TOURIST (Stopover Arrivals)

Stopover arrivals in June 2023 were 268,187 an increase of 15.0% or 34,918 more arrivals over the 233,269 recorded in June 2022.

For the 1st six months of 2023, January–June period, arrivals increased by 26.8%, with 1,483,717 stopovers, this is 313,221 more stopovers compared to the 1,170,496 recorded in 2022.

United States

Stopover arrivals from the United States market recorded an increase of 17.4% in June 2023, with a total of 220,410 arrivals compared to the 187,730 arrivals who visited in June 2022. All US marketing regions recorded increases in arrivals, the Northeast with 82,484 up by 12.5%, the South with 77,911 up by 18.4%, the Mid-West with 28,546 up by 22.1%, and the West with 31,469 up by 24.7%.

For the January to June period, the US market region has grown by 23.1% with 1,093,276 arrivals. The Northeast up by 19.9%, the South up by 21.3%, the Midwest up by 34.4%, and the West region up by 23.4%, compared to the same period in 2022.

Canada

In June 2023, the Canadian market recorded an increase in arrivals of 6.0%, with 18,042 or 1,028 more stopovers compared to 17,014 in June 2022.

Stopover arrivals from Atlantic Canada fell by 26.7%; the main provinces of Newfoundland decreased by 27.3%, over June 2022 and those from Nova Scotia decreased by 40.9%.

Stopover arrivals from Central Canada increased by 7.0%; the leading province of Ontario increased by 8.3%, while the second most important Canadian province of Quebec fell by 1.6%.

Stopover arrivals from Western Canada grew by 5.7%; the main province of Alberta recorded an increase of 10.3%, while the arrivals from British Columbia increased by 4.8%.

Cumulatively, the Canadian market recorded 208,951 visitors, up by 80.2% or 93,027 more visitors than in 2022. The top

producing provinces of Ontario recorded 146,922, and those from Quebec, were 26,616 visitors.

Europe

The European market region recorded a decline of 5.9% in June 2023, with 20,724 stopover arrivals compared to the 22,016 recorded in June 2022.

In the Northern European region, the main visitor producing countries, United Kingdom, with 17,751 arrivals, down by 6.2%, while Ireland with 179 arrivals down by 7.3%.

In the South-Western European region, Germany with 603 visitor arrivals decreased by 37.8%, the Netherlands with 645 rose by 32.7%, France with 274 rose by 29.2% and Italy with 249 rose by 94.5%.

Stopover arrivals from Central-East Europe with 220 arrivals decreased by 29.7%.

For the January to June period, arrivals were 130,106 stopovers, this is 2,283 less stopovers compared to the 132,389 recorded during the same period in 2022.

Latin America


Arrivals from Latin America increased by 48.7% in June 2023, with a total of 2,646 stopovers compared to 1,779 in June 2022.

From the Central American region, stopover arrivals rose by 47.3% with 922 arrivals. Mexico with 334 arrivals grew by 6.0%, and Panama with 213 rose by 43.0%.

From the South American region, stopover arrivals increased by 49.5% with 1,724 arrivals. Argentina with 517 arrivals increased by 92.2%, Colombia with 330 arrivals rose by 11.1%, and Chile with 258 arrivals up by 49.1%.

Cumulatively, for the January to June period, stopover arrivals from Latin America totalled 15,863, which was 4,987 more visitors compared to the same period in 2022. Stopovers from Central America with 5,097 arrivals grew by 49.9% and from South America with 10,766 grew by 44.0%, compared to the same period in 2022.

The Caribbean

Stopover arrivals to Jamaica from the Caribbean region were up 37.4% in June 2023 with a total of 5,447 visitors, compared to 4,101 in June 2022.

The Cayman Is. and Trinidad & Tobago were the major visitor producing Caribbean countries in June 2023 with 1,858 and 802 stopover arrivals, respectively.

Year to date January to June, stopovers from the Caribbean region rose by 52.0% moving from 20,101 in 2022 to 30,559 in 2023.

Asia

The Asian market increased by 55.8% in June 2023 with a total of 455 stopovers compared to 292 in June 2022.

China, India, and Japan, are the major visitor-producing countries with 156, 147 and 48 stopovers arriving from each country, respectively.

Year to date January to June, stopovers from Asia rose by 68.2% moving from 1,527 in 2022 to 2,569 in 2023.

Other Countries

Overall, stopover arrivals from other countries rose by 39.0% with 2,393 arrivals, for January to June 2023 period. Of the Other Countries, Australia provided the most stop-over arrivals to Jamaica, with 899 visitors compared to 341 in 2022. This represents an increase of 163.6%.


Market Share

The market share of stopover visitors for the period January to June 2023 was as follows: USA 73.7%; Canada 14.1%; UK 6.8%; Continental Europe 1.9%, the Caribbean 2.1%; and all others countries 1.4%.

Cruise Passengers

A total of 56,397 cruise passengers from 13 ship calls, visited Jamaica in June 2023. A total of 27,913 visited the port in Ocho Rios, 16,848 visited the port in Montego Bay, and 11,636 visited the port in Falmouth.

Year to date, January–June 2023 Jamaica welcomed a total of 694,671 cruise passengers from 221 ship calls. Of this total 41.3% visited the Port in Ocho Rios and 38.2% visited the Port in Falmouth.



Length of Stay

The average length of stay of Foreign National arrivals in June 2023 was 7.6 nights, compared to 8.1 nights in June 2022. The average length of stay in hotels was 5.6 nights in June 2023, compared to 5.8 nights in June 2022.

The average length of stay of Non-Resident Jamaican arrivals in June 2023 was 16.8 nights compared to 18.1 in June 2022. The average length of stay in hotels in June 2023 was 7.5 nights, compared to 8.6 nights in June 2022.

Year to Date January to June, the average length of stay for Foreign National arrivals in all types of accommodations was 7.4 nights compared to 7.9 nights in 2022. For Non-Resident Jamaicans the average length of stay was 14.7 nights compared to 17.4 nights in 2022.

Purpose of Visit

During the month of June 2023, 94.5% or 234,588 of the 248,382 Foreign Nationals visited Jamaica for Leisure, 2.2% were on Business, 3.2% were on Other purposes of travel and 0.1% did not state their purpose of travel.

A total of 17,462 or 88.2% of the 19,805 Non-Resident Jamaicans were visiting for Leisure, 3.1% were on Business, 8.1% were on Other purposes of travel and 0.6% failed to provide a reason for travel.

Year-to-date January to June 2023, 93.5% or a total of 1,387,718 of the total stopovers arrivals of 1,483,717 visited Jamaica for leisure, 2.6% were on Business, 3.8% were on Other purposes of travel and 0.2% did not state their travel purpose.

Intended Resort Area of Stay

Of the 268,187 stopover arrivals visiting Jamaica in June 2023, the resort area of Montego Bay welcomed 103,279 arrivals or 38.5%; Ocho Rios welcomed 57,504 or 21.4%; Negril received 45,829 or 17.1%, and 23,894 or 8.9% visited Kingston. The remaining 14.1% stayed in the Mandeville/South Coast, Port Antonio resort regions and Other areas in Jamaica.

Between January and June 2023, the combination of Montego Bay, Ocho Rios and Negril accounted for 1,178,024 of 79.4% of stopover arrivals.

Type of Airlines used

Of the 1,483,717 stopover visitors to Jamaica in the January to June 2023 period, 1,418,430 or 95.6% used scheduled airlines, while 65,287 or 4.4% used chartered flights.

During the corresponding period in 2022 the percentage distribution was: 93.5% - used scheduled airlines and 6.5% - used chartered flights.

Net Promoter Score (NPS)

This is a simple metric that can be used to measure the intention to recommend/refer a travel destination and is also an indicator of overall satisfaction with the travel or customer experience.

The NPS YTD 2023 was as follows:
January = 69
February = 59
March = 61
April = 62
May = 55
June = 65

NPS ranges from -100 (meaning everyone is a detractor) to +100 (meaning everyone is a promoter). A decent Net Promoter Score is any number >0%. Any positive NPS is good. An NPS of +50 is excellent.





STOPOVER ARRIVALS BY PURPOSE OF VISIT JANUARY - JUNE 2023











2023**


