited the port of



Montego Bay and another 885 visited Port Royal.

Length of Stay

The average length of stay of **Foreign National** arrivals in January 2022 was **9.7** nights, compared to **13.8** nights in January 2021. The average length of stay in hotels was **6.7** nights in January 2022, compared to **7.9** nights in January 2021.

The average length of stay of **Non-Resident Jamaican** arrivals in January 2022 was **24.3** nights compared to **27.9** in January 2021. The average length of stay in hotels in January 2022 was **7.7** nights, compared to **9.8** nights in January 2021.

Purpose of Visit

During the month of January 2022, **80.9%** or **97,911** of the **121,006 Foreign Nationals** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **1.6%** were on Business, **17.3%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.1%** did not state their purpose of travel.

A total of **4,533** or **42.3%** of the **10,724 Non-Resident Jamaicans** were

visiting for Leisure, **1.8%** were on Business, **55.3%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.6%** failed to provide a reason for travel.

Intended Resort Area of Stay

Of the **131,730** stopover arrivals visiting Jamaica in January 2022, the resort area of Montego Bay welcomed **47,447** arrivals or **36.0%**; Ocho Rios welcomed **28,067** or **21.3%**; Negril received **25,707** or **19.5%**, and **10,560** or **8.0%** visited Kingston. The remaining **15.1%** stayed in the Mandeville/South Coast, Port Antonio resort regions and Other areas in Jamaica.

In January 2022, the combination of Montego Bay, Negril, and Ocho Rios accounted for **29,264** or **66.8%** of the stopover arrivals.

Type of Airlines used

Of the **131,730** stopover visitors to Jamaica in the month of January 2022, **121,318** or **92.1%** used scheduled airlines, while **10,412** or **7.9%** used chartered flights.

During the corresponding period in 2021 the percentage distribution was: **99.0%** - used scheduled airlines and **1.0%** - used chartered flights.

Net Promoter Score (NPS)

This is a simple metric that can be used to measure the intention to recommend/refer a travel destination and is also an indicator of overall satisfaction with the travel or customer experience.

The NPS for January 2022 was as follows: January =72

NPS ranges from -100 (meaning everyone is a detractor) to +100 (meaning everyone is a promoter). A decent Net Promoter Score is any number >0%. Any positive NPS is good. An NPS of +50 is excellent.





STOPOVER ARRIVALS BY PURPOSE OF VISIT JANUARY 2022








