TOURIST (Stopover Arrivals)

Stopover arrivals in August 2016 were **169,023**, less than **40** arrivals when compared to the **169,063** recorded in August 2015.

For the four months of Summer 2016, May to August, arrivals were up **2.5%**, with **759,164** stopovers compared to **740,436** in 2015.

Year to date, January to August 2016, arrivals increased by **2.4%**, with **1,532,272** stopovers compared to **1,496,899** in 2015.

United States

Stopover arrivals from the United States market recorded a **0.6%** increase in August 2016 with a total of **111,726** arrivals compared to the **111,083** arrivals who visited in August 2015. The US marketing regions recorded mixed results in arrivals. The Northeast with **58,207** fell by **3.1%**, the South with **25,690** fell by **0.7%**, the Mid-west with **13,763** increased by **8.1%**, and the West with **14,066** increased by **13.7%**.

For the four months of Summer 2016, May to August, the US market region recorded a **4.1%** increase in arrivals, with **536,370** visitors compared to the **515,400** visitors during the same period in 2015. The Northeast was flat **-0.7%**, the South was up **5.0%**, the Midwest was up **7.5%** and the West up **14.6%**.

Year-to-date, January to August 2016, the US market region has grown by **4.9%**, with **1,007,941** visitors compared to the **960,505** visitors during the same period in 2015. This was **47,436** more arrivals than in 2015, as well as, **79,764** more than in 2014. The Northeast was up by **1.9%**, the Mid-west up by **5.0%**, the South up by **5.4%**, and the West was up **16.1%**.

Canada

In August 2016, the Canadian market recorded a decline in arrivals of **3.9%**, with **23,406** stopovers compared to **24,349** in August 2015.

Stopover arrivals from Atlantic Canada grew by **12.6%**, the main provinces of New Brunswick increased by **41.5%**, over August 2015 and those from Nova Scotia decreased by **26.0%**.

Stopover arrivals from Central Canada fell by **4.6%**, the leading province of Ontario fell by **4.4%**, and the second most important Canadian province of Quebec recorded a decrease of **5.6%**.

Stopover arrivals from Western Canada grew by **0.9%**, Alberta recorded a decline of **10.9%**, and arrivals from British Columbia rose by **41.8%**.

For the four months of Summer 2016, May to August, arrivals from Canada fell by **1.4%** with **92,567** stopovers compared to **93,863** during the same time in 2015.

Cumulatively, the Canadian market with **255,414** visitors recorded a decline of **8.2%** or **22,686** less visitors than in 2015. The top producing provinces of Ontario with **172,506** fell by **5.4%**, and Quebec, with **30,071** visitors fell by **16.5%**.

Europe

The European market region recorded a decline of **0.3%** in August 2016, with **23,185** stopover arrivals compared to the **23,250** recorded in August 2015.

In the Northern European region, the main visitor producing countries, United Kingdom, with **17,640** arrivals, fell by **2.6%** and Ireland with **186** arrivals increased by **24.8%**.

In the South-Western European region, Italy with **1,558** arrivals grew by **24.7%**, Germany with **1,222** visitor arrivals increased by **0.7%**, France with **539** arrivals grew by **52.3%**, the Netherlands with **463** visitors fell by **9.6%**, and Belgium with **359** arrivals rose by **15.8%**.

Stopover arrivals from Central-East Europe with **262** arrivals fell by **7.7%**.

For the four months of Summer 2016, May to August, arrivals from Europe was flat **0.0%**, with **91,216** arrivals compared to **91,235** in 2015.

Year-to-date, January to August 2016 period, arrivals from the European market grew by **4.9%**. Total stopover arrivals were **195,596** this was **9,184** more arrivals than the **186,412** recorded in 2015. Northern Europe grew by **5.6%**, moving from **143,843** in 2015 to **151,968** in 2016. Arrivals from the South/West region increased by **6.1%** with **40,004** arrivals, and those from the Central/East region declined by **25.7%** with **3,624** arrivals.

Latin America

Arrivals from Latin America fell by **5.3%** in August 2016, with a total of **2,661** stopovers compared to **2,809** in August 2015.

From the Central American region, stopover arrivals rose by **40.3%** with **929** arrivals. Mexico with **569** arrivals grew by **80.6%**, and Panama with **121** fell by **6.2%**.


From the South American region, stopover arrivals fell by **19.3%** with **1,732** arrivals. Chile with **400** arrivals fell by **7.8%** and Ecuador with **360** arrivals fell by **52.3%**.

For the four months of Summer 2016, May to August arrivals from Latin America declined by **15.3%**, with **8,975** stopovers compared to **10,593** in 2015.

Cumulatively, January to August 2016, stopover arrivals from Latin America decreased by **6.5%**, with a total of **18,619** arrivals compared to **19,913** in 2015.

Stopovers from Central America increased by **16.0%**. The main Central American countries of Mexico, Costa Rica and Panama recorded increases of **8.2%**, **116.7%** and a decrease of **17.5%** respectively.

Stopovers from South America decreased by **16.7%** with **11,432** arrivals, The top producing countries of Chile with **9,172** arrivals fell by **9.1%**, and Argentina with **2,247** arrivals fell by **11.0%**.



The Caribbean

Stopover arrivals to Jamaica from the Caribbean region increased by **6.3%** in August 2016 with a total of **6,847** visitors, compared to **6,439** in August 2015.

The Cayman Islands and Trinidad & Tobago continued to be the major visitor producing Caribbean countries in August 2016 with **1,539** and **1,483** stopover arrivals, respectively.

Cumulatively, stopovers for the January - August 2016 period grew by **7.4%** moving from **41,238** in 2015 to **44,272** in 2016.

Asia

The Asian market increased by **8.8%** in August 2016 with a total of **702** stopovers compared to **645** in August 2015.

China, Japan, and India, are the major visitor-producing countries with **330**, **143** and **134** stopovers arriving from each country, respectively.

For the January to August 2016 period, stopover arrivals from Asia grew by **1.8%**, with **6,141** arrivals compared to **6,035** arrivals in 2015.

Other Countries

Overall, stopover arrivals from other countries decreased by **8.7%** in the January to August 2016. Of the Other Countries, Australia provided the most stop-over arrivals to Jamaica, with **1,793** visitors in 2016 compared to **2,109** in 2015. This represents a decrease of **15.0%**.


Market Share

The market share of stopover visitors for the January to August 2016 was as follows: USA **65.8%**; Canada **16.7%**; UK **8.9%**; Continental Europe **3.9%**, the Caribbean **2.9%**; and the others, including Latin America and Asia **1.9%**.

Cruise Passengers

A total of **99,677** cruise passengers visited Jamaica in August, 2016. This represented a **3.9%** increase over the **95,962** for August 2015.

For August 2016, Cruise passengers visiting the Falmouth port increased by **2.4%**. Cruise passengers visiting the port of Ocho Rios increased by **64.1%** and those visiting Montego Bay decreased by **19.5%**.



For the four months of Summer, May to August 2016, cruise passengers visiting Jamaica increased by **5.2%**, with **392,355** passengers compared to **372,981** during the same period in 2015.

Year to date, January to August 2016 period saw **1,137,575** cruise passenger arrivals at the three major ports, an increase of **110,030** passengers or **10.7%**.

Length of Stay

The average length of stay of **Foreign National** arrivals in August 2016 was **8.9** nights, compared to **9** nights in 2015. The average length of stay in hotels was **6.9** nights in August 2016, this was the same level as in August 2015.

The average length of stay of **Non-Resident Jamaican** arrivals in August 2016 was **15.0** nights, this was the same level as in August 2015. The average length of stay in hotels in August 2016 was **8.5** nights, this was also the same level as August 2015.

During the January to August 2016 period the average length of stay of Foreign

National arrivals in all types of accommodations was **8.6** nights, this was the same level as in 2015. For the Non-Resident Jamaican arrivals the average length of stay was **16** nights compared to **15.5** nights in 2015.

Purpose of Visit During the period January to August 2016, **90.4%** or **1,290,069** of the **1,427,524** **Foreign Nationals** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **4.5%** were on Business, **4.5%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.6%** did not state their purpose of travel.

A total of **84,906** or **81.1%** of the **104,648** **Non-Resident Jamaicans** were visiting for Leisure, **3.6%** were on Business, **12.2%** were on Other purposes of travel and **3.1%** failed to provide a reason for travel.

Year to date January to August 2016, **89.7%** or a total of **1,374,975** of the total stopover arrivals of **1,532,172** visited Jamaica for Leisure, **4.5%** were on Business, **5.0%** were on Other purposes of travel and **0.8%** did not state their purpose of travel.

Intended Resort Area of Stay Of the **169,023** stopover arrivals visiting Jamaica in August 2016, the resort area of Montego Bay welcomed **54,924** arrivals or **32.5%**; Ocho Rios welcomed **38,876** or **23.0%**; Negril received **30,146** or **17.8%**, and **19,111** or **11.3%** visited Kingston. The remaining **15.3%** stayed in the Mandeville/South Coast, Port Antonio resort regions and Other areas in Jamaica.

Between January and August 2016, the pattern remained the same. Montego Bay, Ocho Rios, and Negril accounted for **1,167,289** or **76.2%** of the stopover arrivals.

Type of Airlines used Of the **1,532,272** stopover visitors to Jamaica in the January to August 2016, **1,430,666** or **93.4%** used scheduled airlines, while **101,606** or **6.6%** used chartered flights.

During the corresponding period in 2015 the percentage distribution was: **93.5%** - used scheduled airlines and **6.5%** - used chartered flights.





STOPOVER ARRIVALS BY PURPOSE OF VISIT JANUARY - AUGUST 2016












