TOURIST (Stopover Arrivals)

Stopover arrivals in July 2017 were a record **248,626**, an increase of **9.0%** over the **228,169** recorded in July 2016.

For the first three months of summer, May to July, arrivals increased by **8.7%**, with **641,414** stopovers compared to **591,141** in 2016.

Cumulatively, January to July 2017, stopover arrivals increased by **5.1%**, with **1,432,379** arrivals compared to **1,363,249** in 2016.

United States

Stopover arrivals from the United States market recorded a **8.6%** increase in July 2017, with a total of **178,432** arrivals compared to the **164,232** arrivals who visited in July 2016. All marketing regions recorded increased arrivals, the Northeast with **78,035** grew by **8.6%**, the South with **50,155** grew by **6.1%**, the Mid-West with **23,625** grew by **11.8%**, and the West with **26,617** grew by **11.1%**.

For the summer period, May to July 2017, the US market region recorded a **7.7%** increase in arrivals, with **457,542** visitors compared to the **424,644** visitors during the same period in 2016. The Northeast increased by **8.0%**, the South grew by **7.7%**, the Midwest increased by **6.2%** and the West increased by **8.8%**.

Year-to-date, January to July 2017, the US market region has grown by **4.1**%, with **933,014** visitors compared to the **896,215** visitors during the same period in 2016. The Northeast grew by **1.3**%, the South grew by **6.2**%, the Mid-west increased by **6.5**%, and the West up by **5.8**%

Canada

In July 2017, the Canadian market recorded an increase in arrivals of **3.0%**, with **26,773** stopovers compared to **25,995** in July 2016.

Stopover arrivals from Atlantic Canada grew by **8.9%**; the main provinces of Nova Scotia decreased by **0.8%**, over July 2016 and those from Newfoundland increased by **9.6%**.

Stopover arrivals from Central Canada increased by **2.9%**; the leading province of Ontario increased by **2.2%**, and the second most important Canadian province of Quebec grew by **6.8%**.

Stopover arrivals from Western Canada rose by **3.0%**; the main province of Alberta recorded a decrease of **1.6%**, and arrivals from British Columbia increased by **11.9%**.

For the first three months of Summer 2016, May to July, arrivals from Canada were up **8.8%** with **75,247** stopovers compared to **69,161** during the same time in 2016.

Cumulatively, the Canadian market with **247,324** visitors recorded an increase of **6.6%** or **15,316** more visitors than in 2016. The top producing provinces of Ontario with **169,359** has grown by **9.4%**, and Quebec, with **28,738** visitors grew by **6.0%**.

Europe


The European market region recorded a significant increase of **20.7%** in July 2017, with **31,576** stopover arrivals compared to the **26,169** recorded in July 2016.

In the Northern European region, the main visitor producing countries, United Kingdom, with **21,444** arrivals, grew by **6.7%** and Ireland with **265** arrivals fell by **66.1%**.

In the South-Western European region, Germany with **2,408** visitor arrivals increased by **124.0%**, Spain with **1,978** increased by an outstanding **544.3%**, Italy with **900** arrivals fell by **2.5%**, Belgium with **838** arrivals increased by **32.2%**, and Portugal with **804** visitors increased by **3,250.0%**.

Stopover arrivals from Central-East Europe with **398** arrivals grew by **22.8%**.

For the summer period, May to July 2017, arrivals from Europe grew by 13.7%, with 77,373 arrivals compared to 68,031 in 2016.



Year-to-date, January to July 2017, arrivals from the European market has grown by **8.0%**. Total stopover arrivals were **186,132** compared to **172,411** in 2016. Northern

East region increased by 57.2% with 5,286 arrivals. Latin America

Arrivals from Latin America increased by **35.2%** in July 2017, with a total of **3,152** stopovers compared to **2,332** in July 2016.

Europe was up 1.0%, moving from 133,993 in 2016 to 135,312 in 2017. Arrivals from the

South/West region increased by 29.9% with 45,534 arrivals, and those from the Central/

From the Central American region, stopover arrivals increased by **2.3%** with **843** arrivals. Mexico with **378** arrivals fell by **12.1%**, while Panama with **174** grew by **38.1%**.

From the South American region, stopover arrivals increased by **53.1%** with **2,309** arrivals. Chile with **596** increased by **32.4%**, Argentina with **542** arrivals grew by **116.8%**, and Brazil with **364** arrivals increased by **122.0%**.

For the summer period, May to July 2017, arrivals from Latin America grew by **37.6%**, with **8,689** arrivals compared to **6,314** in 2016.

Cumulatively, January to July 2017, stopover arrivals from Latin America increased by 20.5%, with a total of 19,229 arrivals compared to 15,958 in 2016.

Stopovers from Central America declined by **13.5%**. The main Central American countries of Mexico declined by **4.6%** and Panama increased by **25.2%**.

Stopovers from South America increased by **42.4%** with **13,814** arrivals, The top producing countries of Argentina with **3,617** arrivals grew by **80.0%**, Chile with **3,406** arrivals grew by **22.9%**, and Brazil with **2,916** increased by **117.8%**.

The Caribbean

Stopover arrivals to Jamaica from the Caribbean region decreased by **10.3%** in July 2017 with a total of **7,064** visitors, compared to **7,877** in July 2016.

The Cayman Islands and Trinidad & Tobago continued to be the major visitor producing Caribbean countries in July 2017 with **2,124** and **951** stopover arrivals, respectively.

Cumulatively, stopovers for the January - July 2017 period were down **1.6%** moving from **37,425** in 2016 to **36,840** in 2017.

Asia

The Asian market increased by **12.7%** in July 2017 with a total of **923** stopovers compared to **819** in July 2016.

China, India, and Japan, are the major visitor-producing countries with **349**, **294** and **138** stopovers arriving from each country, respectively.

For the January to July 2017 period, stopover arrivals from Asia grew by **9.7%**, with **5,966** arrivals compared to **5,439** arrivals in 2016.

Other Countries


Overall, stopover arrivals from other countries increased by **2.1%** in the January to July 2017 period. Of the Other Countries, Australia provided the most stop-over arrivals to Jamaica, with **1,550** visitors in 2017 compared to **1,628** in 2016. This represents a decrease of **4.8%**.

Market Share

The market share of stopover visitors for the period January to July 2017 was as follows: USA 65.1%; Canada 17.3%; UK 8.8%; Continental Europe 4.2%, the Caribbean 2.6%; and the others, including Latin America and Asia 2.0%.

Cruise Passengers

A total of **110,034** cruise passengers visited Jamaica in July 2017. This represented a **25.0%** increase over the **88,015** for July 2016.



For July 2017, Cruise passengers visiting the port of Falmouth grew by **2.5%**. Cruise passengers visiting the port of Ocho Rios rose by **23.7%** and those visiting the port of Montego Bay increased by **79.8%**.

For the first three months of summer, May to July 2016, cruise passengers visiting Jamaica were up by **7.4%**, with **314,199** passengers compared to **292,678** during the same period in 2016.

Year-to-date, January to July 2017 saw **1,088,718** cruise passenger arrivals visiting the three major ports, an increase of **50,823** passengers or **4.9%**.

Length of Stay

The average length of stay of **Foreign National** arrivals in July 2017 was **8.8** nights compared to **9.5** nights in July 2016. The average length of stay in hotels was **6.3** nights in July 2017, compared to **6.9** nights in July 2016.

The average length of stay of **Non-Resident Jamaican** arrivals in July 2017 was **18.0** nights compared to **17.6** in July 2016. The average length of stay in hotels in July 2017 was **8.8** nights, compared to **9.2** nights in July 2016.

During the January to July 2016 period the average length of stay of Foreign National arrivals in all types of accommodations was **8.3** nights compared to **8.5** nights in 2016. For the Non-Resident Jamaican arrivals the average length of stay was **16.3** nights compared to **16.1** nights in 2016.

Purpose of Visit

During the period January to July 2017, 91.5% or 1,231,780 of the 1,346,636 Foreign Nationals visited Jamaica for Leisure, 4.1% were on Business, 4.0% were on Other purposes of travel and 0.5% did not state their purpose of travel.

A total of **68,451** or **79.8%** of the **85,743 Non-Resident Jamaicans** were visiting for Leisure, **4.0%** were on Business, **13.4%** were on Other purposes of travel and **2.8%** failed to provide a reason for travel.

Year-to-date January to July 2017, **90.8%** or a total of **1,300,231** of the total stopover arrivals of **1,432,379** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **4.1%** were on Business, **4.6%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.6%** did not state their purpose of travel.

Intended Resort Area of Stay

Of the **248,626** stopover arrivals visiting Jamaica in July 2017, the resort area of Montego Bay welcomed **81,833** arrivals or **32.9%**; Ocho Rios received **59,106** or **23.8%**, Negril welcomed **45,068** or **18.1%**; and **24,955** or **10.0%** visited Kingston. The remaining **15.1%** stayed in the Mandeville/South Coast, Port Antonio resort regions and Other areas in Jamaica.

Between January and July 2017, the pattern remained the same. Montego Bay, Negril, and Ocho Rios accounted for 1,119,576 or 78.2% of the stopover arrivals.

Type of Airlines used

Of the **1,432,379** stopover visitors to Jamaica in the period January to July 2017, **1,326,134** or **92.6%** used scheduled airlines, while **106,245** or **7.4%** used chartered flights.

During the corresponding period in 2016 the percentage distribution was: **93.3%** - used scheduled airlines and **6.7%** - used chartered flights.





STOPOVER ARRIVALS BY PURPOSE OF VISIT JANUARY - JULY 2017



STOPOVER VISITORS BY MARKET SHARE










