## Monthly Statistical Report



### IN JULY 2022

- Stopover arrivals up 41.5%
- US Market up 21.0%
- Canada up 415.7%
- Europe up 204.3%
- Cruise passengers totalled 74,856

### TOURIST (Stopover Arrivals)

Stopover arrivals in July 2022 were **259,908** an increase of **41.5%** or **76,232** more arrivals over the **183,676** recorded in July 2021.

For the January to July period, arrivals increased by **99.7%**, with **1,430,404** stopovers, this is **714,183** more stopovers compared to the **716,221** in 2021.

#### United States

Stopover arrivals from the United States market recorded an increase of **21.0%** in July 2022, with a total of **202,376** arrivals compared to the **167,289** arrivals who visited in July 2021. All US marketing regions recorded increases in arrivals, the Northeast with **86,611** up by **11.8%**, the South with **67,519** up by **41.2%**, the Mid-West with **21,980** up by **11.0%**, and the West with **26,266** up by **18.1%**.

For the January to July period, the US market region has grown by **61.4%** with **1,090,334** arrivals. The Northeast up by **52.9%**, the South up by **73.5%**, the Midwest by **73.4%** and the West region up by **50.7%**, compared to the same period in 2021.

#### Canada

In July 2022, the Canadian market recorded an increase in arrivals of **415.7%**, with **21,283** or **17,156** more stopovers compared to the **4,127** in July 2021.

Stopover arrivals from Atlantic Canada recorded **289**; the main provinces of Newfoundland recorded **68** and Nova Scotia recorded **125**.

Stopover arrivals from Central Canada recorded **19,185**; the leading province of Ontario recorded **16,651**, the second most important Canadian province of Quebec recorded **2,534**.

Stopover arrivals from Western Canada recorded **1,809**; the main province of Alberta recorded **950**, while the arrivals from British Columbia recorded **525**.

Cumulatively, the Canadian market has recorded **137,207** visitors or **126,808** more visitors than in 2021. The top producing provinces of

Ontario has recorded **104,248**, and those from Quebec, were **14,200** visitors, compared to the same period in 2021.

#### Europe

The European market region has recorded an increase of **204.3%** in July 2022, with **25,917** stopover arrivals compared to the **8,845** recorded in July 2021.

In the Northern European region, the main visitor producing countries, United Kingdom, with **22,382** arrivals, and Ireland recorded **315** arrivals.

In the South-Western European region, Germany recorded **1,184** visitor arrivals, The Netherlands with **966**, and France with **284**.

Stopover arrivals from Central-East Europe has recorded **281** arrivals.

Y-T-D January to July, 2022 period, arrivals from the regions in Europe were **159,306** stopovers, this is **141,667** more stopovers compared to the **17,639** recorded during the same period in 2021.

#### Latin America

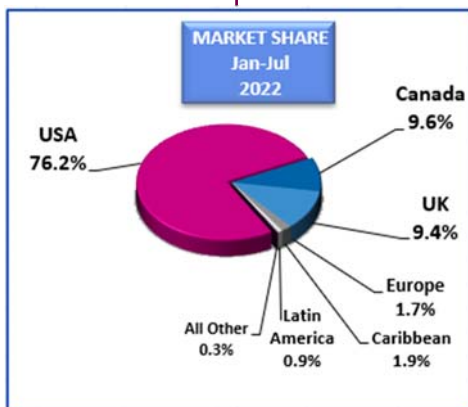
Arrivals from Latin America recorded **1,881** in July 2022, compared to **571** in July 2021.

From the Central American region, stopover arrivals were **660** arrivals. Mexico with **305** arrivals and Panama with **157**.

From the South American region, stopover arrivals were **1,221** arrivals. Argentina with **362** arrivals, Chile with **219**, and Colombia with **201** arrivals.

Cumulatively, for the January to July 2022 period, stopover arrivals from Latin America totalled **12,757** which was **3,163** more visitors compared to the **3,163** during the same period in 2021.

Stopovers from the Central American region was **4,061** arrivals up by **145.7%** and from the South American region was up by **475.9%** with **8,696** arrivals, compared to the same period in 2021.



## The Caribbean

Stopover arrivals to Jamaica from the Caribbean region were up **161.1%** in July 2022 with a total of **6,573** visitors, compared to **2,517** in July 2021.

The Cayman Is. and Trinidad & Tobago were the major visitor producing Caribbean countries in July 2022 with **2,064** and **944** stopover arrivals, respectively.

Year to date, stopovers for the January to July period rose by **225.9%** moving up from **8,184** in 2021 to **26,674** in 2022.

## Asia

The Asian market increased by **190.3%** in July 2022 with a total of **360** stopovers compared to **124** in July 2021.

China, India, and Japan, are the major visitor-producing countries with **126**, **87** and **65** stopovers arriving from each country, respectively.

Year to date, stopovers for the January to July period rose by **150.9%** moving up from **752** in 2021 to **1,887** in 2022.

## Other Countries

Overall, stopover arrivals from other countries rose by **237.2%** with **2,239** arrivals, for the January to July 2022 period. Of the Other Countries, Africa provided the most stop-over arrivals to Jamaica, with **778** visitors compared to **238** in 2021. This represents an increase of **226.9%**.

## Market

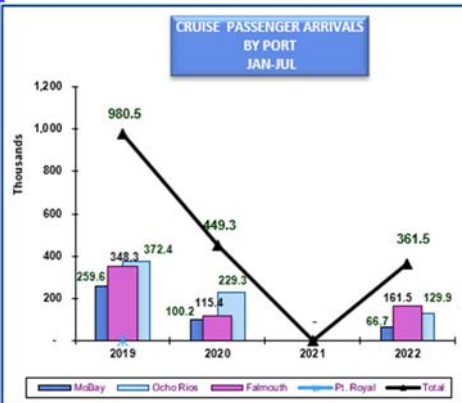
The market share of stopover visitors for the period January to July 2022 was as follows: USA **76.2%**; Canada **9.6%**; UK **9.4%**; Continental Europe **1.7%**, the Caribbean **1.9%**; and the others, including Latin America and Asia **1.2%**.

## Cruise Passengers

A total of **74,856** cruise passengers visited Jamaica in July 2022. A total of **34,495** visited the port of Falmouth, **24,584** visit-

ed the port of Ocho Rios, and **15,777** visited the port of Montego Bay,

Year-to-date, January to July 2022 saw **361,513** cruise passenger arrivals visiting our shores. All ports were closed during the same period in 2021.



## Length of Stay

The average length of stay of **Foreign National** arrivals in July 2022 was **8.7** nights, compared to **8.8** nights in July 2021. The average length of stay in hotels was **6.1** nights in July 2022, compared to **5.9** nights in July 2021.

The average length of stay of **Non-Resident Jamaican** arrivals in July 2022 was **17.4** nights compared to **23.4** in July 2021. The average length of stay in hotels in July 2022 was **9.0** nights, compared to **10.1** nights in July 2021.

During the January to July 2022 period, the average length of stay for Foreign National arrivals in all types of accommodations was **8.0** nights compared to **8.8** nights in 2021. For the Non-Resident Jamaican arrivals the average length of stay was **17.4** nights compared to **24.1** nights.

## Purpose of Visit

During the month of July 2022, **94.1%** or **224,158** of the **238,295 Foreign Nationals** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **1.6%** were on Business, **3.7%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.6%** did not state their purpose of travel.

A total of **18,540** or **85.8%** of the **21,613 Non-Resident Jamaicans** were visiting for Leisure, **2.0%** were on Business, **9.6%** were on Other purposes of travel and **2.6%** failed to provide a reason for travel.

Year-to-date January to July 2022, **90.0%** or a total of **1,287,153** of the total stopover arrivals of **1,430,404** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **1.8%** were on Business, **7.7%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.5%** did not state their travel purpose.

## Intended Resort Area of Stay

Of the **259,908** stopover arrivals visiting Jamaica in July 2022, the resort area of Montego Bay welcomed **95,589** arrivals or **36.8%**; Ocho Rios welcomed **56,686** or **21.8%**; Negril received **41,346** or **15.9%**, and **23,144** or **8.9%** visited Kingston. The remaining **16.6%** stayed in the Mandeville/South Coast, Port Antonio resort regions and Other areas in Jamaica.

Between January and July 2022, the combination of Montego Bay, Negril, and Ocho Rios accounted for **1,118,344** or **78.2%** of the **1,430,404** total stopover arrivals.

## Type of Airlines used

Of the **1,430,404** stopover visitors to Jamaica in the January to July 2022, **1,339,049** or **93.6%** used scheduled airlines, while **91,355** or **6.4%** used chartered flights.

During the corresponding period in 2021 the percentage distribution was: **99.4%** - used scheduled airlines and **0.6%** - used chartered flights.

## Net Promoter Score (NPS)

This is a simple metric that can be used to measure the intention to recommend/refer a travel destination and is also an indicator of overall satisfaction with the travel or customer experience.

The NPS for YTD 2022 are as follows:

January = 72 July = 61.3

February = 70

March = 64

April = 66

May = 63

June = 65

NPS ranges from -100 (meaning everyone is a detractor) to +100 (meaning everyone is a promoter). A decent Net Promoter Score is any number >0%. Any positive NPS is good. An NPS of +50 is excellent.

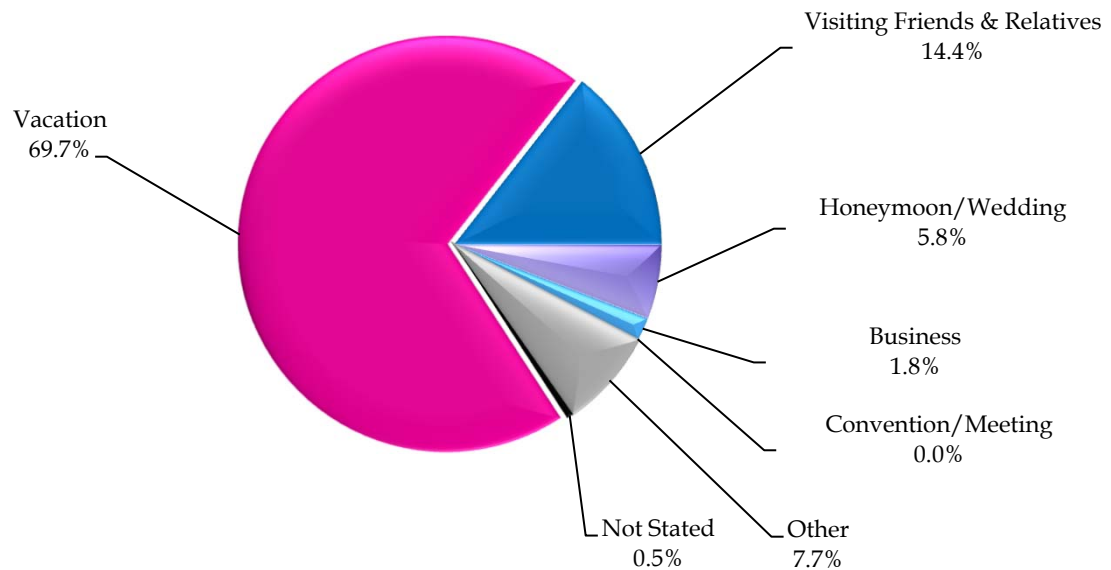

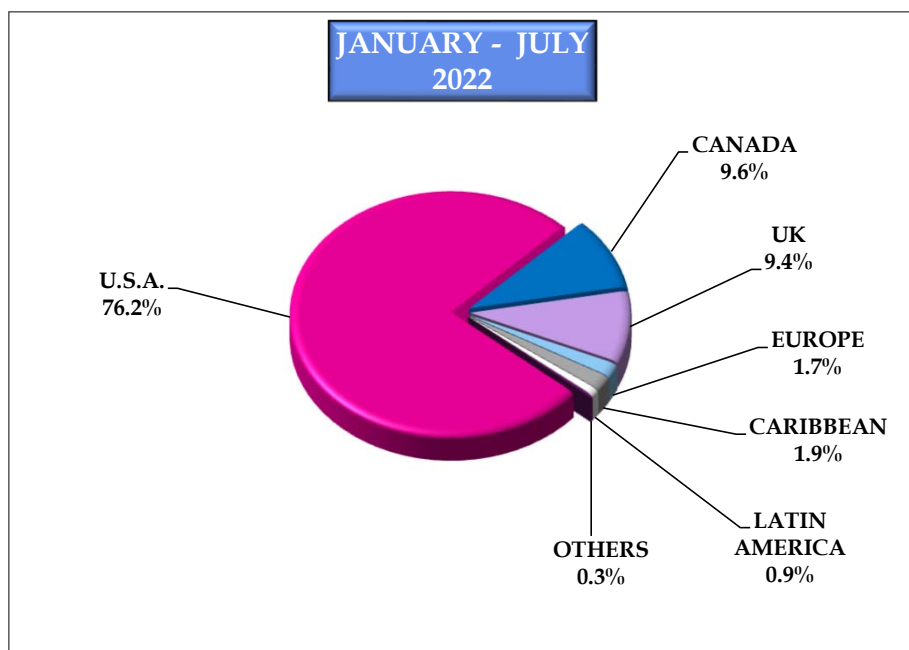


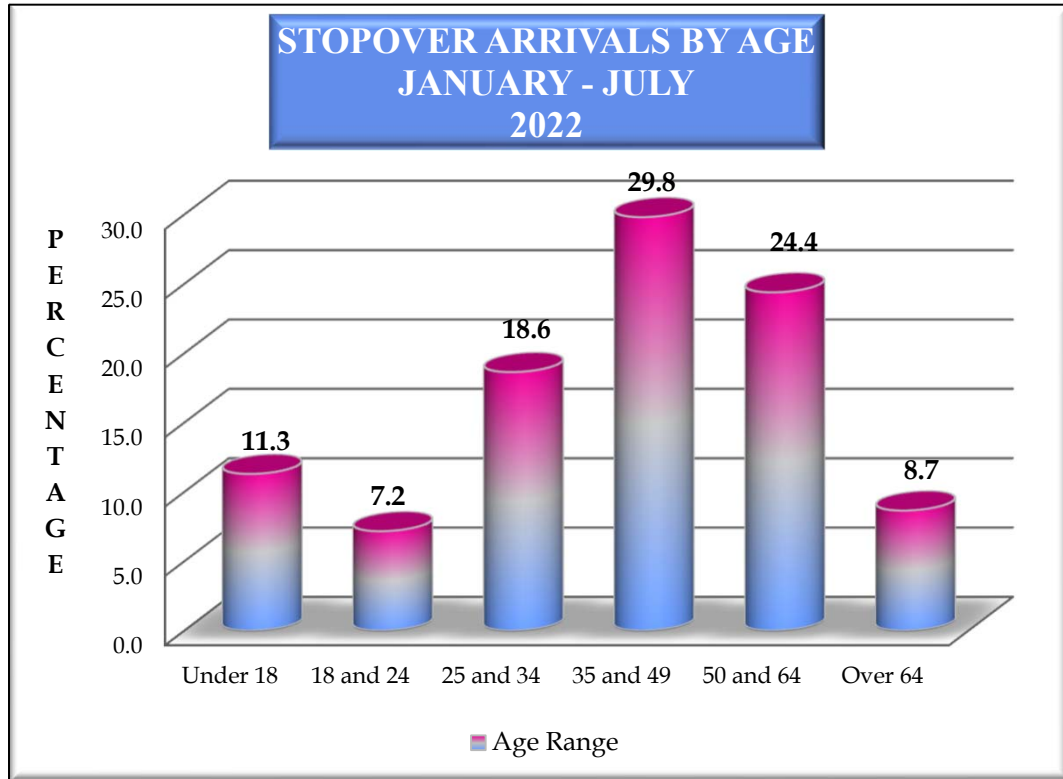

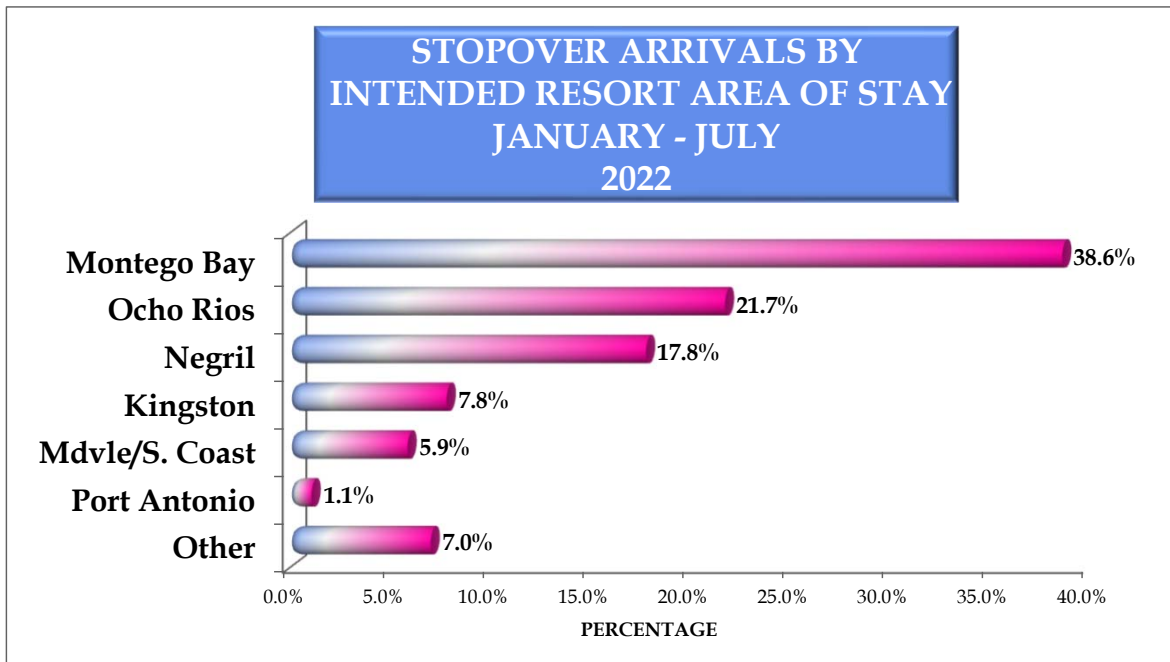
