TOURIST (Stopover Arrivals)

Stopover arrivals in October 2022 were **182,969** an increase of **53.5%** or **63,435** more arrivals over the **118,534** recorded in October 2021.

For the January to October period, arrivals increased by **83.6%**, with **1,999,760** stopovers, this is **910,791** more stopovers compared to the **1,088,969** in 2021.

United States

Stopover arrivals from the United States market recorded an increase of **36.5%** in October 2022, with a total of **133,112** arrivals compared to the **97,545** arrivals who visited in October 2021. All US marketing regions recorded increases in arrivals, the Northeast with **53,910** up by **27.0%**, the South with **44,548** up by **49.2%**, the Mid-West with **18,821** up by **29.5%**, and the West with **15,833** up by **47.7%**.

For the January to October period, the US market region has grown by **52.8%** with **1,515,091** arrivals. The Northeast up by **43.8%**, the South up by **68.0%**, the Midwest by **56.9%** and the West region up by **46.2%**, compared to the same period in 2021.

Canada


In October 2022, the Canadian market recorded an increase in arrivals of **175.7%**, with **20,143** or **12,838** more stopovers compared to the **7,305** in October 2021.

Stopover arrivals from Atlantic Canada recorded **846**; the main provinces of Newfoundland recorded **369** and Nova Scotia recorded **289**.

Stopover arrivals from Central Canada recorded **17,201**; the leading province of Ontario recorded **15,222**, the second most important Canadian province of Quebec recorded **1,979**.

Stopover arrivals from Western Canada recorded **2,096**; the main province of Alberta recorded **1,158**, while the arrivals from British Columbia recorded **618**.

Cumulatively, the Canadian market has recorded **194,045** visitors or **164,679** more visitors than in 2021. The top producing provinces of



Ontario has recorded **148,531**, and those from Quebec, were **19,915** visitors, compared to the same period in 2021.

Europe

The European market region has recorded an increase of **107.7%** in October 2022, with **22,190** stopover arrivals compared to the **10,686** recorded in October 2021.

In the Northern European region, the main visitor producing countries; United Kingdom, recorded **18,306** arrivals, and Ireland recorded **184** arrivals.

In the South-Western European region, Germany recorded **1,144** visitor arrivals, The Netherlands with **836**, and France with **398**.

Stopover arrivals from Central-Eastern Europe recorded **296** arrivals.

Y-T-D January to October 2022, arrivals from all the regions in Europe totalled **226,566** stopovers, this is **179,650** more stopovers compared to the **46,916** recorded during the same period in 2021.

Latin America

Arrivals from Latin America recorded **2,047** in October 2022, compared to **728** in October 2021.

From the Central American region, stopover arrivals were **597** arrivals. Mexico with **249** arrivals and Panama with **136**.

From the South American region, stopover arrivals were **1,450** arrivals. Argentina with **338** arrivals, Brazil with **299**, and Colombia with **225** arrivals.

Cumulatively, for the January to October 2022 period, stopover arrivals from Latin America totalled **18,609** which was **13,736** more visitors compared to the **4,873** during the same period in 2021.

Stopovers from the Central American region was **5,875** arrivals up by **104.1%** and from the South American region, up by **538.6%** with **12,734** arrivals, compared to the same period in 2021.

The Caribbean

Stopover arrivals to Jamaica from the Caribbean region were up **95.1%** in October 2022 with a total of **3,873** visitors, compared to **1,985** in October 2021.

The Cayman Is. and Trinidad & Tobago were the major visitor producing Caribbean countries in October 2022 with **1,213** and **739** stopover arrivals, respectively.

Year to date, stopovers for the January to October period rose by **182.0%** moving up from **14,041** in 2021 to **39,597** in 2022.

Asia

The Asian market increased by **48.5%** in October 2022 with a total of **288** stopovers compared to **194** in October 2021.

China, India, and Japan, are the major visitor-producing countries with **102**, **94** and **39** stopovers arriving from each country, respectively.

Year to date, stopovers for the January to October period rose by **121.4%** moving up from **1,205** in 2021 to **2,668** in 2022.

Other Countries

Overall, stopover arrivals from other countries rose by **208.2%** with **3,184** arrivals, for the January to October 2022 period. Of the Other Countries, African Countries provided the most stop-over arrivals to Jamaica, with **1,114** visitors compared to **439** in 2021. This represents an increase of **153.6%**.


Market

The market share of stopover visitors for the period January to October 2022 was as follows: USA **75.8%**; Canada **9.7%**; UK **9.5%**; Continental Europe **1.8%**, the Caribbean **2.0%**; and the others, including Latin America and Asia **1.2%**.

Cruise Passengers

A total of **75,796** cruise passengers visited Jamaica in October 2022. A total of **30,723** visited the port of Falmouth,

27,297 visited the port of Ocho Rios, and **17,348** visited the port of Montego Bay.



Year-to-date, January to October 2022 saw **585,322** cruise passenger arrivals from 213 ship calls visited our shores. Compared to **16,237** passengers from **10** ship calls during Y-T-D August to October 2021.

Length of Stay

The average length of stay of **Foreign National** arrivals in October 2022 was **7.6** nights, compared to **8.5** nights in October 2021. The average length of stay in hotels was **6** nights in October 2022, compared to **6.1** nights in October 2021.

The average length of stay of **Non-Resident Jamaican** arrivals in October 2022 was **16.1** nights compared to **26.7** in October 2021. The average length of stay in hotels in October 2022 was **7.9** nights, compared to **8** nights in October 2021.

During the January to October 2022 period, the average length of stay for Foreign National arrivals in all types of accommodations was **7.9** nights compared to **8.8** nights in 2021. For the Non-Resident Jamaican arrivals the average length of stay was **16.9** nights compared to **24.9** nights.

Purpose of Visit

During the month of October 2022, **92.2%** or **156,720** of the **169,973 Foreign Nationals** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **3.3%** were on Business, **4.3%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.2%** did not state their purpose of travel.

A total of **9,911** or **82.6%** of the **11,996 Non-Resident Jamaicans** were visiting for Leisure, **4.4%** were on Business, **12.2%**

were on Other purposes of travel and **0.8%** failed to provide a reason for travel.

Year-to-date January to October 2022, **90.6%** or a total of **1,811,836** of the total stopover arrivals of **1,999,760** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **2.1%** were on Business, **6.8%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.5%** did not state their travel purpose.

Intended Resort Area of Stay

Of the **181,969** stopover arrivals visiting Jamaica in October 2022, the resort area of Montego Bay welcomed **70,622** arrivals or **38.8%**; Ocho Rios welcomed **37,426** or **20.6%**; Negril received **32,515** or **17.9%**, and **16,489** or **9.1%** visited Kingston. The remaining **13.7%** stayed in the Mandeville/South Coast, Port Antonio resort regions and Other areas in Jamaica.

Between January and October 2022, the combination of Montego Bay, Negril, and Ocho Rios accounted for **1,554,983** or **77.8%** of the **1,999,760** total stopover arrivals.

Type of Airlines used

Of the **1,999,760** stopover visitors to Jamaica in the January to October 2022, **1,871,339** or **93.6%** used scheduled airlines, while **128,421** or **6.4%** used chartered flights.

During the corresponding period in 2021 the percentage distribution was: **98.6%** - used scheduled airlines and **1.4%** - used chartered flights.

Net Promoter Score (NPS)

This is a simple metric that can be used to measure the intention to recommend/refer a travel destination and is also an indicator of overall satisfaction with the travel or customer experience.

The NPS for YTD 2022 are as follows:

NPS ranges from -100 (meaning everyone is a detractor) to +100 (meaning everyone is a promoter). A decent Net Promoter Score is any number >0%. Any positive NPS is good. An NPS of +50 is excellent.





2022**



STOPOVER VISITORS BY MARKET SHARE






