## TOURIST (Stopover Arrivals)

Jamaica's borders were closed for the months of April and May 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic and re-opened on June 15th 2020.

Stopover arrivals in July 2020 were **41,941** a decrease of **84.5%** or **228,521** less arrivals below the **270,462** recorded in July 2019.

For the January to July period, arrivals decreased by **62.5%**, with **623,260** stopovers compared to **1,661,145** in 2019.

## United States

Limited air service was provided from the US gateways of BWI Maryland, BOS Massachusetts, JFK New York, FLL, MIA and MCO Florida, ATL Georgia, EWR New Jersey, CLT North Carolina and DFW and IAH Texas.

Stopover arrivals from the United States market recorded a decrease of **81.5%** in July 2020, with a total of **37,348** arrivals compared to the **201,721** arrivals who visited in July 2019. All the US marketing regions recorded decreases in arrivals, the Northeast with **17,993** declined by **80.2%**, the Mid-West with **4,082** declined by **82.3%**, the South with **11,573** declined by **80.2%**, and the West with **3,700** declined by **87.3%**.

For the January to July period, the US market region has declined by **63.3%**, with **420,882** in 2020. The Northeast has fallen by **61.8%**, the Midwest fell by **54.4%**, the South fell by **68.9%**, and the West fell by **71.1%**.

## Canada

Air service was only provided from the gateway of YYZ Toronto.


In July 2020, the Canadian market recorded a decrease in arrivals of **89.6%**, with **2,607** stopovers compared to **25,124** in July 2019.

Stopover arrivals from Atlantic Canada fell by **79.1%**; the main provinces of Nova Scotia declined by **81.7%**, over July 2019 and those from Newfoundland declined by **86.1%**.

Stopover arrivals from Central Canada decreased by **89.7%**; the leading province of Ontario declined by **88.4%**, while the second most important Canadian province of Quebec declined by **97.3%**.

Stopover arrivals from Western Canada fell by **89.8%**; the main province of Alberta recorded a decline of **88.9%**, while the arrivals from British Columbia declined by **89.9%**.

Cumulatively, the Canadian market with **112,447** visitors recorded a decrease of **54.9%** or **137,102** less visitors than in 2019. The top producing provinces of Ontario with **78,166** dropped by **55.6%**, and those from Quebec, with **15,996** visitors fell by **48.1%**.

## Europe

Air service out of Europe was only provided from the gateway of LGW London during the month of July 2020.

The European market region recorded a decrease of **95.1%** in July 2020, with **1,471** stopover arrivals compared to the **29,855** recorded in July 2019.

In the Northern European region, the main visitor producing country, United Kingdom, with **1,268** arrivals, fell by **94.6%**.

In the South-Western European region, Germany with **38** visitor arrivals declined by **97.2%**, Spain with **31** fell by **93.2%**, and Italy with **19** arrivals fell by **97.7%**.

Stopover arrivals from Central-East Europe with **36** arrivals fell by **89.2%**.

For the January to July 2019 period, arrivals from the European market region fell by **67.0%**. Total stopover arrivals were **63,097** compared to **190,975** in 2019. Northern Europe fell by **67.4%**, moving from **137,047** in 2019 down to **44,698** in 2020. Arrivals from the South/West region fell by **65.3%**, with **15,949** arrivals, and those from Central/East region decreased by **69.5%** with **2,450** arrivals.

## Latin America

There was no direct air service from Latin American to Jamaica during July 2020.

Arrivals from Latin America decreased by **99.0%** in July 2020, with a total of **35** stopovers compared to **3,528** in July 2019.

Cumulatively, January to July 2020, stopover arrivals from Latin America decreased by **45.2%**, with a total of **12,683** arrivals compared to **23,157** in 2019.

Stopover arrivals from Central America with **2,035** arrivals fell by **66.2%**. The main producing countries of Mexico and Panama decreased by **65.4%** and **61.3%** respectively.

Stopovers arrivals from South America fell by **37.9%** with **10,648** arrivals. The top producing countries of Argentina with **3,702** fell by **3.3%**, Chile with **2,389** fell by **31.8%**, and Peru with **1,801** arrivals fell by **7.4%**.

## The Caribbean

Stopover arrivals to Jamaica from the Caribbean region were down **95.2%** in July 2020 with a total of **411** visitors, compared to **8,579** in July 2019.

The Cayman Is. and The Turks & Caicos Is. were the major visitor producing Caribbean countries in July 2020 with **123** and **46** stopover arrivals, respectively.

Year to date, stopovers for the January to July period fell by **71.3%** moving from **40,865** in 2019 to **11,709** in 2020.

### Asia

The Asian market fell by **97.0%** in July 2020 with a total of **26** stopovers compared to **879** in July 2019.

Philippines, India, and Japan are the major visitor-producing countries with **12**, **3** and **2** stopovers arriving from each country, respectively.

For the January to July 2020 period, stopover arrivals from Asia fell by **76.3%** with **1,243** arrivals compared to **5,254** in 2019.

## Other Countries


Overall, stopover arrivals from other countries fell by **69.0%** with **1,199** arrivals, for the January to July 2020 period. Of the Other Countries, Australia provided the most stop-over arrivals to Jamaica, with **459** visitors compared to **1,319** in 2019. This represents a decrease of **65.2%**.

## Market

The market share of stopover visitors for the period January to July 2020 was as follows: USA **67.5%**; Canada **18.0%**; UK **6.7%**; Continental Europe **3.4%**, the Caribbean **1.9%**; and the others, including Latin America and Asia **2.4%**.

## Cruise Passengers

The cruise ship piers were all closed in April and remain closed.



Year-to-date, January to July 2020 saw **449,271** cruise passenger arrivals visiting our shores, a decline of **54.2%** or 449,271 less cruise passengers.

## Length of Stay

The average length of stay of **Foreign National** arrivals in July 2020 was **13.1** nights, compared to **8.6** nights in July 2019. The average length of stay in hotels was **6.4** nights in July 2020, compared to **6.0** nights in July 2019.

The average length of stay of **Non-Resident Jamaican** arrivals in July 2020 was **26.0** nights compared to **17.3** in July 2019. The average length of stay in hotels in July 2020 was **9.9** nights, compared to **8.7** nights in July 2019.

During the January to July 2019 period, the average length of stay for Foreign National arrivals in all types of accommodations was **8.2** nights compared to **7.7** nights in 2019. For the Non-Resident Jamaican arrivals the average length of stay was **18.0** nights compared to **15.9** nights.

## Purpose of Visit

During the month of July 2020, **87.0%** or **30,042** of the **34,537 Foreign Nationals** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **4.4%** were on Business, **7.8%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.8%** did not state their purpose of travel.

A total of **5,420** or **73.2%** of the **7,404 Non-Resident Jamaicans** were visiting for Leisure, **8.2%** were on Business, **15.5%** were on Other purposes of travel and **3.1%** failed to provide a reason for travel.

Year-to-date January to July 2020, **89.6%** or a total of **558,503** of the total stopover arrivals of **623,260** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **3.7%** were on Business, **6.0%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.7%** did not state their travel purpose.

## Intended Resort Area of Stay

Of the **41,941** stopover arrivals visiting Jamaica in July 2020, the resort area of Montego Bay welcomed **11,238** arrivals or **26.8%**; Ocho Rios received **7,480** or **17.8%**, Negril welcomed **7,293** or **17.4%**; and **5,311** or **12.7%** visited Kingston. The remaining **25.3%** stayed in the Mandeville/South Coast, Port Antonio resort regions and Other areas in Jamaica.

Between January to July 2019, the combination of Montego Bay, Negril, and Ocho Rios accounted for **485,479** or **77.9%** of the **623,260** total stopover arrivals.

## Type of Airlines used

Of the **623,260** stopover visitors to Jamaica during the period January to July 2020, **587,415** or **94.2%** used scheduled airlines, while **35,844** or **5.8%** used chartered flights.

During the corresponding period in 2019 the percentage distribution was: **92.7%** - used scheduled airlines and **7.3%** - used chartered flights.














