TOURIST (Stopover Arrivals)

Stopover arrivals in June 2022 were **233,269** an increase of **40.5%** or **67,223** more arrivals over the **166,046** recorded in June 2021.

For the January to June period, arrivals increased by **119.8%**, with **1,170,496** stopovers, this is **637,951** more stopovers compared to the **532,545** in 2021.

United States

Stopover arrivals from the United States market recorded an increase of **19.2%** in June 2022, with a total of **187,730** arrivals compared to the **157,472** arrivals who visited in June 2021. All US marketing regions recorded increases in arrivals, the Northeast with **73,314** up by **9.9%**, the South with **65,808** up by **38.2%**, the Mid-West with **23,380** up by **10.4%**, and the West with **25,228** up by **15.0%**.

For the January to June period, the US market region has grown by **74.7%** with **887,958** arrivals. The Northeast up by **67.0%**, the South up by **84.1%**, the Midwest by **89.4%** and the West region up by **62.6%**, compared to the same period in 2021.

Canada

In June 2022, the Canadian market recorded an increase in arrivals of **857.5%**, with **17,014** or **15,237** more stopovers compared to the **1,777** in June 2021.

Stopover arrivals from Atlantic Canada recorded **435**; the main provinces of Newfoundland recorded **176** and Nova Scotia recorded **164**.

Stopover arrivals from Central Canada recorded **15,118**; the leading province of Ontario recorded **13,232**, the second most important Canadian province of Quebec recorded **1,886**.

Stopover arrivals from Western Canada recorded **1,461**; the main province of Alberta recorded **735**, while the arrivals from British Columbia recorded **433**.

Cumulatively, the Canadian market recorded **115,924** visitors or **109,652** more visitors than in 2021. The top producing provinces of

Ontario recorded **87,597**, and those from Quebec, were **11,666** visitors, compared to the same period in 2021.

Europe

The European market region recorded an increase of **368.0%** in June 2022, with **22,016** stopover arrivals compared to the **4,704** recorded in June 2021.

In the Northern European region, the main visitor producing countries, United Kingdom, with **18,928** arrivals, while Ireland recorded **193** arrivals.

In the South-Western European region, Germany recorded **969** visitor arrivals, The Netherlands with **486**, and France with **212**.

Stopover arrivals from Central-East Europe recorded **313** arrivals.

Y-T-D January to June, 2022 period, arrivals were **132,389** stopovers, this is **123,595** more stopovers compared to the **8,794** recorded during the same period in 2021.

Latin America

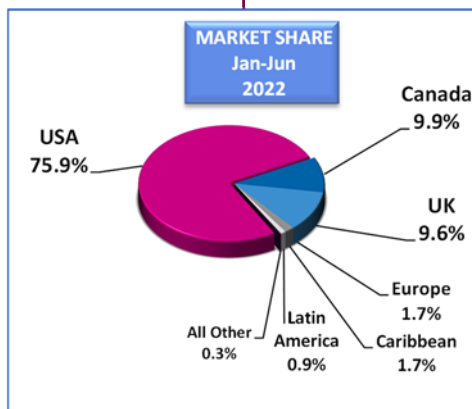
Arrivals from Latin America recorded by **1,779** in June 2022, compared to **424** in June 2021.

From the Central American region, stopover arrivals were **626** arrivals. Mexico with **315** arrivals and Panama with **149**.

From the South American region, stopover arrivals were **1,153** arrivals. Colombia also with **297**, Argentina with **269** arrivals, and Chile with **173** arrivals.

Cumulatively, for the January to June 2022 period, stopover arrivals from Latin America totalled **10,876** which was **8,284** more visitors compared to the same period in 2021.

Stopovers from Central America with **3,401** arrivals up by **181.5%** and from South America up by **440.1%** with **7,475** arrivals, compared to the same period in 2021.



The Caribbean

Stopover arrivals to Jamaica from the Caribbean region were up **192.7%** in June 2022 with a total of **4,101** visitors, compared to **1,401** in June 2021.

The Cayman Is. and Trinidad & Tobago were the major visitor producing Caribbean countries in June 2022 with **1,194** and **655** stopover arrivals, respectively.

Year to date, stopovers for the January to June period rose by **254.7%** moving up from **5,667** in 2021 to **20,101** in 2022.

Asia

The Asian market increased by **102.8%** in June 2022 with a total of **292** stopovers compared to **144** in June 2021.

India, China, and Japan, are the major visitor-producing countries with **121**, **81** and **28** stopovers arriving from each country, respectively.

Year to date, stopovers for the January to June period rose by **143.2%** moving up from **628** in 2021 to **1,527** in 2022.

Other Countries

Overall, stopover arrivals from other countries rose by **273.3%** with **1,721** arrivals, for the January to June 2022 period. Of the Other Countries, Africa provided the most stop-over arrivals to Jamaica, with **615** visitors compared to **185** in 2021. This represents an increase of **232.4%**.

Market

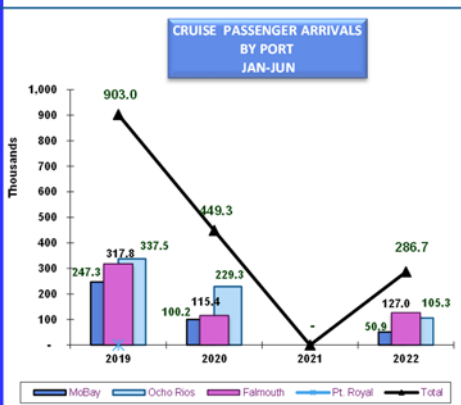
The market share of stopover visitors for the period January to June 2022 was as follows: USA **75.9%**; Canada **9.9%**; UK **9.6%**; Continental Europe **1.7%**, the Caribbean **1.7%**; and the others, including Latin America and Asia **1.2%**.

Cruise Passengers

A total of **74,748** cruise passengers visited Jamaica in June 2022. A total of **34,770** visited the port of Falmouth, **24,208** visit-

ed the port of Ocho Rios, and **15,770** visited the port of Montego Bay,

Year-to-date, January to June 2022 saw **286,657** cruise passenger arrivals visiting our shores. All ports were closed during the same period in 2021.



Length of Stay

The average length of stay of **Foreign National** arrivals in June 2022 was **8.1** nights, compared to **8.7** nights in June 2021. The average length of stay in hotels was **5.8** nights in June 2022, compared to **5.9** nights in June 2021.

The average length of stay of **Non-Resident Jamaican** arrivals in June 2022 was **18.1** nights compared to **25.6** in June 2021. The average length of stay in hotels in June 2022 was **8.6** nights, compared to **9.5** nights in June 2021.

During the January to June 2022 period, the average length of stay for Foreign National arrivals in all types of accommodations was **7.9** nights compared to **8.8** nights in 2021. For the Non-Resident Jamaican arrivals the average length of stay was **17.4** nights compared to **24.3** nights.

Purpose of Visit

During the month of June 2022, **93.5%** or **203,002** of the **217,068 Foreign Nationals** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **1.9%** were on Business, **4.1%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.5%** did not state their purpose of travel.

A total of **13,464** or **83.1%** of the **16,201 Non-Resident Jamaicans** were visiting for Leisure, **2.9%** were on Business, **11.7%** were on Other purposes of travel and **2.3%** failed to provide a reason for travel.

Year-to-date January to June 2022, **89.2%** or a total of **1,044,455** of the total stopover arrivals of **1,170,496** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **1.8%** were on Business, **8.5%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.5%** did not state their travel purpose.

Intended Resort Area of Stay

Of the **233,269** stopover arrivals visiting Jamaica in June 2022, the resort area of Montego Bay welcomed **90,295** arrivals or **38.7%**; Ocho Rios welcomed **51,096** or **21.9%**; Negril received **39,814** or **17.1%**, and **18,509** or **7.9%** visited Kingston. The remaining **14.4%** stayed in the Mandeville/South Coast, Port Antonio resort regions and Other areas in Jamaica.

Between January and June 2022, the combination of Montego Bay, Negril, and Ocho Rios accounted for **924,723** or **79.0%** of the **1,170,496** total stopover arrivals.

Type of Airlines used

Of the **1,170,496** stopover visitors to Jamaica in the January to June 2022, **1,094,174** or **93.5%** used scheduled airlines, while **76,322** or **6.5%** used chartered flights.

During the corresponding period in 2021 the percentage distribution was: **99.6%** - used scheduled airlines and **0.4%** - used chartered flights.

Net Promoter Score (NPS)

This is a simple metric that can be used to measure the intention to recommend/refer a travel destination and is also an indicator of overall satisfaction with the travel or customer experience.

The NPS for YTD 2022 are as follows:

January = 72
February = 70
March = 64
April = 66
May = 63
June = 65

NPS ranges from -100 (meaning everyone is a detractor) to +100 (meaning everyone is a promoter). A decent Net Promoter Score is any number >0%. Any positive NPS is good. An NPS of +50 is excellent.

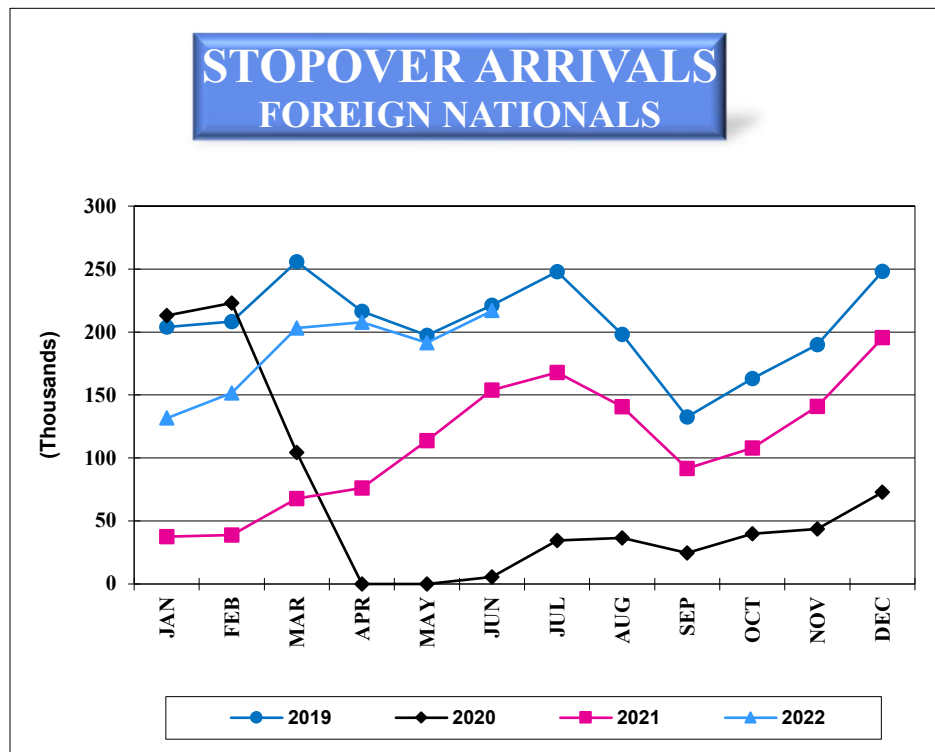

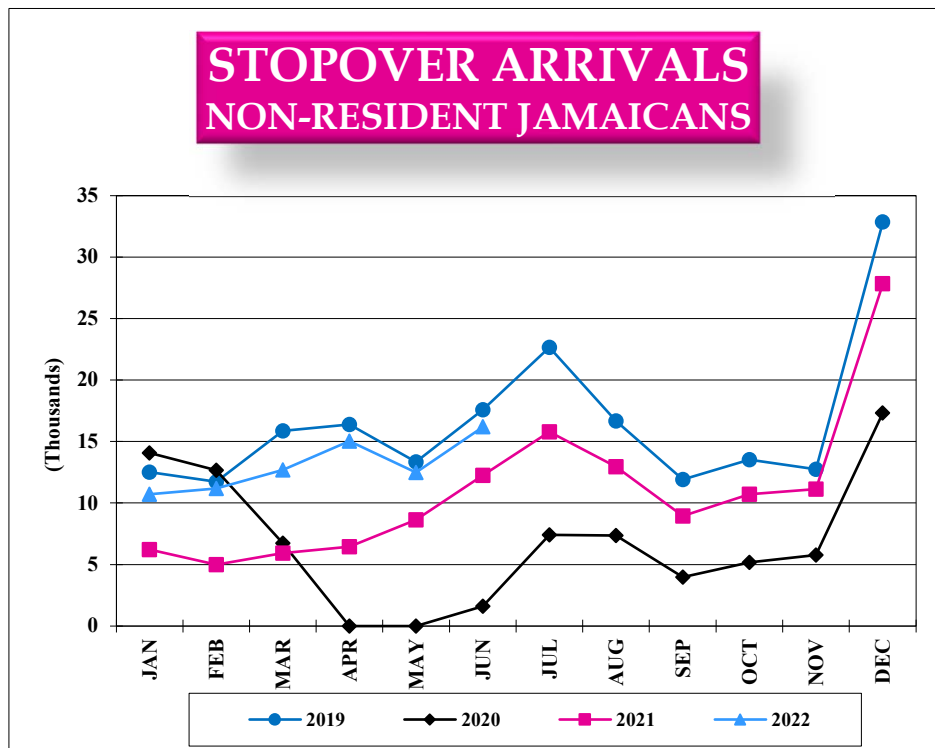

STOPOVER ARRIVALS BY PURPOSE OF VISIT JANUARY - JUNE 2022

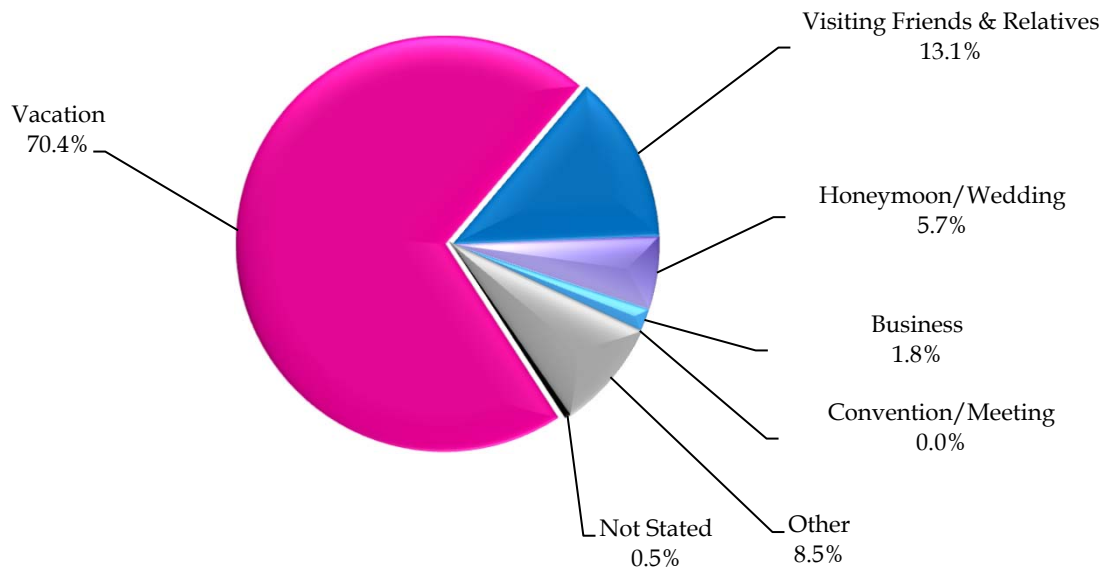

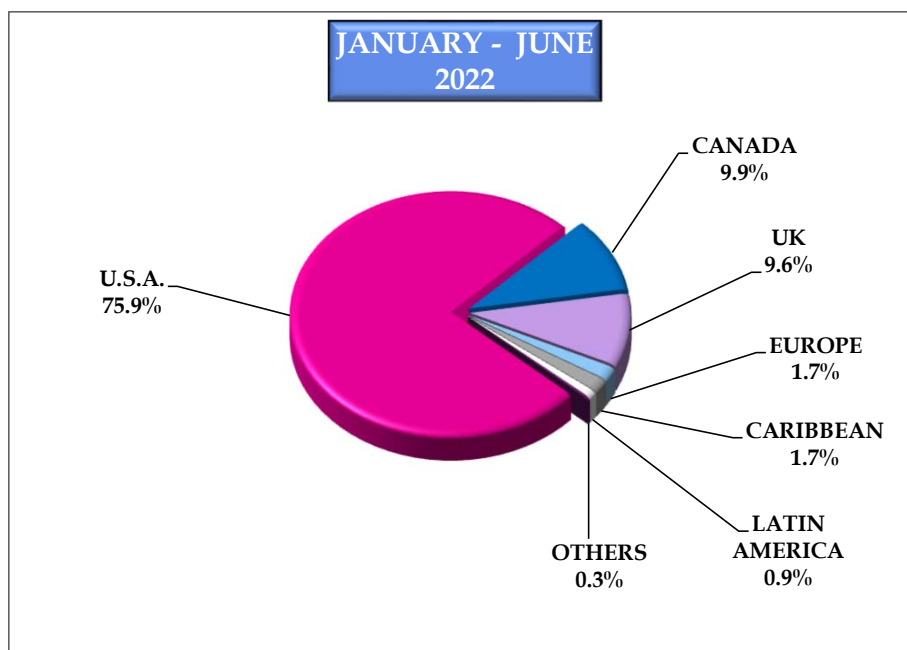

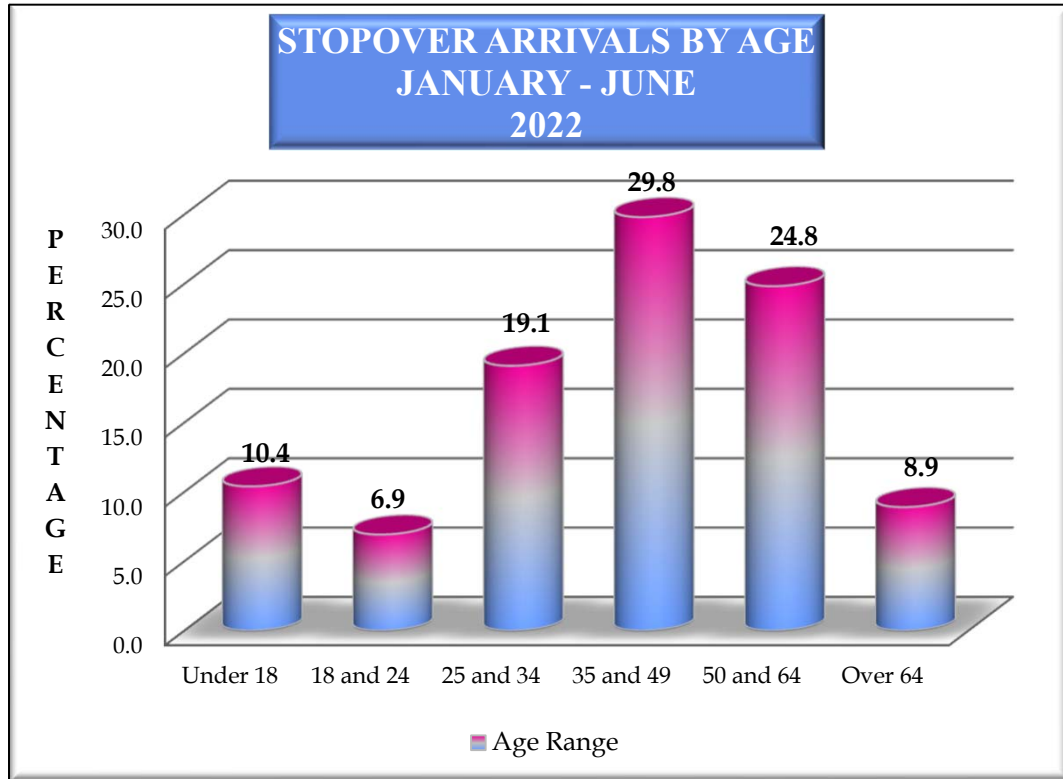

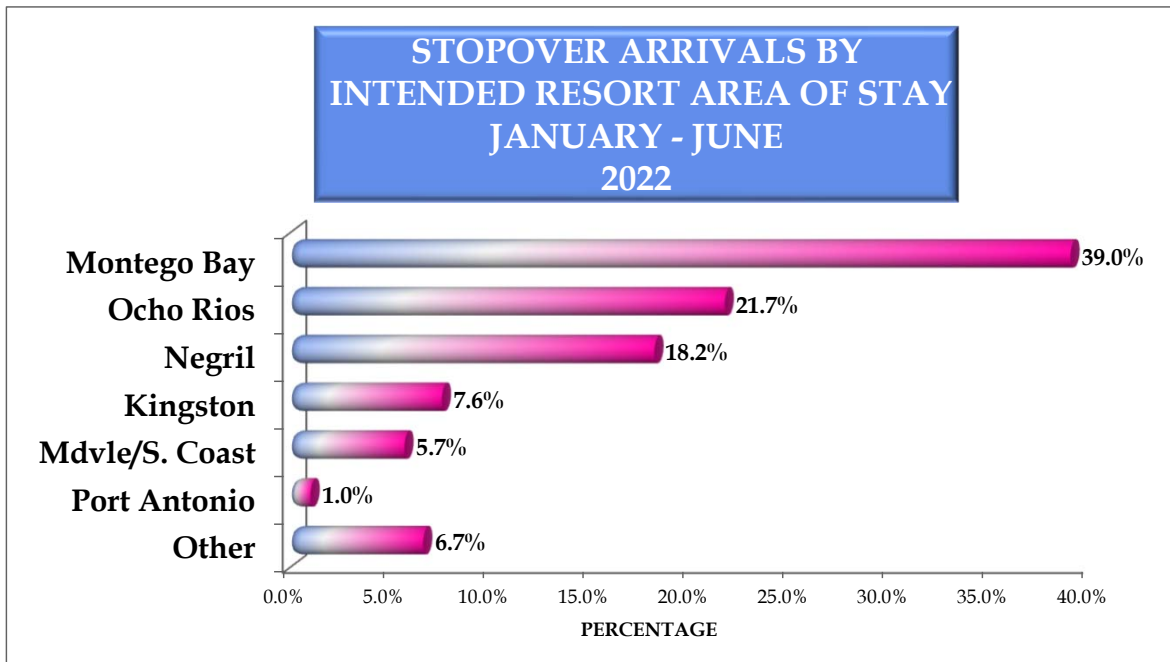
