This procurement proceedings will be administered under the GOJ Handbook (March 2014) of Public Sector Procurement Procedures and Procurement Act 2015 "Exclusion" Procedures and Procurement Act 2015 "Exclusion" provisions for the placement of the Jamaica CARES Travel Health Insurance and Support Logistics package. This Programme is intended to be mandatory for all persons travelling to the island on non-Jamaican passports. Bids satisfying the minimum technical requirements will be ranked based on premium, and the three (3) highest ranked bidders will be selected as the eligible providers ("Winners") of the Programme. This process will not result in a contract agreement between the successful bidders ("Winners") and the Jamaica Tourist Board or the Government of Jamaica. The procuring entity reserves the right to accept or reject any proposal and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids without thereby incurring any liability to bidders at any time prior to the acceptance of the successful bids.
