## TOURIST (Stopover Arrivals)

Stopover arrivals in July 2019 were **270,462** an increase of **5.2%** or **13,412** additional arrivals over the **257,050** recorded in July 2018.

For the first three months of summer, May to July, arrivals increased by **5.2%**, with **720,014** stopovers compared to **681,802** in 2018.

For the January to July period, arrivals increased by **9.9%**, with **1,661,145** stopovers, which is **149,607** more arrivals than the **1,511,538** that came in 2018.

## United States

Stopover arrivals from the United States market recorded a notable increase of **8.1%** for July 2019, with a total of **201,721** arrivals compared to the **186,582** arrivals who visited in July 2018. All the US marketing regions recorded increases in arrivals, with the exception of the Midwest. The Northeast with **91,009** grew by **13.6%**, the South with **58,513** grew by **9.6%**, and the West with **29,155** grew by **2.1%**. The Midwest with **23,043** declined by **6.1%**.

For the summer period to date, May to July 2019, the US market region recorded a **8.7%** increase in arrivals, with **536,947** visitors compared to the **493,878** visitors during the same period in 2018. The Northeast increased by **13.2%**, the South grew by **11.0%** the Midwest was down **2.6%** and the West grew by **3.9%**.

For the January to July period, the US market region has grown by **14.2%**, with **1,147,482** visitors, which is **143,002** more visitors compared to the **1,004,480** visitors that visited during the same period in 2018 and **214,468** or **23.0%** more than the **933,014** in 2017. The Northeast has grown by **18.6%**, the South by **14.6%**, the Midwest by **8.8%**, and the West by **8.2%**.

## Canada


In July 2019, the Canadian market recorded a decrease in arrivals of **4.2%**, with **25,124** stopovers compared to **26,225** in July 2018.

Stopover arrivals from Atlantic Canada fell by **9.6%**; the main provinces of Nova Scotia fell by **7.3%**, over July 2018 and those from Newfoundland fell by **29.4%**.

Stopover arrivals from Central Canada decreased by **3.0%**; the leading province of Ontario increased by **0.8%**, and the second most important Canadian province of Quebec decreased by **20.0%**.

Stopover arrivals from Western Canada fell by **15.8%**; the main province of Alberta recorded a decrease of **31.1%**, and the arrivals from British Columbia decreased by **3.7%**.

For the first three months of summer, May to July, arrivals from Canada are down **6.6%** with **71,703** stopovers compared to **76,787** during the same time in 2018



Cumulatively, the Canadian market with **249,549** visitors recorded an increase of **0.3%** or **710** more visitors than in 2018. The top producing provinces of Ontario with **172,589** grew by **2.0%**, and those from Quebec, with **32,324** visitors fell by **4.6%**.

## Europe

The European market region recorded a decrease of **5.3%** in July 2019, with **29,855** stopover arrivals compared to the **31,511** recorded in July 2018.

In the Northern European region, the main visitor producing countries, United Kingdom, with **23,312** arrivals, grew by **5.7%**, and Ireland with **297** arrivals grew by **20.2%**.

In the South-Western European region, Germany with **1,379** visitor arrivals decreased by **47.9%**, Italy with **812** fell by **2.2%** Portugal with **674** fell by **14.2%**, and the Netherlands with **643** arrivals decreased by **7.5%**.

Stopover arrivals from Central-East Europe with **332** arrivals fell by **23.1%**.

For the summer period, May to July 2019, arrivals from Europe fell by **4.3%**, with **76,149** arrivals compared to **79,557** in 2018.

For the January to July 2019 period, arrivals from the European market region grew by **0.4%**. Total stopover arrivals were **190,975** compared to **190,158** in 2018. Northern Europe rose by **4.8%**, moving from **130,798** in 2018 to **137,047** in 2019.

Arrivals from the South/West region fell by **12.1%**, with **45,905** arrivals, and those from Central/East region increased by **12.3%** with **8,023** arrivals.

## Latin America

Arrivals from Latin America increased by **5.7%** in July 2019, with a total of **3,528** stopovers compared to **3,339** in July 2018.

From the Central American region, stopover arrivals grew by **5.0%** with **881** arrivals. Mexico with **401** arrivals grew by **9.0%**, and Panama with **196** grew by **10.1%**.

From the South American region, stopover arrivals grew by **5.9%** with **2,647** arrivals. Peru with **590** arrivals increased by **98.3%**, Argentina with **541** fell by **4.9%**, and Chile with **524** arrivals fell by **27.4%**.

For the summer period, May to July 2019, arrivals from Latin America increased by **18.9%**, with a total of **10,754** arrivals compared to **9,043** in 2018.

Cumulatively, January to July 2019, stopover arrivals from Latin America increased by **11.1%**, with a total of **23,157** arrivals compared to **20,835** in 2018.

Stopovers from Central America with **6,021** arrivals grew by **14.3%**. The main producing countries of Mexico and Panama increased by **13.1%** and **11.8%** respectively.

Stopovers from South America grew by **10.1%** with **17,136** arrivals. The top producing countries of Argentina with **3,827** fell by **12.2%**, Brazil with **3,604** arrivals fell by **1.3%** and Chile with **3,504** grew by **3.9%**.

## The Caribbean

Stopover arrivals to Jamaica from the Caribbean region grew by **11.0%** in July 2019 with a total of **8,579** visitors, compared to **7,728** in July 2018.

The Cayman Islands and Trinidad & Tobago continued to be the major visitor producing Caribbean countries in July 2019 with **2,278** and **1,270** stopover arrivals, respectively.

Year to date, stopovers for the January to July period increased by **6.0%** moving up from **38,556** in 2018 to **40,865** in 2019.

## Asia

The Asian market grew by **10.7%** in July 2019 with a total of **879** stopovers compared to **794** in July 2018.

China, India, and Japan are the major visitor-producing countries with **396**, **181** and **147** stopovers arriving from each country, respectively.

For the January to July 2019 period, stopover arrivals from Asia grew by **10.9%** with **5,254** arrivals compared to **4,739** in 2018.

## Other Countries


Overall, stopover arrivals from other countries fell by **1.7%** with **3,863** arrivals, for the January to July 2019 period. Of the Other Countries, Australia provided the most stop-over arrivals to Jamaica, with **1,319** visitors compared to **1,378** in 2018. This represents a decrease of **4.3%**.

## Market Share

The market share of stopover visitors for January to July 2019 was as follows: USA **69.1%**; Canada **15.0%**; UK **7.9%**; Continental Europe **3.6%**, the Caribbean **2.5%**; and the others, including Latin America and Asia **1.9%**.

## Cruise Passengers

A total of **77,560** cruise passengers visited Jamaica in July 2019. This represented a **25.5%** decrease over the **104,127** who visited in July 2018.



For July 2019, Cruise passengers visiting the port of Ocho Rios fell by **16.0%** with **34,853** passengers, those visiting the port of Falmouth fell by **6.4%** with **30,442** passengers and the Montego Bay port recorded a decline of **59.3%** with **12,265** passengers.

For the three months of summer, May to July 2019, cruise passengers visiting Jamaica declined by **32.2%**, with **217,792** passengers. Which was **103,439** less passenger than the **321,231** that visited during the same period in 2018.

Year-to-date, January to July 2019 saw **979,648** cruise passenger arrivals visiting our shores, a decline of **13.6%** or **154,360** less cruise passengers.

## Length of Stay

The average length of stay of **Foreign National** arrivals in July 2019 was **8.6** nights, compared to **8.7** nights in July 2018. The average length of stay in hotels was **6.0** nights in July 2019, compared to **6.2** nights in July 2018.

The average length of stay of **Non-Resident Jamaican** arrivals in July 2019 was **17.3** nights compared to **18.3** in July 2018. The average length of stay in hotels in July 2019 was **15.9** nights, compared to **16.7** nights in July 2018.

During the January to July 2019 period, the average length of stay for Foreign

National arrivals in all types of accommodations was **7.7** nights compared to **7.9** nights in 2018. For the Non-Resident Jamaican arrivals the average length of stay was **15.9** nights compared to **16.7** nights.

## Purpose of Visit

During the month of July 2019, **92.8%** or **230,023** of the **247,810** **Foreign Nationals** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **2.6%** were on Business, **470** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.6%** did not state their purpose of travel.

A total of **19,189** or **84.7%** of the **22,652** **Non-Resident Jamaicans** were visiting for Leisure, **2.3%** were on Business, **10.4%** were on Other purposes of travel and **2.6%** failed to provide a reason for travel.

Year-to-date January to July 2019, **91.0%** or a total of **1,511,446** of the total stopover arrivals of **1,661,145** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **3.6%** were on Business, **4.7%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.7%** did not state their travel purpose.

## Intended Resort Area of Stay

Of the **270,462** stopover arrivals visiting Jamaica in July 2019, the resort area of Montego Bay welcomed **95,611** arrivals or **35.4%**; Ocho Rios received **55,870** or **20.7%**, Negril welcomed **48,161** or **17.8%**; and **28,213** or **10.4%** visited Kingston. The remaining **15.8%** stayed in the Mandeville/South Coast, Port Antonio resort regions and Other areas in Jamaica.

Between January to July 2019, the combination of Montego Bay, Negril, and Ocho Rios accounted for **1,290,764** or **77.7%** of the total stopover arrivals.

## Type of Airlines used

Of the **1,661,145** stopover visitors to Jamaica in the January to July 2019, **1,535,752** or **92.5%** used scheduled airlines, while **125,393** or **7.5%** used chartered flights.

During the corresponding period in 2018 the percentage distribution was: **92.7%** - used scheduled airlines and **7.3%** - used chartered flights.






## STOPOVER VISITORS BY MARKET SHARE










