TOURIST (Stopover Arrivals)

Stopover arrivals in March 2022 were **215,789** an increase of **193.0%** or **142,143** more arrivals over the **73,646** recorded in March 2021.

For the January to March period, arrivals increased by **216.5%**, with **510,401** stopovers, this is 349,126 more stopovers compared to the 161,275 in 2021.

United States

Stopover arrivals from the United States market recorded an increase of **124.9%** in March 2022, with a total of **161,441** arrivals compared to the **71,789** arrivals who visited in March 2021. All US marketing regions recorded increases in arrivals, the Northeast with **62,788** up by **96.5%**, the South with **46,629** up by **160.2%**, the Midwest with **34,416** up by **145.5%**, and the West with **17,608** up by **123.1%**.

For the January to March period, the US market region has grown by **150.4%** with **380,897** arrivals. The Northeast up by **133.6%**, the South up by **152.2%**, the Midwest by **185.4%** and the West region up by **156.3%**, compared to the same period in 2021.


Canada

In March 2022, the Canadian market recorded an increase in arrivals of **9,426.1%**, with **24,482** or **24,225** more stopovers compared to the **257** in March 2021.

Stopover arrivals from Atlantic Canada recorded **1,326**; the main provinces of Nova Scotia recorded **726**, New Brunswick recorded by **438**.

Stopover arrivals from Central Canada recorded by **20,740**; the leading province of Ontario recorded by **18,832**, the second most important Canadian province of Quebec recorded **1,908**.

Stopover arrivals from Western Canada recorded **2,416**; the main province of Alberta recorded **1,363**, while the arrivals from British Columbia recorded by **525**.



Cumulatively, the Canadian market recorded **49,359** visitors or **45,629** more visitors than in 2021. The top producing provinces of Ontario recorded **37,206**, and those from Quebec, were **4,704** visitors, compared to the same period in 2021.

Europe

The European market region recorded an increase of **10,772.2%** in March 2022, with **25,006** stopover arrivals compared to the **230** recorded in March 2021.

In the Northern European region, the main visitor producing countries, United Kingdom, with **21,759** arrivals, while Ireland recorded **130** arrivals.

In the South-Western European region, Germany recorded **1,360** visitor arrivals, France with **370**, Switzerland with **181**, and the Belgium with **166**.

Stopover arrivals from Central-East Europe recorded **417** arrivals.

Y-T-D January to March, 2022 period, arrivals were **64,936** stopovers, this is **64,166** more stopovers compared to the **770** recorded during the same period in 2021.

Latin America

Arrivals from Latin America recorded by **1,786** in March 2022, compared to **506** in March 2021.

From the Central American region, stopover arrivals were **505** arrivals. Mexico with **186** arrivals and Panama with **121**.

From the South American region, stopover arrivals were **1,281** arrivals. Argentina with **392** arrivals, Peru with **242** arrivals, and Colombia with **189**.

Cumulatively, for the January to March 2022 period, stopover arrivals from Latin America totalled **5,266** which was **3,667** more visitors compared to the same period in 2021.

Stopovers from Central America with **1,678** arrivals up by **233.6%** and from South America up by **227.4%** with **3,588** arrivals, compared to the same period in 2021.

The Caribbean

Stopover arrivals to Jamaica from the Caribbean region were up **273.3%** in March 2022 with a total of **2,583** visitors, compared to **692** in March 2021.

The Cayman Is. and Cuba were the major visitor producing Caribbean countries in March 2022 with **657** and **386** stopover arrivals, respectively.

Year to date, stopovers for the January to March period rose by **233.2%** moving up from **2,595** in 2021 to **8,646** in 2022.

Asia

The Asian market increased by **105.3%** in March 2022 with a total of **234** stopovers compared to **114** in March 2021.

India, China, and Philippines, are the major visitor-producing countries with **92**, **49** and **30** stopovers arriving from each country, respectively.

Year to date, stopovers for the January to March period rose by **119.9%** moving up from **321** in 2021 to **706** in 2022.

Other Countries

Overall, stopover arrivals from other countries rose by **274.1%** with **591** arrivals, for the January to March 2022 period. Of the Other Countries, Africa provided the most stop-over arrivals to Jamaica, with **207** visitors compared to **75** in 2021. This represents an increase of **176.0%**.

Market

The market share of stopover visitors for the period January to March 2022 was as follows: USA **74.6%**; Canada **9.7%**; UK **10.8%**; Continental Europe **1.9%**, the Caribbean **1.7%**; and the others, including Latin America and Asia **1.3%**.

Cruise Passengers

A total of 49,353 cruise passengers visited Jamaica in March 2022. A total of 20,372 visited the port of Falmouth, 18,202 visit-

ed the port of Ocho Rios, and 8,263 visited the port of Montego Bay.

Year-to-date, January to March 2022 saw 99,798 cruise passenger arrivals visiting our shores. All ports were closed during the same period in 2021.



Length of Stay

The average length of stay of **Foreign National** arrivals in March 2022 was **7.3** nights, compared to **8.3** nights in March 2021. The average length of stay in hotels was **5.9** nights in March 2022, compared to **6.0** nights in March 2021.

The average length of stay of **Non-Resident Jamaican** arrivals in March 2022 was **15.0** nights compared to **20.8** in March 2021. The average length of stay in hotels in March 2022 was **7.7** nights, the same level as in March 2021.

During the January to March 2022 period, the average length of stay for Foreign National arrivals in all types of accommodations was **8.2** nights compared to **10.1** nights in 2021. For the Non-Resident Jamaican arrivals the average length of stay was **19.2** nights compared to **24.2** nights.

Purpose of Visit

During the month of March 2022, **92.8%** or **188,606** of the **203,102 Foreign Nationals** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **1.8%** were on Business, **5.0%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.4%** did not state their purpose of travel.

A total of **9,758** or **76.9%** of the **12,687 Non-Resident Jamaicans** were visiting for Leisure, **3.8%** were on Business, **17.4%** were on Other purposes of travel and **1.9%** failed to provide a reason for travel.

Year-to-date January to March 2022, **85.1%** or a total of **434,466** of the total stopover arrivals of **510,401** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **1.6%** were on Business, **12.9%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.4%** did not state their travel purpose.

Intended Resort Area of Stay

Of the **215,789** stopover arrivals visiting Jamaica in March 2022, the resort area of Montego Bay welcomed **87,771** arrivals or **40.7%**; Ocho Rios welcomed **47,691** or **22.1%**; Negril received **39,294** or **18.2%**, and **14,578** or **6.8%** visited Kingston. The remaining **12.3%** stayed in the Mandeville/South Coast, Port Antonio resort regions and Other areas in Jamaica.

Between January and March 2022, the combination of Montego Bay, Negril, and Ocho Rios accounted for **404,081** or **79.2%** of the **510,401** total stopover arrivals.

Type of Airlines used

Of the **510,401** stopover visitors to Jamaica in the January to March 2022, **472,637** or **92.6%** used scheduled airlines, while **37,764** or **7.4%** used chartered flights.

During the corresponding period in 2021 the percentage distribution was: **98.9%** - used scheduled airlines and **1.1%** - used chartered flights.

Net Promoter Score (NPS)

This is a simple metric that can be used to measure the intention to recommend/refer a travel destination and is also an indicator of overall satisfaction with the travel or customer experience.

The NPS for YTD 2022 are as follows:
January =72
February = 70
March= 64

NPS ranges from -100 (meaning everyone is a detractor) to +100 (meaning everyone is a promoter). A decent Net Promoter Score is any number >0%. Any positive NPS is good. An NPS of +50 is excellent.





2022**



STOPOVER VISITORS BY MARKET SHARE






