TOURIST (Stopover Arrivals)

Stopover arrivals in November 2016 were **163,152**, an increase of **3.0%** in arrivals when compared to the **158,450** recorded in November 2015.

For the seven months of Summer 2016, May to November, arrivals were up **3.0%**, with **1,178,123** stopovers compared to **1,147,483** in 2015.

Year to date, January to November 2016, arrivals increased by **2.7%**, with **1,951,231** stopovers compared to **1,903,946** in 2015.

United States

Stopover arrivals from the United States market recorded a **1.7%** increase in November 2016 with a total of **96,659** arrivals compared to the **95,051** arrivals who visited in November 2015. The US marketing regions recorded mixed results in arrivals. The Northeast region declined by **4.1%** with **41,154** arrivals and the West with **12,252** declined by **1.2%**. The South with **25,541** rose by **10.9%** and the Mid-west with **17,712** increased by **6.1%**.

For the seven months of Summer 2016, May to November, the US market region recorded a **3.5%** increase in arrivals, with **791,227** visitors compared to the **764,657** visitors during the same period in 2015. The Northeast was down **1.5%**, the South was up **5.8%**, the Midwest was up **6.4%** and the West up **12.1%**.

Year-to-date, January to November 2016, the US market region has grown by **4.4%**, with **1,262,798** visitors compared to the **1,209,762** visitors during the same period in 2015. This was **53,036** more arrivals than in 2015, as well as, **93,155** more than in 2014. The Northeast was up by **0.9%**, the Mid-west up by **4.9%**, the South up by **5.8%**, and the West was up **14.0%**.

Canada

In November 2016, the Canadian market recorded an increase in arrivals of **2.2%**, with **32,046** stopovers compared to **31,370** in November 2015.

Stopover arrivals from Atlantic Canada grew by **4.5%**, the main provinces of Nova Scotia rose by **6.7%** and those from Newfoundland rose by **0.5%**, over November 2015.

Stopover arrivals from Central Canada grew by **1.7%**, the leading province of Ontario grew by **1.6%**, and the second most important Canadian province of Quebec recorded an increase of **2.0%**.

Stopover arrivals from Western Canada grew by **3.8%**, Alberta recorded an increase of **0.6%**, and arrivals from British Columbia rose by **6.1%**.

For the seven months of Summer 2016, May to November, arrivals from Canada were flat, **0.5%** with **164,283** stopovers compared to **163,427** during the same time in 2015.

Cumulatively, the Canadian market with **327,130** visitors recorded a decline of **5.9%** or **20,534** less visitors than in 2015. The top producing provinces of Ontario with **222,982** fell by **3.6%**, and Quebec, with **37,402** visitors fell by **14.4%**.

Europe

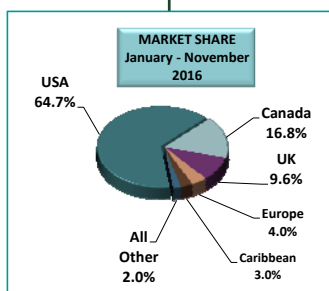
The European market region recorded a growth of **13.8%** in November 2016, with **26,503** stopover arrivals compared to the **23,296** recorded in November 2015.

In the Northern European region, the main visitor producing countries, United Kingdom, with **17,815** arrivals, grew by **17.1%** and Ireland with **159** arrivals declined by **15.4%**.

In the South-Western European region, Germany with **2,493** visitor arrivals grew by **3.3%**, Italy with **983** arrivals down by **0.9%**, the Netherlands with **735** visitors rose by **19.5%**, and Belgium with **730** arrivals rose by **28.1%**.

Stopover arrivals from Central-East Europe with **1,121** arrivals grew by **91.6%**. The main visitor producing country, Poland with **695** arrivals, grew by **226.3%**.

For the seven months of Summer 2016, May to November, arrivals from Europe grew by **3.9%**, with **159,445** arrivals compared to **153,496** in 2015.



Year-to-date, January to November 2016 period, arrivals from the European market grew by **6.1%**. Total stopover arrivals were **263,825** this was **15,152** more arrivals than the **248,673** recorded in 2015. Northern Europe grew by **6.0%**, moving from **192,469** in 2015 to **204,098** in 2016. Arrivals from the South/West region increased by **8.2%** with **54,309** arrivals, and those from the Central/East region declined by **10.0%** with **5,418** arrivals.

Latin America

Arrivals from Latin America fell by **23.2%** in November 2016, with a total of **2,032** stopovers compared to **2,646** in November 2015.

From the Central American region, stopover arrivals fell by **19.9%** with **779** arrivals. Mexico with **363** arrivals fell by **16.7%**, and Panama with **206** fell by **36.8%**.

From the South American region, stopover arrivals fell by **25.1%** with **1,253** arrivals. Brazil with **300** arrivals fell by **28.6%** and Argentina with **270** arrivals grew by **23.9%**.

For the seven months of Summer 2016, May to November arrivals from Latin America declined by **12.3%**, with **15,719** stopovers compared to **17,923** in 2015.

Cumulatively, January to November 2016, stopover arrivals from Latin America decreased by **6.9%**, with a total of **25,363** arrivals compared to **27,243** in 2015.

Stopovers from Central America increased by **9.9%**. The main Central American countries of Mexico, Costa Rica and Panama recorded increases of **6.1%**, **85.8%** and a decrease of **21.2%** respectively.

Stopovers from South America decreased by **15.0%** with **15,601** arrivals, The top producing countries of Chile with **4,048** arrivals fell by **19.9%**, and Argentina with **2,985** arrivals fell by **5.4%**.

The Caribbean

Stopover arrivals to Jamaica from the Caribbean region declined by **2.1%** in November 2016 with a total of **4,722** visitors, compared to **4,825** in November 2015.

The Cayman Islands and Trinidad & Tobago continued to be the major visitor producing Caribbean countries in November 2016 with **1,245** and **807** stopover arrivals, respectively.

Cumulatively, stopovers for the January - November 2016 period grew by **4.0%** moving from **56,008** in 2015 to **58,240** in 2016.

Asia

The Asian market decreased by **9.2%** in November 2016 with a total of **689** stopovers compared to **759** in November 2015.

China, India and Japan are the major visitor-producing countries with **334**, **129** and **109** stopovers arriving from each country, respectively.

For the January to November 2016 period, stopover arrivals from Asia fell by **3.0%**, with **8,140** arrivals compared to **8,396** arrivals in 2015.

Other Countries

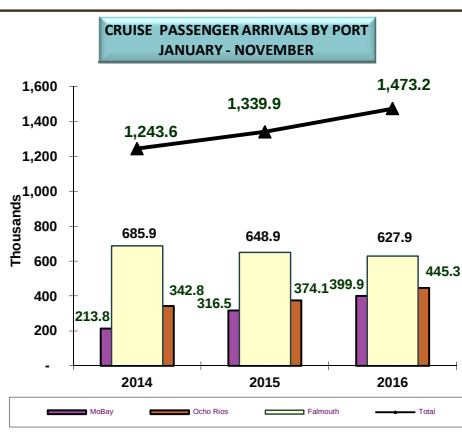
Overall, stopover arrivals from other countries decreased by **7.5%** for the period January to November 2016. Of the Other Countries, Australia provided the most stop-over arrivals to Jamaica, with **2,323** visitors in 2016 compared to **2,662** in 2015. This represents a decrease of **12.7%**.

Market Share

The market share of stopover visitors for the January to November 2016 was as follows: USA **64.7%**; Canada **16.8%**; UK **9.6%**; Continental Europe **4.0%**, the Caribbean **3.0%**; and the others, including Latin America and Asia **2.0%**.

Cruise Passengers

A total of **159,383** cruise passengers visited Jamaica in November, 2016. This represented a **17.7%** increase over the **135,450** for November 2015.



For November 2016, Cruise passengers visiting the Ocho Rios port increased by **69.5%** and those visiting Montego Bay increased by **75.9%**. Cruise passengers visiting the port of Falmouth port decreased by **34.1%**.

For the seven months of Summer, May to November 2016, cruise passengers visiting Jamaica increased by **6.3%**, with **728,004** passengers compared to **685,118** during the same period in 2015.

Year to date, January to November 2016 period saw **1,473,224** cruise passenger arrivals at the three major ports, an increase of **133,542** passengers or **10.0%**.

Length of Stay

The average length of stay of **Foreign National** arrivals in November 2016 was **8.7** nights, compared to **8.8** nights in 2015. The average length of stay in hotels was **6.9** nights in November 2016, this was the same level as in November 2015.

The average length of stay of **Non-Resident Jamaican** arrivals in November 2016 was **20.3** nights, this was the same level as in November 2015. The average length of stay in hotels in November 2016 was **7.7** nights, this was the same level as in November 2015.

During the January to November 2016 period the average length of stay of For-

eign National arrivals in all types of accommodations was **8.6** nights, this was the same level as in 2015. For the Non-Resident Jamaican arrivals the average length of stay was **16.3** nights compared to **15.9** nights in 2015.

Purpose of Visit

During the period January to November 2016, **90.2%** or **1,637,027** of the **1,816,801** **Foreign Nationals** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **4.8%** were on Business, **4.5%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.6%** did not state their purpose of travel.

A total of **107,190** or **79.7%** of the **134,430** **Non-Resident Jamaicans** were visiting for Leisure, **4.0%** were on Business, **13.2%** were on Other purposes of travel and **3.2%** failed to provide a reason for travel.

Year to date January to November 2016, **89.4%** or a total of **1,744,217** of the total stopover arrivals of **1,951,231** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **4.7%** were on Business, **5.1%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.8%** did not state their purpose of travel.

Intended Resort Area of Stay

Of the **163,152** stopover arrivals visiting Jamaica in November 2016, the resort area of Montego Bay welcomed **58,016** arrivals or **35.6%**; Ocho Rios welcomed **37,179** or **22.8%**; Negril received **32,718** or **20.1%**, and **15,966** or **9.8%** visited Kingston. The remaining **11.8%** stayed in the Mandeville/South Coast, Port Antonio resort regions and Other areas in Jamaica.

Between January and November 2016, the pattern remained the same. Montego Bay, Ocho Rios, and Negril accounted for **1,488,450** or **76.3%** of the stopover arrivals.

Of the **1,951,231** stopover visitors to Jamaica in the January to November 2016, **1,821,326** or **93.3%** used scheduled airlines, while **129,905** or **6.7%** used chartered flights.

During the corresponding period in 2015 the percentage distribution was: **93.5%** - used scheduled airlines and **6.5%** - used chartered flights.

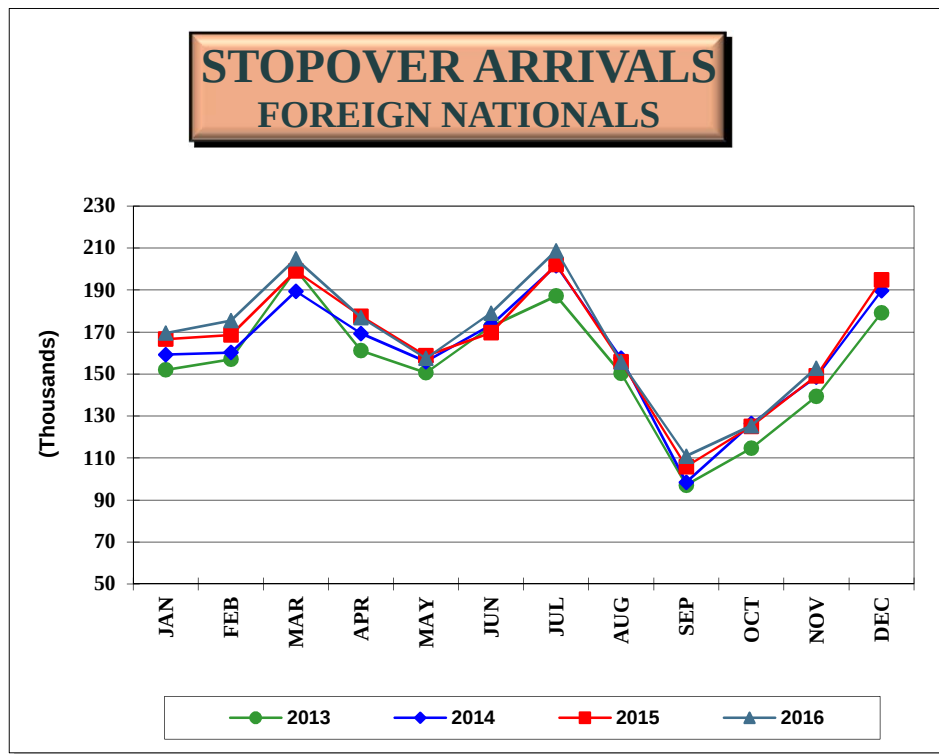

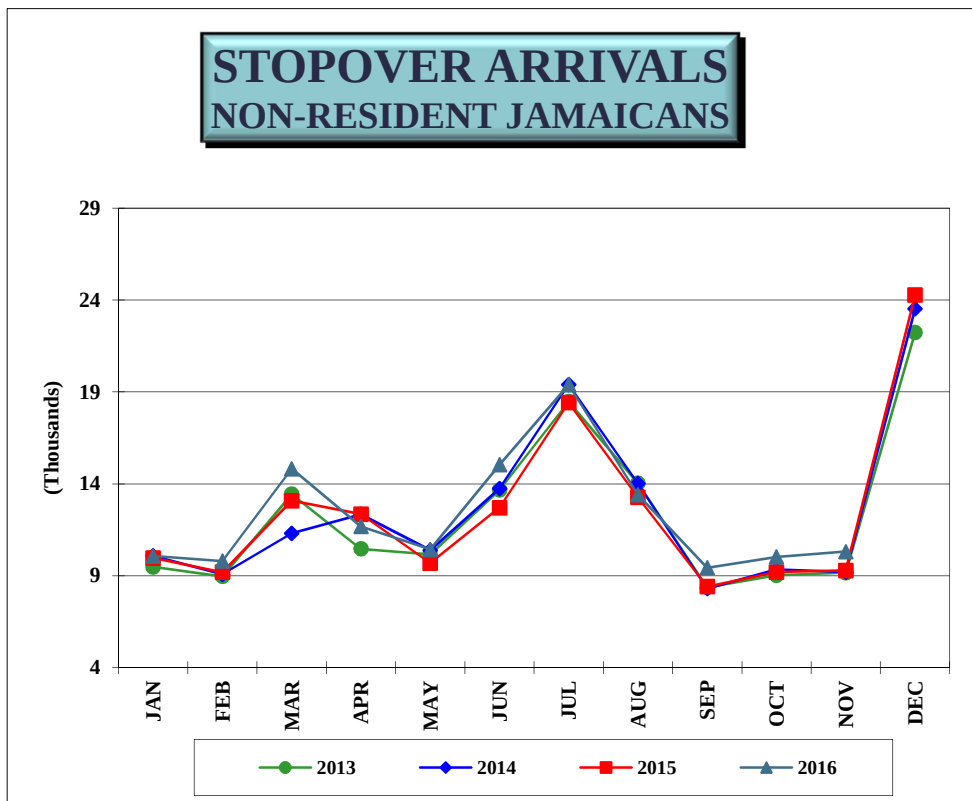

STOPOVER ARRIVALS BY PURPOSE OF VISIT JANUARY - NOVEMBER 2016

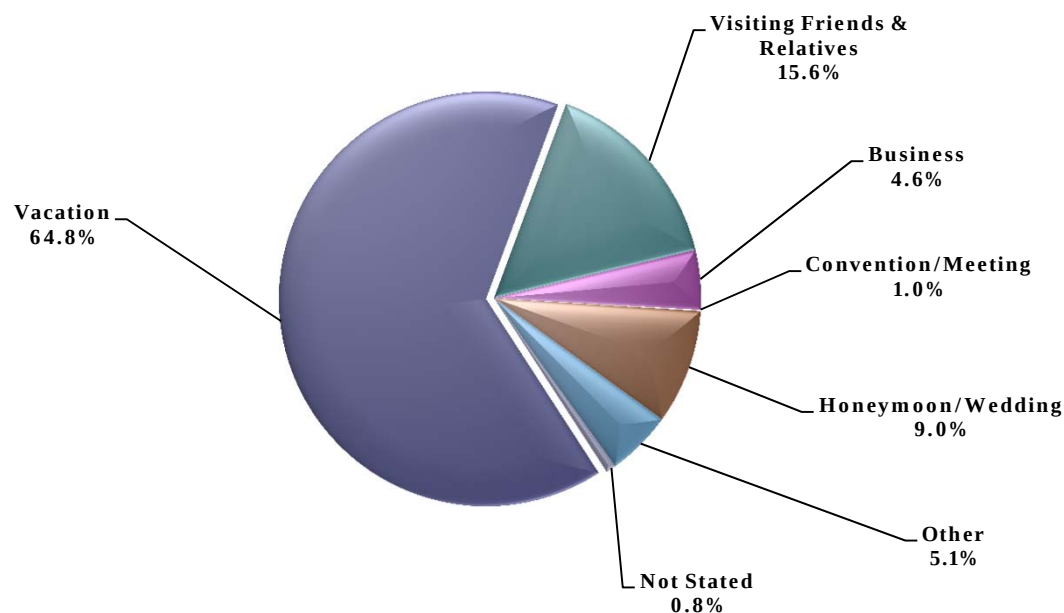

STOPOVER VISITORS BY MARKET SHARE

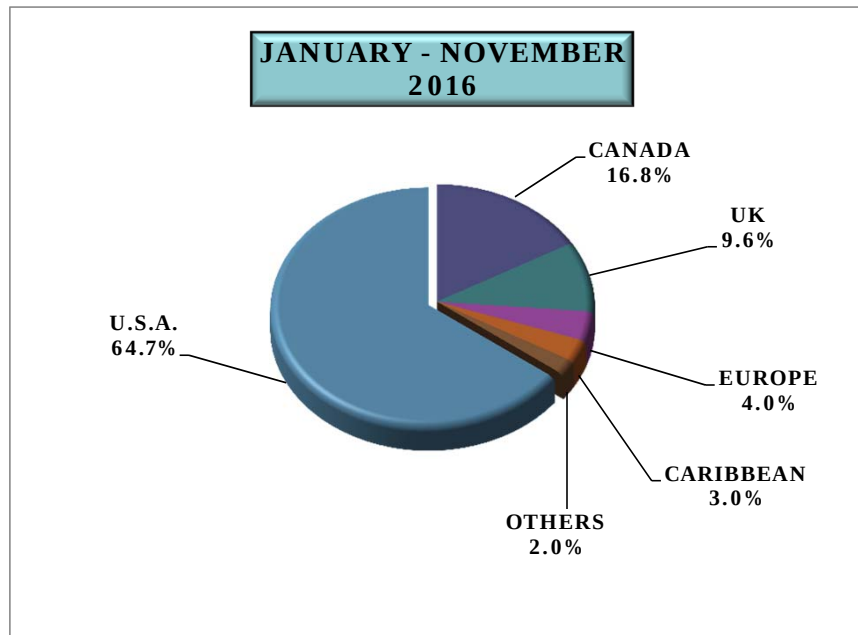

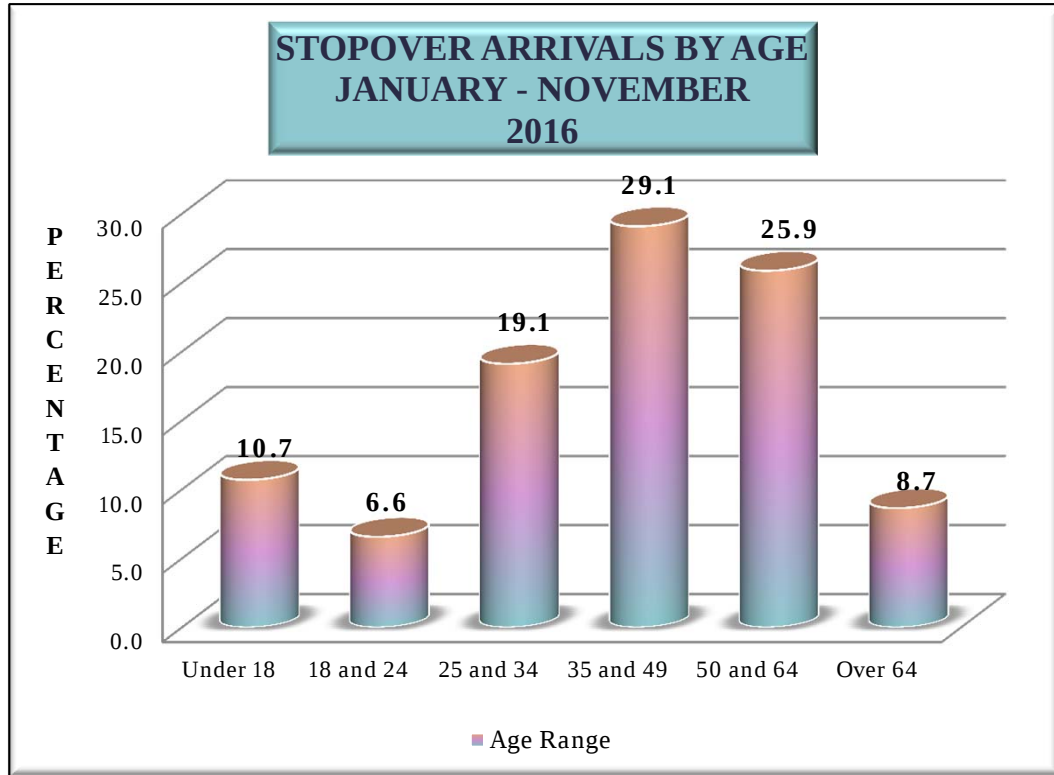

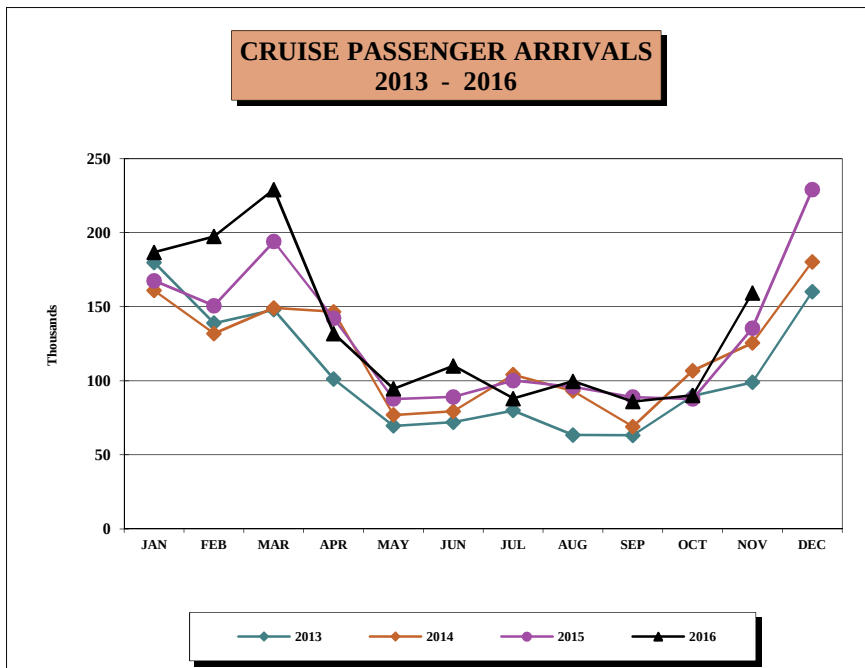

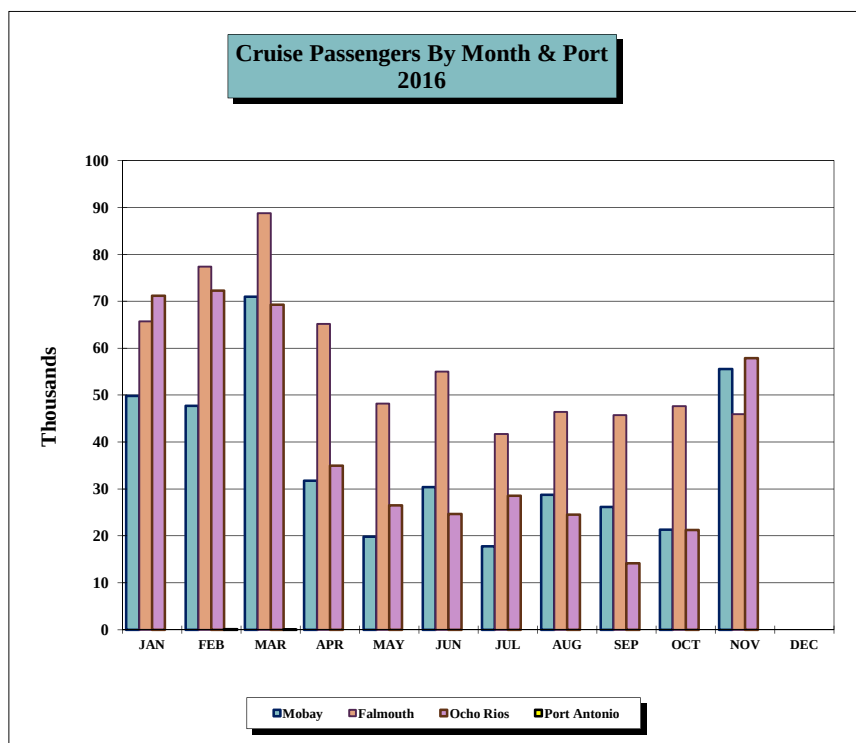

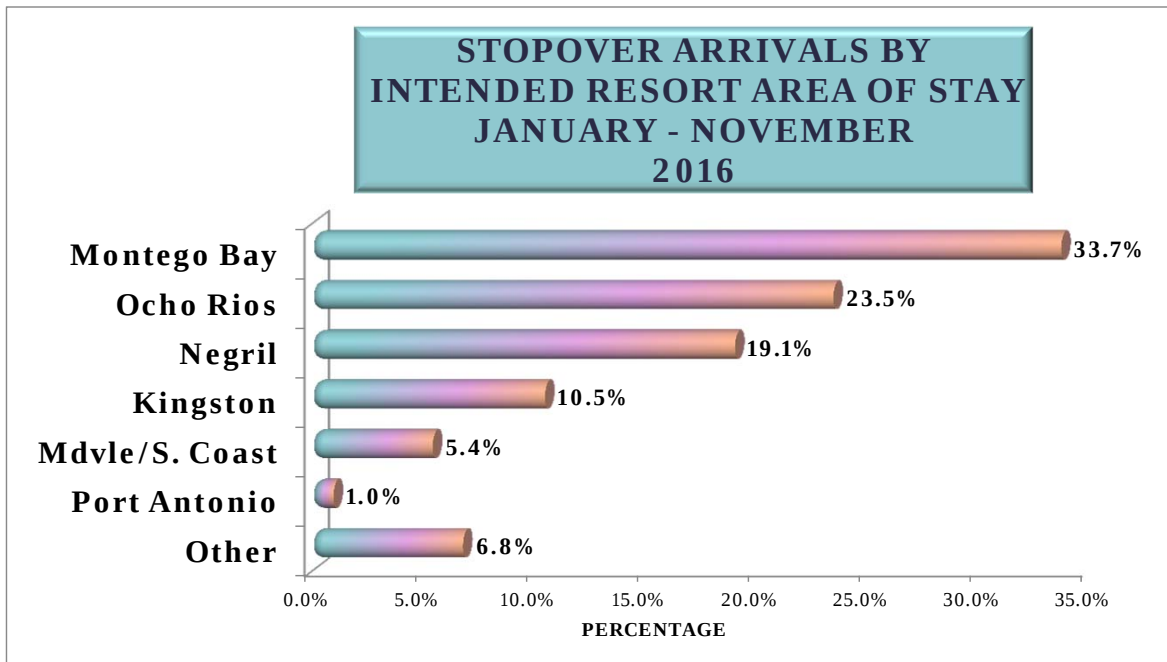
